KEY STORYLINES

THE SERIES

- The former Atlantic 10 foes are set to meet for the 17th time Friday afternoon in Charlotte, N.C. The Hokies hold a 10-6 advantage in the all-time series.
- This will be the second straight game against an A-10 opponent after falling to Dayton, 62-57, Sunday afternoon on the road.
- Friday's game will be the fourth time Tech and St. Bonaventure clash at a neutral site. The Hokies have a 2-1 edge in those meetings.
- Tech will take a two-game win streak into Friday's matchup with the Bonnies. It's last loss in the series was on Nov. 22, 2002 (91-78) in

St. Thomas, V.I. This game was later vacated by St. Bonaventure due to the use of an ineligible player.

A WIN WOULD...

- Give the Hokies their first win at a neutral site this season.
- Improve Tech to 11-6 in the all-time series and mark its third straight win against the Bonnies.
- Hand St. Bonaventure its second straight loss.
- Prevent Tech from dropping back-to-back games for the second time this season.
- Secure the Hokies' secondbest NET win of the season. St. Bonaventure checks in at No. 81 entering Friday's game.

HOKIE HEADLINES

- Keve Aluma has reached double-figure scoring in six straight games. He's at least tied for leading scorer honors in four straight games.
- Tech is coming off a seasonlow 21 field goals made at Dayton. It was the third time the Hokies finished with a field-goal percentage below 40 percent.
- Friday's game will feature two teams that rely heavily on their starting five. The Hokies' starters produce 74.3 percent of Tech's scoring. The Bonnies get 86.9 percent of their scoring from starters. In fact, only three bench players have scored for SBU all season.

NOTEWORTHY

MUTTS NAMED CANDIDATE FOR SENIOR CLASS AWARD

- Virginia Tech's Justyn Mutts has been selected as a candidate for the 2021-22 Senior CLASS Award.
- An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®, the Senior CLASS Award recognizes seniors that have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.
- Mutts was named one of 30 NCAA Division I men's basketball student-athletes in contention for the award.
- From the list of 30 candidates, a committee
 will select 10 finalists for the Senior CLASS
 Award in February. Those 10 names will
 then be placed on the official ballot for
 a nationwide vote. Fan balloting will be
 coupled with votes from coaches and media
 to determine the recipient of the award.

EMBRACE HARD

- Mike Young told the Hokies in the locker room following their win over Cornell to "embrace hard."
- He was referring to Tech's upcoming schedule, which includes road dates at Dayton, Duke and North Carolina, along with a neutral-site matchup with preseason A-10 favorite St. Bonaventure.

EXPERIENCE VS. EXPERIENCE

- Friday's game will feature two of the more veteran starting lineups in the nation.
- The Hokies will have three fifth-year players in their starting lineup, meanwhile the Bonnies will have five seniors or older in their starting rotation.

SEVENTH HEAVEN

 Seven Hokies reached double figures in the scoring column against Cornell on Dec. 8.
 This is the first time that's occured since Dec. 17, 2016 vs. The Citadel.

CAREER DAYS AGAINST THE BIG RED

- Darius Maddox and Sean Pedulla dialed up career highs in the scoring column against Cornell, contributing 14 and 11, respectively.
- David N'Guessan racked up a career-high nine boards.

WHAT CAN YA DO?

- On Dec. 4, Wake Forest shot 63.5 percent (33-52) from the field, the highest mark by any Virginia Tech opponent since Dayton (63.6) on Nov. 26, 2019 in the Maui Invitational.
- It was the highest field-goal percentage by an ACC team in any game this season, and Tech became the first high-major program to allow an opponent to shoot 63.5 or higher (as of Dec. 4).

WHATEVER IT TAKES

- Virginia Tech ranks eighth nationally on defense in non-steal turnover percentage (.135), per KenPom.com.
- Non-steal turnovers forced include travels, double-dribbles, offensive fouls or any time the ball is out of bounds without the defense directly forcing it.

REBOUND. REBOUND. REBOUND!

 Against Memphis, Justyn Mutts (12) and Keve Aluma (11) combined for 23 of Tech's 33 rebounds. It was the first time Tech had two players record double-digit rebounds in the same game since Mutts and Aluma did so at Notre Dame on Jan. 27, 2021.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE KEVE

- Keve Aluma recorded his first double-double of the season vs. Memphis - 14 points and 11 rebounds.
- The Berlin, Maryland native recorded the second double-double of the season in his homecoming game against the Terrapins on Dec. 1 - 17 points and 12 rebounds.
- He led all Hokies with six double-doubles during the 2020-21 campaign.
- Aluma has reached double-figure scoring in nine of Tech's 11 games and double-figure rebounding in two games.

WHAT A START

- Tech won each of its first five games by an average of 28 points per game.
- Each game was decided by at least 20 points. The smallest margin of victory was at Navy (77-57). The largest margin of victory

 The last time the Hokies won five games in a row, all by 20-or-more points, was in 1943-44. Between Jan. 26 and Feb. 12, 1944, Tech rattled off six-consecutive wins by 20-plus points against VMI (twice), Blackstone Army

was vs. Maine in the season opener (82-47).

MOMENTUM ON OUR SIDE

- With its third-place finish in the regularseason standings in 2020-21, Tech has finished in the top five of the ACC two of the last three seasons.
- Placing third tied for the highest ACC finish in school history as the Hokies tied for third in 2006-07 and 2009-10.
- If Tech can post a top-five ACC finish this season, it would mark the third time in four years accomplishing that feat.

YOU GET A BUCKET, YOU GET A BUCKET, EVERYBODY GETS A BUCKET

- Eight players scored a 3-point field goal vs.
 Merrimack. The last time that occurred was against Coppin State on Dec. 19, 2020.
- With late threes from walk-ons Camden Johnson and Ben Varga, each member of the Hokies' squad has scored a point this season. Keve Aluma leads the way for Tech with 158 points.

BENCH PRODUCTION

- A big question mark entering the 2021-22 season was the impact Tech's bench would have
- Through 11 games, the Hokies' reserves are averaging 18.1 points per game.
- Tech has gone over the 30-point threshold three times, with a season-high 36 points coming against Maine and Cornell.
- Per KenPom, the Hokies rank 322nd in bench players contributing minutes (.236).
 With the starting five that Mike Young has rolled with through the first 10 games, each player is averaging at least 27.4 mpg.

DEGREES ON DEGREES

- Storm Murphy and Justyn Mutts are both in grad school at Virginia Tech.
- Murphy graduated from Wofford with a finance degree in May 2021 and is currently pursuing
 a graduate degree in leadership studies within the Agricultural and Life Sciences program at
 Virginia Tech.
- Mutts graduated with a psychology degree from Delaware and completed his master's degree
 at Tech in agricultural and life sciences with a concentration in education in May 2021. He's
 currently pursuing his second master's degree in educational psychology.
- Keve Aluma earned his first undergraduate degree in human development from Virginia Tech in May 2021 and is currently working on his second undergraduate degree in sociology.

PUT THE CLAMPS ON 'EM

Through the first five games of the season, the Hokies held each of their opponents below 60 points. Their 57.2 scoring defense average ranks second in the ACC and 13th nationally.

- The last time Tech opened the season holding its first five opponents below 60 points was the 1946-47 season. That season, the Hokies held their first 18 opponents below the 60-point threshold.
- In addition to their scoring defense, the Hokies rank fourth in the ACC in field-goal percentage defense (.402).
- Tech held its first six opponents of the season below 40 percent shooting before Xavier shot 47.8 percent against the Hokies on Nov. 26.

OWNING THE ARC

• The 3-point line has been under new management 11 games into the 2021-22 season. Tech has owned both sides of the arc, ranking first in 3FG% defense (.254) and third in 3FG% (.393) among ACC programs. The Hokies are also fourth in 3-pointers made per game (8.6).

WINNING THE TURNOVER BATTLE

- Through 11 games this season, Tech has won the turnover battle 10 times.
- The lone game where the Hokies failed to win the turnover battle was against Wake Forest on Dec. 4.
- The Hokies rank fifth in the ACC and 35th nationally in turnovers per game (10.7).

TECH SIGNS NO. 26 CLASS IN THE COUNTRY

 Coach Young announced the signing of three standout recruits during the early signing period, which began on Nov. 10. The Hokies are set to welcome MJ Collins (Rock Hill, S.C.), Patrick Wessler (Matthews, N.C.) and Rodney Rice (Clinton, Md.) to Blacksburg next summer as part of Tech's 26th-ranked recruiting class according to 247Sports.

REUNITED IN BLACKSBURG

- Keve Aluma, Storm Murphy and Coach Young spent two seasons (2017-19) together at Wofford, highlighted by their 2018-19 season that included a first-round win (84-68) over Seton Hall in the 2019 NCAA Tournament.
- Upon Aluma's and Young's departure from Wofford, Murphy stuck around in Spartanburg, South Carolina, guiding the Terriers to a 34-25 record.
- While together at Wofford, the trio combined for a 51-18 (.739) mark.

WHO IS THIS GUY?

- Keve Aluma only attempted one 3-pointer in his two seasons at Wofford. In Coach Young's words, "it wasn't even close."
- Fast forward two seasons and Aluma has become a post player with range from beyond the arc. He attempted 57 threes in his Hokie debut in 2020-21, knocking down 20 of them for a 35.1 percent clip.
- After going 2-16 through Tech's first eight games this season, Aluma knocked down four of his seven attempts from long range vs. Wake Forest.

JUSTYN TIME

- Coach Young has gone on record saying, "Justyn Mutts was probably the key to our year last year."
- The Delaware transfer was the Hokies' fourth-leading scorer from last season (9.5) and second-leading rebounder (6.4).
- From Dec. 29, 2020 through the end of the season, Mutts scored at least nine points in 11 of Tech's 14 games. The Millville, New Jersey native twice broke the 20-point plateau - at Miami (Fla.) (22) and vs. North Carolina (24) - during that stretch.

LOGGING THE MINUTES

- Storm Murphy logged 3,723 minutes in his career entering this season, which is the 16th-most of anyone in the country returning for 2021-22.
- He ranked ninth in that category among point guards.

- The Bonnies enter Friday's matchup following their second loss of the season - a 74-64 defeat against No. 15 UConn. St. Bonaventure sits at 8-2 on the season with a 3-1 record in neutral-site contests.
- Leading St. Bonaventure in scoring is a pair of senior guards - Kyle Lofton and Jaren Holmes - both averaging 17.4 points per game. Holmes is a staple in the Bonnies' lineup, averaging 38:34 minutes per game, which is best in the country. St. Bonaventure protects the rock well, as it ranks first in the A-10 in turnovers per game (10.0) and third in assist-turnover ratio.
- All five members of the Bonnies starting rotation - each of which have at least four years of experience - average double-digit scoring. Holding his own down low is 6-foot-10 center Osun Osunniyi, who sits second in the A-10 in blocks per game with 2.9 and is the reigning A-10 Defensive Player of the
- Mark Schmidt, the 2016 and 2021 Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year, is in his 15th season in charge of the Bonnies. Holding the spot as the all-time leader in wins at St. Bonaventure. Schmidt has led his squad

to 18-plus wins in seven of the last eight seasons. Last season was one of the most impressive in Bonnies' history, as the program claimed both the A-10 regular season and tournament titles.





CHALLENGING NONCON

- Coach Young's nonconference scheduling philosophy is quite different from his predecessor - one in which should provide plenty of Quadrant 1 and Quadrant 2 opportunities for the NCAA Tournament resume.
- The Hokies have the potential to play up to six Quadrant 1 or 2 games in their nonconference slate, highlighted by games vs. Memphis, vs. Xavier, at Maryland and vs. St. Bonaventure.
- It's important to note, Tech secured two Quadrant 1 wins all of last season (vs. Villanova and vs. Virginia).
- Six of the Hokies' 11 nonconference games will be played either on the road or at neutral sites.
- Three of Tech's nonconference opponents appeared in the AP preseason poll: No. 12 Memphis, No. 21 Maryland and No. 23 St. Bonaventure.

HOKIES IN PRIMETIME

- If you're a night owl, then the Hokies' 2021-22 schedule will be right up your ally.
- Tech is set to appear in at least 10 games this season with an official start time of 8 p.m. or later. Seven of those games will tip at 9 p.m. or later.

PROGRAM WIN NO. 1,500

- Virginia Tech earned its 1,500th program win Nov. 21 vs. Merrimack, becoming the 90th men's basketball program in Division I history to achieve the mark.
- Tech joined ACC counterparts North Carolina, Duke, Syracuse, Notre Dame, NC State, Louisville, Virginia, Pitt and Wake Forest as the 10 conference programs that have reached the milestone.

NOTEWORTHY

STORM WARNING

- Grad student Storm Murphy takes over the reins at point guard following the graduation of Wabissa Bede.
- The Wofford transfer averaged 17.8 points, 3.3 rebounds and 4.3 assists last season. He was one of only 11 players to average that stat line or better nationally.
- Murphy tallied double figures in 21 of 24 contests, including 10 20-point performances, and dished over five assists on eight occasions.
- He concluded his Wofford career with 1,315 points to finish 24th on the program's alltime scoring list.
- The First-Team All-SoCon selection will provide a scoring threat from outside, as he shot 40 percent from three last season.
- Murphy knocked down 70 3-pointers a year ago. In comparison, Bede connected on 12 with a 24.5 percent clip.

DANCIN' IN YEAR TWO

- In previous seasons in Virginia Tech history, the fastest head coach to make the NCAA Tournament was in Year Three. Those Hokies were Howie Shannon, Charlie Moir and Buzz Williams.
- Therefore, with Mike Young doing so in Year Two, he became the fastest Tech coach to make The Dance.

HOKIE CENSUS

- Tech has 13 players on the squad who represent eight states and two international countries (Netherlands, Nigeria).
- Florida leads the way with three players Hunter Cattoor, Lynn Kidd and Jalen Haynes – while Maryland has two players – Keve Aluma and Darius Maddox.

BOUNCEBACK MENTALITY

- Tech doesn't lose back-to-back games as it did against Memphis and Xavier, often.
- Young and the Hokies were 5-1 last season after a loss with their lone back-to-back losing skid coming at the end of the season to North Carolina in the ACC Tournament and Florida in the NCAA Tournament.
- In 2019-20, Young had five wins following a loss.

50 SPOT

- Tech shot over 50 percent in a game five times during the 2020-21 season - going 5-0.
- Since Young got to Blacksburg, the Hokies are 14-1 in contests shooting 50 percent or greater, with the lone loss coming to BYU on Nov. 27, 2019 in the fifth-place game of the Maui Jim Maui Invitational.
- Over the last decade (2010-11 season to present), Tech is 85-12 when shooting 50 percent or better.

LEADING AT THE BREAK

- Over the last two seasons, Tech is 19-2 when leading at halftime, with the two losses coming against North Carolina and Florida to end the 2020-21 season.
- The Hokies are 32-6 in the Mike Young era when up at half.

GREEN-LIGHTED FROM THREE

- With the potential lineup of Storm Murphy, Hunter Cattoor, Nahiem Alleyne, Justyn Mutts and Keve Aluma, all five of those players have the green light from distance.
- The last team Coach Young had with this type of threat from deep was his 2018-19 Wofford squad, which ranked second nationally in 3-point accuracy (41.4). The Terriers finished 30-5 that season, including

an unbeaten mark in SoCon action, and reached the second round of the 2019 NCAA Tournament.

RANKED WINS BECOMIN' COMMON

• Tech had four ranked wins last season, tying the most-ever in school history (set 2017-18).

REACH OUR POTENTIAL

- When asked how he'd define success for this season, Coach Young expressed he wanted the Hokies to reach their potential.
- "That will be a real success for me," he said,
 "And I'll get back to the mountains of North Carolina this spring and fish with a big smile on my face."


ACC POY CONVERSATION

CASSELL COLISEUM - RENDERING OF PROPOSED \$75 MILLION-PLUS RENOVATION OF VIRGINIA TECH'S HOME VENUE

REACH FOR EXCELLENCE

- Virginia Tech announced on April 20, 2021 a \$400 million fundraising campaign to propel Hokie sports to the forefront of the Atlantic Coast Conference, prepare generations of student-athletes for success in life, and raise the university's profile nationwide.
- The campaign will leverage the momentum of recent successes on the field and in fundraising, such as adding about 10,000 more Hokie Club members in the past five years and opening the Student-Athlete Performance Center, thanks to a record gift. Still, leaders acknowledged that the athletics enterprise needs an infusion of revenue in order to compete at the top of the ACC.
- The budget increase will support athletics in three primary areas: facilities, coaching, and the student-athlete experience.



- The Reach for Excellence campaign has five main pillars, which are:
 - A football enhancement fund to build a program that consistently competes at the top of the ACC, by allotting \$30 million over time for recruiting, assistant coaches' salaries, quality-control coaches, player development, and capital needs.
 - Renovations to improve Cassell Coliseum, with at least \$50 million to be raised privately.
 - The Drive for 25 initiative to increase Hokie Club membership to 25,000 and raise \$20 million annually for student-

- athlete scholarships.
- Striving for comprehensive excellence for all sports by providing operating expenses, facility improvements, nutritional and strength and conditioning programs, and more.
- Increasing the number of student-athlete scholarship endowments to expand capacity to support students and broaden reach in recruiting.
- When it's filled with nearly 10,000 fans cheering the Hokies to victory in the last seconds of a basketball game, Cassell Coliseum is an amazing sight. But when it's empty, the home of Virginia Tech basketball, volleyball, and wrestling shows its age. Built in the early 1960s, the Coliseum is due for an extensive renovation.
- Plans call for a completely redesigned experience, including:
 - A new glass entrance along Washington Street
 - Extended concourse areas along both sides to allow fans easier access to different sections of the coliseum
 - The addition of high-end premium seating areas, including club seating and luxury suites on both sides
- This much-needed \$75 million-plus project, helped by at least \$50 million in private support, would create one of the best home venues in the ACC.



WHAT'S A HOKIE?

The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute. With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body.

Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Hokie" yell which is still used today. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the word was solely the product of

his imagination and was used only as an attention-getter for his yell. It soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

The official university school colors - Chicago Maroon and Burnt Orange - also were introduced in 1896. The colors were chosen by a committee because they made a 'unique combination' not worn elsewhere at the time. The official definition of "Hokie" is "a loyal Virginia Tech Fan."




