• Off to its first 2-0 start since 2015, GW hits the road for the first time this season, traveling to Virginia Tech on Tuesday. Tip-off is scheduled for 5 p.m. with the broadcast on ACC Network Extra.

- GW improved to 2-0 with a 55-37 win over Old Dominion on Saturday. The Colonials limited the Monarchs to nearly 30 points below their 2018-19 scoring average.
- ODU's 37 points were the fewest scored by a GW opponent since the Buff & Blue topped Coppin State, 54-35, on 12/1/19.
- Junior Neila Luma led the team in scoring for the second TBD straight contest, dropping 18 points (14 in the first half). She's 2 p.m. averaging 17.0 ppg over the first week of the season. **TBD**
 - Freshman Ali Brigham poured in 10 points for the second straight contest to begin her career. For the second straight year, a GW first-year has reached double digits in the season's first two games (Tori Hyduke, 2019-20).
- TBD GW is 2-0 for the first time under head coach Jen Rizzotti. **TBD** The Buff & Blue's last 2-0 start came in the 2015-16 campaign. **TBD**
- A win on Tuesday would improve the Colonials to 3-0 for TBD the first time since the 2007-08 season when the Buff & Blue knocked off UMBC, UVA and Kentucky to open that year en route to ultimately reaching the Sweet 16. **TBD**
- **TBD** • For the second straight year, GW does not have a scholarship **TBD** senior on the roster. Of the 12 players on the roster, only two, **TBD** Luma and junior Maddie Loder, have played for at least two years under Coach Rizzotti. TBD
 - GW is the only program in the A-10 that does not have a scholarship senior on the roster. The Buff & Blue also feature the second-fewest upperclassmen (5) in the league.

HISTORIC DEFENSIVE PERFORMANCE

Through two games, GW has allowed a total of 75 points (37.5 per game), the third-fewest in program history and fewest in 43 years:

- 1977-78: 68 (30 vs. Liberty, 38 vs. St. Mary's (MD))
- 1976-77: 71 (55 vs. Liberty, 16 vs. UDC)
- 2020-21: 75 (38 vs. Lincoln, 37 vs. Old Dominion)

NOT A MISPRINT

GW has yielded just three points in the second quarter of its first two games (2 vs. Lincoln, 1 vs. ODU) on 1-of-27 shooting (3.7%). Overall in the first half, the Colonials have limited opponents to 21 points and 8-of-61 (13.1%) shooting.

NATIONALLY-ACCLAIMED DEFENSE

Of teams that have played multiple games this year, GW is statistically the best defense in the NCAA in both field goal percentage defense (22.4%) and scoring defense (37.5 ppg). The Buff & Blue have allowed only 26 made field goals, fewest in the nation, and five 3s, the third-fewest in the category.

In GW annals, the 18.6% shot by Lincoln on Wednesday was the lowest of the Rizzotti era (since 2016-17) and the lowest recorded since November 21, 2004 (ECU, 17.4%).

MAKING UP FOR LOST TIME

Redshirt junior Neila Luma went over a year in between games due to a knee injury last year, but has started this season by averaging 17.0 ppg in the first two contests on 59.3% shooting, ranking fourth and third, respectively, among A-10 players who have appeared in multiple games.

Her 34 points in the first two games are the most for a Colonial since Kelli Prange combined for 39 points in the first two games of the 2017-18 campaign. She was named the College Sports Madness A-10 Player of the Week on Monday.


WASHINGTON - The George Washington women's basketball team knew it had its hands full with visiting Old Dominion on Saturday, as the Lady Monarchs came to D.C. off a 24-win campaign a season ago with games still to play in the Conference USA Tournament before it was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Their success saw former Head Coach Nikki McCray-Penson leave for 2017 and 2018 back-to-back NCAA runner-up Mississippi State, opening the door for DeLisha Milton-Jones, who joined the program after a year as an assistant coach at Syracuse and two years as the bench boss at Pepperdine.

After leading the nation in 3-point defense (24.3%) last season and ranking 15th in scoring defense, allowing just 55.3 ppg, the Monarchs posed a challenge for GW, who's lone tune-up before Saturday's clash was Wednesday's opener against Division II Lincoln. A look at the second quarter, however, would have suggested that it's the Buff and Blue that boasts a nationally-ranked D.

GW held ODU to a single second quarter point on 0-for-13 shooting from the field, and the home team's quarter-ending 10-0 run gave the Colonials a 13-point halftime lead that would not be threatened in the 55-37 triumph. In two second quarters now this season, the Colonials have allowed a total of three points across 20 minutes of basketball.

It was the veteran/rookie frontcourt tandem of Neila Luma and Ali Brigham who led the way once again for GW, as the pair once again both reached double-figures in the contest. After double-doubling in the season-opening win, Luma continued her resurgent redshirt junior campaign with a game-high 18 points. Brigham, meanwhile, was a force on both sides of the court, tallying 10 points while swatting two shots on the other end, and altering several other looks with her 6-foot-4 frame.

All told, GW held ODU to 26.3% shooting, including .105 (2-of-19) from three-point range, while forcing 22 Monarch miscues. In two games, the Colonials have yielded just 75 points (37.5 per game) on 22.4 percent shooting. Grad transfer Jasmine Whitney controlled the game from her point guard position, with a team-leading eight rebounds, four assists and five steals in 38 minutes of play. Sophomore Faith Blethen stuffed the stat sheet with five points, seven rebounds two blocks, two steals and an assists.

HISTORY VS. VIRGINIA TECH

The Colonials and Hokies renew acquaintances for the first time since 2012. The former Atlantic 10 rivals have met 21 times with VT holding a slight 11-10 edge thanks to three straight wins in the series dating back to 2002. Eleven of the 21 meetings came when the teams were in the A-10 from 1996-2000. GW last topped the Fighting Gobblers in the final matchups as conference mates on February 2, 2000, 73-58.

Pitt transfer **Jasmine Whitney** faced off with Tech three times in her ACC career, reaching double figures in each matchup. In those three games, Whitney averaged 13.3 ppg, 6.0 apg, 4.3 rpg and 3.3 spg.

HISTORY VS. THE ACC

The Colonials are 21-44 against current members of the ACC with wins over the Hokies representing 10 of the triumphs. However, GW has not topped a team that was in the ACC at the time of the game since November 28, 2014 in a 74-66 win over NC State. GW is 0-4 against the ACC under head coach **Jen Rizzotti**, falling to Syracuse (twice), Georgia Tech and NC State.

A LOOK AT THE HOKIES

Virginia Tech has possessed a potent offensive attack in its first two games, scoring over 80 points in wins over Richmond and Liberty. Five players are averaging double figures, led by preseason All-ACC selections Aisha Sheppard (16.0 ppg) and Elizabeth Kitley (15.5 ppg & 13.5 rpg). Kitley is reigning ACC Freshman of the Year for a Tech squad that went 21-9 last season and was positioned to make the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2006.

VT has won 57 straight non-conference home games, including all 41 under head coach Kenny Brooks, who is in his fifth year as the program's head coach. The Hokies were projected to finish seventh in the ACC this season.

UP NEXT

GW returns home for a second straight matchup with an ACC foe, welcoming Virginia to D.C. on Sunday afternoon. Tip-off from the Smith Center is scheduled for 2 p.m. with the broadcast on ESPN+.

MORE ON LUMA

Luma's career-high 17 rebounds as part of a double-double on Wednesday were the most recorded by a Colonial since future WNBA All-Star Jonquel Jones ripped down 18 against VCU on March 5, 2016 in the A-10 semifinals. Her 11.0 rpg rate as the best among A-10 players with multiple games played.

ETCHING HER OWN LEGACY

First-year **Ali Brigham** has put up 10 points off the bench in each of her first two games of her Buff & Blue career, following in the footsteps of her father, Bill, who played for two seasons from 1991-93 at GW. Bill averaged 10.6 ppg in 58 games for the Colonials playing for the 1992-93 team that advanced to the Sweet 16 and played the Fab 5 in that year's NCAA Tournament.

SEASON OF ACTION

This season, GW student-athletes will take part in a seasonlong marketing campaign that brings to light numerous causes identified by student-athletes and coaches that are Bigger Than Basketball. Throughout the season, women's basketball student-athletes will lend their voices to causes, including this week's cause of **Black Lives Matter**. Each week will feature a multi-faceted approach that highlights the cause. Included in the effort will be Q&A videos with members of the program, informative social media posts, team apparel on game days and fundraising promotion.

PLAYING FROM AHEAD

Thanks to the eye-opening defense, GW has trailed for a grand total of 1:17 in the first two games of the season while playing with the lead for 72:47 of a possible 80 minutes. The lead has been double digits for 45:09 of the 72:47.

THEY'RE FREE AFTER ALL

GW was a perfect 12-of-12 from the charity stripe on Saturday vs. Old Dominion, the sixth perfect day at the free throw line (min. 10 attempts) in program history. For the season, the Colonials have made 19-of-20 free throws.

WHO'S BACK

Three starters return in sophomore Faith Blethen, redshirt sophomore Mayowa Taiwo and graduate student Sydney Zambrotta. Junior Maddie Loder, Luma and sophomore Essence Brown, all of whom started at least five games last

A WELCOME SIGHT

Neila Luma was named to the Preseason All-Conference Third Team, her second straight year with the honor. Last season, she was named to the preseason second team, but missed all but five games after going down with a season-ending knee injury at Maryland (Nov. 20) and taking a redshirt year. During those five games, she averaged 5.6 ppg and 5.0 rpg in 25.6 mpg.

Prior to last season, the Macungie, Pa., native had started 59 of the first 63 games in her career and averaged 27.5 mpg.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

Luma, Blethen and graduate student **Jasmine Whitney** were voted as the team's captains this season. Blethen is the first sophomore to be named captain in Coach Rizzotti's five seasons at GW. Whitney joined the program in the spring and was elevated to captain less than a year into the program.

Whitney appeared in 91 games for the Panthers, leading the team in assists for three straight years and finishing in the top 10 in program history in both assists (374) and steals (162).

FRESH FACES (PART I)

In addition to Whitney, GW also welcomed **Gabby Nikitinaite** via the transfer portal this year from Northern Illinois. The UK native spent three years with NIU, averaging 8.0 ppg and 3.4 rpg during her career. Her best season came as a sophomore in 2018-19 where she poured in 12.1 ppg as the team's second leading scorer.

Nikitinaite has received an NCAA waiver that will allow her to be eligible for GW in January.

FRESH FACES (PART II)

GW welcomes six newcomers to the fray overall, including three scholarship freshmen - Ali Brigham, Aurea Gingras and Caranda Perea - and walk-on Piper Macke.

Brigham was a nominee for the Massachusetts Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior. Gingras, hailing from nearby Alexandria, Va., won three state championships in her high school career between Paul VI and Edison High School. Perea was a defensive menace and All-Region performer for Altoona Area High School, also winning an AAU National Championship in 2016.

ALL- ROOKIE PERFORMER

Sophomore **Mayowa Taiwo** was named to the A-10 All-Rookie team in her initial campaign, the first Colonial to earn the honor since 2016. Taiwo averaged 6.8 ppg and 6.1 rpg while shooting 48.3% in 30 games. She was one of just four players to appear in every game, starting 23, third-most on the team.

THE CHALLENGES OF SCHEDULING

Despite the uncertain nature and limitations of scheduling in a pandemic, Coach Rizzotti has once again put together a challenging non-conference slate for the Colonials to tackle. Of the seven teams on the schedule, four won at least 20 games a season ago. GW's first three opponents this year combined to qo 68-21 in 2019-20.

Virginia's visit to D.C. this coming Sunday will mark the 23rd time in the last 24 years that GW has hosted at least one Power 5 opponent. The Colonials' non-conference RPI a year ago was

COMEBACK KIDS

The Colonials had the propensity of coming from behind last year, winning nine times when trailing at halftime. In Coach Rizzotti's first three seasons at GW, the Buff & Blue registered just six such victories. GW authored six double-digit comebacks, including three such wins in A-10 play.

A BAKER'S DOZEN

GW used 13 different starting lineups last season with 11 different Colonials starting at least one game. The Buff & Blue only had three lineup combinations that were used more than twice last season. Of the returners, Faith Blethen had the most starts with 26.

THE MAGIC NUMBER

Coach Rizzotti's recipe for success always stems from her team's defense. The Colonials are 32-6 under Rizzotti when holding their opponent to 35% shooting or less, including a 2-0 mark in the 2020-21 campaign.

SEARCHING FOR 60

During Coach Rizzotti's tenure, 60 points has typically spelled victory with the Colonials posting a 43-10 mark when crossing the 60-point threshold. Defensively, GW is 53-16 when holding its opponent to fewer than 60 points, having accomplished the feat in 69 of Coach Rizzotti's 115 games on the sideline (60%).

GW SIGNS FIVE IN CLASS OF 2025

GW announced the program's signing class for the 2021-22 season on Nov. 13, welcoming five new student-athletes to the Buff & Blue. The five-member recruiting class, Rizzotti's largest in her five-year tenure, includes two guards - Taylor Golembiewski and Leila Patel, and three forwards - Andrea Daley, Sophie Haydon and Michelle Ojo.

"Recruiting through the COVID-19 pandemic created some new challenges for us, but I couldn't be more thrilled with the five women who took a leap of faith and committed to playing for us here at GW," Rizzotti said. "This class is versatile, competitive and high character, and I can't wait to get them in GW uniforms."
