### Virginia Tech Head Coach Mike Young Q&A Highlights Postgame Media Conference at Boston College Jan. 25, 2020

***On them making defensive adjustments in the second half:***

"I don't think it was as much what they did defensively as it was us and what we did to ourselves offensively. Our movement was horrific, our ball movement was horrific. I can think of many times we've had a negative assist-turnover ratio like we had today. You get what you earned and we earned what we got."

***On Tech's 14 turnovers and then them holding Tech to one 3 in the second half:***

"Playing a half-court ... did nothing tricky about what they were doing. So, no. I thought our ball movement was poor, but [Boston College head coach] Jim's [Christian] bunch did a nice job guarding some things very well. But our ball reversal and things were time and time again not good, with us being sloppy."

***On having a lot of freshmen play and if that was a reason why the team did not play well on the road:***

"Probably fair but I'm not going to bail them out with that however. We've been good throughout, but that was not one of them."

### Virginia Tech Players Q&A Highlights

#### NAHIEM ALLEYNE

***On what Boston College did in the second half to take the lead:***

"In the second half, they got all of the loose balls, the 50-50 balls. They played a little harder than us and had more energy. We came out a little sluggish."

***On what Boston College did on defense to make it tougher to shoot in the second half:***

"They just kept switching everything and were hard-hedging. That was really hard for us because we don't necessarily work on those types of things. We weren't really cutting around when we had possession, were in a lot of 1-on-1 situations."

***On how Tech did defensively:***

“For the first half, we were pretty locked in on defense. In the second half towards the end, we kind of let our scouting report loose and that’s why they made a couple of 3s and got a couple of rebounds.”
