QUICK HITTERS

- The Mountaineers play their first road game this afternoon when they face Virginia Tech on the ACC network.
- App State is coming off a 70-60 win over UNCA last Sunday for its first 2-0 start since the 2010-11 campaign.
- Pre Stanley scored 19 of her game-high 25 points in the fourth guarter with 15 coming in the final period.
- Brooke Bigott scored a career-high 15 points, while Michaela Porter earned her second consecutive double-double with 12 points and a personal-high 12 boards. Lainey Gosnell also collected a career-best 13 boards.
- After averaging 22.5 points, 6.5 rebounds and 4.0 assists last week, Stanley was named the Sun Belt Player of the Week for the first time in her career.
- App State's next game is back at home against Davidson next Friday, Dec. 11.

SCOUTING THE HOKIES

- Virginia Tech is off to a hot 3-0 start following a 92-57 win over George Washington on Tuesday.
- Four players scored in double figures with Aisha Sheppard pouring in 22 points. Elizabeth Kitley posted a double-double with 16 points and a game-high 12 boards.
- -The Hokies' average margin of victory has been 23 points this season.
- Sheppard leads five Virginia Tech players in double figures averaging 18 points per game.
- Kitley is pulling down a team-high 13.0 rebounds per game.
- Virginia Tech has been dominating at home with 58 straight nonconference victories in Cassell Coliseum.
- The Hokies came off its best ACC finish last season at fourth place.
- Kitley leads the nation with three double-doubles.

5 THINGS TO WATCH

- App State has a plus-8.5 rebounding margin through the first two games, highlighted by double-figure rebounding averages by **Lainey Gosnell** (11.5 rpg) and **Michaela Porter** (11.5 rpg). Watch if the Apps can stay successful on the glass.
- Virginia Tech is tied for first in the nation averaging 14 3-pointers, second with 42, and in the top 20 shooting 44.7 percent from 3-point land. See if the Mountaineers can contain the Hokies' 3-point attack.
- **Brooke Bigott** is shooting 54.5 percent from beyond the arc this season and 44.1 percent over the last 14 games dating back to last season. Watch if the junior can continue her solid shooting.
- Over the last five road games dating back to last season, Gosnell is averaging 16 points, seven rebounds, and shooting 49.1 percent from the floor. See if the senior can have a solid Friday at Virginia Tech.
- Opponents against Virginia Tech are averaging 17 free throw attempts through three games. Watch if the Mountaineers can get to the line as they average 22.5 through their first two contests.

An App State Win Would

- Give the Mountaineers their first 3-0 start since the 1994-95 season.
- Give the Apps their first Power Five win since 2011-12 when they beat NC State.
- Snap the Hokies' 58-game home win streak against non-conference opponents.
- Move App State's record to 5-12 against Virginia Tech.

An App State Loss Would

- Drop the Apps' record to 2-1.
- Give Virginia Tech a 4-0 mark.
- Fall to 4-13 against the Hokies.

Who's Back

- Appalachian brings back three of five starters in Brooke Bigott, Lainey Gosnell and Pre Stanley, who combined for a total of 27.8 points.
- Gosnell and Stanley scored over 10 points per game last season, while Stanley led the team averaging 14.1 points per game and Gosnell 10.1
- Bigott had a solid ending to the season, averaging 5.9 points, 2.7 assists and shot 40.5 percent from beyond the arc over the last 21 games of the season.
- **Tierra Wilson** returns after sitting out the season due to a torn ACL. Wilson led the Black and Gold in 3-pointers made her first two years.
- App also returns nine letterwinners from last season.

Closer Look: Backcourt

- App State is back with a core backcourt of last season, Pre Stanley, Tierra Wilson, and Brooke Bigott.
- In addition, **Janay Sanders** is in her first season of eligibility after sitting out due to NCAA transfer rules. Sanders led LaSalle in assists per game in her only season for the Explorers.
- All four guards will look to replace the production of Ashley Polacek, who was the floor general the last two seasons for the Mountaineers.
- Stanley was one of five players in the Sun Belt to lead her team in points and steals, which led to an All-Third Team Sun Belt selection.
- Bigott led the team in 3-point field goal percentage shooting 36.9 percent, while she's the leading returning assist leader.

Closer Look: Frontcourt

- App State is back with a core backcourt of last season, **Pre Stanley**, **Tierra Wilson**, and **Brooke Bigott**.
- In addition, Janay Sanders is in her first

- All four guards will look to replace the production of Ashley Polacek, who was the floor general the last two seasons for the Mountaineers.
- Stanley was one of five players in the Sun Belt to lead her team in points and steals, which led to an All-Third Team Sun Belt selection.
- Bigott led the team in 3-point field goal percentage shooting 36.9 percent, while she's the leading returning assist leader.

Newcomers

- App State brought in three talented newcomers in Faith Alston, Dane Bertolina, Zahra Daniel and
- Alston is the perfect point guard in coach Elderkin's uptempo style of play. The Virginia native led Paul VI Catholic to a state championship as the point guard, leading one of the top high school teams in the nation.
- Bertolina did it all at Charlotte Catholic, as she averaged 18.5 points, 5.3 rebounds and 3.2 steals in her final season. She is the school's all-time leader in 3-pointers made and scoring.
- App State got a sharpshooter in Trumm, as the Powell, Tenn., native broke the Tennessee school record for 3-pointers.
- Daniel was a late addition as she transferred from Moberly Area Junior College.
- Daniel appeared in 31 games, where she scored in double figures in five games, including a personal-high 21 points.

Apps Sign four players in 2021 class

- Head coach Angel Elderkin and the coaching staff brought in four players for the 2021 class, signing Emily Carver, Mariah Frazier, Adair Garrison and Zada Porter.
- Carver is her school's all-time leading scorer with more than 1,700 career points.
- She averaged 26.9 points, 6.1 rebounds, and 2.9 assists per game.
- Her all-around numbers led to being named the Western Mountain Athletic Conference Player of the Year, the North Carolina Basketball Coaches Association's District 12 Player of the Year and to the NCBCA All-State Second Team.
- Frazier was named all-conference all three years while averaging 14.0 points, 8.0 assists, 5.0 rebounds, 4.0 steals and one blocked shot per game.
- Her numbers also led to a First-Team All-Metro honor, while defensive numbers led to a Defensive Player of the Year award.
- After turning in all-around numbers her junior campaign of 21 points, 8.5 rebounds, 4.8 assists, 3.8 steals and 1.2 blocks per game, Porter garnered the River Ridge District Player of the Year award, was named Second-Team All-State and to the All-Timesland Team.
- Porter earned Team MVP honors and was named the team captain in her sophomore, junior and senior years. She holds the school record for most points in a game (38), steals (12) and most assists in a game (15).

Three's Company

- Head coach Angel Elderkin named Gosnell, Stanley and Wilson captains during the summer.
- It's the first time in her tenure she's named at least three captains.
- Said Elderkin: "During our time in quarantine, our coaching staff realized we couldn't continue to strive for growth without the commitment from our team. Upon meeting with these three, they accepted the responsibility of being our captains. Empowering these three ladies who have given there all for App State since they stepped on campus is truly rewarding for our coaching staff."

Mountaineers in the Community

- In late March, the Apps finished first in the nation and in the Sun Belt in the 2020 NCAA Team Works Helper Helper Community Service Competition that ran from January through the beginning of April during the spring semester.
- Women's basketball totaled a stellar number of 1,132 hours and 100 percent participation, leading three other Sun Belt teams (Troy - Women's Basketball, Louisiana - Men's Golf, Georgia Southern - Softball) in the top 10. App State is joined by the likes of Arizona, Louisville, Michigan, Penn State, Pitt, West Virginia, and Clemson in the top 100.
- The Mountaineers made it an emphasis to get involved within the community, working with such organizations as the Health and Hunger Coalition, High Country Breast Cancer Foundation and Habitat for Humanity. Also, App State took part in Operation Christmas Child and the blanket and coat drive.

ANGEL ELDERKIN HEAD COACH SEVENTH SEASON (79-111)

SOUTHERN MAINE, 1999

Angel Elderkin, a longtime assistant coach in the Southeastern Conference, Atlantic Coast Conference and Big East, was named the eighth head coach in Appalachian State University women's basketball history on Oct. 1, 2014.

The head coach for #TheTeam heads into her seventh season for the Black and Gold, making her the third-longest tenured coach in program history. Last season, she had the Mountaineers win seven of their final 12 games following a slow start due to injuries. She helped develop Bayley Plummer into the program's second all-time rebounder and fourth in blocks.

Under Elderkin's guidance, Stanley scored a career-high 14.1 points per game en route to becoming the 26th player in program history to score 1,000-career points. Off the court, the Apps did a stellar job helping the community, as they finished first in the country in the 2020 NCAA Team Works Helper Helper Community Service Competition with over 1,000 hours of community service.

Elderkin's fifth season was her best on the App State sidelines, where she , led the Mountaineers to their most successful season in recent history with a 22-win season en route to the program's second WBI championship.

The Mountaineers reeled off a 10-2 stretch over their last 12 games of the season en route to their 22-14 mark. The 22 victories are the program's most wins since the 2011-12 campaign and the seventh-best win total in a season. Elderkin also led the Black and Gold to one of the top turnarounds in the nation. On top of the 14-win improvement tying a program mark for the largest turnaround in school history, the Apps' jump from eight wins in 2017-18 to 22 victories this season was the fifth-best resurgence in the nation.

Elderkin's squad was dominant on its home floor with a 14-3 record, which is the best mark at home in program history.

In Sun Belt play, App State registered 10 league wins for its highest total since joining the league. The Mountaineers' fifth-place standing was also their best finish in Sun Belt action. App State put forth its deepest run in the Sun Belt Tournament with a pair of victories over Coastal Carolina in the first round and Georgia State in the quarterfinals.

In season four facing a rash of injuries that included a torn ACL to senior and an All-Sun Belt First Team Presson selection in Madi Story, Elderkin helped the most inexperienced team in the Sun Belt post eight wins including a first round Sun Belt Tournament win over Arkansas State. It was the second straight season the Black and Gold collected a postseason win, which was the first time since the 2012 and 2013 SoCon Tournaments.

The Mountaineers boasted one of the most lethal 3-point shooting attacks as the trio of Tierra Wilson (56), Lainey Gosnell (38) and Nicola Mathews (38) were the third-best 3-point shooting trio in the Sun Belt, while the 167 team trifectas were the second most in a single season in program history.

Elderkin also helped guide the freshmen into one of the top producing classes in the league, as the team's leading scorers were first-year players in Pre Stanley (11.4 ppg) and Wilson (10.5 ppg). In addition, Mathews' first season led to a year where she dished out a team-high 3.1 assists per contest.

Her goal to raise money for the Play4Kay continued as Appalachian raised \$1,092 for the Play4Kay Free Throw Challenge, which was first in the Sun Belt and 13th in the nation, while the Mountaineers raised over \$3,000.

In coach Elderkin's third season at the helm, she helped App improve its win total by two games despite injuries to key players, and recorded its first-ever Sun Belt Tournament victory over Coastal Carolina in the first round. App won its most road games since the 2013-14 season while doubling its win total in non-conference from the 2015-16 season with six, equaling the most victories since the 2012-13 campaign.

The Mountaineers had three players score in double figures in Madi Story (13.2 ppg), Joi Jones (13.0 ppg) and Q. Murray (10.3 ppg). Story and Jones was the first duo under a coach Elderkin coached team to make an all-conference team, as the tandem were named Third Team All-Sun Belt.

With the help of Elderkin, Jones endured a successful career where she ended up in the record books rank 15th all-time in scoring with 1,178 points and sixth in assists with 299, becoming one of seven players in school history to be ranked in the top 20 in scoring and top 10 in assists. In addition, Jones was named to the WBCA "So you Want to be a Coach" Program.

Coach Elderkin continues to be an advocate in raising funds for the research and awarenessin the fight against cancer. In three years at App State, she has helped raise more than \$10,000, including over \$5,000 combined through the Kay Yow Fund and the American Cancer Society.
