A WIN ON SUNDAY WOULD

- Be the 955th win in program history (954-471)
- Be head coach Wes Moore's 737th career win (736-231)
- Be Moore's 179th win at NC State (179-62)

- Be the Pack's third-straight 11-0 start to a season
- Extend the Wolfpack's winning streak over Virginia Tech to seven games

NOTING THE WOLFPACK (10-0, 5-0)

- Ranked season-high and program best-tying No. 2 nationally in the Associated Press Top 25
- Returning to action on Sunday for the first time in three weeks, as NC State has had five games in a row postponed or canceled since it last played on Jan. 3
- One of two remaining unbeaten teams in the conference and one of seven remaining unbeaten teams in the nation
- Ranked second in the league, just one game behind No. 1 Louisville
- Currently riding the ACC's longest winning streak of 15 games that started last season on Feb. 27, 2020
- No. 1 nationally and first in the conference in defensive rebounds per game (33.8)
- No. 10 nationally and first in the conference in field-goal percentage defense (.329)
- Also leads league in scoring defense (58.7)
- No. 7 in field-goal percentage (.490)
- No. 9 in scoring margin (+23.4)

- Also top-25 nationally in rebounds per game (10th, 46.2), rebound margin (15th, +11.6), scoring offense (17th, 82.1) and three-point field-goal percentage (21st, .372)
- Four members of the squad with scoring averages in double digits - **Elissa Cunane** (16.2), **Jakia Brown-Turner** (13.7), **Kayla Jones** (12.9) and **Jada Boyd** (11.7)
- Top six scorers all averaging at least 42 percent shooting
- Shot better than 50 percent as a team in each of the last three outings and a total of five games this year
- **Cunane** (3rd - .582), **Jones** (4th - .573) and **Brown-Turner** (15th - .444) all ranked in the top 15 in the league in field-goal percentage
- Only team in the ACC with a pair of players averaging better than 50 percent on the season (five field goals made per game minimum)
- Averaging 40.6 points in the paint. Outscored its opponents in the category in every game this season for an average advantage of 16.0 points per game
- Also a threat from distance with an average of 7.3 made three pointers per contest. Shooting 37.2 percent as a team from distance and put together three-point shooting percentages of 40 percent or better in five outings

NATIONAL NO. 2

The Wolfpack tied its best Associated Press Top 25 ranking in program history as it moved up to second in the nation on Monday. It marks the 43rd week in program history that NC State has been featured in the top five.

LAST MEETING - NC STATE vs. Virginia Tech

February 6, 2020

BLACKSBURG, Va. - The seventh-ranked NC State women's basketball team (22-1, 11-1 ACC) extended its current winning streak to eight games, earning the 71-59 road victory over Virginia Tech (16-6, 6-5 ACC) inside Cassell Coliseum on Thursday evening.

Elissa Cunane led the way for NC State with 17 points and 16 rebounds for her 12th double-double on the year. She was one of four Wolfpack players to score in double figures. Aislinn Konig and Jakia Brown-Turner both posted 11 points apiece, and Jada Boyd added 10 to round out NC State's leaders.

NC State held Virginia Tech to 20-of-66 (.303) from the floor, marking the Hokies' worst shooting performance of the 2019-20 campaign. In what was a tremendous defensive effort by the squad, the Wolfpack limited Virginia Tech to just seven second-quarter points and 17 points in the first half for the Hokies' lowest single-half scoring mark of the season.

In total, NC State led for 37:24 of the game's 40 minutes. Virginia Tech scored the first basket of the game to go up 2-0 and never led again.

Three Virginia Tech players scored 10+ points on the night. Tajia Cole led all players on the floor with 19, and Dana Mabrey (15 points) and Aisha Sheppard (10 points) followed after her.

NC STATE VS. VIRGINIA TECH | TALE OF THE TAPE

The placement marks NC State's first No. 2 national ranking since week seven of the 1990-91 campaign. In total, Wolfpack women's basketball has spent eight weeks in program history as the nation's second-ranked team.

NC State opened the year with its best AP preseason ranking (No. 8) since 1990-91. The Wolfpack has now spent the last seven weeks in the AP Top 5, which is the longest such streak since it also spent seven weeks in a row ranked fifth or better in the middle of the 1999-2000 season.

The Pack has already established itself as a mainstay in the Top 25. The program has spent 402 total weeks ranked in the AP Poll in its history and has been ranked every week since Feb. 5, 2018. In 2019-20, the Pack spent the entire year in the AP Top 15 and was featured inside the Top 10 for the last 15 weeks of the campaign.

The squads squared off twice during the 2019-20 season, most recently meeting on Feb. 6, 2020. NC State won 71-59 inside Cassell Coliseum to hand the Hokies their first home loss in 16 games.

STIFLING DEFENSE

The Wolfpack has seen no shortage of points scored this season (averaging 82.1 per game), but its defensive effort as a team ranks among the best in the nation as the squad nears the end of January.

NC State has limited its opponents to just 32.9 percent shooting from the field, a number that ranks 10th in the nation. The Pack has held five of its opponents to under 30 percent shooting and eight of 10 opponents to under 40 percent.

The Pack's opponents average just 58.7 points per game, a defensive mark for NC State that leads the league. The team has held four teams to under 50 points this season, with that number including conference foe Miami and then top-ranked South Carolina.

CRUSHING CONFERENCE PLAY

The Pack has found its stride during ACC action as it continues on the path to defending its ACC Tournament title.

Through five conference contests:

- Four Wolfpack players are putting up scoring averages of more than 10 points - Elissa Cunane (18.6), Jakia Brown-Turner (15.4), Kayla Jones (13.8) and Jada Boyd (10.5). NC State and Virginia Tech are the only two ACC schools that have a pair of players averaging more than 15 points per game in league play. NC State is shooting a blistering 49.0 percent from the field against ACC foes, which ranks second in the league, and leads the conference in field-goal percentage defense after only allowing its ACC opponents to shoot 34.6 percent. Three players (with at least 20 attempts in ACC play) are shooting better than 50 percent - Elissa Cunane (.635), Kayla Jones (.571) and Jada Boyd (.565). The Pack is outscoring its ACC opponents by an average of 15.8 points, which ranks second behind Louisville.

TALK ABOUT EFFICIENCY

Jada Boyd earned the starting nod for the first two games of the season before being sidelined for four games with a meniscal injury. The sophomore forward is still extremely productive coming off the bench, as she also was in her rookie season.

She has played 36 games in her young Wolfpack career and has compiled shooting averages of 60 percent or better in 14 of those outings (minimum five attempts). Of her 16 career double-figure scoring games, 10 of those have come when Boyd played 20 minutes or less.

LAST TIME OUT

- NC State picked up another double-digit win over a conference foe, most recently defeating Boston College 76-57 at home on Sunday. Elissa Cunane led the way with a season-high 24 points in what was her third 20+ point performance of the year. She went a perfect 9-of-9 from the field. Raina Perez put up 16 points and finished just one assist shy of her first double-double as a member of the Pack. Jakia Brown-Turner (13) and Jada Boyd (10) also found double figures. NC State shot a collective 30-of-56 (.536) from the field and assisted on 17 of those made baskets. The team capitalized on Boston College's 15 turnovers with 21 points off of those mishandles. It also held the Eagles to under 27 percent shooting in each of the game's final three quarters and under 30 percent from the floor on the day.

SCOUTING THE HOKIES (7-6, 2-6 ACC)

- Started the season with 6-0 record before losing six of its last seven ACC contests. Most recently fell to Notre Dame, 60-65, at home on Jan. 21. Getting outscored by a margin of just 0.13 in league contests, with four of its six ACC losses coming at margins of five or fewer points. Three Hokies have scoring averages in double digits, led by senior guard Aisha Sheppard (18.5 ppg). Sophomore center Elizabeth Kitley averages a double-double on the year with 17.5 points (third in the ACC) and 11.8 rebounds (second in the ACC). Hokies lead the ACC in three pointers per game with an average of 9.8. Also top three in the ACC in three-point field percentage (3rd - .365) and blocks per game (3rd - 5.4).

SERIES HISTORY (NC STATE leads 21-1)

- Sunday marks the 23rd overall meeting between NC State and Virginia Tech. The Wolfpack is currently on a six-game winning streak in the series. The Hokies have just one victory in the all-time series, a win that came at the 2015 ACC Tournament. NC State is a perfect 10-0 against Virginia Tech at home.

GUILFORD GIRLS

NC State and Virginia Tech boast two players who are arguably the best post players in the Atlantic Coast Conference. Wolfpack junior **Elissa Cunane** and Hokie sophomore Elizabeth Kitley are childhood best friends who grew up just minutes down the road from one another in Guilford County.

The two 6-5 centers both wear the same number (33) and were featured on the preseason watch list for the 2021 Lisa Leslie Award. They each rank in the top 10 in the league in scoring, rebounding, field-goal percentage and blocks, and they both average under three fouls drawn per game. Both players tend to draw the double team, and Cunane owns the advantage in turnover numbers with only 19 this season to Kitley's 40.

Virginia Tech's Cayla King is also from the Greensboro area and played, as all three are former AAU teammates.

EXCEEDING EXPECTATIONS

NC State has met ACC coaches' preseason expectations in all seven completed seasons under Coach Moore and has exceeded expectations in five of those years.

In head coach Wes Moore's eight seasons in Raleigh, the Wolfpack has posted an impressive 82-37 (.689) record in league games that includes a 43-17 (.717) mark in Raleigh.

STRENGTH IN THE PACK

Since the renovation of Reynolds Coliseum was completed in August 2016, NC State has put together a 67-9 mark when playing on Kay Yow Court. That record includes 40 consecutive victories over non-conference opponents and 27 out of 36 possible league wins. The Pack's non-conference streak dates back to the old Reynolds Coliseum days and excludes the 2015-16 season that was played at Broughton High School during renovations. NC State's last non-conference defeat on Kay Yow Court coming at the hands of Minnesota on Dec. 3, 2014.

CLUTCH KJ

The versatility and reliability of **Kayla Jones** continues to shine bright in her senior season. She is currently one of three players in the ACC (Maddy Westbeld of Notre Dame, Lorela Cubaj of Georgia Tech) to average at least 12 points, seven rebounds and 2.5+ assists per game.

After tallying just five points in the Pack's season opener, Jones has scored in double figures in eight of nine games since. Her best scoring output this season came on the road at Boston College where she posted a career-high 25 points, nine more than her previous career high of 17 points. That outing marked the first 25+ point performance for a member of the Pack since Elissa Cunane posted 27 points at Duke on Feb. 2, 2020.

MAKING IT RAINA

Raina Perez came to NC State after averaging nearly 20 points per game at Cal State Fullerton last season, and she has shown her ability to be both a prolific scorer and a consistent play facilitator.

She is the best in the league and among the best in the nation as a ball handler. Perez owns the nation's 17th-ranked assist-to-turnover ratio (3.2) with 45 assists and just 10 turnovers. The Goodyear, Ariz., native has four games this season with zero

turnovers.

Despite her small size, Perez has a knack for scoring from a variety of spots on the court. She shoots 10-of-27 (.370) from three-point range this season and 26-of-48 (.542) from two.

TAKING CARE OF ROAD BUSINESS

In the midst of its eighth season under the leadership of head coach **Wes Moore**, the Wolfpack has earned 53 true road wins (averaging 7.1 per completed season) since the start of the 2013-14 season. In the prior eight seasons from 2005-06 to 2012-13, the Wolfpack earned 32 true road wins (4.0 per season).

DOUBLE-DOUBLE CLUB

Four different Wolfpack players have contributed a double-double performance this season - **Elissa Cunane** (3), **Kayla Jones** (3), **Jada Boyd** (2) and **Jakia Brown-Turner** (1). That mark ranks second in the league behind North Carolina with six different players posting double-doubles.

DISHING IT OUT

Two Wolfpack starters are averaging 3+ assists per game - **Raina Perez** (4.5, 4.5 average) and **Jakia Brown-Turner** (3.2, 3.2 average). NC State is the only program with two players averaging 3.2+ assists. Both of those players also take great care of the ball with the conference's top two assist-to-turnover ratios of 3.21 and 3.20 respectively.

As a team, NC State has dished out 20 or more assists in four games, which includes a season-high 28 assists in the Pack's win over Coastal Carolina. That number marks the most in a single game for NC State in the Wes Moore era (previous high was 27 against Elon in 2013, Moore's first season with the Wolfpack). It is also the most for the Pack in a single game since at least the 2000-01 campaign.

RANKED WINS UNDER MOORE

Under the leadership of head coach Wes Moore, NC State has defeated a total of 21 nationally-ranked opponents, 14 of which have come in the last four seasons. The Pack has defeated two top-five foes under Moore's leadership (No. 2 Notre Dame in 2016-17 and No. 1 South Carolina earlier this season).

The Wolfpack has hosted a total of 11 opponents ranked in the AP Top 25 since the renovation of Reynolds Coliseum (start of the 2016-17 season), and NC State has won seven of those 11 home games.

WE WIN

In what was one of the most highly-anticipated matchups of non-conference collegiate women's basketball, NC State came away with the 54-46 victory over No. 1 South Carolina on the road on Dec. 3. The victory marked the Wolfpack's first over a top-ranked team since March 3, 2007 when it defeated No. 1 Duke in the ACC Tournament. It was also just the third win over a top-ranked team in a total of 20 tries in program history.

STATEMENT SHOOTING NIGHT

On Nov. 29, NC State picked up a 108-70 victory over NC Central during which the team posted its highest field-goal percentage since Nov. 23, 1990. The team shot 41-of-60 from the floor for its second-highest shooting percentage in 46 completed seasons of Wolfpack women's basketball.

The team's performance was its first time exceeding 100 points in a single game in the Wes Moore era. The last time NC State had done so was with 102 points in a win over Longwood on Nov. 15, 2012. The Pack's 108 points also marked the most in a contest since the 1996-97 campaign.

Elissa Cunane reached the 1,000 career point milestone in the first game of her junior campaign. After the 2019-20 season was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Cunane needed just 12 points to reach 1,000 and hit that exact number in the first half of the Wolfpack's win over North Florida.

Cunane became the ninth active ACC player, the only active junior in the conference and the 35th player in program history to reach the milestone. It took the Summerfield, N.C., native just 67 career games and 43 career starts.

THEN AND NOW

After the 2018-19 Wolfpack team was plagued by injuries, multiple players were called upon to step up to the plate, including then-sophomores **Kayla Jones** and **Kai Crutchfield**. The season prepared both of them for even better junior campaigns during which each player saw her statistical output increase drastically.

2019-20 REWIND

NC State capped off one of the best seasons in its 46-year history by winning the 2020 ACC Tournament on March 8. The title was the first for NC State in 29 years (since 1991) and the fifth in program history.

Overall on the season, NC State:

- Reached 25+ wins for the third season in a row with its 28-4 overall record
- Won a program-best 14 ACC games, bettering its previous record of 13 ACC wins set during the 1984-85 campaign
- Compiled the best 23-game record in program history as it opened the year 22-1, surpassing 21-2 marks set in both 1977-78 and 2018-19
- Finished second in the league following regular season play, marking its best ACC Tournament seed since 1990 when it was the top-seeded squad
- Earned its best season-ending AP ranking since 1990-91 when it was tabbed eighth in the nation

SENIOR CLASS

The four-year members of NC State's senior class - **Kai Crutchfield** and **Kayla Jones** - will look to continue making their mark on the Pack. Since they arrived at the start of the 2017-18 campaign, Crutchfield and Jones have helped the Wolfpack go 92-19 (.829) overall, 53-7 (.883)

at home and 42-13 (.764) in conference play in three seasons. The class needs 13 victories to tie for the most by a four-year group in program history (105).

SOPHOMORE SENSATION

Center **Elissa Cunane's** breakout sophomore campaign was highlighted by All-America Third Team honors from the Associated Press and USBWA and Honorable Mention All-America honors from the WBCA. Cunane's status as an AP All-America honoree made her the first player in program history to earn a spot on one of the three teams after six honorable mention recognitions in program history.

Cunane is one of five returning All-ACC selections from last season, joining Louisville's Dana Evans, Syracuse's Kiara Lewis, Virginia Tech's Aisha Sheppard and Wake Forest's Ivana Raca. Cunane received three ACC Preseason Player of the Year votes from the league's head coaches and 11 from the Blue Ribbon Panel.

WEST RETURNS

Over the offseason, Wes Moore rounded out and bolstered his staff with the announcement of **Nikki West's** return to the Wolfpack bench. West previously spent five seasons (2013-14 through 2017-18) on the NC State staff and rejoined the Pack after spending the 2019-20 campaign as an assistant coach for the Charlotte 49ers.

In her previous five seasons with the Wolfpack, West helped Moore and the Pack post a 112-52 (.683) overall record and a 51-29 (.638) mark in ACC games. She helped lead NC State to postseason invitations each year, including a Sweet 16 berth in 2018, in addition to four 20+ win campaigns, two top-four ACC finishes and three top-25 national finishes.

THREEEEEEEEEEEE

At the end of last season, NC State set the NCAA Division I women's college basketball record for most consecutive made three pointers by a team. The Wolfpack started its March 1, 2020 game at Virginia shooting a perfect 13-of-13 from downtown before missing its first three of the game early in the third quarter. Additionally impressive, seven different members of the NC State roster contributed to the streak.

The 13 consecutive threes surpassed the previous record of 11, which was set by both Bowling Green (Feb. 6, 2016) and TCU (March 3, 1996).

POSTSEASON PROGRESS

During the 2019 postseason, NC State participated in NCAA Tournament games in Raleigh for the second consecutive year. The Wolfpack is 16-2 in NCAA Tournament games played in Raleigh and has not lost a home game in the tournament since 1983.

NC State made its fourth NCAA Tournament appearance during head coach Wes Moore's sixth season in Raleigh. This marked the first time that the Wolfpack has made three consecutive NCAA Tournaments since the program did so in 2005, 2006, and 2007. With its first-round victory over Maine on March 23, 2019, NC State has won at least one game in three straight tournaments played for the first time since the program did so in 1989, 1990, and 1991.

The Wolfpack concluded the 2018-19 season in the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament, making its second consecutive appearance in this round for the first time since 1990 and 1991.
