About Tonight's Game

The Hokies enter the game 18-3 on the season and 7-2 in ACC play ... The Cardinals are 16-6 this season and 7-2 in the ACC ... The Hokies are ranked 12th in the AP poll and 11th in the USA Today Coaches poll and Louisville is 15th in the AP and 16th in the coaches poll.

Last Game: #12 VT 47, #23 NCSU 24

There was a lot of history made on Saturday in PNC Arena, as the Hokies defeated NC State, 47-24 ... Tech held the Wolfpack to just 16.7 percent from the field in the win ... **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, had his fourth double-double of the season with 13 points and 13 rebounds and **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** added 11 points in the win ... A full listing of records and notes are on page 2 of this release.

Vs. Louisville

The Hokies are 8-33 all-time against Louisville and have lost the last 14 games against the Cardinals ... Tech lost the last meeting in Cassell Coliseum, 75-68 on Feb. 24, 2018 ... Tech is 3-15 at home against the Cards, with all 18 games being played in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech is 0-5 against Louisville under **Buzz Williams** ... Tech is 0-5 against Louisville in ACC regular season games and 6-31 all-time in conference games, dating back to the Metro Conference.

BIG Again This Season

The Hokies will host two "Big Monday" games, beginning with tonight's game against Louisville and including the Feb. 18 game against Virginia ... Tech was 2-0 in "Big Monday" games last season, both at home and both against top 10 teams, including a win over No. 10 North Carolina ... The game at North Carolina on Jan. 21, 2019 was the Hokies' first of three Big Monday games this season and its first-ever on the road ... Last season was the first year the Hokies had ever been part of the "Big Monday" package.

Being Ranked

The Hokies are currently ranked 12th in the AP poll ... Tech is ranked for the 14th consecutive week (including the preseason poll), the second-longest streak in school history ... The longest is 17 consecutive weeks in the 1995-96 season.

The Wolfpack's 24 points are:

- the fewest by a ranked team in the shot clock era.
- the fewest by a Virginia Tech opponent in an ACC game.
- the fewest points in a conference (any conference) game since 2008.
- the fewest points by any Virginia Tech opponent since Jan. 9, 1959, when the Hokies defeated Washington and Lee, 105-24, in Blacksburg.
- NCSU's fewest points in a regular season game since joining the ACC (1953-54).
- the fewest points scored by any Division I team in the last decade.

More Virginia Tech notes:

The 71 combined points are the fewest in an ACC game in the shot clock era.

The Wolfpack's 16.7 percent from the field is the lowest in NCSU history.

The 23-point margin of victory is the largest for the Hokies over NC State since a 43-12 victory in Lynchburg on Feb. 22, 1921. It is the largest margin over victory over NC State in Raleigh.

The Wolfpack's 10 2nd half points are the fewest by a Tech opponent in an ACC game.

The Hokies picked up their first win in PNC Arena since a 77-69 win on Feb. 2, 2011.

Wrapping Up the NCSU Game

Kerry Blackshear

Jr., scored 13 points and grabbed 13 rebounds, both team highs ... He now has four double-doubles this season and eight for his career ... **Wabissa Bede**, **Ahmed Hill** and **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** all played all 40 minutes ... That is a career-high for Bede and ties a career-high for Alexander-Walker ...

Isaiah Wilkins played 17 minutes, the most for him in an ACC game ... Bede set new personal, ACC highs with nine points, four steals and three, three-point field goals ... **Jon Kabongo** entered the game having played a total of two minutes in ACC action this season ... He played five minutes in the first half.

Hitting the Boards

The Hokies grabbed an ACC season-high 42 rebounds in the win at NC State ... Virginia Tech grabbed 42 rebounds in the win over North Carolina A&T (42-20) ... The last time Tech grabbed at least 42 rebounds in a non-overtime ACC game was on Jan. 7, 2014, when Tech grabbed 42 rebounds against Syracuse ... The last time the Hokies had more than 42 rebounds in a non-overtime ACC game was on Jan. 19, 2013, when Tech had 43 rebounds in a home win over Wake Forest.

A New All-Time Leader

In the win over Syracuse, **Justin Robinson** dished out eight assists, and in doing so, became the all-time leader in career assists at Virginia Tech, passing Malcolm Delaney and former leader Bimbo Coles ... He now has 551 career assists ... Robinson averages 4.6 assists per game in his career and is averaging 5.5 assists per game this season ... He is second in the ACC in assists this season and is first among active ACC players in career assists.



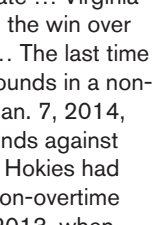

5 is Honored

Justin Robinson has been named the Atlantic Coast Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week, for the week ending Jan. 27, 2019 ... This is the first time Robinson has been honored by the ACC ... This is the second time this season that a Hokie has received the honor ... **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** was honored for the week ending Nov. 18, 2018.

Take-Aways from Miami

In the Hokies' win at Miami on Wednesday night, **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** tied a school-record for steals in an ACC game, with six ... It was also NAW's career-high in the category ... He becomes the seventh Hokie with six steals in an ACC game and the first since 2008.

Naw on Offense in MIA

In the win at Miami, **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** scored 25 points, tying his career-high in an ACC game ... For the ninth time this season, Alexander-Walker dropped 20 or more points ... The nine 20-point games is tied for third-most in the ACC on the season ... The Toronto native also had his best two-game stretch of distributing, with five assists at Miami and eight against Syracuse on Jan. 26, for a total of 13.

They are Free

The Hokies enter tonight's game having made 258 of 342 free throw attempts (75.4 percent) ... Tech has made 197 of its last 252 attempts (78.2 percent) and is shooting 78.9 percent from the line in ACC competition ... Tech set a season high at North Carolina, when Tech was 15 of 16 from the line, for 93.8 percent ... Two Hokies, **Ahmed Hill** (86.1 percent) and **Justin Robinson** (82.5 percent) are shooting better than 80 percent from the line ... Tech has made better than 80 percent from the line in nine of 21 games so far this season and six of its nine ACC games ... The school record for field goal percentage in a season is 75.0 percent in the 1980-81 season ... Tech is third in the ACC in free throw percentage and leads the league in free throw percentage in conference games ... Tech is 28th nationally in free throw percentage.

January was a Good Month

Virginia Tech finished 6-2 in January ... This marks the first month since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season that the Hokies have won six ACC games ... Tech is 1-0 in February.

North of 80

Virginia Tech defeated Miami, 82-70, in Coral Gables on Wednesday night ... The 82 points are the most for the Hokies in an ACC road win since Tech downed Boston College, 85-80, in overtime 364 days earlier ... It is the most points scored in a non-overtime ACC road game since Tech defeated Wake Forest in Winston-Salem, 83-75 on Jan. 10, 2018.

More About 5

In the record-breaking night against Syracuse, **Justin Robinson** also set a new Virginia Tech record for three-point field goals in a game, with nine ... The nine 3s is tied for fourth-best in ACC history ... That breaks the old mark of eight, set two seasons ago against Miami by teammate **Ty Outlaw** ... Robinson's 35 points is also a career-high and is tied for second in Virginia Tech school history for points in an ACC game, trailing on Malcolm Delaney's 37 points against Clemson in 2009 ... He is the first Hokie to score more than 30 points in a game since he scored 32 points in the win over NC State last February ... The 35 points is tied for the fourth-highest total by an ACC player this season and the nine three-pointers are the most by an ACC player this season.

KJ Doubles

Kerry Blackshear Jr., had his best-ever collegiate game at North Carolina ... KJ had 19 points and a career-high 17 rebounds in the loss, including 10 offensive rebounds ... In the win over Central Connecticut State, he recorded his first double-double of the season, with 12 points and 13 rebounds ... It was the first for the Hokies this season and the first by any Hokie since **Justin Robinson** had 10 points and 12 assists at Boston College on Jan. 31, 2018 ... He had his second double-double of the season with 14 points and 10 rebounds at Georgia Tech ... Blackshear had 13 points and 13 rebounds in the Hokies' win at NC State, his fourth double-double of the season and eighth of his career.

More on KJ's Rebounds

Kerry Blackshear Jr., had 17 rebounds at North Carolina on Jan. 21 ... That is the third-highest rebounds in an ACC regular season game in school history ... Jeff Allen had 19 rebounds at Boston College on Feb. 5, 2011 and Coleman Collins had 18 rebounds in a win over Duke on Feb. 17, 2005 in Cassell Coliseum ... The 17 rebounds marks the first time a Hokie has had more than 15 rebounds in an ACC game in more than five years.

Selling Out the Cassell

Home games against UVa, Wake Forest, Syracuse, Duke, Louisville and Miami have sold out ... Earlier this season, the CCSU game was a sell out ... The Hokies sold out nine games in the 2017-18 season, including seven of the nine home ACC games ... Single game tickets for Tech's home game against Georgia Tech are still available.

Providing A Spark

In the win over Wake Forest, the Hokies got 25 points off the bench ... That is the most points off the bench in an ACC game this season ... The last time the Hokies had more than 25 points off the bench in an ACC game was March 3, 2018 at Miami, when Tech had 28 bench points.

Take a 3, Make a 3

Virginia Tech is second nationally and leads the ACC in three-point field goal percentage, at 42.2 percent ... Tech leads the ACC and is 13th nationally in three-point field goals made per game, at 10.3 ... Tech has made at least 10 three-pointers in 13 of the 21 games this season, including a school-record 18 made three-pointers in the win over Central Connecticut State ... The top individual in three-point field goal percentage in the ACC is **Ty Outlaw** and **Ahmed Hill** (5th) joins him in the top 5.

NAW on the Lists

Virginia Tech guard **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** is one the Lute Olson Award, John R. Wooden Award and Oscar Robertson Trophy Midseason Watch Lists ... He was named to *The Sporting News'* Midseason All-American third team ... The awards are given annually to the nation's top player.

Winning Low

When the Hokies defeated NC State, 47-24, defeated Georgia Tech, 52-49, on Jan. 9 in Atlanta, it marked the fewest points for the Hokies in an ACC regular season victory since defeating Virginia, 47-45 in Charlottesville on Jan. 22, 2012, which ties this game for the fewest points in an ACC win for the Hokies.

Much Improved

Nickeil Alexander-Walker is third-best among ACC players in improved scoring average from last year to this year ... The sophomore averaged 10.7 points per game as a freshman and is currently at 17.6 ppg, for an increase of 6.9 points per game ... He is the only listed player to have averaged double figures last season.

Climbing the Lists

Justin Robinson passed Les Henson in the Miami game and is now in 23rd place on the career scoring list at 1,347 and **Ahmed Hill** passed multiple players in the win at NC State and is in 25th place with 1,295.

Vs. Ranked Teams

With the win at No. 23 NC State, the Hokies are 2-2 against ranked teams this season ... The Hokies were 4-3 against ranked teams last season and 3-6 in the 2016-17 season ... The seven combined wins against nationally-ranked teams in the two previous season are the most in a two-year span in school history ... The wins over No. 10 UNC and No. 2 Virginia last season marked the first time Tech won two straight against top 10 teams since winning three straight against top 10 teams in 2007 ... The win at UVa was Tech's second-ever against a team ranked second and first since 1986 ... Before the win at NC State, Tech's last previous road win vs. a ranked team was Feb. 10, 2018, when Tech defeated No. 2 Virginia in Charlottesville, 61-60 in overtime ... This is our first back-to-back games against ranked teams this season.

Buzz Williams Facts

Buzz Williams is in his fifth season at Virginia Tech ... He has a record of 245-149 in his 12th season as a collegiate head coach ... He is 92-63 at Tech ... With the 92 wins, Williams is sixth in career wins at Virginia Tech.

Assisting for the Score

In the win over Syracuse, the Hokies assisted on 23 of its 25 made baskets, for 92.0 percent, a new season-high ... Against North Carolina, the Hokies assisted on 21 of the teams' 26 made baskets, for 80.8 percent ... That was the ninth time this season that the Hokies had assisted on at least 60 percent of their made field goals and the fifth time that number has exceeded 70 percent ... Tech is averaging 60.8 percent for the season on assists per made field goals.

More About Assisting

Tech assisted on 92.0 percent of their made baskets against Syracuse (23-of-25), which is the highest percentage by an ACC team this season ... Across the Power 6, only two other teams have done so ... Ohio State assisted on 26 of 28 made field goals (92.9 percent) versus UCLA, and Kansas State, just like the Hokies, was 23 of 25 for a 92-percent clip against Georgia State.

Analytics and All

As of Feb. 3, the Hokies are ranked eighth by Kenpom.com ... Tech leads the nation in defensive three-point field goals, third in effective field goal percentage, raw offensive efficiency and three-point percentage and eighth in adjusted offensive efficiency ... Tech is 11th in raw defensive efficiency, 13th in defensive free throw rate, 14th in defensive turnover percentage, 15th in adjusted defensive efficiency, 20th in offensive three-point field goals and assist percentage, 24th in two-point percentage and 30th in free throw percentage ... **Ty Outlaw** is 24th in three-point percentage and 27th in effective field goal percentage ... **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** is 29th in steal percentage.

Tech in NCAA Stats

As of Feb. 3, the Hokies are second nationally in three-point field goal percentage, sixth in scoring margin and scoring defense and seventh in field goal percentage ... Tech is 13th in three-point field goals per game, 18th in assist turnover ratio, 22nd in assists per game, 23rd in field goal percentage defense, 26th in turnover margin and 28th in free throw percentage ... **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** is 26th in steals per game ... **Justin Robinson** is 44th in assists per game.

Since **Buzz Williams** arrived in

Blacksburg for the 2014-15 season, Tech is 63-20 (.759) in Cassell Coliseum and is 54-11 (.831) since the beginning of the 2015-16 season ... Tech has won a school-record 24 consecutive home non-conference regular season games ... The nine non-con home wins last season are second-best at Virginia Tech since the Hokies joined the Metro Conference in 1978.

599 in the Cassell

The Hokies have a 599-194 overall record in Cassell Coliseum, for a .755 winning percentage ... The win over Florida State in 2011 was the 500th victory in Cassell ... Tech was 12-4 in Cassell Coliseum last season and is 11-0 this season on its home court.

Where It Counts the Most

While the Hokies have gotten off to a great start on the court, their fall semester in the class room was even better ... Ten Hokies recorded at least a 3.00 grade point average, as the team recorded a 3.22 overall GPA, the best semester in program history ... Two Hokies, **Ty Outlaw** and **Ahmed Hill** entered the semester with their undergraduate degrees and two more, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, and **Justin Robinson**, completed their requirements for graduation and will walk in Spring 2019 ceremonies.

Hokies' Non-Con

The Hokies' 11 non-conference wins in the last three seasons are tied for the best at Virginia Tech since the ACC went to an 18-game conference schedule beginning with the 2012-13 season.

Virginia Tech has held its opponents to less than 50 points six times this season ... This is the first season since the 2007-08 season that the Hokies have accomplished that feat ... Tech opponents are averaging 60.2 points per game this season.

Getting on Track

In the win over Saint Francis, **Ty Outlaw** was 5-of-9 from three-point range ... Outlaw entered the game with just four made three-pointers in the first four games combined ... Outlaw followed that by going 4-of-5 from behind the arc at Penn State and followed that with a 3-of-5 effort in the win over Central Connecticut State ... Head Coach Buzz Williams

Buzz Williams has proven that hard work, determination and an eye for details are key aspects in building an elite-level collegiate basketball program. The head coach of the men's squad is in his fifth season in Blacksburg and has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

Though his program has earned growing acclaim nationally, Williams does not focus on such external praise. He wakes up every morning with a sense of purpose to make the Hokies the best that they can be.

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Now beginning his 12th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 245-149. Williams has compiled a 92-63 record, now in his fifth season in Blacksburg.

To cap off the 2017-18 season,

the Hokies made a second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, the first time the school could claim that in more than three decades. The Hokies finished the season 21-12 overall and 10-8 in the ACC. Tech made it three consecutive 20-win season and three consecutive 10-win ACC seasons.

The Hokies took care of business in the regular season. They defeated four nationally-ranked teams for the first time in school history, including three wins against top 10 programs. The Hokies also finished 11-2 in the non-conference regular season slate.

The 2016-17 season was their most successful season in the last decade. Tech finished the season 22-11 overall and earned its first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007. Tech was 10-8 in the ACC regular season for the second consecutive season. The Hokies claimed three top 25 victories against ACC foes and finished with an impressive 11-1 record in non-conference regular season action.

Williams led the Hokies through many of the usual obstacles that beset college basketball programs each season. Injuries were one such obstacle, but the Hokies weathered the injuries and continued to achieve. Towards the end of the season, with just a handful of

healthy bodies, Tech thrived and earned its at-large NCAA Tournament berth through its efforts.

In his second season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. While he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more focused on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. During Williams' tenure, six Marquette players made it to the NBA.

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 21 seasons, and 2018-19 will mark his 12th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New

Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07. His roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season

as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in

25 years in 2005-06. The previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, where he served as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple have two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
