BY THE NUMBERS



The Hokies recorded 17 hits against Radford. TJ Rumfield and Fritz Genther both accounted for three. Tech recorded five of those hits in the eighth inning.



The Hokies hit three home runs on Tuesday against Radford. Rumfield hit two of his own while Cade Hunter hit his first of the year. This is the most since 2019 (5 vs. VMI).



DECUDU BDEVRUUMN

The Hokies travel to Coral Gables, Florida to face the No. 6 Hurricanes. The last time the Hokies beat a ranked team was in 2019 when they beat No. 1 Florida State.

NOTEWORTHY

FEELING 22

- The Hokies scored 22 runs against the Radford Highlanders on Tuesday, the most runs ever scored in the series.
- The Hokies had 17 hits, including three home runs from TJ Rumfield and Cade Hunter.
- Virginia Tech pitchers tossed 12 strikeouts and only gave up two runs.

HOKIES STRIKE FIRST

- In both games on Sunday, Tech scored at least one run in the first inning.
- The Hokies were able to maintain their lead in both games, leading to a sweep of the Golden Flashes.
- Since 2017, Tech has scored first in 3 of 5 opening games and won four of those games.

YEAR FOUR

- Virginia Tech head coach John Szefc begins his fourth year with the Hokies and, as history says under Szefc, it should be the best season for Tech in recent memory.
- In his fourth season at his previous stops,
 Szefc won 27 games at Marist (1999) and 30 at Maryland (2016).
- The last time the Hokies won 30 or more games was in 2013 (won 40). So, it's looking like good things are brewing for Tech now, with the foundation build, and that hasn't happened in some time.

DEPTH WILL BE A STRONG SUIT

- Tech should be feeling pretty good about the quality of depth it has on this team coming back from a season ago, with it returning 26 letterwinners.
- The Hokies have six starters coming back that are position players and two starting pitchers, as well.
- That's something that hasn't happened in some time, with over the last few years there being quite a flip of the roster yearover-year.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Tech will play a 51-game regular season in 2021 and of those 51 contests, 33 will be played at the friendly confines of English Field at Atlantic Union Bank Stadium.
- That marks the most games at home over the last 20 seasons, with the second most being back in 2008 when the team played 31 home contests.
- Look for the Hokies to capitalize on that with their home-field advantage, owning a .542 home winning percentage in the Szefc era (32-27).

BUNCH OF ROADRUNNERS

- Tech was one of the better teams on the base paths last season, ranking 13th nationally in steals per game (2.25), which was good for third in the ACC.
- The Hokies racked up the 10th most in the land (36) behind Fritz Genther and Brennan Reback owning eight steals apiece, and they both return for the maroon and orange.
- Outfielder Gavin Cross had seven himself, for the three to account for 23 of the 36 swipes (63,9%).

THROW 'EM A CHAIR

- Tech also was very effective at striking its opponents out at the plate regularly last season, taking pressure off the defense to make play after play for outs.
- The Hokies ranked ninth in the country in strikeouts per nine innings (11.9), which was fourth in the ACC.
- However, a big part of them ranking so high was behind the arm of lan Seymour, who is no longer playing ball at Tech after being selected in the second round of the MLB Draft last summer to the Tampa Bay Rays, with his ridiculous 17.7 average that ranked fourth nationally.
- So, for the Hokies to be one of the top teams in that department again, look for the likes of Chris Gerard (29 Ks in '20), Anthony Simonelli (26 Ks in '20) and others to carry the load in the 2021 season.

SMALL BALL WINS

- Tech, which won 11 of its first 16 games last year before the season being put on the shelf due to COVID-19 implications, was getting it done with small ball as one of its staples to its success.
- Having three players in the top eight of the

ACC for sacrifice bunts, the Hokies' Brennan Reback and Tanner Thomas each had three last season and Fritz Genther had two.

• The Hokies had 10 sacrifice bunts on the year to rank second in the ACC and sixth among Power Five teams.

BIDDISON, WHAT'S NOT TO LOVE?

- The player who really took a step forward last year for the Hokies was Nick Biddison, improving his batting average from .281 his freshman year in 2019 to .344 last season.
- He also improved his slugging percentage from .500 to .557, respectively.
- The infielder, who has dabbled as a catcher and outfielder as well since his arrival to Blacksburg, is riding a 14-game hitting streak into this weekend, as well as a 23game on-base streak that dates way back to April 30, 2019 against Old Dominion.
- He got on base the last seven games of the season in 2019 and made it to first base in all of last year's 16 games for a total of 23.
- Lastly, he also has started every game he's played in for Tech, owning a 62-game start streak. He had 52 starts his freshman year and 16 last season.

CROSS READY FOR NEXT STEP

- As mentioned on the first page, outfielder Gavin Cross had himself quite a freshman season in Blacksburg last year.
- Now, looking to make strides off that, expect the Tennessee native to take a step forward and be one of the key contributors for Tech and to be thought of as a leader as well.
- Cross, who was a Freshman All-American, stacked up pretty well to other ACC freshmen at the dish, owning the third best batting average among the league's freshies.

- Maryland made three NCAA appearances in the first 120 years in program history. Szefc led the Terps to three berths in five seasons.
- His .596 winning percentage at Maryland is the best ever in school history.
- Owns 10 overall 30-win seasons, which includes three 40-win seasons – Maryland (2), Marist (1).
- Has won two conference regular-season titles and four tournament titles at Marist
 Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (3), Northeast Conference (1).
- Has coached 107 players that have been drafted or signed pro contracts since 1997, including 34 over the last seven drafts (as a head coach).
- Was NEC Coach of the Year in 1997 and ABCA Northeast Coach of the Year in 2001.
- Has developed 23 All-Americans, including 10 at Maryland.

Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock announced the hiring of Tech's 25th head baseball coach on June 9, 2017 and formally introduced John Szefc as the head coach of the baseball program at a press conference a few days later on June 15. The 2020 season will mark his third as the Hokies' head coach.

Szefc (pronounced SHEFF), who won his 400th career game on March 10, 2018 guiding the Hokies to a 3-1 victory over Pitt, accepted the position at Tech after leading Maryland to three NCAA appearances and a 180-122 (.596) overall record as the Terrapins' head coach. Before arriving in Blacksburg, Szefc owned a 392-259-3 (.602) career record in 12 seasons as an NCAA head coach, producing 10 campaigns with 30 or more wins

In addition to ending a 43-year NCAA tournament drought and becoming the fastest coach to 100 career wins at Maryland, Szefc spent seven seasons (1996-2002) at the helm of the Marist College baseball program, where he led the team to four conference championships, four NCAA Regional appearances and a 212-137-3 (.607) overall mark. Szefc earned Northeastern Conference Coach of the Year honors in 1997 and was the American Baseball Coaches Associate Northeast Region Coach of the Year in 2001.

The first coach in Maryland history to ever take the Terrapins to an NCAA Super Regional, Szefc accomplished the feat twice in 2014 and 2015 as he guided the program to the first two 40-win seasons in school history and claimed Maryland's first two NCAA Regional crowns. Maryland achieved a final No. 14 ranking both seasons, the highest finishes in school history.

He guided the Terrapins to the ACC Tournament final for the first time in 38 years in 2014 and then took Maryland to the Big Ten tournament final in the school's initial season in that conference, winning a program-best 42 games in 2015.

Szefc has coached 107 players that have been drafted or signed professional contracts since 1997, including four in 2018 and five in 2019. Over the last seven drafts, 34 of his players have been selected, including the 45th pick of the 2014 draft Jake Stinnett, the highest pick of a Maryland player in almost a decade. Almost a dozen have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, including most recently, Mike Shawaryn (Red Sox) and Lamonte Wade (Twins) in 2019. He has also helped develop 23 All-Americans, including 10 of the 20 players in Maryland history to earn that distinction.

The Middletown, N.Y. native arrived at Maryland after a two-year stint as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas State (2011-12) and a two-season stay as assistant head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas (2009-10). He also enjoyed a six-season tenure as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Louisiana (2003-08). Szefc began his coaching career as an assistant at Sacred Heart (1995) and at Drexel (1990-93).

Szefc managed the New York Generals in the Atlantic College Baseball League during the summers of 1995 and 1996. He led the club to a 47-28 record, earned two consecutive division titles and took the Generals to the ACBL title game in 1996

Collegiately, he played two years at Connecticut before transferring in 1987 to Drexel. During his senior campaign for the Dragons, he was tabbed an All-East Coast Conference outfielder.

He graduated from Drexel University with a degree in corporate communications in 1989. He also holds a master's degree in sports administration from Temple University.

Szefc and his wife, Barbara, have a daughter, Anna, and two sons, John Michael and Sam.
