GAME NOTES

- Virginia Tech is now 15-22 all-time vs. Miami.
- The Hokies have won 27 straight contests when holding foes to 21 points or fewer dating back to 2015.
- Virginia Tech owns a 24-1 mark under Fuente when leading at halftime.

JUSTIN FUENTE

- Moves to 28-17 at Virginia Tech and 54-40 in his career.
- Improves to 3-2 against teams from Florida in his Virginia Tech career.
- Moved to 2-2 in th4 state of Florida with Virginia Tech.
- The Hokies are 19-3 under Fuente when scoring 30 or more points.

HENDON HOOKER

- First career start.
- Career high 10 completions and 184 yards.
- Threw his first career TD pass in the first quarter, a 20-yard strike to Keene.
- Responsible for four touchdowns; three through the air and one on the ground.

DALTON KEENE

- Three receiving touchdowns.
- Five receptions tied a career high (12/1/18 vs. Marshall)
- First multi-touchdown game of his career.

JAMES MITCHELL

- First career rushing TD.
- Second career TD.
- Career best 67-yard reception in the fourth quarter set up a score.
- Career high 74 yards receiving.

JERMAINE WALLER

- Two interceptions in the game, a new career best.
- Two interceptions on the season, three for his career.

CALEB FARLEY

- Reorded his second and third INT of the season.
- Second career two INT game (at FSU 9/3/18).
- Now owns five career INTs.

REGGIE FLOYD

- Had three pass breakups, a new career high.

CHAMARRI CONNER

- First forced fumble of his career.
- Three passes defended, a career best.

DIVINE DEABLO

- First forced fumble of the season. second of his career.
- Had one pass defended and recorded a QB hurry.

RAYSHARD ASHBY

- Led the Hokies with 11 tackles - (6 solo).
- Had 2.0 TFL and 1.0 sacks, bringing his season tally to 2.5 sacks.

LPD FORCES FIVE TURNOVERS

- The Hokies' defense forced four turnovers against the 'Canes in the first quarter. The last time that the Hokies forced four turnovers in a quarter was in 1998 at Miami.
- The five total forced turnovers are the most since forcing that many at Florida State in 2018.
- The last time an opponent tossed four interceptions was against Duke (10/26/13).
- The game served as the fifth time that the Hokies have forced five turnovers in a half since 1987. The most recent occasion had been at North Carolina (11/3/10).
- The defense also tallied six sacks in the game, setting a new season high.
