BONA SET TO CLASH WITH FORMER A-10 RIVAL HOKIES IN QUEEN CITY

- St. Bonaventure plays in its second special event in as many weeks, traveling to Charlotte to take on Virginia Tech in the Basketball Hall of Fame Shootout at the Spectrum Center. Last weekend, the Bonnies battled #15/18 UConn to the wire before dropping a 74-64 final in Newark, N.J. as part of the Never Forget Tribute Classic at Prudential Center.
- St. Bonaventure already made the most of its first trip to a prestigious event this season, winning the Charleston Classic championship with victories over Boise State, Clemson and Marquette Nov. 18-21.
- Bona has played the last three games without star senior point guard Kyle Lofton (ankle). The New Jersey native started the first 93 games of his career prior to Dec. 4. During that span, he had played less than 30 minutes just four times during his career, all of which coming in his freshman campaign. Lofton had handed out 41 percent of the team's assists over the past three seasons.
- SBU is aiming for its third win over a Power 6 opponent and second over an ACC foe after defeating Clemson as well as Big East opponent Marquette last month.
- St. Bonaventure has not lost back-to-back games in well over a calendar year: Feb. 26 and Feb. 29, 2020.



Bonnies senior Jaren Holmes has averaged 16.3 ppg, 5.0 rpg and 7.3 apg since assuming the point guard role following an ankle injury suffered by Kyle Lofton. In three games as the point guard, Holmes as played every second of each contest.

The appropriate reference for our institution is St. Bonaventure University - the term "St. Bonnies" is an unacceptable University reference.

OPENING TIP ODDS 'N ENDS

- SBU is seeking to notch three wins over Power 6 opponents in the same season for the first time since 2017-18 when the Bonnies had victories over Maryland, Syracuse and UCLA.
- Virginia Tech represents St. Bonaventure's sixth Top-100 opponent in the NET rankings thus far during non-conference play. The Bonnies are 4-1 vs. NET Top-100 squads so far, scoring wins over Clemson (68), Marquette (73), Buffalo (74), and Boise State (78) before dropping a hard-fought neutral court battle vs. UConn (15) last weekend. Tech ranked No. 37 as of Dec. 14.
- St. Bonaventure is 3-1 in neutral court games this season.
- Abdoul Karim Coulibaly and Quadry Adams each have some experience with VT playing in the ACC previously (Pitt, Wake Forest). Coulibaly posted five points and two blocks in 27 minutes vs. VT last year and had 10 points and five boards as a freshman in Blacksburg.

TAKING CARE

 Entering this week, the Bonnies averaged just 10 turnovers per game and posted single-digit turnovers in six of the first 10 games. That average ranked 12th nationally and first in the Atlantic 10.

CASHING IN AT THE CHARITY STRIPE

• St. Bonaventure has converted on 79.1 percent of its foul line attempts this season, a total that stands 17th nationally and atop the Atlantic 10.

HONOR ROLL HOLMES

 Senior Jaren Holmes earned a spot on this week's Atlantic 10 Weekly Honor Roll. Holmes averaged 20.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 7.0 assists in a pair of games last week, shooting better than 57 percent from the floor while playing all 80 possible minutes. He tallied 22 points and nine assists in a win over Loyola (MD) Dec. 8 before finishing with 19 points, eight rebounds and five assists vs. #15/18 UConn Dec. 11.

ATTA-WAY, ADAWAY

Redshirt senior Jalen Adaway has stepped up when needed this season. He logged his third double-double in four games, and fourth of his career, with 14 points and 10 boards vs. UConn last Saturday. With Lofton out of the lineup, Adaway has averaged a team-best 17.3 points per game, including his game-winning 3-pointer with 1.3 seconds to play in a 68-65 win over Buffalo Dec. 4. His 7.8 rebounds per game ranks fourth among all A-10 players.

ADAMS' ADDITIONAL MINUTES

Redshirt freshman Quadry Adams has made the most of added playing time during the absence of Kyle Lofton from the starting lineup.
 Adams has received his first three career starts, averaging 7.3 points and 2.7 rebounds in over 22 minutes per contest. He delivered a career-high 12 points on 6-of-7 shooting Dec. 8 vs. Loyola Maryland.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- Bonnies opponents have been held to 65 points or less 19 times since the start of last season. St. Bonaventure is 17-2 when holding opponents to 65 points or less during that span.
- St. Bonaventure ranked seventh nationally last year in scoring defense, holding opponents to 61.1 ppg. Opponents shot 38.9% for the year which ranked sixth nationally. Both totals led the A-10.
- By holding Marquette to 54 points Nov. 21, the Bonnies have kept opponents to 59 points or fewer 12 times since the start of the 2020-21 season.
- Bona opponents have shot 40 percent or better in five straight games entering Friday. Prior to that, Bonnies opponents were held under 40 percent in 17 of the previous 26 contests.
- Bona's loss to Northern Iowa Nov. 27 came as a contrast as the Panthers scored a 90-80 victory. It was the first time the Bonnies had allowed 90 or more points in a game since Feb. 14, 2020 vs. Davidson. The 15 3-pointers allowed by the Bonnies also represented the most by an opponent since Davidson had 16 in the 2018 Atlantic 10 Tournament.
- It was only the fourth time the Bonnies have allowed 90+ points in a game since the start of the 2017-18 season and first by a non-conference opponent in regulation since NC State on Dec. 22, 2012.

SERIES HISTORY

The Bonnies and Hokies have met 16 times previously with Tech owning a 10-6 series advantage. The two schools were Atlantic 10 rivals from 1996-2000, facing off five tmes during that span with the Hokies owning three wins, though the Bonnies won the final two conference matchups in 1999 and 2000. Bona won a neutral site game, 91-78, in the opening round of the 2002 Paradise Jam in the Virgin Islands.

Virginia Tech captured the last two meetings - a 73-64 win on its home court in 2011 and an overtime triumph, 76-68, in December 2010 on a neutral floor in Rochester. That game continued a trend of barnburners between the Bonnies and Hokies: though their meetings have been few and far between over the years, their games are generally very entertaining: nine of the 16 all-time contests have been decided by single digits.

BONNIES IN PRO ARENAS

St. Bonaventure has had success playing in primetime venues in recent seasons. Last season, the Bonnies defeated Akron in the 2020-21 season opener inside Rocket Mortgage Fieldhouse in Cleveland, home of the Cleveland Cavaliers. In 2019, the Bonnies won over Rutgers in Toronto's Scotiabank Arena as part of the Basketball Hall of Fame Naismith Classic, home of the Toronto Raptors. Last weekend's game vs. UConn was set in the Prudential Center, home of the NHL's New Jersey Devils.

ABOUT VIRGINIA TECH

- Virginia Tech was selected to finish fifth in the ACC Preseason Poll, tallying five first-place votes and 857 total points. Keve Aluma earned a spot on the Preseason All-ACC First Team, finishing second with 16 Player of the Year votes.
- In their last game, the Hokies fell at A-10 member Dayton, 62-57. The team's most notable victory this season was at Maryland, 62-58, in the Big Ten/ACC challenge.
- Virginia Tech finished the 2020-21 season with an overall record of 15-7 and a conference record of 9-4. VT fell to North Carolina in the ACC Tournament quarterfinals, 81-73. The team earned the 10th seed in the South region, where they were defeated by the seventh seed Florida, 75-70, in the round of 64
- The Hokies return their leading scorer from a year ago and this season in redshirt senior and Second Team All-ACC, Keve Aluma (14.4 ppg). The team's leader in rebounds and assists this season is graduate forward Justyn Mutts (7.5 rbg, 2.9 apg).

TRENDING **NUMBERS**

- **1 Osun Osunniyi** leads all active NCAA Division I players who have played at least 30 games with a career blocks per game average of 2.70.
- **2 –** The Bonnies scored back-to-back wins over Power 6 opponents at the Charleston Classic, defeating Clemson and Marquette. It is the first time St. Bonaventure has scored multiple Power 6 wins in the same season since 2017-18 when it defeated Maryland and Syracuse during the regular season before knocking off UCLA in the NCAA Tournament. St. Bonaventure had not defeated-Power 6 opponents in back-to-back games since their 1977 NIT championship run.
- **3 Osun Osunniyi** has three or more blocks in 46 career games.
- **16** Bona's 16 bench points in the Dec. 4 win over Buffalo represent the team-high this season and most since scoring 25 in a win last February over GW, their 2020-21 season-high.
- **20** The Bonnies had a 20-game winning streak when outrebounding their opponent snapped in last weekend's loss to UConn. The Bonnies outrebounded the Huskies, 40-37, despite UConn owning a +10 rebounding margin entering the day.
- **22 Jaren Holmes** has handed out 22 assists in three games serving as the team's point guard in place of Kyle Lofton.
- **53 Jaren Holmes** has drawn 53 fouls this year, an average of 5.3 per game including a season-high 10 in the Nov. 21 win over Marquette.
- **80** Prior to a two-game stretch vs. UNI (Nov. 27) and Coppin State (Dec. 1), the Bonnies had not allowed 80+ points in back-to-back games since three straight Jan. 18-25, 2020. In all three of those games, though, SBU played without Osun Osunniyi due to a concussion. **With Osunniyi in the lineup, the Bonnies had never allowed 80+ in back-to-back games during regulation prior to Nov. 27 and Dec. 1's games.**
- **+91 –** St. Bonaventure owns a +91 scoring margin during the second half of games thus far this season. St. Bonaventure has been outscored in the second half just twice: vs. Buffalo (36-33) and vs. UConn (45-36). St. Bonaventure has trailed in every game this season but has still posted an 8-2 record.
- **97.5%– Kyle Lofton** had played in 97.5 percent of Bona's total team minutes through the first seven games this season prior to suffering an ankle injury which has caused him to miss the last three contests.
- **192 Dominick Welch** enters Friday with 192 career 3-pointers, needing one more to break a tie with Tim Winn, '00, for fourth in school history.
- **240 Osun Osunniyi** has 240 career blocks, needing four to tie Andrew Nicholson, '12, for second in school history. Last week vs. UConn, he finished his first game this season without a block. **That snapped a 17-game streak with at least one block.**
- **700 Osun Osunniyi** recently became the 12th player in Bonnies program history to reach 700 career rebounds, now standing 10th in school history.
- **900 Dominick Welch** surpassed 900 career points vs. UConn Dec. 11. **Jalen Adaway** enters Friday's game needing seven points to reach the 900 total for his career, currently owning 893 career points. Both players are aiming to join **Kyle Lofton** in the 1,000-point club.

SENIOR YEAR, BEST YEAR

- Jaren Holmes has been outstanding thus far. The senior from Michigan averages 17.4 points and 7.1 rebounds per contest in addition to 4.9 assists through his first 10 games.
- Taking a new role with Kyle Lofton sidelined due to injury, he scored a season-low eight points Dec. 4 vs. Buffalo, but handed out eight assists, a career-high at the time, and had just one turnover.
- He led the A-10 in 3-point percentage at 44% during the regular season last year.
- He opened the year by scoring in double figures in seven straight games, his longest such streak in a Bonnies uniform. His previous best was six straight as a sophomore in 2019-20. He currently ranks fifth among all A-10 players in scoring, fifth in assists and sixth in rebounding.

IRON MAN FIVE 2.0

One of St. Bonaventure's legendary teams from its rich basketball history is a team Bona fans refer to as the "Iron Man Five." The 1967-68 Bonnies team went an undefeated 22-0 in the regular season and rose to No. 3 in the national rankings behind a starting five that played nearly every second (Bob Lanier, Bill Butler, Jim Satalin, Bill Kalbaugh, John Hayes). The 2020-21 Bonnies starters had a similar "iron man" feel with all averaging over 32 minutes per game. Over 89 percent of St. Bonaventure's season scoring came from its regular starting five, the highest percentage in the nation.

TEAM CAPTAINS

For the first time in program history, the Bonnies boast five team captains - the returning senior class of Kyle Lofton, Osun Osunniyi, Dominick Welch, Jaren Holmes and Jalen Adaway. Lofton has been a captain since his freshman season - the only Mark Schmidt player to boast that - while Osunniyi and Holmes are each captains for the second year in a row. Welch and Adaway are captains for the first time.

ALL-STAR TRIO

 When Bonaventure's star senior trio of Kyle Lofton, Osun Osunniyi and Dominick Welch have all been available for a full game, the Bonnies are 49-13 since Feb. 12, 2019.



LOFTON'S LOFTY NUMBERS

- Kyle Lofton is a preseason favorite for Atlantic 10 Player of the Year and national honors, earning recognition as one of the country's best point guards. He is on the preseason Wooden Award Watch List Top 50 to honor the nation's top collegiate player and the Cousy Award Watch List representing the country's top point guard.
- He is a back-to-back Atlantic 10 First Team selection, one of five players in school history to achieve that feat.
- He played 94 percent of possible team minutes the past three seasons including 96 percent last year. Lofton ranked as the nation's ironman with most minutes per game in 2019-20 and stood third last year.
- His 2.22 assist-to-turnover ratio also stands 14th among all active NCAA Division I players.
- He averages five assists per game for his career, a mark that ranks fourth in school history.
- Lofton has handed out seven or more assists on 22 occasions. He has reached at least five assists in 54 career games.
- He is the only member of last year's A-10 First Team to return this season.
- Has started every game played during his career, earning team captain rank before ever playing a collegiate game. Had a 93-game start streak snapped Dec. 4 (ankle). Prior to Dec. 4, the last time the Bonnies played without Lofton was the 2018 NCAA Tournament game vs. Florida (3/15/18), a span of 1,360 days.



'SHOON SWATS

- Osun Osunniyi has proven himself to be one of the nation's top shot blockers. His 240 career blocks stand third among all active Division I players. More impressively, his 2.70 blocks per game rank FIRST among all D-I players (30+ games) as of Dec. 12. Also, his 8.2 rebounds per game over his career stand T-17th nationally among all active Division I players. He has been named to the A-10 All-Defensive Team each of the last three years.
- Osunniyi finished last season leading the A-10 in blocks per game (2.8), second
 in rebounding (9.3 rpg) and third in field goal percentage (55.2%). For the
 second consecutive year, Osunniyi was the ONLY A-10 player to rank in the
 top five of each category.
- His 2020-21 +/- average of +8.1 is the best of any returning player in the A-10 this season - next best were Hyunjung Lee of Davidson (+7.3) and Jacob Gilyard of Richmond (+6.8).
- Last season, Osunniyi became the first player in program history to block 60 shots and hand out 50 assists in the same year despite playing only 21 games.

THE ELDER STATESMEN

St. Bonaventure is one of the nation's oldest teams this season. Bona's 11 active scholarship players are an average age of 21.1 with four players (Jalen Adaway, Jaren Holmes, Osun Osunniyi, Dominick Welch) 23 years of age and Kyle Lofton 22. Newcomers Linton Brown and Abdoul Karim Coulibaly are also 21, each with multiple seasons of collegiate experience - Coulibaly owning two seasons of previous experience in the ACC with Pitt.

For the second consecutive year, the Bonnies are off to one of the best starts in program history. At 8-2 through 10 games, the program has had a better start just four times in the past 50+ years:

THE BIG MAN IN THE MIDDLE

There's little denying the impact senior center Osun Osunniyi has on the Bonnies. When he's played 18 minutes or more the past three seasons, the Bonnies are 41-11. Since the start of the 2019-20 season, when Osunniyi plays at least 18 minutes, the Bonnies have been outscored in the paint just 10 times and only twice by double digits. Bona moved to 2-8 in games where Osunniyi plays less than 18 minutes since the '19-20 season when it scored a win over Canisius Nov. 15, 2021 despite Osunniyi being limited to 13 minutes due to injury.

- When the Bonnies ranked No. 23/24 in the preseason polls, it represented the first national Top 25 ranks for the program since 1971. Prior to that point, national rankings had been common place for St. Bonaventure, which has previously earned national AP rankings in 82 weeks, ranking as high as No. 2 multiple weeks during the 1960-61 season.
- In years since, the Bonnies have received Top 25 votes numerous times, including coming oh-so-close to a national ranking in 2018 when a 12-game winning streak and a 24-6 record pushed the Bonnies to the "first team out" of the rankings with 72 voter's points at the conclusion of the regular season that year. Bona again received votes in multiple Top 25 polls last season.
- The Bonnies were a trendy preseason favorite among many national college basketball writers. A few other St. Bonaventure rankings to begin the year: Sporting News ranked SBU at No. 20 in its preseason poll (and No. 2 in its mid-major poll). The Athletic ranked the Bonnies No. 1 in their preseason mid-major poll. Blue Ribbon Yearbook placed SBU at No. 24 in its preseason Top 25. The Athletic's college basketball staff also selected St. Bonaventure as their pick to be the "next NCAA Tournament Cinderella" while NCAA.com's Andy Wittry boasted the Bonnies to be one of eight "dark horse" selections for a Final Four run.

IMPRESSIVE NON-CONFERENCE SLATE

• St. Bonaventure boasts its most challenging non-conference schedule in decades. The Bonnies have six teams ranked in last year's top-90 of the NCAA NET rankings in their non-conference schedule – UConn (33), Clemson (45), Virginia Tech (51), Boise State (53), Buffalo (86) and Marquette (93).

FRIENDLY COURTS

• While the Bonnies will make a few high-profile trips to neutral courts during non-conference play - three games at the Charleston Classic, Newark, New Jersey's Prudential Center for the Never Forget Tribute Classic vs. UConn and Charlotte's Spectrum Center for the Hall of Fame Shootout vs. Virginia Tech - SBU will have just one true road game during non-conference action. St. Bonaventure travels to Boston for a date with Northeastern Dec. 22 in the only true road game of the non-conference schedule, a date that begins three straight road games as the Bonnies open Atlantic 10 play at George Washington and at Dayton over the holidays.

UNDER THE BRIGHT LIGHTS

Bona's will be on national TV often this year. St. Bonaventure will play 13
of their 18 conference games in front of a national TV audience. The nonconference slate boasts five more games on ESPN national networks, bringing
the total of over-the-air national TV games to 18. Every game not broadcast on
a national network will be available either on a regional network, NBC digital
streaming platform or ESPN+.

1,000-POINT CLUB

- St. Bonaventure already has one active 1,000-point scorer: senior Kyle Lofton, who entered the season ranking 28th in program history with 1,230 career points. Three of his teammates have a chance to join the 1,000-point club this season: Dominick Welch started the year at 793 points while Osun Osunniyi was at 739 career points. Jalen Adaway entered the year with 762 collegiate points counting two seasons at Miami (OH).
- Lofton, Welch and Osunniyi are all part of the program's top-100 all-time scoring list. **Jaren Holmes** cracked the top-100 in the first game of the season after starting the year ranked No. 101 in Bonnies scoring history.

BEASTS ON THE BOARDS

- Three Bonnies currently rank among the Atlantic 10's top seven on the conference leaderboard in rebounding: Jalen Adaway (7.8 rpg, fourth), Jaren Holmes (7.1 rpg, sixth) and Osun Osunniyi (7.0 rpg, seventh).
- St. Bonaventure has won the battle of the boards nine times this season. The lone game where the Bonnies lost the rebounding battle came in a Nov. 27 loss vs. Northern Iowa.

POWER IN THE PAINT

- St. Bonaventure rarely has the most size in a matchup, but it almost always finishes with the advantage in the paint. This season, the Bonnies are +98 in paint scoring. Bona has been outscored in the paint just twice this year.
- Last season, the Bonnies finished +170 in paint scoring and were outscored in just five contests.

DOWNTOWN DOM

- Dominick Welch entered the year ranking third among all active Atlantic 10 players in career 3-pointers (166), behind only Jacob Gilyard (238) of Richmond and Taylor Funk (201) of Saint Joseph's. Only Funk's 2.18 3-pointers per game ranked above Welch's 2.15/gm, however.
- Since, Welch has moved into a tie for fourth in the program record books. A 37% career 3-point shooter, he ranks 11th in SBU career 3-point percentage.
- He has at least one 3-pointer in every game this season and in 24 straight games dating back to Jan. 20, 2021. In the past two seasons, he has failed to make a 3-pointer in just two games. For his entire Bonnies career, there have been just nine games where he has played without hitting at least one trey.
- Labeled by head coach Mark Schmidt as perhaps the best rebounding guard
 he has ever coached, Welch is more than just a perimeter threat. Recently he
 surpassed 500 career rebounds, becoming the first player in school history
 to hit at least 115 career 3-pointers and haul in 500+ rebounds.

A STAR ON AND OFF THE COURT

- Entering the game vs. Virginia Tech, Jaren Holmes is the only Atlantic 10 player to rank in the league's top-six in scoring, rebounding and assists.
- A back-to-back Atlantic 10 All-Academic Team selection, Holmes is an outstanding student. A Sports Media major with a 3.65 GPA, he took part in a workshop with PolitiFact and coauthored two articles for the nationally known fact-checking organization during the spring 2020 semester. He became the only person to write for PolitiFact and play in an NCAA Tournament this past March. His published article was on the promise of convalescent plasma therapy in the treatment of COVID-19. Further, he is a regular contributor to St. Bonaventure's campus news station, SBU-TV, producing his own news pieces and doing

Bonaventure's campus news station, SBU-TV, producing his own news pieces and doing on-air work. Following last season, he was also selected to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court.

WHAT'S A BONNIE?

In their earliest years of athletics, Bona teams were referred to as the "Alleganies," then they derived the name "Brownies."

St. Bonaventure made the decision to change their athletics team names to Bonnies in 1992, moving away from a Brown Indians name used in some fashion dating to 1927.

The Bonnies nickname had been used by fans and media members for decades, however. The term "Bonnies" came to be as a shortcut name of St. Bonaventure without any official starting point.

The Bona Fanatic made its debut as the team mascot in 1996 but only lasted two years. In 1998, a committee was formed to derive a new mascot, and the Bona Wolf was created. "Reilly" The Bona Wolf made its debut on Feb. 16, 1999 against Rhode Island.

Although the mascot and nickname have changed over the years, what has remained the same are the Brown and White colors, the Brown from the Franciscan Friars' habits and the White from their white cords.

The mascot has ties to the Franciscan tradition that friars of the school live upon. Legend has it that St. Francis of Assisi tamed a fierce wolf at Gubbio, Italy. Thus, this new mascot would also help to represent the religious aspect which is so closely related to St. Bonaventure University itself.


2021 CHARLESTON CLASSIC CHAMPIONS

- St. Bonaventure scored its biggest in-season tournament championship crown since the days of Bob Lanier in the 1969 Madison Square Garden Holiday Festival when it recorded three wins in four days to capture the Charleston Classic Championship Nov. 18-21 at TD Arena on the campus of the College of Charleston.
- The Bonnies defeated Boise State (67-61), Clemson (68-65) and Marquette (70-54) to bring home the title. Kyle Lofton was named tournament MVP and Jaren Holmes was selected to the All-Tournament Team.
- St. Bonaventure held Boise State scoreless over the final 3:07 of game time to win the opener. In the semifinals, the Bonnies erased a 16-point first half deficit, roaring back from 14 down with 13:30 to play to storm past Clemson. Bona went on a 21-2 run for their first win over an ACC team since 2017. It was also the Bonnies' largest second half comeback in a victory since rallying from 15 down at halftime in a 70-54 win over VCU Jan. 20, 2021.
- The championship game was a clinic as the Bonnies dominated Marquette.
 The Bonnies cooled what had been a red-hot 5-0 Golden Eagles squad, fresh
 off wins over No. 10 Illinois as well as Ole Miss and West Virginia to reach the
 Charleston finals. Bona led by as many as 27 points during the second half,
 and held Marquette under 30 points until less than 10 minutes remained in
 the game.
- By winning the title, St. Bonaventure became just the second non-Power 6 team to win the Charleston Classic championship since the tournament began in 2008 (2020 canceled due to the pandemic). UMass won the title in 2013, but all other past winners reside in power conferences.



A ROSTER UNLIKE ANY OTHER

 St. Bonaventure is one of the nation's veteran-most teams, bringing back five senior starters from last year's NCAA Tournament team. The Bonnies also bring many new faces as not a single player from last year's bench returns for this season. Nine new players join the roster, presenting perhaps the most unique roster composition in the country.



St. Bonaventure has produced a winning non-conference mark in all but two seasons since head coach Mark Schmidt took over the program 15 years ago: his first season of 2007-08 and in 2018-19 when a young, injury-riddled squad went 4-9 but eventually rebounded to reach the Atlantic 10 Championship Game.

NEWPORT NEWS, Va. – The St. Bonaventure men's basketball team was selected as the unanimous favorite to win the 2021-22 Atlantic 10 Championship, conference officials announced at A-10 Media Day Oct. 27.

In addition, a pair of Bonnies were named to the preseason All-Conference First Team as seniors Kyle Lofton and Osun Osunniyi each received the honor. Lofton is a two-time First Team postseason all-conference pick while Osunniyi was the league's Defensive Player of the Year and tournament Most Outstanding Player as a junior. Senior guard Jaren Holmes was picked to the second team after also being named all-conference last year for the first time in his Bonnies career. Osunniyi also earned a spot on the All-Defensive Team.

The reigning Atlantic 10 regular season and tournament champions, St. Bonaventure is a unanimous preseason conference favorite for the first time in program history and the first A-10 squad to be an unchallenged No. 1 pick in the preseason poll since VCU was in 2014. Rhode Island was just one vote shy of a unanimous selection in 2017-18, when the lone outlying vote went to the second-ranked Bonnies. That season previously stood as the high water mark for the program in a preseason poll during a time when the A-10 was not split into multiple divisions.

The Bonnies claimed all 28 first-place votes for 392 voter's points, with Richmond second at 359 points. Saint Louis (325), VCU (288) and Dayton (274) round out the top-five. Davidson (260), Rhode Island (231), George Mason (158), UMass (147) and Saint Joseph's (144) complete the top-10.

Lofton became the fifth player in program history to pick up postseason First Team All-Atlantic 10 honors in back-to-back years when he averaged over 14 points per game while standing third in the league at 5.4 assists per contest last season. He led the league in minutes (38.3 mpg) for the second consecutive year and has played in 94 percent of Bona's minutes in the past two years.

He is also a member of the Bob Cousy Award Watch List as one of 20 candidates to be named the nation's top point guard.

Osunniyi is a preseason First Team selection after being honored as the league's top defensive player and Second Team All-Conference last March. He led the A-10 in blocks per game (2.8) last year while also ranking second in rebounding (9.3 rpg). He anchored the A-10's top defense, a squad that

ranked seventh in the nation by allowing just over 59 points per game during conference play. For the second consecutive year, he was the only A-10 player to rank among the league's top-five in blocks, field goal percentage and rebounding.

ST. BONAVENTURE

A nominee for the Karim Abdul-Jabaar Watch List as one of 20 candidates to be named the country's best center, he has been on the league's All-Defensive Team following each of his three collegiate seasons.

Holmes enjoyed a breakout season in his second campaign with the Bonnies last year, ranking second on the team at 13.8 points per contest while averaging 5.3 rebounds and shooting over 38 percent from long range.

HEAD OF THE CLASS

Mark Schmidt is St. Bonaventure's all-time-coaching wins leader. Now in his 15th season, Schmidt entered the year with 245 wins at St. Bonaventure. With win No. 203 on Feb. 17, 2019 when the Bonnies topped George Mason, Schmidt topped Larry Weise's mark of 202 that had stood since 1973.

- He stands 2nd in conference victories among active A-10 coaches with 129
 Atlantic 10 wins behind only Richmond's Chris Mooney and is sixth all-time.
- Schmidt is the second-longest tenured active A-10 head coach (A-10 seasons only), again behind only Mooney who is in his 16th year with the Spiders.
- Schmidt's win total at St. Bonaventure ranks third among all active A-10 coaches for victories at their current school – only Mooney (288) and Bob McKillop (607) rank higher (numbers entering 2021-22).
- Only one coach in St. Bonaventure men's basketball history led the program for longer than Schmidt's current tenure -Mike Reilly, the namesake for the Reilly Center, guided the program for 15 years between 1928-43. Schmidt ties that mark this season.

On average, when school is in session, at least half of the student body (1,840) attends games. In 2019-20 attendance at the Reilly Center averaged 4,359 fans.

ST. BONAVENTURE PROGRAM NOTES

BONNIES BRILLIANCE

- St. Bonaventure has created an Atlantic 10 power under head coach Mark Schmidt. When the Bonnies captured both the regular season and tournament championships in 2021, it marked a continuation of A-10 prominence for the program
- The Bonnies are the only Atlantic 10 team to win double-digit conference games in seven straight seasons, dating to 2014-15
- Bona's 83 victories in conference play in the last seven years rank second only to Dayton among all A-10 squads
- The Bonnies have won at least 18 games every year since 2013-14 with one exception - last season when the team was limited to 21 games by the pandemic, but finished 16-5 (.761 win pct)
- The current "golden era" of Bonnies basketball could point to 2011-12 as the beginning of the St. Bonaventure basketball renaissance when the program won 20 games and the 2012 Atlantic 10 Championship, the first in program history. Since that time, the Bonnies have a .620 winning percentage from '11-12 through '20-21
- Schmidt's teams have averaged 17.5 wins per season over his 14 years in charge of the program

HEAD OF THE PACK

- The Bonnies have finished in the top-five of the A-10's final regular season standings in each of the past six seasons
- Entering this year, the Bonnies had 121 overall wins since the start of the 2015-16 season, ranking third among all A-10 programs



- The St. Bonaventure men's basketball program has reached unforeseen heights under head coach Mark Schmidt, who has now completed 14 seasons in charge of the program. St. Bonaventure's all-time wins leader, Schmidt has keyed the return of the Bonnies to national prominence and as one of the Atlantic 10's finest.
- Though the 2019-20 season was cut short due to COVID-19, Schmidt's Bonnies continued their streak of rising to the top of the A-10 with their sixth consecutive season of double-digit conference wins, the longest active streak among all Atlantic 10 programs. SBU scored 19 victories overall, the seventh year in a row of 18 or more wins, and finished fifth in the A-10 regular season standings the fifth straight year the program has finished in the league's top five. At the end of the season, sophomore point guard Kyle Lofton gave the program five straight years with a First Team All-Conference selection.
- A young Bonnies squad in 2018-19 represented one of Schmidt's finest coaching jobs as he guided a freshman-laden team to a 12-6 A-10 record and a spot in the Atlantic 10 Championship Game. It marked the fifth straight year of double digit conference wins, a program first. Senior Courtney Stockard's all-conference selection gave SBU four straight seasons of landing players on the A-10 First Team while both Kyle Lofton and Osun Osunniyi earned All-Rookie Team picks with Osunniyi also landing on the All-Defensive Team. Along the way, Schmidt captured history. On Feb. 17, 2019, he became the winningest coach in program history as he passed the legendary Larry Weise with his 203rd victory as Bonnies head coach.
- With the All-Conference backcourt of Jaylen Adams and Matt Mobley leading the way, 2017-18 was the most successful year of Schmidt's tenure. The Bonnies went 26-8, setting a school record for wins in a season (the prior mark of 25 had stood since the Final Four season of 1969-70) and reached the NCAA Tournament. There, they beat UCLA in the First Four in Dayton, Ohio, for the program's first NCAA win since that same 1969-70 season. The Bonnies went 14-4 in the Atlantic 10 to finish second, their fourth straight year with double-digit conference victories. Perhaps the most remarkable achievement of the season were the 13 straight wins to end the regular season. Both Adams and Mobley were selected to the All-Conference First Team as well as the NABC All-District Team. Junior forward LaDarien Griffin was named co-winner of the A-10's Chris Daniels Award for Most Improved Player.

In 1969, Bob Lanier was stepping on every college team that dared cross his path. Not only did he already hold the Reilly Center record for rebounds in a game with 27, but against Seton Hall Lanier scored a school and RC record 51 points.

Dec. 21, 1969 - SBU 77, Duquesne 58

The largest crowd ever to witness a game at the Reilly Center saw the Bonnies defeat Duquesne, 77-58. The standing room only crowd of 6,291 flooded the aisles and any available spots on the floor.

Feb. 4, 1995 - SBU 69, Rhode Island 66 The Bonnies scored the 1,000th win in St. Bonaventure history.

March 16, 1995 - SBU 75, So. Miss 70

St. Bonaventure played its first-ever home postseason game during the 1995 NIT when they hosted Southern Mississippi in round one. More than 6,000 fans watched as the Bonnies prevailed.

1997-98 Ranked Wins

During the 1997-98 season, St. Bonaventure defeated three Top 20 teams at The RC. Thirteenth-ranked Xavier (80-77), 20th-ranked Rhode Island (86-81) and 20th-ranked Massachusetts (72-70, 2OT) fell, much to the delight of the Bona faithful.

Jan. 15, 2000 - SBU 57, #13 Temple 56 In a game many fans described as the best they had ever seen in The RC, J.R. Bremer's three-pointer with 2.8 seconds left gave the Bonnies a 57-56 win over 13th-ranked Temple.

Jan. 29, 2014 - SBU 78, #19 UMass 65 Charlon Kloof scored 14 points as the Bonnies registered their first Top 25 win since 2000.

Feb. 7, 2015 - SBU 73, #18 VCU 71

Marcus Posley played the hero on Feb. 7, 2015, when he drove and scored on an off-balance shot as time expired to give St. Bonaventure a 73-71 win over No. 18 VCU.

Feb. 16, 2017 - SBU 77, #14 Rhode Island 74

St. Bonaventure ended what was the nation's active longest winning streak when the Bonnies beat No. 14/16 Rhode Island live before a Friday night national TV audience on ESPN2.

Dec. 7, 2019 - SBU 73, Hofstra 45 With the 1970 Final Four team in attendance as well as the program's All-Time Team, Bona dominated the Pride.

On a night where the St. Bonaventure men's basketball team celebrated last year's championship campaign, the Bonnies gave the Reilly Center faithful more to cheer about with a second half push to storm past Siena, 75-47, in Tuesday's season-opener.

The second half was absolute domination from the defending Atlantic 10 champions. No. 23/24 St. Bonaventure outscored the Saints by a 39-15 margin over the final 20 minutes, limiting the visitors to just 6-for-25 from the floor.

In pregame, the Bonnies finally had the chance to revel in last year's accomplishments with over 4,400 fans filling The RC in a regular season game for the first time since March 4, 2020. In addition to each of the five returning senior starters being presented with their A-10 championship rings, the 2021 NCAA Tournament banner was added to the arena rafters.

Siena was out to dampen the Bonnies celebration, however. The Saints had control early, jumping out to a double digit lead, 18-8, forcing Dominick Welch to the bench with his second foul at the 13:41 mark.

Siena, the defending MAAC regular season champs, opened the game 6-for-10 from the floor and 3-for-5 from distance while the Bonnies connected on just two of their first 11 tries.

Bona's responded, though, bringing the Reilly Center crowd to life with a 16-5 run to push ahead. As the second half dawned, the Bonnies looked every bit worthy of their national Top 25 ranking.

The Bonnies defense limited Siena out of the break, holding the Saints scoreless over a 3:15 stretch which allowed the hosts to pull ahead, 46-37, following a steal and dunk by Abdoul Karim Coulibaly.

A Siena trey out of a timeout brought the game back to two possessions, 46-40, but the Bonnies would embark on a game-changing 15-2 sprint to take a commanding 61-42 cushion with 6:30 remaining.

During the stretch, the Bonnies were stifling. The lead eventually grew to 23 as the Saints went scoreless for over five minutes. Siena struggled to even get shots away, attempting only two field goal tries during the five-minute visitor drought.

Through the early season, No. 22/24 St. Bonaventure has proven to be a second half team. The Bonnies produced their most thrilling second half in recent memory, erasing a 16-point deficit to shock Clemson in the semifinals of the Charleston Classic, 68-65, Friday afternoon at TD Arena.

Bona ironman Kyle Lofton played the full 40, delivering a season-best 22 points while handing out four assists. Jaren Holmes was also clutch during the rally, posting 19 points along with five assists and five rebounds. Jalen Adaway provided a third double-figure scoring effort with his line of 14 points and six rebounds.

Clemson (4-1) led by 16 with three minutes left in the first half and turned away multiple Bonaventure efforts at a comeback before the Bonnies finally broke through.

The Tigers lead remained at 14, 51-37, with 13:30 to play when the Bonnies exploded for a 21-2 run over a 7:26 span to change everything.

St. Bonaventure (4-0) took its first lead since the opening seconds when Lofton drilled a three for a 55-53 score as the clock hit the eight-minute mark, the Bonnies crowd roaring.

Bona's would never trail again.

Clemson didn't go away quietly, though.

After the Bonnies grabbed a five-point edge following Lofton's trey, the Tigers tied the game with 1:59 to go on a jumper from Nick Honor.

Holmes came back and knocked down another triple seconds later to break the deadlock.

Clemson got back within a point on the next trip, but a defensive stop forced the Tigers to foul. Lofton calmly knocked down a pair at the line for another three-point lead with 19 seconds left. One more lock down on defense, capped by a Holmes block of an Honor desperation three-point attempt at the buzzer, sealed the victory.

The Bonnies scored the game's first points on a layup from Lofton on the very first possession, but the Tigers immediately launched an 11-2 run and would not trail for over 31 minutes.

What a week to remember in Charleston.

Following a run of outstanding efforts and amazing fan support that captured the attention of the nation, St. Bonaventure earned the Charleston Classic championship in convincing fashion over Marquette Sunday night in TD Arena,

Against a red-hot Marquette squad which had won five in a row, including an upset of No. 10 Illinois to start the week before dispatching Ole Miss and West Virginia in Charleston, the Bonnies were at their best.

No. 22/24 St. Bonaventure (5-0) stifled Marquette offensively after the Golden Eagles entered the day averaging 78 points per game over their first five contests.

Kyle Lofton was named the tournament Most Valuable Player after posting 12 points, four assists and two steals. Jaren Holmes was excellent again as well, joining Lofton on the All-Tournament Team with his second double-double of the week: 19 points, 13 rebounds and four assists. Osun Osunniyi was dominant in the post, finishing with 16 points, 11 rebounds and four blocks.

Unlike their first two games of the week where they needed to rally in the second half, the Bonnies played an excellent first 20 minutes.

After a back-and-forth opening 12 minutes, the Bonnies employed an 8-0 run for a 21-15 advantage, forcing a Marquette timeout.

Later in the stanza, the Bonnies held Marquette without a point for a four-minute stretch that allowed the Bona lead to grow to 10. The Golden Eagles got a bucket before intermission to send the clubs to the break with SBU in possession of a 33-25 edge.

St. Bonaventure put the momentum into overdrive immediately after halftime, sprinting out to a 45-26 cushion while the Marquette cold spell extended.

By then, the Bonnies defense was in full lockdown mode. Marquette could not find a field goal for nearly eight minutes to begin the second half, watching the Bonnies build a 22-point advantage.

Marquette could never gather any traction against the Bonnies defense after playing their fourth game of the week. The Golden Eagles starting backcourt finished without a single made field goal as they struggled to reach 30 points until the clock clicked under 10 minutes to play.

Marquette was limited to just 30 percent from the floor after halftime and 22 percent from distance while committing 17 turnovers against the Bona defense.

A 21-5 second half run erased a 19-point deficit and tied the game with still 10:30 to play, but in the end St. Bonaventure could not find an answer for AJ Green and visiting Northern Iowa as the Panthers came away with a 90-80 victory Saturday afternoon at the Reilly Center.

Green delivered nine 3-pointers and a game-high 35 points while the Panthers sank 15 threes as a team, most for a Bonnies opponent in over three

Fresh off hitting 17 3-pointers last week at then-No. 16-ranked Arkansas in an upset bid there in their last game, the Panthers remained red hot against a Bonnies team that was this week ranked No. 16 in both national polls.

All five Bonnies starters finished with double-figure scoring: Kyle Lofton with 21 points and seven assists; Dominick Welch 20 points and seven rebounds; Jaren Holmes 15 points and six assists; Jalen Adaway and Osun Osunniyi both with 12 points and seven rebounds.

Lofton started hot, scoring the first nine points for the Bonnies as they led by eight early.

The teams shared four ties and exchanged the lead six times during the first half, but then Green caught fire for the Panthers.

The 2019-20 Missouri Valley Player of the Year drained 17 points over the final 3:56 before halftime as the Panthers launched a 14-0 run for a 47-34 lead at the break.

Northern Iowa (2-3) stretched its lead to 19 with 17:39 remaining, but that advantage quickly evaporated as the Bonnies rallied.

A dunk from Jalen Adaway tied the game, 62-62, and the Reilly Center came unglued. With still over 10 minutes left, the Bonnies seemed to be back in control.

Like most of the day, though, Green put any thoughts of the Bonnies racing ahead on ice as he drilled a trey for the game's next points, breaking the tie. UNI would slowly extend its edge to seven, 73-66, over the next three-plus minutes, but the Bonnies got back within 75-72 on a perimeter jumper from Holmes and still 4:29 remaining.

Nate Heise put that rally to bed, too, with a layup and a jumper from beyond the arc to quickly push the score back to 80-72, and the Bonnies would never get any closer down the stretch.

ST. BONAVENTURE, N.Y. – Jalen Adaway drilled a 3-pointer with 1.3 seconds remaining to break a tie and send St. Bonaventure to a 68-65 victory over Buffalo Saturday afternoon in a classic Big 4 battle inside the Reilly Center.

The fifth-year senior calmly knocked down an open look off a feed from Jaren Holmes who drew a double team from UB defenders by driving into the paint.

Adaway's trey threw ice on what was a 13-2 Buffalo run over 2:38 to stun The RC crowd.

Maceo Jack's three with 29 seconds left completed a furious Buffalo rally, erasing Bona's 63-52 lead with 3:05 to go.

It was the only time during the second half the Bonnies did not have a lead. Following Jack's tying shot, a Bonnies timeout set up the final dramatics.

As expected, the Bulls would make things interesting down the stretch, cutting into what was a 13-point advantage for the hosts.
