THE SERIES

- Thursday's meeting marks the 16th game all-time between the two programs with Virginia Tech leading the series 10-5.
- The Hokies are 6-1 all-time at home against the Panthers.
- Virginia Tech has won three straight in the series with Pitt's last win on Feb. 16, 2017 at home.

A WIN WOULD...

- Be the Panthers sixth win against the Hokies all-time and second in Blacksburg.
- Give Pitt their first win in an ACC opener since joining the conference.
- Give Pitt a 3-1 record for the second time in three seasons under Coach White.

STORYLINES

- The Panthers will be looking to bounce back after their first loss of the season Sunday. In the loss, Pitt had a season-high four players score in double figures while shooting 49.2% from the floor as a team.
- Junior **Jayla Everett** has been everything the Panthers could've asked for as she has led the offensive attack for Pitt in all three games. The St. Louis, MO product currently ranks second in the ACC in scoring (20.3 ppg) while also ranking fifth in the conference in three-point shooting (47.8%).

THE OPENING TIP

- Pitt travels to Virginia Tech to open up ACC play Thursday, Dec. 10 (6 p.m. - ACCNX) in the 16th meeting of all-time between the two teams. Evan Hughes and Mack McCarthy will be on the call from Cassell Coliseum.
- The Panthers offense is off to their best start under Coach White as they are averaging 74.0 ppg while shooting 43.8% from the floor and 36.7% from behind the arc.
- Pitt has out-rebounded all three opponents this year as they are averaging 47.3 rpg while holding opponents to just 39.0 rpg.

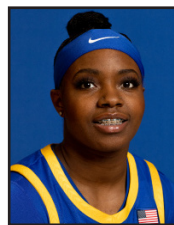

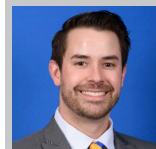

BY THE NUMBERS

70+

The Panthers offense is enjoying a strong start to the season as they have scored 70+ points in all three games this season, the first time they have done so since the 2014-15 campaign when they did it in five straight.

61

Junior guard **Jayla Everett** opened up her Pitt career with a combined 61 points (18, 23, 20), the most points scored by a Pitt player in the first three games of the season since Asia Logan netted 68 through three games in 2012-13.

The Panthers offense is off to a quick start through three games as they are shooting 43.8% from the floor as a team, the highest field goal percentage through three games for Pitt since the 2010-11 campaign (44.9%).

TEAM NOTES

LAST TIME OUT - DELAWARE

- » The Panthers fell at home to Delaware, 85-79, thanks to a season-high 24 turnovers that the Blue Hens turned into 25 points.
- » Pitt shot a season-high 49.1% from the floor and connected on nine three-pointers but the turnovers killed them down the stretch.
- » Junior **Jayla Everett** was once again the best player on the floor for the Panthers as she netted a team-high 20 points and four assists while **Rita Igbokwe** notched her second career double-double with 11 points and 11 rebounds in the loss.
- » As a team, the Panthers held the 47-34 edge in rebounds while being outscored 25-2 in points off of turnovers.

ACC OPENERS

- » The Panthers are searching for their first ACC opening victory Thursday night as they are 0-7 in ACC openers (including 0-3 on the road) since joining the conference in 2013-14.
- » Pitt is averaging 55.3 ppg while allowing 74.3 ppg across seven ACC openers.

THE DAY AND JAY SHOW

- » Heading into the 2020-21 campaign, the Panthers knew they would be relying on their talented guards to produce at a high level and through three games they haven't disappointed.
- » In Sunday's game against Delaware, **Jayla Everett** and **Dayshnette Harris** combined to score 31 points, seven assists and six rebounds.
- » Everett has now led the Panthers in scoring in all three games while Harris has scored in double figures in each game this season and in 11 straight games dating back to last season.
- » For Everett, the 20 point game marked her 35th game scoring in double figures and ninth scoring 20+ while Harris has 19 career double digit scoring games for the Panthers.

MUCH IMPROVED REBOUNDING

- » One of the biggest points of emphasis for the Panthers since Lance White became head coach was rebounding the ball.
- » Last time out, the Panthers snagged 47 rebounds and won the battle on the boards for the third straight game to start the season.
- » In the season opening win over George Mason, Pitt grabbed 53 rebounds which is tied for the sixth most in a single game by the Panthers since joining the ACC in 2013-14.
- » Winning the rebounding battle is a major key for the Panthers as they own a 14-12 record when they win the rebounding battle opposed to a 4-35 record when they are out-rebounded since coach White took over the program in 2018-19.
- » Pitt went from 238th in the NCAA in 2018-19 to 58th in the NCAA last season in total rebounds (1,231) and from 250th in 2018-19 to 75th in the NCAA in rebounds/game (39.7) last season.
- » The Panthers have won the rebounding battle in all three games this season while grabbing 40+ boards in each game. The last time Pitt opened the season with three straight games with 40+ rebounds was the 2016-17 campaign.
- » Pitt recorded 40+ rebounds 16 times in 2019-20, the most in a season since doing it 19 times in 2014-15.

PANTHERS RACKING UP THE POINTS

- » The problem over the past couple seasons for Pitt has been their lack of offensive firepower. So far this season, the Pitt offense has been able to produce at a high clip.
- » On Sunday, the Pitt offense was able to shoot a season-high 49.1% from the floor against Delaware. The 49.1% shooting night was the best team shooting effort for Pitt in 39 games when they connected on 59% of their shots in a home victory over North Carolina on Feb. 14, 2019.
- » The Panthers have scored 70+ points in all three games, marking the first time Pitt has done that in their first three games of a season since the 2014-15 season.
- » As a team, Pitt is shooting 43.8% from the floor this season which is the best team shooting effort through three games since 2010-11 when they shot 44.9% through the first three games.

ABOUT VIRGINIA TECH

- The Virginia Tech Hokies enter Thursday's game with an unblemished 5-0 record as they downed Gardner-Webb Sunday 73-39 to close out non-conference play.
- The Hokies are being led offensively by sophomore center Elizabeth Kitley who is averaging 18.8 points and 13.4 rebounds. She has recorded an ACC-high five double-doubles while ranking inside the top-5 in the conference in scoring (5th), rebounding (2nd) and field goal percentage (3rd).
- Senior Aisha Sheppard is enjoying a strong start to her season as she is averaging 18.0 points and a team-high 3.6 assists while connecting on a team-best 22 three-pointers and shooting 44.9% from behind the arc.

HEY DAY DAY

- » Sophomore **Dayshanette Harris** made her 27th career start at point guard on Sunday against Delaware and finished her game with 11 points, six rebounds and three assists in 23 minutes of work.
- » Harris is enjoying a nice start to her second season as a Panther as she is averaging 27.3 mpg, 11.7 ppg, a team-best 8.0 rpg and 5.0 apg while also leading Pitt with three steals through three games. Her 5.0 apg currently ranks fourth in the ACC.
- » She has scored in double figures in all three games this season and has 19 double digit scoring efforts across her Pitt career. The sophomore has also surpassed the 20-point plateau six times during her career.
- » Defensively, Harris has 19 career multi-steal games while leading the Panthers in steals 17 times in her career. Last season her 53 steals were the most by a Pitt freshman since the 1996-97 season.
- » Harris has led Pitt in assists in two games this season and 20 times over her career while notching 5+ assists a total of six times.
- » The crafty point guard excelled down the stretch for the Panthers a season ago as she averaged 17.2 ppg, 4.8 rpg, 2.6 apg and 1.7 spg across her final 13 games of the 2019-20 season. She also netted 20+ points in each of her last three games of the season.

EVERETT MAKING IMMEDIATE IMPACT

- » After earning immediate eligibility after her transfer from New Mexico, **Jayla Everett** didn't waste much time making a strong first impression for the Panthers.
- » The St. Louis, MO product is enjoying a great start to her Pitt career as she is averaging 31.0 mpg, 20.3 ppg, 2.7 rpg and 2.7 apg while shooting 45% from the floor and 47.8% from behind the arc.
- » Everett currently ranks second in the ACC in scoring (20.3 ppg), tied for first in free throw percentage (100%), third in three-pointers made/game (3.7) and fifth in three-point field goal percentage (47.8%).
- » Last time out against Delaware, Everett led the Panthers in scoring for the third straight game as she netted 20 points and a season-high four assists. She finished the game going 4-for-9 from deep.
- » Everett is the first Pitt player in over 20 seasons to net at least 18 points in each of the first three games of the season.
- » Her 61 points scored through three games are the most by a Pitt player since Asia Logan had 68 points through three games in 2012-13.
- » The 61 total points for Everett are the most scored by a Pitt newcomer in their first three career games in over 20 seasons.

TEAM NOTES...

- » The 20 point effort gives Everett 35 career games scoring in double figures including nine games with 20+ points scored (two straight).
- » She has made three or more three-pointers in each game this season and in 16 games over her career.
- » Across her career at New Mexico, Everett posted averages of 12.7 points, 3.6 assists and 3.3 rebounds while starting 48 games.
- » The lengthy guard out of St. Louis was the 2018-19 Mountain West Conference Freshman of the Year after posting freshman year averages of 13.5 ppg, 3.7 apg, 3.5 rpg and 1.2 spg while setting a program freshman record with 417 points scored.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU

- » Sophomore forward **Amber Brown** has started all 34 career games for the Panthers and has been asked to play major minutes so far in her young career.
- » Brown has continued to grow into her role in the starting lineup and posted her best game of the season against Delaware. The sophomore netted seven points, grabbed a season-high 11 rebounds and three assists across a season-high 33 minutes.
- » She now has 10 career games with 10 or more rebounds.
- » Brown has posted 20+ minutes played in all 34 career games while leading the Panthers in rebounding a team-best 17 times over her career.
- » Brown closed out her first season as a Panther leading all ACC freshman in rebounding (238, 7.7 rpg) while also ranking 11th nationally among freshman in total rebounds (238) and 12th nationally in rebounds/game (7.7 rpg).

IGBOKWE STEPS UP

- » Sophomore center **Rita Igbokwe** became a household name for Pitt fans late last season as her unique ability to block shots and be a presence underneath the hoop stuck out down the stretch of the season.
- » After a couple of quiet games to start the season, Igbokwe stepped up against Delaware and netted her second career double-double with 11 points and 11 rebounds while going 4-for-6 from the floor across 19 minutes of work.
- » The sophomore now has seven games with 10+ rebounds while leading the squad in rebounding 12 times across her career.
- » So far this season, Igbokwe has earned three starts at center and is averaging 6.7 points, 6.7 rebounds and 1.0 blocks while shooting 61.5% from the floor.
- » Across her career, she has posted 18 multi-block games while leading Pitt in blocked shots 21 times so far.

GREEN LIGHT

- » Senior team captain **Gabbie Green** has been asked to take more of a leadership role this season with a very youthful squad and she has embraced that role through the first three games.
- » Green had her best game of the season Sunday against Delaware as she posted a season-high 13 points and two rebounds across just 15 minutes of work due to foul trouble.
- » The senior went 5-for-8 from the floor and 3-for-6 from behind the arc, her first game this season with multiple three-pointers made.
- » For her career, Green has 20 career games with multiple three-pointers made including netting a career-high five three-pointers a season ago at Clemson.

2019-20 HIGHLIGHTS

- » The Panthers had a strong close to their 2019-20 campaign as they collected just the second ACC Tournament win in program history as they downed Notre Dame, 67-65, in the first round behind a **Dayshyanette Harris** game-winning runner in the lane.
- » One of the brightest spots for the Panthers a season ago was the play of coach White's first recruiting class, **Dayshyanette Harris, Amber Brown, Rita Igbokwe** and **Emy Hayford**.
- » The freshman quartet etched their names in the Pitt record book as they became the highest scoring freshman class in program history (948 points combined). The 948 points combined also ranked third amongst Power 5 conference freshman classes in scoring, trailing only USC (1,308 points) and South Carolina (1,047; #1 recruiting class in the NCAA).
- » Pitt was one of two Power 5 conference teams a season ago to have four freshman average at least 19.5 minutes/game (Cal).
- » Guard **Dayshyanette Harris** burst onto the scene for the Panthers down the stretch and she finished the year as the only freshman from a Power 5 conference school to lead her team in scoring, assists and steals. Harris was the lone Power 5 conference freshman to average at least 12.5 ppg, 4.5 rpg and 1.8 spg a season ago.
- » Harris earned a spot on the All-ACC Freshman Team following her strong first season as a Panther. She is just the second Pitt player in program history (Brenna Wise, 2016) to earn a spot on the All-ACC Freshman Team.
- » The dynamic freshman rebounding duo of **Amber Brown** (7.7 rpg - led all ACC freshman) and **Rita Igbokwe** (6.8 rpg) were the third best rebounding freshman duo in the NCAA (14.5 rpg combined). Brown and Igbokwe were one of only two freshman duos in the NCAA (Oregon State) to average at least 6.8 rpg each.
- » Brown earned ACC Freshman of the Week honors twice during her first season as she is just the second Panther in program history to earn that recognition twice in a season (Jasmine Whitney 2016-17).
- » Brown was also the only Power 5 conference freshman to lead her team in minutes played (31.9 mpg) while averaging at least 9.1 ppg and 7.7 rpg.
- » Igbokwe burst onto the scene for the Panthers as a presence down low during her first season. The athletically-gifted Igbokwe set a Pitt freshman record for blocks in a season with 60, breaking the previous record that stood for 43 years.
- » Igbokwe was one of six Power 5 conference freshman a season ago to shoot at least 46.2% from the floor while averaging 6.8 rpg and notch at least 60 blocked shots.
- » Igbokwe had a monster game against Ohio during her freshman season in which she grabbed 18 rebounds which were the most rebounds in a game by a Pitt player since 2010 and the most by a Panther freshman since 2005 when Mercedes Walker snagged 19 boards.
- » Junior sharpshooter **Gabbie Green** exploded onto the scene for Pitt a season ago after transferring in from South Plains College in Texas. Green finished off her first season connecting on 60 three-pointers, the most triples by a junior in program history. The 60 trey's are also the fourth most in a single season in program history.
- » At the conclusion of the season, Pitt placed two student-athletes (**Aysia Bugg** and **Dayshyanette Harris**) on the All-ACC Academic Team. It marked the second straight season with two representatives and the ninth and tenth in program history.

BLACKSBURG, VA – The Pitt women's basketball team wasn't able to overcome an early deficit on Thursday night on the road against Virginia Tech as they fell 68-56 to the Hokies. Virginia Tech improved to 12-3 overall and 2-2 in ACC play with the win.

Amber Brown opened the scoring for Pitt on the Panthers second possession of as she battled through some contact and finished off a tough layup. The Hokies responded with an 8-0 run to take the lead into the first media timeout of the game. Out of the media timeout, Pitt got a pair of layups from Brown and Dayshanette Harris finished off an old fashion three-point play to cut the Hokies lead to three, 13-10. The Hokies responded however with a 9-2 run to close the quarter and take the 22-12 lead into the second.

The Panthers had a less than ideal start to the second quarter as they were outscored 13-5 through the media timeout in the second as Aysia Bugg was the lone Pitt player to score, scoring all five. The Hokies pushed their lead out to 18, 38-20, but Pitt was able to end the half on a 5-0 run behind a triple from Gabbie Green and a steal and layup from Harris.

Pitt had a great start to the third quarter as Green opened things up with a deep triple on Pitt's first possession before Brown netted a layup and Harris notched a steal and layup to force the Hokies to take a timeout as the Panthers cut the home teams lead to six, 38-32. After a four point spurt by the Hokies, Bugg knocked down a triple to get Pitt within five, 44-39, but the Panthers couldn't get any closer. In the final minute, Rita Igbokwe grabbed an offensive rebound and finished off a layup to cut the Pitt deficit to six, 51-45, but the Hokies were able to hit a runner at the end of the third quarter to take an eight-point lead into the final quarter.

The Panthers offense just couldn't get it going in the final quarter as Virginia Tech pushed their lead out to as much as 16 late in the quarter. The young Panthers continued to fight down the stretch but fell on the road to the Hokies, 68-56.

Brown had another strong game for Pitt as she netted 10 points, nine rebounds and three assists across 28 minutes of action while Bugg netted 10 points and four boards in the loss. Harris finished off her night with nine points and two steals while Hayford netted eight points and three rebounds off the bench for the Panthers. Igbokwe grabbed a team-high nine boards and had two blocks in 23 minutes of action.

LANCE WHITE

HEAD COACH | 3RD SEASON | TEXAS TECH '96

Lance White enters his third season at the helm of the Panthers in 2020-21 after being named as the ninth head coach in Pitt women's basketball history on April 19, 2018.

In White's second season in charge, the Panthers showed growth in every part of the program and it was capped with an ACC Tournament victory over the defending ACC Champions, Notre Dame. The win over the Irish marked just the Panthers second ACC Tournament win in program history as freshman sensation Dayshannette Harris knocked down the game-winning jumper with just 2.7 seconds left in the game. With the win, Pitt handed Notre Dame just their second loss in ACC Tournament history.

The foundation for the Pitt program was laid in season two as White's "First Class" of seven student-athletes made huge impacts that will shape the program for years to come. The Pitt freshman class of Harris, Amber Brown, Emy Hayford and Rita Igboke was not only the best freshman class in the ACC but they were one of the best in the NCAA. The quartet averaged 31.0 points/game combined, the most ever by a Pitt freshman class.

The youthful Panthers roster during the 2019-20 campaign was able to get loads of experience that will help down the road as Pitt was the only team in the ACC to start five newcomers, doing so in the final seven games of the season.

White signed his highest ranking recruiting class for the 2020-21 campaign as he will have five newcomers to the lineup, three freshman and two transfer student-athletes. The three freshman joining the program are Tracey Hueston, the 73rd ranked recruit in the 2020 class, Liatu King and Taisha Exanor. Hueston is the highest rated recruit for the Panthers since joining the ACC while King and Exanor are both three-star prospects with winning pedigrees.

Also joining the 2020 class will be New Mexico transfer Jayla Everett who earned the Mountain West Freshman of the Year accolades in 2018-19 after coming out of Kirkwood High School ranked as the 94th best player in the 2018 class. Sophomore Destiny Strother also transferred to Pitt after one year at Marquette, helping the Eagles to a 24-8 record while coming off the bench.

Off the court, the 2019-20 Panthers posted their best semester in the classroom since joining the ACC as they posted a team cumulative GPA of 3.481. Pitt also saw two student-athletes, Aysia Bugg and Harris, earn ACC All-Academic Team honors for the second straight season.

White notched his first career head coaching victory in the Panthers second game of the season on Nov. 9, 2018 as he led Pitt to the dominant 90-38 victory over New Orleans, their seventh largest defeat in program history and their largest in over a decade.

White collected his first ACC victory on Feb. 14, 2019 when the Panthers knocked off the North Carolina Tar Heels inside the Petersen Events Center, 91-78. The 91 points scored for the Panthers were their most scored in a game since 2014 and their most ever in an ACC contest. Another historic win for the Panthers during White's first season was the road victory over Duquesne in the City Game as they downed the Dukes by the score of 66-58.

With White at the helm, Pitt upped its offensive efficiency as they had four players average over 9.5 points/game including leading scorer Danielle Garven who finished off her impressive senior campaign averaging a career-high 11.8 points and 4.3 rebounds. Fellow senior Cassidy Walsh also had a great season under White's watchful eye as she quadrupled her scoring production from her junior season, averaging a career-high 9.7 points/game for the Panthers. Pitt also posted the fourth best season in school history from behind the arc as they connected on 32.7% from behind the arc while also bumping up their rebounding average to 35.5 rebounds/game.

Off the court, White had a pair of student-athletes, Jasmine Whitney and Cassidy Walsh, named to the All-ACC Academic Team, the most for Pitt since 2015 when they placed three on the team.

White came to Pitt after spending 15 years at Florida State, where he helped the Seminoles to a 350-145 (.707) record, including 12 seasons of 20+ wins.

During his final season at Florida State (2017-18), the Seminoles posted 25 or more wins for the fourth consecutive season, finishing with a 26-7 overall record and averaged the second-most points in a season in program history with 81.0 points per game. It was just the second time FSU averaged 80 or more points per game in a season. The team ranked in the Top 20 nationally in field goal percentage (20th), offensive rebounds per game (16th), rebound margin (sixth), rebounds per game (11th), scoring margin (10th) and scoring offense (13th). The Seminoles led the ACC in rebounding offense (42.8), rebounding margin (+10.0) and offensive rebounding percentage (41.4 percent).

During his time at FSU, 10 players were selected in the WNBA Draft, eight earned ACC All-Defensive team honors and 37 earned all-conference awards. He helped the Seminoles reach the NCAA Tournament in 13 of the past 14 years, while the team won at least one NCAA Tournament game in each of its past 15 appearances.

For his standout coaching efforts during the 2016-17 season, White was named the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year.

White helped FSU reach new levels of success and brought an infectious energy to the program. He directed the Seminole defense and offense during his tenure in addition to being one of the country's top recruiters.

Florida State captured back-to-back regular season ACC co-titles in 2010 and 2011, and advanced to the 2010 NCAA Tournament Elite Eight. After serving as assistant coach for the first nine seasons in Tallahassee, White was promoted to associate head coach in advance of the 2012-13 campaign.

Prior to FSU, White spent 11 seasons at Texas Tech, including five years as an assistant coach with the Lady Raiders' top-10 program under legendary head coach Marsha Sharp. With White on staff, Texas Tech won three Big 12 championships and advanced to seven consecutive NCAA Tournaments, including five Sweet 16 and two Elite Eight appearances. He was a student assistant on Tech's 1993 national championship team and a graduate assistant coach for two seasons before being elevated to a full-time coach in 1998.

While in Lubbock, White worked with some of the best players the game has ever seen, including National Player of the Year and three-time WNBA MVP Sheryl Swoopes as well as Plenette Pierson, who was named 2007 WNBA Sixth Woman of the Year.

A 1996 graduate of Texas Tech, White earned his bachelor's degree in exercise and sports science. He went on to receive a master's degree in sports administration in August 1998. He attended Lubbock Christian University for three semesters before transferring to Texas Tech in January 1993.

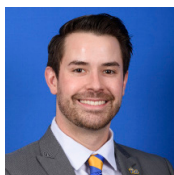

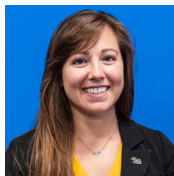

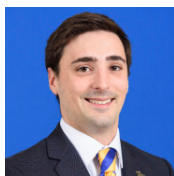
