KEY STORYLINES

SCOUTING BOSTON COLLEGE

- The Eagles enter Friday's contest with a 15-14 overall record and 5-10 mark in ACC play
- Most recently, the Eagles had a single game weekend with a 3-1 win over the Duke Blue Devils. The previous weekend, BC fell to Pitt 3-0 but beat Virginia 3-1
- Boston College is averaging 12.5 kills per set with 11.5 assists per set. The Eagles are also leading opponents with 1.3 aces per set
- Offensively, Clare Naughton leads the team with 3.34 kills per set and 3.72 points per set
- Amaka Chukwujekwu has 219 kills on the season and sits at eighth in the ACC in

hitting percentage with a .335

- Setters Penn Grace and Sophia Lambros are the leaders in assists, as Grace has posted 498 and Lambros added 402, both averaging over four assists per set
- Defensively, Gabby McCaa and Chukwujekwu have each recorded 87 blocks, as McCaa is averaging .86 blocks per set and Chukwujekwu has .81 blocks per set.
- Anna Murphy leads the Eagles in digs with 409 and 3.93 per set. She is ranked first in the conference in digs as well as fifth in the conference in digs per set

SCOUTING NOTRE DAME

- The Fighting Irish have only one match this weekend with the Hokies making the trip to South Bend for a 1 p.m. first serve.
- Notable wins for the Irish include then-No. 18 Georgia Tech (3-2) and Arizona (3-2). Notre Dame also swept North Carolina and N.C. State earlier this season
- Last weekend, Notre Dame defeated N.C. State 3-0 but fell to No. 1 Louisville 3-0. Both matches were played in South Bend
- Charley Niego and Aubrey Hamilton lead the Irish attack as Niego leads the team with 272 kills and 3.02 kills per set. Hamilton is averaging 2.97 kills per set with 276

total kills. Lauren Tarnoff is leading the Irish with a .329 hitting percentage

- At the net, Notre Dame has 237.5 blocks compared to only 194 by opponents. Lindsey Miller plays a big role in the block with 99 total and 1.06 per set. Tarnoff is leading the team with 1.37 blocks per set
- The assist leader is Zoe Nunez, she has 812 total and is averaging 8.83 per set. She also has 239 digs with 2.60 per set

LAST TIME AGAINST BOSTON COLLEGE

- The Hokies fell to the Eagles 3-2 (18-25, 25-15, 25-21, 20-25, 13-15) earlier this season on Oct. 1 in Boston
- Despite recording a season-high 19 blocks, BC pulled away in the fourth and fifth sets to record its 12th win of the season and second in the ACC. The Hokies fell to 9-6 and 0-3 in ACC play
- For the Hokies, Powell recorded 13 kills and Marisa Cerchio added 12. Cerchio also had seven block assists on the night, as well as Angel Robinson with a solo block and seven block assists.
- Mosley had a solid night defensively, posting 20 digs for the Hokies.
- Clair Naughton ended her match with a team-high 17 kills for the Eagles while Amaka Chukwujekwu added 10

LAST TIME AGAINST NOTRE DAME

- Tech fell to Notre Dame 3-0 (25-18, 25-15, 25-15) on Oct. 17 in Blacksburg
- With the win, the Irish improved to 5-3 in the ACC and 8-10 overall. Tech fell to 9-11 and 0-8 in the conference
- For the Hokies, Griere Hughes ended her match with a team-high eight kills. Cera Powell also added seven
- Mara Perry had a solid match defensively, recording nine digs. Talyn Jackson was the primary setter with 24 assists.
- Notre Dame's offensive leader was Aubrey Hamilton with 13 kills, hitting .333 on the day
- Hattie Monson scooped up 12 digs and Charley Niego had a block solo and block assist, as the Irish finished the match with five total blocks

ABOUT A WEEK AGO

- The Virginia Tech volleyball team fell to North Carolina last Friday afternoon, taking a 3-1 loss (13-25, 25-11, 23-25, 17-25) to the Tar Heels
- After falling in the first set 25-13, Tech battled back to take the second set in convincing fashion, 25-11. The Hokies came out firing, going on a 6-1 run capped by a kill from Cerchio. Virginia Tech increased its lead to 11-3 and never relinquished it to even the score at one set apiece.

- After taking a tight third set, the Tar Heels powered through to take the fourth set 25-17 to earn their 19th win of the season and eighth in ACC play. The Hokies fall to 10-17 overall.
- For the Hokies, Cerchio led the way offensively with 14 kills, just shy of her career-high of 15. The senior hit .464 on the day. Hughes finished her match with 12 kills, with a .429 hitting percentage.
- Mosley finished with 18 digs and Postema added 15. On the block, Robinson had seven blocks assists and Cerchio added five.
- For UNC, Mabrey Shaffmaster recorded a double-double with 12 kills and 20 digs. Nia Robinson led the team with 16 kills and Amanda Phegley added 11. Meghan Neelon had a game-high 44 assists while Karena Wurl led the way with 24 digs.

ACC PLAY

- The Hokies finished ACC play with a 5-11 record a season ago, sweeping Virginia as well as then-No. 14 Duke and Syracuse
- The ACC currently has three teams ranked in the top 25. Georgia Tech is No. 13, while Pitt is No. 3 and Louisville is No. 1, the first team in ACC history to be ranked No. 1
- After Georgia Tech defeated Pitt, Louisville is the only undefeated ACC team with a 25-0 overall record
- The ACC has six teams in the top 30 of the Nov. 14 RPI. No. 1 Louisville leads the conference, followed by No. 2 Pitt, No. 6 Georgia Tech, No. 11 Florida State, No. 15 Miami and No. 28 North Carolina
- As a whole, the ACC was 127-33 in non-conference competition with a .794 win percentage, both the best among Power Five conferences

DID YOU KNOW...

- Heading into the Hokies first road ACC matches, Virginia Tech had played the highest number of sets so far this season in the ACC with 57 over 14 matches
- Boston College now has the most sets played with 107. Virginia Tech is second with 102 sets played
- Louisville has only played 87 sets over 25 matches as they have 11 ACC sweeps on the season
- Eight of Virginia Tech's matches have gone into five sets as the Hokies have a 5-3 record in five-set matches

TALYN ON THE BLOCK

- Setter Talyn Jackson has been big at the net recently for the Hokies, making her presence known on the block as well as assisting the attackers
- Back in the starting rotation against Louisville, Jackson recorded four total blocks against the No. 2 Cardinals. She followed that up with a block against Notre

Dame the next match

- Against Pitt, the senior recorded a season-high five total blocks, including a solo block and four block assists
- The Hokies had 13 total blocks against No. 4 Pitt compared to only six by the Panthers
- Jackson tied Angel Robinson for the team-high in blocks. Marisa Cerchio also added three

BLOCKSBURG

- The Hokies are currently ranked 73rd nationally in total team blocks with 229.5 and are seventh in the ACC
- Heading into the weekend of Oct. 8, the Hokies were ranked fifth nationally in total team blocks with 161.5 and led the ACC
- Tech recorded 19 blocks in the match over Boston College, a season-high for the Hokies and three blocks away from the school record of 22 set in 2001
- Angel Robinson has been a big contributor to the Hokie's block total with 105 blocks. She is currently ranked fifth in the ACC and 93rd nationally

Marci Byers was named the sixth head coach of the Virginia Tech volleyball program in January, 2020. She enters her second season at the helm of the Hokies.

During her first season with Tech, the team tallied five conference wins including a sweep of Virginia and a win over then No. 14 Duke in five sets. Byers looks to build off the 2020 season with many key returners and 10 newcomers set to make an impact.

A four-time Big South Coach of the Year selection at Radford University, she is the winningest coach in Highlanders' history, leading the program to three Big South regular season titles, two Big South Tournament championships and two NCAA Tournament berths. She is one of only five head coaches in Big South history to register 200 or more career victories.

Throughout her tenure at Radford, the Chicago native consistently recruited top talent to the New River Valley from across the country, thanks to her strong relationships within the ACC footprint, as well as with elite club programs in the Midwest, Texas and California.

Byers' squads at Radford topped the 20-win mark five times over seven seasons and compiled an 81-34 (.708) overall record over four years. She led the Highlanders to a 22-7 record in 2018, including a 12-4 mark in Big South play. They reached the Big South Tournament title game for the second consecutive season and were selected to play in the National Invitational Volleyball Championship where they defeated App State in the first round. During her tenure at Radford, her student-athletes twice registered the top team GPA of any program at the school (2008 and 2013).

No stranger to defeating Power Five foes, under her direction in 2017 the Highlanders registered wins at Arizona, at South Carolina and at Virginia Tech en route to a Big South Tournament title and an NCAA Tournament berth. In 2016, Byers led Radford to a 24-6 record, including a perfect 11-0 mark at home and a Big South regular season championship. Her squads also registered wins against Wake Forest in 2016 and Washington State in 2015. Byers' 2014 squad finished with a 24-8 mark that included wins over California and Maryland as Radford claimed

the Big South regular season title. The Highlanders earned their first NCAA Tournament appearance under Byers in 2013 after winning both the Big South regular season and tournament titles, finishing the season with a 25-10 record.

Prior to beginning her tenure at Radford in 2008, she spent two seasons at NCAA Division II Chowan University in Murfreesboro, N.C. After going 4-17 in her initial season in 2006, Byers guided the Hawks to a 26-11 record as the squad averaged the most aces per game of any Division II squad. Prior to joining the collegiate ranks, she posted a 121-49 record in 10 seasons coaching in the Richmond prep ranks, spending two seasons at Mills Godwin High School and eight years at Hermitage High School.

Byers has also been a successful coach at the club level. Her 2003-04 team qualified for the Junior Olympics in Houston, while her 2004-05 team reached the Junior Olympics in Salt Lake City. She was also invited to participate in the USA Volleyball Coaches Clinic at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs.

She is a 1995 graduate of Virginia Union University where she graduated with honors with a bachelor's degree in secondary education with a concentration in mathematics. A four-year starter on the volleyball team, she captained the team as both a junior and senior. Her husband, J.D., serves as an assistant men's basketball coach at VCU. The couple are parents of a daughter, Kamryn Grey.

NOTEWORTHY

ACC LEADERS

- Logan Mosley is third in the ACC in digs with 372 and is 9th in digs per set with 3.65 on the season
- Middle Blocker Angel Robinson secures the 10th spot for blocks per set, averaging 1.06 blocks per set, a team-high
- Tasha Vipond grabs the 11th spot for blocks per set with an average of 1.05. She has 79 total blocks, with 10 solo blocks and 69 block assists
- Sophomore Cierra Huntely is ranked fifth in service aces per set, holding an average of .35 and 18 total

NEW FACES

- Grace Kelly made her first appearance as a Hokie on Oct. 22, playing one set each against Florida State and Miami
- Against Florida State, the freshman recorded three kills on eight attempts throughout the set. In the Miami match, she had one kill and one dig
- Michelle Bennett played in her first match the previous weekend, making her Hokie debut against Louisville
- The freshman has played in every match since as a defensive specialist. She played in three sets against Miami, recording a team-high 10 digs, which is also a season-high for her

ZERO TIME TO WASTE

- Anabel Zier played a season-high four sets against Boston College, making a big impact at the net with seven total blocks, as the Hokies recorded a season-high 19 blocks
- The junior also had six kills and hit .308 over her four sets, both a season-high for her
- Zier made her first start of the season the following Sunday against Syracuse, playing in all three sets
- She had five kills and a block assist on the afternoon

GETTING IN THE GROOVE

- Graduate student Griere Hughes has been making an impact for the Hokies on the court, leading the team in several different categories
- Along with points per set, the outside hitter is also leading the team in kills per set with 2.66, which ranks 27th in the

conference

- Hughes has 242 kills on the season, 55 more than the next highest player on the team
- She has also been big at the net for Tech, with 43 total blocks, good for .47 blocks per set

1,000 KILLS

- Senior Marisa Cerchio is 24 kills away from reaching 1,000 kills over her Virginia Tech career
- Cerchio would be the 17th player in school history to reach the milestone, with the most recent Hokie being Kaity Smith who recorded 1,122 from 2017-20
- She has been a mainstay in the Hokie lineup since arriving on campus in 2017, playing in 446 sets over her five-year career
- The right-side hitter had a standout junior campaign, recording 312 kills after playing in all 31 matches, a career-high. She was averaging 2.62 kills per set and hit .218 on the season

MILESTONE ACHIEVED

- Logan Mosley recorded her 1,000th career dig in the match against Louisville, becoming the 19th Hokie in school history to do so
- The Apex, N.C. native recorded her ninth and record-clinching dig late in the third set
- She is the first Tech player to reach 1,000 career digs since Carol Rafferty did so in 2018
- Mosley also holds the single-match dig record, achieving 39 digs in just her fifth match as a freshman. The junior also holds the single-season freshman digs record, tallying 507 as a rookie

HOKIE LEADERS

- Virginia Tech has had success at the net, leading its opponents with 211.5 blocks and allowing 166.5 by opponents. The Hokies are averaging 2.3 blocks per set while opponents are averaging 1.8
- Leading the Hokies in points per set is Griere Hughes, averaging 3.02 so far this season, the only Hokie averaging over three points per set
- Brie Postema has taken over as the assist leader for the Hokies with 430. She is averaging 5.66 assists per set

RECORD BREAKDOWN
