## HISTORY MADE IN THE WNIT'S FIRST ROUND

- For the third consecutive season under head coach Kenny Brooks, Virginia Tech set a new program record for made 3-pointers, connecting on 308 for the season. The previous record was 295.
- Freshman Dara Mabrey who sunk six shots from deep in the opening round victory over Furman, set the program's single season mark, with 78 made triples. She passed Vanessa Panousis' previous record of 77 set in 2014-15. Earlier in the game Mabrey passed teammate Aisha Sheppard's record for 3's by a freshman, which was 76.


## SECOND ROUND MATCHUP FEATURES IN-STATE RIVAL VCU

- Tech has not matched up with Virginia Commonwealth since 2010, an overtime win for the Hokies.
- VCU went 13-3 in the Atlantic 10 season, earning the one seed in the conference tournament. The squad lost to Fordham in the championship game, landing them in the WNIT.


## TECH SET FOR ANOTHER RUN IN THE WNIT

- In the program's fourth consecutive trip to the WNIT, Virginia Tech will look to bring home the hardware after last season's runner up finish.


## HOKIES GIFT COACH BROOKS 400TH CAREER VICTORY IN GREENSBORO

- With the 85-63 victory over Wake Forest in the opening round of the ACC Tournament, Tech recorded its third straigh 20-win season all under head coach Kenny Brooks. For Brooks, the win was his 400th as a coach and the 20-win mark is his 14th consecutive season reaching that benchmark dating back to his time at James Madison where his 337 wins are the most in program history.
- Tech's 85 points tied for the most in an ACC Tournament game and the 23-point margin was the Hokies' largest in history.

Kenny Brooks was named the seventh head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 28, 2016. He enters his third season at the helm of the Hokies' program heading into the 2018-19 season.

Since Brooks' arrival in Blacksburg, the Hokies have enjoyed back-to-back seasons of 20-plus wins and late runs in the month of March, making a WNIT championship game appearance in 2018 after finishing in the quarterfinals of that competition a season earlier.

To begin his tenure, Brooks and the Hokies reeled off 15 straight wins to open the 2016-17 season, Tech's strongest start to a season in 18 years. Behind that strong start, Tech climbed to as high as No. 15 in the AP Poll.

Brooks has ushered in a new era of up-tempo basketball at Virginia Tech, as his Hokies have reset the team scoring record in each of his first two seasons as well as reset the mark for most 3-pointers made.

During his time in Blacksburg, Brooks has recruited and developed second team All-ACC performer Taylor Emery, who set the single season scoring record in 2017-18 at 667 points. She also scored the most field goals in a single campaign with 236.

Brooks' tenure has also seen two players reach the 1,000-point plateau including forward Regan Magarity who became the program's all-time leading rebounder during the WNIT run in 2018.

Brooks joined the Hokies after an impressive 14-season stint as head coach at James Madison University where he compiled a record of 337-122 (.756), making him the winningest coach in that school's history. Brooks guided the Dukes to 11 consecutive postseason appearances, including six NCAA bids and five trips to the WNIT.

Over an 11-year stretch (2005-2016), Brooks' squads never won fewer than 24 games, averaging 26.3 wins per year. The Dukes won three consecutive CAA championships (2014-2016) under Brooks' tutelage and captured a total of five conference titles over a seven season span.

During those final three seasons in Harrisonburg, Brooks and the Dukes compiled an impressive 60-3 record in conference play.

He was named CAA Coach of the Year for a fourth time in 2015-16, while his student-athletes also garnered CAA Player and Rookie of the Year honors.

Brooks registered winning campaigns in 13 of his 14 seasons in Harrisonburg, ascending to No. 23 in the AP Poll and No. 21 in the USA Today Coaches Poll in 2014-15 as his squad tied a school record with 29 victories. In 2013-14, he led the Dukes to their first NCAA Tournament victory since 1991 when his 11 th-seeded Dukes knocked off sixth-seeded Gonzaga 72-63 in the first round. In 2007, the Dukes earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament, marking only the second time a CAA team had received an at-large berth.

Under Brooks, JMU tallied six CAA Players of the Year, three Rookies of the Year and two Defensive Players of the Year. The Dukes also recorded 31 All-CAA selections, 11 Defensive team and 10 All-Rookie team selections during his tenure.

The Waynesboro, Virginia, native has coached three WNBA Draft picks; first-rounder Tamera Young, as well as Lauren Okafor and Jazmon Gwathmey, in addition to several other players who have signed professional contracts.

A 1992 graduate of James Madison, Brooks played for three seasons under legendary coach Lefty Driesell and made two NIT appearances while earning a degree in business management. He began his coaching career as a part-time assistant for the 1993-94 JMU men's squad that won the CAA Tournament and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

After four seasons as an assistant for the men's program at VMI (1994-98), he moved back to his alma mater as a men's assistant from 1998-2002. He was named interim women's head coach on Dec. 6, 2002 before taking over those duties on a full-time basis on March 21, 2003.

For more than half a century, Cassell Coliseum has provided Virginia Tech with one of the greatest home venues in all of college sports. Winning has been the norm in the facility since its opening in 1961, and Cassell is perhaps even more exciting today than ever in its history.

Cassell serves as the home to Virginia Tech mens and women's basketball, volleyball and wrestling programs, and in 2010-11, the Virginia Tech athletics department celebrated Cassell's 50th anniversary by bringing back many of the former great players and coaches in various sports who have played in the arena. Also, the first men's basketball team ever to play in Cassell was recognized.

Construction for the main portion of Cassell began in 1961, and though not completed, the Tech men's basketball team opened the arena on Jan. 3, 1962, with a $91-67$ victory over Alabama. The team played in the building for two years before workers from T.C. Brittain and Company of Decatur, Ga., finished the building in December of 1964 at a cost of $\$ 2.7$ million.

For years, the arena was called the Virginia Tech Coliseum. But on September 17, 1977, Virginia Tech officials and friends dedicated the coliseum in honor of the late Stuart K. Cassell, who spearheaded the project. In the late 1950s, Cassell, who was the chief business officer at the time and later became the vice president of the school, saw the need for a new basketball arena to replace the outdated War Memorial Gymnasium, and he eventually managed to get the state legislature to ap-
 prove the building of the 8,000-seat arena. Cassell, though, found a seat manufacturer that made seats a little smaller than normal seats and squeezed an extra 2,000 seats into the building, bringing the capacity to 10,000 .

Since that time, Cassell Coliseum has undergone many renovations and additions to make it the building it is today. The latest addition came in the fall of 2013 when Tech officials hired Panasonic to install two new video scoreboards with high-definition LED displays on each end of the arena. The scoreboards are 18 feet high and 29 feet wide - more than double the size of the previous video scoreboards - and enhance the fan experience. Combined with a new video scoreboard for Lane Stadium, the Hokies' football home, and a new control room, the project cost nearly $\$ 7$ million.

Other improvements have been made. Prior to the 2003-04 season, the concourse area was renovated and now features more accessible concession areas, new flooring, video monitors that allow fans to watch the action when not in the arena and the addition of Hokie stone to many of the entrances to the seating area. In 2001-02, the seats were stripped of their original paint and refinished to retain their natural wood look. In 1996-97, workers replaced the roof of the facility and installed structural access to the heating and lighting systems. They also restored and resealed the exterior concrete walls and buttresses.

Through new projects, renovations and maintenance reserve projects, Cassell Colise-

The athletics department has taken out some seats to make room for more seating for the handicapped, and also renovations in certain areas forced the need to eliminate some seating. The capacity of the building now sits at nearly 9,275. Cassell Coliseum today ranks as one of the most difficult places for opposing teams to play and is considered one of the best home environments in all of college sports.

## CARILION CLINIC COURT

The court at Cassell Coliseum received a makeover during the summer months in 2017. Three iconic campus landmarks, Torgersen Bridge, Burruss Hall and the Pylons are depicted on the court, in addition to a Hokie Stone design surrounding the playing surface. Featured prominently near midcourt is the logo of Carilion Clinic, a proud supporter of Virginia Tech Athletics. The court was named Carilion Clinic Court at Cassell Coliseum as part of the partnership between Carilion Clinic and Virginia Tech Athletics.

## JEAN BACK IN ACTION

- Senior forward Alexis Jean returned to the floor in the Hokies; 67-51 victory over Rutgers in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, scoring her only field goal attemmpt in seven minutes of work.
- It was her first appearance of the season following a shoulder injury which occured in practice before the season tipped off.
- Jean averaged 8.8 points and 6.1 rebounds per game last season, her first with the Hokies.


## HOT OUT OF THE GATE

- The Hokies dropped 96 points in the season opening win over USC Upstate. It was the most since Tech poured in 99 against Wagner in last season's opener.
- The 60 second half points were the most since at least 2016 when Kenny Brooks took the helm of the program.
- Tech has 10 wins in its history by a 50-point margin, with two of those coming under Coach Brooks.
- The Hokies made 13 triples against the Spartans, the most of any contest of the season so far.


## THAT'S THE WAY TO START A CAREER

- Sophomore forward Trinity Baptiste came off of the bench to record a double-double in her first career game with the Hokies, tallying 10 points an 10 rebounds. It was the first time since 1981 that a player recorded a double-double to open the season as a newcomer. - She then repeated the feat in the Hokies' second game against Georgia Southern, going for 13 points and 12 rebounds.


## ALREADY MAKING HISTORY TOGETHER

- Forwards Regan Magarity and Trinity Baptiste have already carved out some history, recording concurrent double-doubles three times in 2018-19. That tally is already tied for third in the annals of Virginia Tech women's basketball history.


## THREE DOUBLE-DOUBLES IN ONE NIGHT

- Tech's trio of Regan Magarity (18 points, 11 rebounds), Trinity Baptiste (13 points, 12 rebounds) and Taylor Emery (14 points, 10 rebounds) each recorded double-doubles in the Hokies' 78-49 victory over Georgia Southern.
- It was the fourth time in program history that the feat had been accomplished, and the first since 1986.


## ALEXIS JEAN BACK IN THE STARTING LINEUP

- Senior Alexis Jean, who had been limited all season with a shoulder injury, returned to the starting lineup in the Hokies' last contest against Florida State.
- She played 30 minutes, scoring 8 points and grabbing 5 rebounds.


## LINING IT UP FROM DEEP

- This season's Hokies roster is perhaps the most prolific in school history when it come to shooting the long ball. Three players (Kendyl Brooks, Taylor Emery and Aisha Sheppard) are in the top 10 all-time when it comes to 3-point shooting. Forward Regan Magarity is also on the cusp of cracking the top 10, a feat she should accomplish by the end of the season.
- In each of Kenny Brooks' previous seasons in Blacksburg, his teams have reset the program record for triples in a season.


## IN A CATEGORY OF HER OWN

- Forward Regan Magarity has quietly put together one of the best careers for a women's basketball player in Virginia Tech program history. Already the all-time leader in rebounds, Magarity reached 1,000 career rebounds in the Hokies' win over Mount St. Mary's, joining six other women as active players with 1,000 boards.
- Magarity also owns the most double-doubles of any Hokie (45) a mark which places her sixth amongst active players.
- In 2018-19, she is averaging 12.2 rebounds per game


## 3-POINT QUEENS

- In the comeback victory over Ohio State, the Hokies knocked down 15 3-pointers, tying the program mark which was first achieved Feb. 26, 2017 when the Hokies defeated Boston College on the road 82-79.
- Against Longwood, Tech broke the school record with 16 made triples.
- As a team, the Hokies are shooting . 381 from deep, the best mark in the conference.


## THE QUEEN HERSELF

- Freshman Dara Mabrey leads the ACC in 3-point field goal percentage, shooting the long ball at a clip of .481.
- She made her debut in the league with five triple at Miami and in her last game at Pitt, the Belmar, New Jersey native knocked down a career best six.


## FIRST TIME ON THE ROAD, A LITTLE NERVY FOR THE HOKIES

- Tech opened the season 2-0 at home before travelling outside the confines of Cassell Coliseum, up I-81 to take on Liberty in Lynchburg, Virginia.
- The Hokies bested a quality Flames squad that featured in the 2018 NCAA Tournament 72-61.
- Four players were in double figures that night as Tech moved to 3-0 on the season; Taylor Emery (13), Dara Mabrey (13), Trinity Baptiste (12) and Rachel Camp (10).


## MABREY, A TRUE FRESHMAN AND A TRUE TALENT

- Dara Mabrey has started each of the Hokies' contests so far and has acquitted herself well, averaging 13.7 points and shooting .500 from the floor in 26 minutes of work each night.
- Mabrey, the youngest of three in a basketball family, has an older sister Marina who plays for ACC foe Notre Dame and an older sister Michaela who also played hoops for the Fighting Irish.
- The Belmar, New Jersey native went off for 26 points against Monmouth, a school just minutes from her hometown. She knocked down 4 of 6 shots from beyond the arc in that contest and also grabbed 7 rebounds.


## FREQUENT FLYERS

- The trip to Miami is already the Hokies' third venture to Florida this season following the two-game UCF Thanksgiving Tournament that the Hokies won and the West Palm Invitational that saw Tech knock off Dayton and Ohio State.
- Last season the Hokies competed in the Paradise Jam which was relocated to Melbourne, Florida due to hurricanes affecting the Virgin Islands. Additionally in 2017-18, the Hokies had road contests at Miami and Florida State.


## HOKIES MAKE DEBUT IN FINAL COACHES POLL OF THE YEAR

- The Hokies are garnering votes in the AP Poll as they have all season, receiving 59 votes, leading the 'receiving votes' category.
- Tech made its debut on Monday, Dec. 31 in the USA Today Coaches Poll, coming in at he 25 spot.

## TECH SWEEPS WEEKLY AWARDS FOR FIRST TIME IN PROGRAM HISTORY

- On February 4, the league announced its weekly awards, with both going to Hokies. ACC Player of the Week was forward Regan Magarity and the Rookie of the Week was Dara Mabrey, the first sweep for the Hokies in program history. It was the first sweep in the league for women's basketball since December of 2016.
- On the men's side, Virginia Tech guard Nickeil Alexander-Walker claimed Player of the Week honors, marking the second time in history that the Hokies earned POW in the same week. The other was Dec. 9, 2013 when Uju Ugoka and Jarell Eddie each won.


## HOKIES PICK UP FIRST LEAGUE VICTORIES IN QUICK SUCCESSION

- Tech ended its drought with a convincing 74-58 victory at Pittsburgh Thursday night.
- The Hokies jumped out to a lead after Dara mabrey knocked down four 3-pointers in the first quarter, part of career best six long balls made in a game. The freshman recorded 22 points, the most of her young ACC career.
- Taylor Emery, the league's third leading scorer recorded 24 points on an efficient night shooting 9 of 16 from the floor. Emery also pulled down 8 rebounds in the win.
- Regan Magarity, the league's top rebounder, had another fine showing, recording her 14th double-double of the season with 14 points and 17 rebounds. She also had 7 assists, 3 blocks and 2 steals in the game.


## HOKIES SNAP STREAKS, DEFEAT FOURTEENTH-RANKED MIAMI AT HOME

- After seven ACC lossed by single digits, Virginia Tech was on the other side of a close contest this past Thursday, knocking off No. 14 Miami 73-65.
- For Tech, it was the program's first victory over a ranked opponent since November of 2016, when they took down No. 17 Tennessee.
- The win also snapped a long drought against the Hurricanes who had won 15 straight games in the series.


## MAGARITY PULLS DOWN A CAREER BEST 19 BOARDS IN UPSET

- Redshirt senior forward Regan Magarity is on a record setting pace for rebounds in 2018-19, averaging 12.8 per game the most in the league. Her 333 boards in already the second most in a single season, trailing only her own tally from a season ago (357).
- Her 19 rebounds in the win over Miami sets her new career high.
- In the last three games, Magarity has averaged 17 rebounds a game and helped the Hokies go 2-1.
