Quentin Hillsman has transformed the Orange women's basketball program into a national championship contender. In his 14 seasons at the helm, Syracuse boasts an impressive résumé, which includes 12 consecutive postseason appearances, eighth trips to the NCAA Tournament, 18 all-conference selections, five All-Americans, and four WNBA Draft picks.

Hillsman won his 300th game as Syracuse's head coach on Feb. 9, 2020 in an upset win over No. 6 Louisville. Under his direction, the Orange own a 315-164 overall record, averaging nearly 20 victories per season. He is the all-time winningest coach in school history.

The 2015-16 campaign put Syracuse on the national map. The Orange advanced to its first Sweet 16, Elite Eight, Final Four, and national final in their history. Syracuse set program records with five wins against nationally-ranked foes, 13 conference victories, 23 regular-season wins, and 30 overall victories. Following its run to the national final, Syracuse was ranked third in the final USA Today Coaches Poll.

In only his second season in 2007-08, he guided Syracuse to a 22-9 overall record and its fourth trip to the NCAA Tournament in school history. SU climbed into the national rankings for the first time in history, checking in as high as No. 21 in the country in the Associated Press Poll.

Hillsman has built a strong reputation as one of the top recruiters in women's collegiate basketball. Eleven of the past 12 recruiting classes have been touted as top- 25 classes nationally. In addition, the school's first six McDonald's All-Americans have all been recruited and played under Hillsman.

Prior to being elevated to the position of head coach of the Orange program on 0ct. 17, 2006, Hillsman spent one year as an assistant coach on the staff. His collegiate coaching tenure also includes stop at Alabama, American, Siena, and St. Mary's (Md.). Hillsman has also coached at the international level.

A native of Suitland, Md., Hillsman graduated from St. Mary's College (Md.) in 1993 after a standout playing career with the Seahawks. He led the squad to two Capital Athletic Conference championships and one conference tournament title, earning all-conference accolades and setting the school's single-game and single-season assist records. Hillsman studied sport management at the United States Sports Academy in Daphne, Ala. from 1994-96, as well.

He, his wife, Shandrist, and their sons, Kyan and Harlem, reside in Jamesville.

Syracuse has defeated 14 nationally-ranked opponents inside the Dome since Hillsman took over the program and has hosted the NCAA First and Second Rounds twice (2016 \& 2019).

## \#TOUGH4T

Tiana Mangakahia missed the 2019-20 season due to a battle with Stage 2 breast cancer. The two-time Nancy Lieberman Award finalist was granted an Extension of Eligibilty Waiver by the NCAA last month. She made her return to the court on Sunday, Nov. 29 against Stony Brook in her first competitve basketball game in 615 days. She totaled a game-high 16 points, 7 rebounds, 3 assists and 4 steals.

Mangakahia is a two-time All-ACC First Team selection, a Associated Press (AP) Honorable Mention All-American, a three-time top-10 finalist for the Nancy Lieberman Award and holds the Syracuse and ACC record for assists in a season. She
is the all-time leader in career assists at Syracuse with 707, surpassing former Syracuse All-American Alexis Peterson (590). She is the first player in program history to reach 700 assists which she reached against Pittsburgh on Feb. 7.

Hillsman signed five players in the Class of 2020 including the No. 5 overall player, Kamilla Cardoso, and No. 11, Priscilla Williams. Faith Blackstone (No. 91 overall), Khamya McNeal (No. 29 guard) and Kiara Fisher (No. 47 point guard), Ava Irvin and Maud Huijbens round out the class.

Four of the seven (Cardoso, Williams, Blackstone, McNeal) were named McDonald's All-America Nominees, while Cardoso and Williams were both

## THE BEST BACKCOURT

Syracuse's backcourt tandem of Kiara Lewis and Tiana Mangkahia is one of America's best.

Mangakahia is fourth in the nation in assists per game (7.7) and is leading the ACC. She has assisted on $44.6 \%$ of Syracuse's made baskets this season, ranking 4th in the nation in that category.

Lewis is assisting on 16.4 \% of Syracuse's makes while adding 14.1 points per game of her own.

The duo, whom have both been selected to the AllACC First Team in past seasons (Lewis in 2020 and Mangakahia in 2018 \& 2019) were on the 2020-21 Preseason All-ACC Team.

## DOUBLE 'E'

Emily Engstler is nearly averaging a double double off the bench ( $9.5 \mathrm{pts}, 9.1 \mathrm{reb}$ ) and leads the team with five double doubles. She ranks fifth in the ACC in rebounds per game and is shooting 43.9 percent from the field.

In the offseason, Englster worked on her strength and physique shedding 40 pounds and building muscle while working out with her siblings in the family's NYC apartment during the COVID-19 pandemic.

## INTERNATIONAL FLARE

Syracuse boasts a roster that includes five international players this season: Maeva DjaldiTabdi (France), Tiana Mangakahia (Australia), Maud Huijbens (Netherlands), Kamilla Cardoso (Brazil) and Digna Strautmane (Latvia).

Syracuse has two players currently on their respective senior national team rosters, Mangakahia (Australia) and Strautmane (Latvia).

## THE ‘CILLA AND ‘MILLA SHOW

Head Coach Quentin Hillsman has two freshman in his starting lineup for the first time since the 2017-18 season when Strautmane and FinkleaGuity started 31-straight games together as true freshman.

Kamilla Cardoso and Priscilla Williams made up four-straight ACC Freshman of the Week Awards (Jan.18-Feb.8).

Cardoso was awarded ACC Freshman of the Week for three-consecutive weeks (Jan. 26, Feb. 1 and Feb. 8). She leads the Orange in scoring ( 15.2 ppg ), leads the ACC in blocked shots per game (3.12) and is second the ACC in FG\% (.600).

Williams is undoubtedly Syracuse's biggest perimeter threat. In her first career start she tied
a program record eight threes in a game. She tied a program record 9-for-9 FGM against Miami and made six threes in the win on Jan. 17. She was named ACC Freshman of the Week on Jan. 18.

## TOP-15 RECRUITING CLASS SECURED

Hillsman secured another top-15 recruiting class when he signed the No. 11 recruiting class according to ESPN HoopGurlz earlier this month. It's the fourth top-15 recruiting class in the last five years for Hillsman.

The 2021 class features four players ranked in ESPN's Top-100 and the Washington state scoring leader for the last three years.

## SYRACUSE BLOCK PARTY

The Orange lead the ACC and rank 2nd in the nation in blocked shots per game (7.1). The Orange have had four 10+ block games this season, most recently against Wake Forest (Feb. 4) when Cardoso accounted for 6 on her own.

## ACC LEADERS

Tiana Mangakahia leads the ACC in assists per game (7.9) and total assists (116), Kamilla Cardoso leads the league in blocked shots per game (3.12)

As a team, Syracuse's 7.1 blocks per game is an ACC best.

## ON PAUSE

Syracuse went on pause due to COVID-19 protocols after a Tier 1 positive test was announced Dec. 27. The 28-day gap between games (Dec. 20-Jan.17) is the longest in program history since the 44-day break between games during the 1978-79 season when the team recessed for the university's winter break.

## SNOW PLACE LIKE THE DOME

Syracuse is 4-0 at the Dome this season on days when it snows in Syracuse on game day.

## FOUR IN EIGHT

Syracuse is the only ACC team to play four league games in eight days twice this season. The Orange went 2-2 in the first round winning against Miami and UNC before dropping to \#1 Louisville and Clemson (0T). In the latest 4-in-8 installment Syracuse is 2-1 with wins over Notre Dame and Wake Forest and a loss at Georgia Tech. The Orange closed our the second four-game stretch with a 71-67 win at Pittsburgh on Feb. 7.

## YOUNGEST TEAM IN THE ACC - BY CLASS

Syracuse has more freshman (7) on its roster than any team in the ACC. Combined with just two true sophomores, the Orange have nine underclassmen making for one of the most youthful squads in Division I basketball.

## 1000-POINT CLUB

Syracuse is one of two teams in the ACC, and six in NCAA Division I, with three 1,000-point scorers in
