QB Hendon Hooker

On the team's turnaround (since the Duke game September 27)

"It's really unique. Everyone's just coming together as a family and showing love and support. At the same time, everyone's expected to do their job. It's been good."

On the support from the defense the past two weeks

"That's great. I love seeing defensive touchdowns, that's big time. Just kind of moving forward, I'm happy those guys are playing their game and having fun. We're just getting after it."

On his relationship with r-senior QB Ryan Willis

"We're roommates on the road. I kind of told him I'm trying to get this win for you for Senior Day so you can go out with a bang. We're real close in the quarterback room, we show each other some love and he encouraged me to have a good game."
