KEY STORYLINES

SCOUTING NC STATE

- The Wolfpack enters Friday's match with a 7-8 overall record and a 1-3 ACC record
- Most recently, NC State was on the road in Florida, falling to Florida State (3-1) and Miami (3-0)
- NC State has a notable win over Georgia (3-1) and an ACC win over Virginia (3-1)
- The Wolfpack is led offensively by Jade Parchment, averaging 3.77 kills per set, good for fifth in the ACC. The senior is also averaging 4.05 points per set which is a team-high and sixth in the ACC
- Kristen McDaniel is the assist leader for NC State with 10.37 per set and 425

total. She ranks fifth in the ACC in assists per set

- Libero Kaylee Frazier has 158 total digs on the year and leads the team with 3.59 digs per set
- The Wolfpack has 100 total blocks on the year, compared to 143.5 by its opponents

SCOUTING NORTH CAROLINA

- Sitting at 11-4 overall, the Tar Heels will take on Wake Forest on Friday night before hosting the Hokies
- UNC is 0-4 in ACC play but has notable wins over Michigan (3-2) and Duke (3-0) in a non-ACC match
- Leading the Tar Heels

on the offensive end is Nia Robinson, averaging 3.98 points per set with 195 kills

- Kaya Merkler has a team-high .410 hitting percentage which is second in the ACC. She also is ninth in the ACC with 1.11 blocks per set with 52 total
- Libero Karenna Wurl has 162 digs on the season and is 10th in the ACC in digs per set with 3.77
- Meghan Neelon is the primary setter for the Tar Heels with a team-high 371 assists and 6.75 assists per set

LAST TIME AGAINST NC STATE

- The Hokies wrapped up their fall slate against NC State in October 2020, falling 3-0 in both matches
- During the last match, Marisa Cerchio recorded a team-high seven kills and added two total blocks on the defensive end
- Logan Mosley recorded double-digit digs for the eighth straight match
- NC State hit .278 on the day vs. .029 for the Hokies
- The Wolfpack also had seven aces compared to only two by Tech

LAST TIME AGAINST NORTH CAROLINA

- Virginia Tech split its two matches against UNC a season ago, falling in the first match 3-1 and taking the second match 3-2
- The win was the Hokies first ACC victory of the season and head coach Marci Byer's first ACC win as a Hokie
- Talyn Jackson recorded a season-high 32 assists and Brie Postema recorded her third straight game with 20 or more assists
- Marisa Cerchio had 15 kills and two blocks while the Hokies hit .297 as a team with 65 kills
- The Hokies also had a strong defensive performance with 11 blocks compared to only five by UNC

ABOUT A WEEK AGO

- The Hokies spent last weekend up north, facing Boston College on Friday and Syracuse on Sunday
- Virginia Tech had a season-high 19 blocks against Boston College but ultimately fell in five sets
- Cera Powell recorded 13 kills while Angel Robinson had a career-high eight total blocks on the day
- Brie Postema also had a career-high against BC with 45 assists on the night
- Anabel Zier made her way into the lineup and made an impact defensively with seven blocks
- Tech finished the weekend with a 3-0 loss to Syracuse, as Powell once again led the Hokies with 10 kills
- Mosley added 14 digs and Postema had 23 assists

ACC PLAY

- The Hokies finished ACC play with a 5-11 record a season ago, sweeping Virginia as well as then-No. 14 Duke and Syracuse
- The ACC currently has three teams ranked in the top 25. Georgia Tech is currently No. 18, while Pitt is No. 2 and Louisville is No. 3
- Two teams are currently undefeated with Louisville (14-0) and Pitt (14-0) not suffering a loss so far this season

- The ACC was 7-2 in non-conference ranked matches and 6-3 against top-15 opponents this season
- As a whole, the ACC was 103-25 in non-conference play which was best among the Power 5

DID YOU KNOW...

- Heading into last weekend, Virginia Tech had played the highest number of sets so far this season in the ACC with 57 over 14 matches
- After playing five sets against the Hokies and Wake Forest, Boston College now has the highest number of sets with 70. The Hokies are at 65 sets played
- Miami has only played 47 sets over 14 matches
- Seven of Virginia Tech's matches have gone into five sets as the Hokies have a 4-3 record in five-set matches

THE LOWE DOWN

- Blacksburg native Amanda Lowe got her first start as a Hokie against Chattanooga and has made an impact for the Hokies
- At the Hokie Invite, she tallied two career-highs against Wofford with 11 kills and 13 points
- The freshman hit .692 against George Mason and .688 against Wofford, both match-highs for the Hokies
- On the weekend, Lowe finished with 2.82 kills per set over the three matches with a .367 hitting percentage
- She totaled 31 kills and nine total blocks

BLOCKSBURG

- The Hokies are currently ranked fifth nationally in total team blocks with 161.5 and lead the ACC
- Tech recorded 19 blocks in the match over Boston College, a season-high for the Hokies and three blocks away from the school record of 22 set in 2001
- Angel Robinson has been a big contributor to the Hokie's block total with 71 blocks. She is currently ranked third in the ACC and 25th nationally
- Middle blocker Tasha Vipond has also been in on the action, recording 60 blocks, good for eighth in the ACC

CONFERENCE STATS

- The Hokies come in at fourth for opponent hitting percentage, with opposing teams averaging a .169 hitting percentage, ahead of this week's opponents NC State (#14) and North Carolina (#8)
- Virginia Tech also sits in the fifth spot for

- blocks, averaging 2.48 per set in the ACC
- The Hokies also land within the top ten spots for total team digs (second), service aces (second) and opponent blocks (fifth)

ACC LEADERS

- Logan Mosley leads the ACC in digs with 274 and is second in digs per set with 4.22 on the season
- Middle Blocker Angel Robinson secures the fifth spot for hitting percentage, posting a .393, a team-high, on 224 total attempts
- Tasha Vipond grabs the number six spot for blocks with an average of 1.28 per set. She has 47 total blocks, with nine solo blocks and 51 block assists
- Sophomore Cierra Huntely is ranked tenth in service aces, holding an average of .37 per set and 18 total

Marci Byers was named the sixth head coach of the Virginia Tech volleyball program in January, 2020. She enters her second season at the helm of the Hokies.

During her first season with Tech, the team tallied five conference wins including a sweep of Virginia and a win over then No. 14 Duke in five sets. Byers looks to build off the 2020 season with many key returners and 10 newcomers set to make an impact.

A four-time Big South Coach of the Year selection at Radford University, she is the winningest coach in Highlanders' history, leading the program to three Big South regular season titles, two Big South Tournament championships and two NCAA Tournament berths. She is one of only five head coaches in Big South history to register 200 or more career victories.

Throughout her tenure at Radford, the Chicago native consistently recruited top talent to the New River Valley from across the country, thanks to her strong relationships within the ACC footprint, as well as with elite club programs in the Midwest, Texas and California.

Byers' squads at Radford topped the 20-win mark five times over seven seasons and compiled an 81-34 (.708) overall record over four years. She led the Highlanders to a 22-7 record in 2018, including a 12-4 mark in Big South play. They reached the Big South Tournament title game for the second consecutive season and were selected to play in the National Invitational Volleyball Championship where they defeated App State in the first round. During her tenure at Radford, her student-athletes twice registered the top team GPA of any program at the school (2008 and 2013).

No stranger to defeating Power Five foes, under her direction in 2017 the Highlanders registered wins at Arizona, at South Carolina and at Virginia Tech en route to a Big South Tournament title and an NCAA Tournament berth. In 2016, Byers led Radford to a 24-6 record, including a perfect 11-0 mark at home and a Big South regular season championship. Her squads also registered wins against Wake Forest in 2016 and Washington State in 2015. Byers' 2014 squad finished with a 24-8 mark that included wins over California and Maryland as Radford claimed

the Big South regular season title. The Highlanders earned their first NCAA Tournament appearance under Byers in 2013 after winning both the Big South regular season and tournament titles, finishing the season with a 25-10 record.

Prior to beginning her tenure at Radford in 2008, she spent two seasons at NCAA Division II Chowan University in Murfreesboro, N.C. After going 4-17 in her initial season in 2006, Byers guided the Hawks to a 26-11 record as the squad averaged the most aces per game of any Division II squad. Prior to joining the collegiate ranks, she posted a 121-49 record in 10 seasons coaching in the Richmond prep ranks, spending two seasons at Mills Godwin High School and eight years at Hermitage High School.

Byers has also been a successful coach at the club level. Her 2003-04 team qualified for the Junior Olympics in Houston, while her 2004-05 team reached the Junior Olympics in Salt Lake City. She was also invited to participate in the USA Volleyball Coaches Clinic at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs.

She is a 1995 graduate of Virginia Union University where she graduated with honors with a bachelor's degree in secondary education with a concentration in mathematics. A four-year starter on the volleyball team, she captained the team as both a junior and senior. Her husband, J.D., serves as an assistant men's basketball coach at VCU. The couple are parents of a daughter, Kamryn Grey.



BY THE NUMBERS

NOTEWORTHY

ON THE ROAD

- The Hokies have put up a 4-4 record away from Cassell Coliseum so far this season, competing in tournaments at North Florida and Chattanooga
- Tech's two non-conference losses came at the hands of North Florida (3-2) and Troy (3-1)
- The Hokies look to snap the five-game skid they are on as they make the trip to NC State and North Carolina
- This is Virginia Tech's second weekend on the road before coming back to host two straight weekends in Blacksburg

POINTS PER SET

- The Hokies currently have six players who are averaging over two points per set
- Griere Hughes leads the way with 2.98 points per set. She has 159 kills and 182 points total
- Angel Robinson is averaging 1.62 kills per set and is second on the team with 158 total points so far this season
- After her weekend at BC and Syracuse, Anabel Zier is now averaging 2.06 points per set with 1.38 kills per set

ZERO TIME TO WASTE

- Anabel Zier played a season-high four sets against Boston College last Friday, making a big impact at the net with seven total blocks, as the Hokies recorded a season-high 19
- The junior also had six kills and hit .308 over her four sets, both a season-high for her
- Zier made her first start of the season the following Sunday against Syracuse, playing in all three sets
- She had five kills and a block assist on the afternoon

GETTING IN THE GROOVE

- Graduate student Griere Hughes has been making an impact for the Hokies on the court, leading the team in several different categories
- Along with points per set, the outside hitter is also leading the team in kills per set with 2.61
- Hughes already has 159 kills on the season,

40 more than the next highest player on the team

- She has also been big at the net for Tech, with 30 total blocks, good for .49 blocks per set

OPENING ACC PLAY

- The Hokies entered the 2021 conference season with a 9-3 record after a 2-1 weekend at the Hokie Invite
- In 2019, Virginia Tech went into conference play with a 7-6 record. The previous year, the Hokies had a 9-3 record heading into ACC play
- The Hokies look to record their first ACC win of the season at NC State on Friday

1,000 DIGS CLUB

- Junior libero Logan Mosley is 27 digs away from joining the 1,000 digs club
- She would be the 19th Hokie in school history to achieve this milestone
- Mosley set the freshman record in 2019, recording 507 digs as a rookie and breaking the record of 481 set in 2016
- She also set the single-match dig record as a freshman in just her fifth match, scooping up 39 digs vs. Davidson
- Mosley currently has 273 digs on the year, with her season-high sitting at 34, which she posted in a match against Davidson

HOKIE LEADERS

- The Hokies are outperforming their opponents in hitting percentage this season, hitting .194 on the year compared to .169 by opponents
- Virginia Tech has also had success at the net, leading its opponents with 161.5 blocks and allowing 118.5 by opponents. The Hokies are averaging 2.5 blocks per set while opponents are averaging 1.8
- Nationally, the Hokies are ranked 5th in total blocks with 161.5
- Angel Robinson leads the Hokies in total blocks with 71, while Tasha Vipond adds 60 total blocks
- Sophomore Brie Postema leads the Hokies in assists, totaling 267
