### KEY STORYLINES

#### SCOUTING CLEMSON

- The Tigers enter ACC play with an 8-3 non-conference record after sweeping the Big Orange Bash, hosted by Clemson
- Clemson defeated UNC Asheville 3-0, Rutgers 3-0 and East Tennessee State 3-1
- A perfect 7-0 at home, the Tigers losses come on the road against UCF, South Carolina and Santa Clara
- Clemson is averaging 13.1 kills per set compared to only 11.5 by its opponents and T-6th in the ACC in hitting percentage with .269
- Kaylee Martin is the team-leader in kills with 124. She also has 135 points on the year
- Ava Pritchard has 60 kills

and 83 points, as well as a team-high 27.5 blocks, good for .809 blocks per set

- Defensively, Devan Taylor leads the Tigers with 156 digs and 4.105 digs per set
- The Tigers rely on McKenna Slavik and Jenna Moore as their setters, recording 245 and 122 assists, respectively

#### SCOUTING GEORGIA TECH

- The No. 18 Yellow Jackets come to Blacksburg with a 9-1 record, playing Wake Forest on Friday night before taking on the Hokies
- Georgia Tech has posted signature wins over then-No. 12 Penn State 3-2, and two sweeps of Arkansas and Georgia

- The only loss of the season comes at the hands of then-No. 18 UCLA 3-1
- Julia Bergmann currently leads the ACC with 5.28 kills per set and 161 kills. Mariana Brambilla is also ranked fourth with 4.47 points per set
- Breland Morrisette has 40 total blocks on the season, averaging 1.11 blocks per set
- Matti McKissock has 384 assists so far, good for 10.97 assists per set
- GeorgiaTech's 9-1 nonconference record marks the best start for the Jackets since a 9-0 opening to the 2018 season.
- With the latest win, they have now won 41 of the last 48 matches

## LAST TIME AGAINST CLEMSON

- The Hokies fell to the Tigers in their final match of the 2020-21 season, 3-1 at Clemson
- Clemson posted 59 kills compared to 48 by the Hokies. The Tigers also added nine blocks and 55 digs, with the Hokies recording 38 digs
- Angel Robinson posted a hitting percentage of .412 with eight kills and 2.5 blocks
- Brie Postema had 27 assists and Mara Perry added 14
- For Clemson, Camryn Hannah finished her match with 20 kills and a .395 hitting percentage. McKenna Slavik posted 16 digs

## LAST TIME AGAINST GEORGIA TECH

- Georgia Tech defeated the Hokies 3-0 in March 2021
- Angel Robinson nearly notched a career-high with nine kills against the Yellow Jackets
- Mara Perry had ten assists against Georgia Tech
- For the Yellow Jackets, Julia Bergmann had 15 kills and three aces and Isabella D'Amico had 23 assists
- Georgia Tech posted 39 kills while the Hokies had 26. The Yellow Jackets also edged the Hokies in digs with 39 compared to 28 for the Hokies

## ACC PLAY

- The Hokies finished ACC play with a 5-11 record a season ago, sweeping Virginia as well as then-No. 14 Duke and Syracuse
- The ACC currently has three teams ranked in the top 25. Georgia Tech is currently No. 18, while Pitt is No. 4 and Louisville is No. 5
- Three teams are currently undefeated with North Carolina (11-0), Louisville (10-0) and Pitt (10-0) not suffering a loss so far this season
- The ACC is currently 7-2 in non-conference ranked matches and 6-3 against top-15 opponents this season
- As a whole, the ACC is 103-25 in non-conference play which is best among the Power 5

## DID YOU KNOW...

- Virginia Tech has played the highest number of sets so far this season in the ACC with 51 over 12 matches
- The next closest team is Boston College who has played 49 sets
- Florida State has only played 32 sets over nine matches
- Six of Virginia Tech's matches have gone into five sets as the Hokies have a 4-2 record in five-set matches
- The Hokies have not been swept so far

this season, with all three of their three-set matches ending in their favor

## HOKIE INVITE

- Virginia Tech finished its final non-conference tournament with a 2-1 record, defeating George Mason 3-1 and Wofford 3-0
- The Hokies fell to North Carolina A&T in five sets to wrap up the Invite
- Mekenzi Heckmann was named to the All-Tournament team following the weekend, recording 24 kills and two kills per set
- The sophomore hit .316 on the weekend and had five total blocks

## THE LOWE DOWN

- Blacksburg native Amanda Lowe got her first start as a Hokie against Chattanooga and has started in every match since
- This weekend at the Hokie Invite, she tallied two career-highs against Wofford with 11 kills and 13 points
- The freshman hit .692 against George Mason and .688 against Wofford, both match-highs for the Hokies
- On the weekend, Lowe finished with 2.82 kills per set over the three matches with a .367 hitting percentage
- She totaled 31 kills and nine total blocks

## A WALK AROUND THE BLOCK

- Angel Robinson and Tasha Vipond had a solid weekend at the net, ending the Hokie Invite with 17 and 19 total blocks, respectively
- Vipond had three solo blocks and 16 block assists while Robinson had four solo blocks and 13 block assists
- Vipond's current season-high is eight total blocks in the sweep over Tennessee Tech earlier this season
- Against George Mason, Robinson totaled a new career and season-high with seven total blocks. She also had three aces, another season-high for the senior

## CONFERENCE STATS

- The Hokies come in at fourth for opponent blocks, with opposing teams averaging 1.69 per set, ahead of this week's opponents Clemson (#11) and Georgia Tech (#14)
- Virginia Tech also sits in the fifth spot for blocks, averaging 2.48 per set, in the ACC
- The Hokies also land within the top ten spots for team Digs (eighth), Service Aces (seventh) and Opponent Hitting Percent (fourth)

## ACC LEADERS

- Logan Mosley leads the ACC in Digs with

an average of 4.41 per set and a total of 225

- Tasha Vipond grabs the number five spot for blocks with an average of 1.26 per set, and her Clemson counterpart, Ava Pritchard, holds the number six spot
- Sophomore Cierra Huntely is ranked fifth in service aces, holding an average of 0.46 per set
- Middle Blocker Angel Robinson secures the fifth spot for hitting percentage, posting a .384 on 185 total attempts

## RANKED ACC TEAMS

- After playing Georgia Tech, the Hokies will have two more ranked teams on the horizon
- Louisville makes the trip to Blacksburg on Oct. 15 for a 6 p.m. match up. The Cardinals are currently ranked No. 5
- Virginia Tech makes the trip to Pitt in the back half of the ACC schedule on Oct. 31
- Florida State and North Carolina are also receiving votes in the latest AVCA poll

Marci Byers was named the sixth head coach of the Virginia Tech volleyball program in January, 2020. She enters her second season at the helm of the Hokies.

During her first season with Tech, the team tallied five conference wins including a sweep of Virginia and a win over then No. 14 Duke in five sets. Byers looks to build off the 2020 season with many key returners and 10 newcomers set to make an impact.

A four-time Big South Coach of the Year selection at Radford University, she is the winningest coach in Highlanders' history, leading the program to three Big South regular season titles, two Big South Tournament championships and two NCAA Tournament berths. She is one of only five head coaches in Big South history to register 200 or more career victories.

Throughout her tenure at Radford, the Chicago native consistently recruited top talent to the New River Valley from across the country, thanks to her strong relationships within the ACC footprint, as well as with elite club programs in the Midwest, Texas and California.

Byers' squads at Radford topped the 20-win mark five times over seven seasons and compiled an 81-34 (.708) overall record over four years. She led the Highlanders to a 22-7 record in 2018, including a 12-4 mark in Big South play. They reached the Big South Tournament title game for the second consecutive season and were selected to play in the National Invitational Volleyball Championship where they defeated App State in the first round. During her tenure at Radford, her student-athletes twice registered the top team GPA of any program at the school (2008 and 2013).

No stranger to defeating Power Five foes, under her direction in 2017 the Highlanders registered wins at Arizona, at South Carolina and at Virginia Tech en route to a Big South Tournament title and an NCAA Tournament berth. In 2016, Byers led Radford to a 24-6 record, including a perfect 11-0 mark at home and a Big South regular season championship. Her squads also registered wins against Wake Forest in 2016 and Washington State in 2015. Byers' 2014 squad finished with a 24-8 mark that included wins over California and Maryland as Radford claimed

the Big South regular season title. The Highlanders earned their first NCAA Tournament appearance under Byers in 2013 after winning both the Big South regular season and tournament titles, finishing the season with a 25-10 record.

Prior to beginning her tenure at Radford in 2008, she spent two seasons at NCAA Division II Chowan University in Murfreesboro, N.C. After going 4-17 in her initial season in 2006, Byers guided the Hawks to a 26-11 record as the squad averaged the most aces per game of any Division II squad. Prior to joining the collegiate ranks, she posted a 121-49 record in 10 seasons coaching in the Richmond prep ranks, spending two seasons at Mills Godwin High School and eight years at Hermitage High School.

Byers has also been a successful coach at the club level. Her 2003-04 team qualified for the Junior Olympics in Houston, while her 2004-05 team reached the Junior Olympics in Salt Lake City. She was also invited to participate in the USA Volleyball Coaches Clinic at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs.

She is a 1995 graduate of Virginia Union University where she graduated with honors with a bachelor's degree in secondary education with a concentration in mathematics. A four-year starter on the volleyball team, she captained the team as both a junior and senior. Her husband, J.D., serves as an assistant men's basketball coach at VCU. The couple are parents of a daughter, Kamryn Grey.

## NOTEWORTHY

### RESUME BUILDER

- The Hokies have defeated a top 25 team the past two seasons and set their sights on #18 Georgia Tech
- During the 2020 season, Virginia Tech defeated then-No. 14 Duke 3-2 in Durham
- Marisa Cerchio went off for 18 kills against the Blue Devils and Angel Robinson and Cera Powell each posted five blocks
- In 2019, the Hokies beat then-No. 23 Louisville 3-1
- Powell had 12 kills while Cerchio added 11
- Logan Mosley was strong defensively, posting 17 digs

### POINTS PER SET

- The Hokies currently have six players who are averaging over two points per set
- Griere Hughes leads the way with 2.90 points per set. She has 121 kills and 139 points total
- Angel Robinson is averaging 1.74 kills per set and is second on the team with 128.5 total points so far this season
- Amanda Lowe has made an impact in the 19 sets she's played in, averaging 2.68 points per set and 2.26 kills per set

### HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

- Tech looks to start a new home winning streak, falling for the first time in Cassell against North Carolina A&T
- The Hokies have a 386-174 overall record in Cassell, making it a difficult place for opponents to play
- After wrapping up the Hokie Invitational, Virginia Tech will have nine ACC matches in Blacksburg

### GETTING IN THE GROOVE

- Graduate student Griere Hughes has been making an impact for the Hokies on the court, leading the team in several different categories
- Along with points per set, the outside hitter is also leading the team in kills per set with 2.52
- Hughes already has 121 kills on the season, 28 more than the next highest player on the team
- She has also been big at the net for Tech, with 24 total blocks, good for .50 blocks per set

### OPENING ACC PLAY

- The Hokies enter the 2021 conference season with a 9-3 record after a 2-1 weekend at the Hokie Invite
- In 2019, Virginia Tech went into conference play with a 7-6 record. The previous year, the Hokies had a 9-3 record heading into ACC play
- The first weekend will see Clemson and Georgia Tech make the trip to Blacksburg
- Three ACC teams remain undefeated, including North Carolina (11-0), Louisville (10-0), Pitt (10-0)

### BOUNCE BACK MENTALITY

- The Hokies have responded well after losses this season, following each one up with a win
- After Tech's first loss to North Florida, the Hokies defeated Davidson 3-2 to wrap up the North Florida Invitational
- The Hokies then fell to Troy to open the Chattanooga Classic but followed it up with a win over Chattanooga in five sets and a sweep of Tennessee Tech
- Tech was on a four-game win streak after its loss to Troy before falling to North Carolina A&T to end the Hokie Invite

### HOKIE LEADERS

- The Hokies are outperforming their opponents on aces this season with 82 compared to only 55 by opponents
- Virginia Tech has also had success at the net, leading their opponents 126.5-86, and 2.5-1.7 on blocks per set
- Leading the team in points is outside hitter Griere Hughes, scoring 139 total points, averaging 2.90 points per set, and tallying 121 total kills
- Sophomore Mara Perry leads the Hokies in assists totaling 202
- Both Tasha Vipond and Angel Robinson are tied for total blocks this season with 53 each
