THE STARTING 5 - LIBERTY'S TOP STORYLINES

- · Liberty (0-1, 0-0 ASUN) will play its second straight road game to begin the 2020-21 season on Saturday, traveling across the Commonwealth to face Virginia Tech (1-0, 0-0 ACC).
- Liberty is playing at Cassell Coliseum for the second season in a row. Host Virginia Tech held off the Lady Flames 73-69 on Nov. 15, 2019, improving to 16-1 in the all-time head-to-head series.
- · The Lady Flames are seeking their first win over an ACC opponent since a Dec. 30, 2008 triumph at Virginia Tech. They will look to become the second Liberty team to win in Blacksburg this month. The Liberty football team topped Virginia Tech 38-35 on Nov. 7.
- Averaging 16.0 ppg against the Hokies during her career, Emily Lytle posted 21 points and eight rebounds at Ohio on Wednesday, her third consecutive 20-point game. She has made 18 straight free throws dating back to last season. The program record is 26.
- · Mya Berkman provided 10 points and eight boards off the bench during the season opener at Ohio. She is averaging 8.5 rebounds per game against the Hokies, including a career-high 10 during last year's meeting.

NOTES AND ANECDOTES - LIBERTY VS. VIRGINIA TECH

- Liberty is just 1-16 all-time versus Virginia Tech, but the lone victory came at Cassell Coliseum (Dec. 30, 2008). Future WNBA players Megan Frazee (20 points) and Avery Warley (18 rebounds) helped Liberty pull out a 45-43 triumph.
- The average margin of victory during the last nine Liberty-Virginia Tech meetings (dating back to the 2002-03 season) is just 5.2 points per game.
- Carey Green is 1-11 when coaching against Virginia Tech, beginning with his very first game as Liberty's head coach, Nov. 15, 1999. The Hokies spoiled his coaching debut with a 60-45 Preseason WNIT first round victory at Cassell Coliseum
- Green (No. 23) and Virginia Tech's Kenny Brooks (No. 20) both rank among the top active NCAA Division I women's basketball head coaches for career winning percentage.
- Green is 2-9 when facing Brooks, including 2-7 during Brooks' 14 years as James Madison's head coach and 0-2 during his current tenure at Virginia Tech.
- Rebounding will be a key stat to watch. Liberty has outrebounded 12 straight opponents dating back to last year, while Virginia Tech boasted a +9 rebound margin against Richmond. Last year, Aisha Sheppard's offensive rebound off a missed free throw sealed the Hokies' win over Liberty.

LAST MEETING WITH VIRGINIA TECH

NOV. 15, 2019 VIRGINIA TECH 73, LIBERTY 69 BLACKSBURG, VA. (CASSELL COLISEUM)

- Trailing Virginia Tech by 14 points late in the third quarter, Liberty roared back to cut its deficit to one. However, the Hokies' Aisha Sheppard grabbed a key offensive rebound and hit two free throws with 10.4 seconds left to clinch her team's victory.
- Sheppard scored nine of her team-high 20 points during the fourth quarter for the Hokies, who recorded 15 fast break points on the night.
- Liberty was led by the duo of Keyen Green (20 points, seven rebounds and three blocks in 22 minutes) and Emily Lytle (15 of her 19 points came during the fourth quarter, including the Lady Flames' last 13 points of the game.)

BOMBS AWAY!

- Liberty and Virginia Tech knocked down 12 three-pointers apiece duing their respective season openers on Wednesday. For the Lady Flames, it equaled a program single-game record set twice previously (Jan. 22, 1991 & Jan. 3, 2017).
- Emily Lytle (5), Nenna Lindstrom (3) and Bridgette Rettstatt
 (2) all matched their single-game highs for triples made.
 Liberty's 31 three-point attempts were just two off the program record, set Jan. 18, 1999 at Charleston Southern. Half of the Lady Flames' made field goals and half of their field goal attempts at Ohio came from beyond the arc.
- The Lady Flames are coming off a 2019-20 season which saw them make 173 three-pointers, two away from the program record of 175 from the 2013-14 campaign.

LIBERTY VS. ACC

- Liberty is 4-30 all-time versus ACC opponents, with two of its victories coming against Virginia and one apiece versus Virginia Tech and Wake Forest.
- The Lady Flames have lost 11 straight meetings with ACC foes since Dec. 30, 2008. That day, Liberty edged Virginia Tech 45-43 in the championship game of the Hokie Hardwood Classic in Blacksburg, Va.
- Liberty will be facing an ACC opponent for the eighth straight season. The Lady Flames are 0-9 vs. the ACC over the span, with five of the losses coming by eight points or fewer.

COMPETING AGAINST THE COMMONWEALTH

- The Lady Flames are 24-11 in their last 35 games against instate opponents, including a 2-2 record last season. During 2019-20, Liberty defeated Commonwealth foes Norfolk State and Hampton while falling to Virginia Tech and James Madison. All four games were played on the road.
- Saturday's game is the first of four in-state matchups on the Lady Flames' 2020-21 schedule. The Lady Flames will open Liberty Arena versus Norfolk State on Tuesday, play host to Hampton on Dec. 9 and travel to William & Mary on Dec. 22.
- Liberty is playing in Virginia on the weekend following Thanksgiving for the first time since 2005. That year, the Lady Flames played host to William & Mary on Saturday.

ON THIS DATE: Liberty is 5-2 all-time when playing on Nov. 28.

Six years ago today, Liberty defeated Penn State 80-68 on the opening day of the GSU Thanksgiving Tournament in Atlanta.

Liberty is 85-79 all-time in November, including 50-61 under Carey Green. The Lady Flames are 0-1 this November and are just 3-13 in November over the last three seasons.



LIBERTY TEAM NOTES

LADY FLAMES BY THE NUMBERS

- 1: 2020-21 will be the Lady Flames' inaugural season at Liberty Arena. Liberty spent the previous 30 seasons playing next door at the Vines Center.
- **3:** The 2020-21 season marks Liberty's third year as ASUN Conference members. The Lady Flames spent the previous 27 seasons (1991-92 through 2017-18) in the Big South Conference, winning 16 regular-season titles and 17 tournament championships.
- **3:** Three former Lady Flames have gone on to play in the WNBA, including Katie (Feenstra) Mattera, Megan (Frazee) Leuzinger and Avery Warley-Talbert.
- **6:** Carey Green is the sixth head coach in program history. He is the winningest coach all-time for the Lady Flames.
- **6:** The Lady Flames have made six appearances in the WBCA Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll, including 1998-99, 1999-2000, 2005-06, 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2015-16.
- 10: The Lady Flames captured 10 consecutive Big South Championship titles between 1997 and 2006, marking the longest run of championships in conference history.
- **16:** Liberty made its first Sweet 16 appearance in the 2005 NCAA Tournament, thanks to victories over Penn State and DePaul.
- 17: Liberty ranked among the nation's top 20 teams for rebound margin for 17 consecutive seasons (2002-03 through 2018-19). The Lady Flames have led the nation in rebound margin six times, most recently in 2013-14.
- 17: Liberty has advanced to the NCAA Tournament 17 times in the last 24 seasons, entering 2020-21.
- **20:** Liberty has recorded 20 20-win seasons in the last 24 years, entering 2020-21.
- **21:** Liberty has won 10+ conference games for 21 consecutive seasons, entering 2020-21.
- **33:** Liberty is playing its 33rd season as an NCAA Division I member in 2020-21. The Lady Flames' inaugural Division I season was 1988-89.
- **46:** Liberty is playing its 46th season of women's basketball in 2020-21. The program began playing in 1975-76, the fifth year of Liberty University's (then Liberty Baptist College) existence.

: WE ARE THE (CO)-CHAMPIONS!

Liberty and FGCU were named co-champions of the 2020 ASUN Women's Basketball Championship. The Lady Flames and Eagles had set up a rematch of the 2019 title game before it was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

It marked Liberty's first ASUN title and the Lady Flames' 19th year winning a conference championship in the last 24 seasons.

ACTIVE STREAKS

Liberty is currently riding several winning streaks:

8 straight wins against ASUN opponents 6 straight ASUN Conference wins 5 straight home wins

The Lady Flames have won 10+ conference games for 21 consecutive seasons (1999-2000 through 2019-20).

Individually, Emily Lytle has made a three-pointer in 13 straight games and has made each of her last 18 free throw attempts. The program record for consecutive free throws made is 26 by Jaymee Fisher-Davis between 2013 and 2015.

OFFENSE, OFFENSE!

Liberty averaged 69.0 ppg last season, marking its highest scoring average since 2013-14. The Lady Flames return 64.2 percent of their scoring from the 2019-20 season.

Liberty also adds last season's national scoring leaders at the NJCAA Division I (Dee Brown - 26.6 ppg) and Division II (Alyssa Iverson - 27.0 ppg) levels.

RULERS OF THE REBOUNDS

Liberty ranked among the nation's top 20 teams for rebound margin for 17 straight seasons (2002-03 through 2018-19), leading the country on six occasions (2003-04, 2004-05, 2009-10, 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-14). The streak came to an end last season as Liberty finished 'only' 31st nationally with an ASUN-best +6.7 rebound margin.

RULERS OF THE REBOUNDS, PART 2

Liberty won the rebounding battle in 27 of 31 contests last season and has outrebounded 12 straight foes.

RULERS OF THE REBOUNDS, PART 3

During Carey Green's tenure at Liberty, the Lady Flames have outrebounded 83.9 percent (564 of 672) of their opponents. Liberty's record when winning the rebounding battle under Green's direction is 438-126 (.777), including 0-1 this season.

COACHING CONTINUITY

Carey Green is in his 22nd season as Liberty's head coach, and two of his assistants (Alexis Sherard and Andrea 'Andy' Bloodworth) have each been part of his staff for the last 14 seasons.

Green is the longest-tenured head coach in program history, while Sherard and Bloodworth are the Lady Flames' two longest-tenured assistants.

THE GLASS IS HALF FULL

The Lady Flames are 124-2 under Head Coach Carey Green when making at least 50 percent of their field goals, including 6-0 last season.

THE GLASS IS HALF EMPTY

Only 28 of 672 (4.2 percent) opposing teams have shot 50 percent or better from the field during Head Coach Carey Green's tenure at Liberty.

Liberty has held 57 of its last 59 opponents below 50 percent field goal shooting.

WORKING OVERTIME

Liberty has played 37 overtime games in program history, going 17-20.

The Lady Flames went 2-1 in overtime last season, culminating with a 90-87 victory at North Alabama in the ASUN semifinals on March 11, 2020.

MOVING NEXT DOOR

Liberty Arena is connected to the Vines Center, which served as the home of Liberty basketball for 30 years (1990-2020). The first basketball game at Liberty Arena (Dec. 1, 2020) is set to take place almost exactly 30 years to the date after the first basketball game inside the Vines Center (Nov. 30, 1990).

The Lady Flames enjoyed a considerable amount of success at their previous home, going 308-83 and winning seven Big South Championship titles at the Vines Center.

HIEPLER COURT

Thanks to a lead naming gift, the Liberty University Athletics Department announced in August 2020 the court in the new Liberty Arena will be named in memory of Dr. Orville and Florence Hiepler.

In March 2019, Orville passed away and son Mark wanted to honor both his parents and their love for Liberty, as well as their heart for ministry, by naming the court in the new Liberty Arena in their memory. Orville and Florence's grandson Ryan Hiepler was part of the Liberty men's basketball team from 2015-18.




