WR DAMON HAZELTON

- One TD reception, his sixth of the season.
 He now has 14 for his VT career and 18 overall
- Five receptions in the game tied a season best. Those catches went for 63 yards.
- Third straight game with a receiving TD.

CB ARMANI CHATMAN

- Wore Coach Beamer's number 25 jersey.
- Made four solo tackles.

LB RAYSHARD ASHBY

- Made 13 total stops, 11 solo.
- Forced a fumble.
- 3.0 TFL, brining his season total to 13.0.
- Has led the team in tackles six times this season.

FS DIVINE DEABLO
