KEY STORYLINES

DOWN GOES #1

- Virginia Tech defeated No. 1 Marshall on August 29 in Harrisonburg, Va. Trailing 2-0 at the half, a brace from Sivert Haugli and go-ahead PK from Nick Blacklock gave the Hokies their fourth win over a No. 1 opponent in program history.
- Tyler Taber and Ben Martino made their first career starts for Tech in the match.
- The Hokies are 3-0 in the first match following a win against a No. 1 team.

HAUGLI HONORS

- For his performance against Marshall, Haugli earned United Soccer Coaches Player of the Week honors.
- Along with two goals, Haugli anchored the back line that held Marshall to two shots in the second half.

TOUGH TASK AT HAND

- Three of Tech's first four opponents were ranked in the United Soccer Coaches preseason poll: No. 1 Marshall, No. 13 UCF, and No. 10 Seton Hall.
- Following the first week of competition, only Marshall (No. 7) and Seton Hall (No. 20) remain in the top 25, while UCF is receiving votes.

BACK AT IT

 After missing the first two matches of the season due to red card accumulation in 2020-21, Jacob Labovitz made an appearance on Friday against UCF. The forward scored the game-winning goal.

LAST TIME OUT...

 Seton Hall eliminated Tech in the 'Sweet Sixteen' of the 2020 NCAA DI Men's Soccer Championships.

FIVE STRAIGHT

- With its selection to the 2020 NCAA DI Men's Soccer Championship, Virginia Tech qualified for its fifth-consecutive NCAA tournament. Only five other teams can boast that accomplishment: Indiana, Maryland, Stanford, Wake Forest, and Washington.
- Tech's journey to the NCAA Tournament to the postseason was not an easy trip. After excelling in the fall and being ranked as high as No. 4 in the country, the Hokies faced setbacks in the spring due to injury and the loss of Dani Pereira.
- After losing four of its first five matches in the spring, the Hokies finished the regular season on a three-game unbeated streak, including ACC road wins against #15 UNC and Notre Dame.
- The unseeded Hokies defeated #15 Oregon St. before falling to No. 6 Seton Hall in penalties.
