- Virginia Tech volleyball will hit the road yet again to Raleigh, North Carolina to face off against NC State on Oct. 29 & Oct. 30 to conclude their fall slate.
- With the win over No. 14 Duke on Saturday night the Hokies earned their seventh win over a ranked opponent in program history and it was the second highest ranked win in program history (No.12 Illinois is the highest).

- Last time out against NC State, Tech fell to the Wolfpack 3-2 in Raleigh in a five set match.
- The Hokies lead the overall series between the two programs 21-15. Tech's last win against NC State was a 3-1 win in 2015 in Blacksburg. The Hokies last win in Raleigh came in 2013 and was a 3-0 success.

- Freshman Brie Postema ranks first in ACC in aces per set with 0.55 so far this season.
- The setter has recorded 15 or more assists in all seven matches for the Hokies this season.

- Libero Logan Mosley broke the freshman school record for most digs in a season with 507.



- Returning sophomore Logan Mosley continued her ways on the defensive end as she notched a season-high 23 digs in the second match at Duke.
