#### HOKIES TRAVEL TO RALEIGH FOR DUAL WITH WOLFPACK

- Virginia Tech and NC State meet on the mat for the 62nd time Friday night at Reynolds Coliseum. The Wolfpack hold the series edge, 33-27-1.
- NC State took the last matchup 17-16 in Blacksburg last February. However, Virginia Tech is 8-2 against State in their last 10
- · Virginia Tech enters Friday night with an 11-1 record on the season, 2-1 in the ACC. NC State is a perfect 13-0, 3-0 ACC.
- Most recently, Virginia Tech defeated Duke 46-3 in Blacksburg and NC State beat in-state rival North Carolina 19-14 in Raleigh.

#### RANKED MATCHUPS TO BE THE DIFFERENCE

- · Virginia Tech is ranked seventh in the country by the NWCA Coaches' Poll. NC State is third.
- Tech has six wrestlers ranked by InterMat this week to NC State's five. There are four projected ranked matchups for Friday's dual, including No. 2 Hunter Bolen vs. No. 3 Trent Hidlay at 184 pounds.
- The other ranked matchups to watch for consist of No. 6 David McFadden vs. No. 10 Thomas Bullard, No. 18 B.C. LaPrade vs. No. 2 Hayden Hidlay and No. 19 Mitch Moore vs. No. 10 Tariq Wilson.
- Moore and Wilson met at the Cliff Keen Invitational in Las Vegas, where Wilson won a tight 5-3 decision in sudden victory.

#### HOKIES DISMANTLE DUKE ON SENIOR NIGHT

- After honoring six senior wrestlers at Virginia Tech's Moss Arts Center, the Hokies took down the Blue Devils 46-3 last week.
- Collin Gerardi and B.C. LaPrade both won by fall while Bryce Andonian, Cody Howard and John Borst picked up tech falls. Stanley Smeltzer also won by major decision.
- David McFadden and Hunter Bolen sat out of the dual vs. Duke.
- · The Hokies won nine of the 10 matches, cruising to their 11th victory of the season and second conference win. Tech is now 2-1 in the ACC heading into Friday's dual with undefeated N.C. State.

#### BOLEN, McFadden Setting the Pace for TECH

- Despite both of them sitting out against Duke, Hunter Bolen and David McFadden have been Tech's catalysts this season.
- Each of the two are ranked in the top 10 of their respective weight classes; Bolen is No. 2 at 184 pounds, McFadden No. 6 at 165.
- Bolen is 21-1 on the season and is 11-0 in dual matches. McFadden is 18-3 and 9-2 in duals.

#### HOKIES SWEEP IN-STATE WEEKEND

- Needing a bounce back after the home defeat to North Carolina, Virginia Tech won their Commonwealth Clash against Virginia 20-16 in Charlottesville.
- Tech followed that up with a 23-9 victory over Old Dominion in Norfolk two days later.
- Mitch Moore, David McFadden, Cody Hughes and Hunter Bolen each went 2-0 to help the Hokies to two straight dual wins, including their first ACC win of the year.

When Virginia Tech head wrestling coach Tony Robie came to Blacksburg in 2006, he was an associate head coach who inherited a barren program that had the potential to be great. Progressively he helped build the Hokies into one of the top programs in the ACC and a mainstay in the top 10 nationally. Two full seasons into his tenure as head coach, Robie is still leading the Hokies into new territory.

In 2018-19, Robie helped guide Mekhi Lewis to the program's first national championship and Most Outstanding Wrestler honors at the 2019 NCAA Championships in Pittsburgh. Lewis' title run at 165 pounds wrapped up a season that saw the Hokies finish in the top 11 at the NCAA Championships for the eighth consecutive season and a top two placing at the ACC Championships for the seventh straight year. Tech had three All-Americans and three ACC champions in Lewis, Zack Zavatsky and David McFadden. Robie's performance earned him 2019 ACC Coach of the Year accolades, his second time receiving the honor.

In his first season leading the program, Robie continued Virginia Tech wrestling's run of success as the Hokies won its second consecutive ACC Championship and placed eighth at the NCAA Championships in Cleveland.

Robie became the first coach in the history of ACC wrestling to guide his team to conference championships in his first two seasons. With Robie on staff, Virginia Tech has won four ACC titles over the last seven years and seven conference trophies overall when including dual meet championships.

In Robie's first full campaign, Virginia Tech placed at least three wrestlers on the podium at nationals for the sixth consecutive season. Jared Haught led the group of three All-Americans in 2018 by becoming the Hokies' second-ever national finalist, joining Devin Carter in 2014. Four Hokies – Haught, David McFadden, Brent Moore and Dennis Gustafson – won ACC titles, with Moore taking home Most Valuable Wrestler honors. Robie also coached McFadden to a regular season record of 30-0, the first undefeated season at Virginia Tech since 2001-02.

In duals, Robie led the Hokies to a 14-3 overall record, a 4-1 mark in ACC matches and a final ranking of No. 10 in the final NWCA Coaches Poll. Robie's 14 dual meet victories ranks second in the ACC record book for most wins by a firstyear head coach behind Wade Schalles' 15 wins with Clemson in 1978. His .824 winning percentage ranks third all-time in ACC history for a rookie head coach. In Virginia Tech history, Robie's winning percentage ranks first among rookie head coaches while his 14 wins ranks second behind Tom Brands' 16 dual meet wins in 2004-05. Robie, who started five freshmen in duals for a majority of the season, was also named a finalist for the Theraworx NWCA National Coach of the Year award.

Robie was an integral part of the Virginia Tech wrestling staff for 11 seasons as associate head coach under former head coach Kevin Dresser. Between that 2006-07 and 2016-17, the Hokies won three ACC Dual Meet Championships, three ACC tournament championships and finished in the top 10 at the NCAA Championships five times. One of those top 10 team finishes included a then-ACC record and program best fourth place finish in 2016. He also helped recruit and coach 17 ACC champions and 14 All-Americans.

A world-class wrestler in his own right, Robie was a two-time All-American at Edinboro and a 1997 NCAA finalist at 158 pounds who turned in a career record of 126-23. A two-time captain for Olympic gold medalist Bruce Baumgartner, Robie was a three-time Eastern Wrestling League Champion and a three-time Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) champion. As a senior, Robie led the Fighting Scots to a sixth-place national finish - the highest in school history. He ranks fourth on the school's all-time wins list and went on to earn a bronze medal at the 1998 U.S. Open Freestyle Championships. In 2008, he was inducted into the Edinboro Sports Hall of Fame.

A native of Erie, Pa., Robie was a Dean's List student at Edinboro and received the school's Academic Achievement Award before graduating with a bachelor's degree in criminal justice in 1997. Robie and his wife, Jennifer, reside in Christiansburg with their three children - Nate, Luke and Jake.


