The 3-2 win over North Carolina in September marks Marci Byers first ACC win as the Hokie head coach.

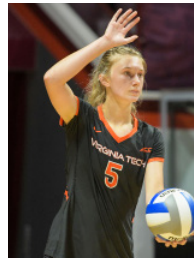

- Virginia Tech and Virginia are tied in the overall series at 37-37. The last Hokie victory over the Cavaliers came in 2018 in a 3-0 win in Blacksburg. Virginia has claimed the last three outings in the series.

- Libero Logan Mosley broke the freshman school record for most digs in a season with 507.

- Also led the Timberwolves to an unblemished record in conference play and a 31-4 overall record in 2017.

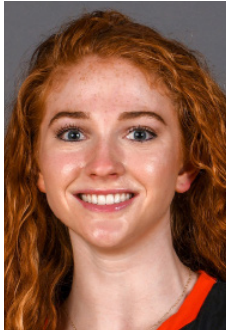
