KEY STORYLINES

SCOUTING GEORGE MASON

- The Patriots are 2-6 so far this season, coming into Friday's match on a four-game skid
- George Mason opened the season with two wins against American and Howard at the DC Challenge, but have lost the next six
- Peyton Ehmke leads George Mason offensively with 72 kills and 2.83 points per set. She also has a team-high .287 hitting percentage. She also leads the team in total blocks with 19
- Olyvia Kennedy is also solid for the Patriots, registering 68 kills and a team-high 2.52 kills per set
- As a setter, Erin Derick has a team-high 204 assists and

8.87 assists per set. She also has 22.5 points so far this season

- The Patriots return 13 letterwinners and all of their starters from a season ago. The 2021 roster also features nine newcomers

SCOUTING WOFFORD

- Entering Friday evening's match on a three-game winning streak, Wofford is 5-4 on the season
- The Terriers most recently swept the Wofford College Invitational, defeating South Carolina State 3-0, Gardner Webb 3-0 and North Alabama 3-1
- Sophomore setter Emily Hodsdon highlighted

Wofford's All-Tournament honors as the Tournament MVP, while outside hitter Addison Foote and middle blocker Sarah Barham notched All-Tournament Team recognition

- As a team, Wofford has 391 kills compared to 379 by their opponents
- The Terriers are also averaging 10.8 assists per set and have 56 aces on the season
- Meghan Yaffa leads Wofford with 91 kills, good for 2.94 kills per set and 3.58 points per set

- North Carolina A&T saw wins against North Carolina Central University 3-0 and Mercer University 3-1. Its Tuesday matchup was a 3-0 loss to Wake
- Freshman outside hitter Naiya Sawtelle led the team in kills this weekend with 32 total
- Leading the team in assists each game this past weekend, setter Edie Brewer totaled 50 assists
- The Aggies are averaging 10.6 assists per set and 11.7 kills per set this season

CHATTANOOGA CLASSIC

- The Hokies most recently competed in the Chattanooga Classic, finishing the weekend with a 2-1 record
- Virginia Tech opened with a 3-1 loss to Troy but bounced back to defeat Chattanooga 3-2 and swept Tennessee Tech to end the tournament
- Tech won the tournament, followed by Tennessee Tech, Troy and Chattanooga
- The is the second tournament win for the Hokies, who also won the Virginia Tech Invitational to open the season

MOST OUTSTANDING PLAYER

- Following her weekend at the Chattanooga Classic, Angel Robinson was named Most Outstanding Player
- She ended her weekend with 21 kills and a .370 hitting percentage
- Played in all 12 sets for the Hokies and had 12 total blocks
- The senior had her best match of the weekend in the win over Chattanooga, recording 11 kills and .375 hitting percentage
- Posted six block assists against Chattanooga, a weekend-high for her

ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

- Along with Robinson, Logan Mosley and Griere Hughes were named to the All-Tournament Team following the Chattanooga Classic
- Defensively, Mosley led the Hokies with 49 digs, good for 4.08 digs per set over the weekend
- The libero posted a .949 reception percentage and also had five assists over the three matches.
- She posted a season-high three aces in the win over Chattanooga and had a weekend-high 20 digs against Troy.
- Hughes led the Hokies with 32 kills on the weekend, averaging 2.67 kills per set. She also had 8 total blocks and a team-high 37.5 points.
- The graduate student posted several season-highs, with 12 kills and 13.5 points against Chattanooga

FRESHMAN DEBUTS

- Amanda Lowe appeared in her first match in a Hokie uniform on Saturday against Chattanooga
- She finished her match with nine kills and five digs
- Making the start in the next match against Tennessee Tech, Lowe had three kills on eight attempts
- Kellen Morin made her Hokie debut at the UNF Invitational, providing a spark in the match against North Florida, registering three kills in her two sets played
- She made the start against Davidson the next day, finishing with a season-high eight kills and a .421 hitting percentage,
- Morin finished the weekend with seven block assists and two digs
- Elayna Duprey and Mary Page made their debuts at the Hokie Invitational and have remained an integral part of the Tech lineup
- During Duprey's debut against Lehigh, the outside hitter finished the match with 11 kills and a .529 hitting percentage
- Page has been consistent in the Hokie lineup, playing as a defensive specialist. She had her best game at the UNF Invitational against Davidson, posting 14 digs

UNF INVITATIONAL

- The Hokies competed in the UNF Invitational, finishing their weekend in Florida with a 2-1 record
- All three matches went to five sets, with Tech tallying wins against Georgia State and Davidson
- Virginia Tech suffered its first loss of the season, falling to North Florida 3-2 in a tight match
- Angel Robinson and Marisa Cerchio were named to the All-Tournament team after their performances at the Invitational
- Robinson finished her weekend with 30 total kills and a .446 hitting percentage
- Cerchio registered 36 kills at the Invitational, finishing the three games with 2.40 kills per set

SPREADING THE LOVE

- Virginia Tech has had a different starting rotation for the majority of its matches, with many familiar faces and a few newcomers
- Sixteen different members of the squad have seen action so far this season, including the four freshmen
- Four Hokies have seen the floor for every set so far this season, including Angel Robinson, Marisa Cerchio, Mara Perry and Logan Mosley
- Robinson leads the Hokies in points with 95 but Cerchio is not far behind with 93 points

ASSIST LEADERS

- The Hokies have been using three different setters this season, with Mara Perry, Talyn

Jackson and Brie Postema each working into the rotation

- Sophomore Mara Perry currently leads the team in assists with 145. She has played in all 39 sets so far this season
- Senior Talyn Jackson is the team-leader in assists per set with 4.82. She has 106 assists over 22 sets played
- Sophomore Brie Postema has played in 25 sets, registering 115 assists and 4.60 assists per set

FIVE SET VICTORIES

- All of Virginia Tech's matches at the UNF Invitational went to five sets, as well as the Hokies match last weekend against Chattanooga
- The Hokies opened their season with a five-set win over Lehigh and also defeated Georgia State, Davidson and Chattanooga in five sets
- The only loss for Tech this season came at the hands of North Florida in a tight five set match

Marci Byers was named the sixth head coach of the Virginia Tech volleyball program in January, 2020. She enters her second season at the helm of the Hokies.

During her first season with Tech, the team tallied five conference wins including a sweep of Virginia and a win over then No. 14 Duke in five sets. Byers looks to build off the 2020 season with many key returners and 10 newcomers set to make an impact.

A four-time Big South Coach of the Year selection at Radford University, she is the winningest coach in Highlanders' history, leading the program to three Big South regular season titles, two Big South Tournament championships and two NCAA Tournament berths. She is one of only five head coaches in Big South history to register 200 or more career victories.

Throughout her tenure at Radford, the Chicago native consistently recruited top talent to the New River Valley from across the country, thanks to her strong relationships within the ACC footprint, as well as with elite club programs in the Midwest, Texas and California.

Byers' squads at Radford topped the 20-win mark five times over seven seasons and compiled an 81-34 (.708) overall record over four years. She led the Highlanders to a 22-7 record in 2018, including a 12-4 mark in Big South play. They reached the Big South Tournament title game for the second consecutive season and were selected to play in the National Invitational Volleyball Championship where they defeated App State in the first round. During her tenure at Radford, her student-athletes twice registered the top team GPA of any program at the school (2008 and 2013).

No stranger to defeating Power Five foes, under her direction in 2017 the Highlanders registered wins at Arizona, at South Carolina and at Virginia Tech en route to a Big South Tournament title and an NCAA Tournament berth. In 2016, Byers led Radford to a 24-6 record, including a perfect 11-0 mark at home and a Big South regular season championship. Her squads also registered wins against Wake Forest in 2016 and Washington State in 2015. Byers' 2014 squad finished with a 24-8 mark that included wins over California and Maryland as Radford claimed

the Big South regular season title. The Highlanders earned their first NCAA Tournament appearance under Byers in 2013 after winning both the Big South regular season and tournament titles, finishing the season with a 25-10 record.

Prior to beginning her tenure at Radford in 2008, she spent two seasons at NCAA Division II Chowan University in Murfreesboro, N.C. After going 4-17 in her initial season in 2006, Byers guided the Hawks to a 26-11 record as the squad averaged the most aces per game of any Division II squad. Prior to joining the collegiate ranks, she posted a 121-49 record in 10 seasons coaching in the Richmond prep ranks, spending two seasons at Mills Godwin High School and eight years at Hermitage High School.

Byers has also been a successful coach at the club level. Her 2003-04 team qualified for the Junior Olympics in Houston, while her 2004-05 team reached the Junior Olympics in Salt Lake City. She was also invited to participate in the USA Volleyball Coaches Clinic at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs.

She is a 1995 graduate of Virginia Union University where she graduated with honors with a bachelor's degree in secondary education with a concentration in mathematics. A four-year starter on the volleyball team, she captained the team as both a junior and senior. Her husband, J.D., serves as an assistant men's basketball coach at VCU. The couple are parents of a daughter, Kamryn Grey.

ACC RANKINGS

- Defensively, the Hokies rank third in the ACC in team digs with 497
- Logan Mosley leads the charge, ranking first in the ACC in digs per set and total digs
- The libero is currently averaging 4.85 digs per set and has 165 total digs, good for 38th nationally
- Tasha Vipond is ranked 16th in the ACC in hitting percentage with a .343

POINTS PER SET

- The Hokies currently have five players who are averaging over two points per set
- Griere Hughes leads the way with 2.57 points per set. She has 82 kills and 92.5 points total
- Angel Robinson is averaging 1.74 kills per set and she leads the team with 95 total points so far this season
- Cera Powell is second on the team with 2.22 kills per set. She has also registered 2.48 points per set with 60 kills

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

- Tech looks to defend its undefeated record at home this season, currently sitting at 3-0 in Cassell Coliseum
- The Hokies have a 384-173 overall record in Cassell, making it a difficult place for opponents to play
- After wrapping up the Hokie Invitational, Virginia Tech will have nine ACC matches in Blacksburg

LAST TIME IN BLACKSBURG

- Graduate student Tasha Vipond had a standout weekend for the Hokies at the Virginia Tech Invite, recording multiple career-highs in the win over Elon
- The middle blocker had 11 kills and 12 points, both career-highs. She also added two blocks
- Vipond joined the Hokies in 2020 after spending the previous four years of her athletic career playing basketball at Lafayette College
- She earned a Bachelor of Science in 2019 and is now pursuing a Master's of Science in Civil Engineering with aspirations of becoming a design engineer

PREPPING FOR ACC PLAY

- This is the Hokies final non-conference weekend of play as they begin ACC play next Friday
- Tech is in a good position to open ACC play with a solid record after the Hokie Invite
- In 2019, Virginia Tech went into conference play with a 7-6 record. The previous year, the Hokies had a 9-3 record heading into ACC play
- The first weekend will see Clemson and Georgia Tech make the trip to Blacksburg
- Four ACC teams remain undefeated, including North Carolina (9-0), Louisville (8-0), Pitt (8-0) and Miami (7-0)

OFF TO A GOOD START

- The Hokies are off to a solid start with a 7-2 record
- Following their first weekend of play, Tech was 3-0 to start the season
- The last time the Hokies started 3-0 was the 2018 season, when Virginia Tech defeated USC Upstate, Presbyterian and Charlotte to open the season
- The Hokies were 8-0 that season before seeing their first loss in the third week of the season

FIRST MEETINGS

- This is the Hokies third straight weekend playing an opponent for the first time
- Tech will face Wofford and North Carolina A&T this weekend for the first time in program history
- The Hokies are currently 1-2 against first time opponents, beating Georgia State 3-2 and falling to North Florida 3-2 and Troy 3-1
- George Mason is Tech's other opponent this weekend, the Hokies have seen the Patriots 19 times in program history and hold a 12-7 advantage in the series
