GAME NOTES

- Virginia Tech is now 10-7 against Georgia Tech.
- With the win, Virginia Tech is now bowl eligible for the 27th consecutive season, the longest active bowl streak in America.
- The win snaps the Jackets' three-game winning streak in the series.
- The Hokies move to 2-2 on the road in 2019.
- Tech has won four consecutive ACC games in the same season for the first time since winning seven straight en route to an ACC Coastal Championship in 2011.
- The 45 points are the most that Virginia Tech has ever scored in the series at Georgia Tech.

HEAD COACH JUSTIN FUENTE

- Moves to 32-18 at Virginia Tech and 58-41 in his career.
- Improves to 21-0 at Virginia Tech when holding opponents to 20 or less points.
- Has now defeated every team in the Coastal Division at least once (was 0-3 vs. Georgia Tech).
- Has taken his team to a bowl in six straight seasons.

PLAYER NOTES

QB HENDON HOOKER

- Improved to 5-0 as the starting QB.
- Scored Two rushing TDs Saturday taking his season total to four.
- He was also 9 of 13 throwing for 159 yards and one TD.

RB KESHAWN KING

- One rushing TD Saturday, the second of his career.

DB KHALIL LADLER

- Wore Coach Beamer's number 25 jersey in the game and had four solo tackles.

TE JAMES MITCHELL

- Had one TD reception, his second of the season.
- Second straight game with a score, after rushing for a TD against Wake Forest (11/9).

WR TAYVION ROBINSON

- Career best 49-yard rush in the first quarter.
- Returned three punts for 34 yards.

LB DAX HOLLIFIELD

- Had one interception in the game, his third straight game with an INT.
- Was also in on three stops (two solo)

CB CALEB FARLEY

- Scored on a 17-yard INT return.
- The INT is his fourth of the season.

DB CHAMARRI CONNER

- Registered 2.0 TFL in the game and led the team with seven total tackles.

DE DASHAWN CRAWFORD

- Forced a fumble and had 1.5 sacks in the game.
- On the season, he now has 2.5 sacks.
- Had three total tackles in the game.

FS DIVINE DEABLO

- Had one pass breakup and one TFL.
- Recorded three solo tackles.

LB ALAN TISDALE

- Registered 2.0 sacks in the game, bringing his season tally to 3.0.
- Had three total tackles in the game.

K BRIAN JOHNSON

- Made a 22-yard field goal.
- He is 7 for 7 on attempts between 20 and 29 yards this season.

TEAM

- The 31 points scored in the first half were the most in a half since scoring 34 vs. William & Mary in 2018.
- Tech's last shutout was a 10-0 victory over UVA in 2017.
- Georgia Tech hadn't been shut out since 10/18/97 when they lost 38-0 at FSU. Their scoring streak was at 282 straight games.
