GAME NOTES

 Virginia Tech is now 24-12-6 against North Carolina.

• Virginia Tech owns a 26-1 mark under Fuente when leading at halftime.

• The game was the first time since 9/22/07 that Virginia Tech had three players complete a pass. All three (Hooker, Willis and Patterson) completed touchdowns.

• The game was only the 10th tenth in Tech football history since 1996 that the Hokies had 60 or more rushing attempts.

JUSTIN FUENTE

• Moves to 30-17 at Virginia Tech and 56-40 in his career.

• The Hokies are 21-3 under Fuente when scoring 30 or more points.

ACC FOOTBALL NOTE

• The game was the first six overtime contest in league history.

PLAYER NOTES QUINCY PATTERSON

• Career highs in completions (3), attempts (6) and yards passing (54). Had his first career touchdown thow.

• Had 122 rushing yards on 21 attempts, both career bests.

• Scored his first career rushing touchdown on a 53-yard run.

HENDON HOOKER

• One passing touchdown, the seventh of his career.

• Has had at least one in every contest since becoming the starter 10/5 at Miami.

RYAN WILLIS

• Threw one touchdown pass, his ninth of the season and 45th of his career.

TRE TURNER

• Career long 55-yard reception in the first quarter.

• Finished with one touchdown, his second of 2019.

- First 100-yard receiving game of his career, finishing with 106 yards.
- Tied a career high with five receptions.

DAMON HAZELTON

 Second two-touchdown receiving game of his career.

- Takes his total to four touchdowns on the season and 13 in his career VT (17 overall).
- Had three receptions for 43 yards.

DALTON KEENE

• First career rushes in the game.

• Finished the game with seven carries for 25 yards.

Caught one pass for 18 yards.

DESHAWN MCCLEASE

• Scored one rushing touchdown, his third of the season and eighth of his career.

• Third consecutive game with a rushing touchdown.

Finished with 13 carries for 72 yards.
 RAYSHARD ASHBY

• Team high 17 tackles (4 solo).

Registered 0.5 sacks in the game. Season tally is 3.0 on season and 4.0 for his career.
He has led the team in tackles five times this season.

JARROD HEWITT

Had five tackles in the game, three solo.
Tallied 3.0 TFL and 2.5 sacks, both career highs.

• Now has 4.0 TFL and 3.0 sacks on the season.

Also had two quarterback hurries against UNC.

DEVON HUNTER

First start of 2019 at rover.

• Career high 8 tackles (4 solo).

CHAMARRI CONNER

Posted nine tackles in the game (4 solo).Broke up one pass, his seventh of the season.

NORRELL POLLARD

• Set a new career best with five tackles (3 solo).

• Had two sacks, a career best. Now has 3.0 on the season.

• Also had one quarterback hurry.

CALEB FARLEY

• Career high four passes defended, all in the first half of play.

AUSTIN CANNON

• First career start at left guard.
