

THE SERIES

- UNC has prevailed in the previous two encounters with the Hokies, both in the ACC Tournament.
- The Tar Heels lead the all-time series, 70-15. The first game of the series was played on Feb. 15, 1912 in Blacksburg.
- Tech has won two of the last five meetings, but both have come at home.
- The Hokies last won in Chapel Hill on Feb. 13, 2007, an 81-80 overtime victory by Tech.
- Tech is 5-32 all-time against UNC in Chapel Hill and have lost seven straight times on the road in the series.

A WIN WOULD

- Give the Hokies their second ACC road win of the season. They totaled three ACC wins on the road in 2020-21.
- Be Coach Young's first win at UNC since Dec. 20, 2017 when he led Wofford into the Smith Center and prevailed 79-75. He was 1-2 against the Tar Heels as the head coach at Wofford.
- Hand the Tar Heels their first loss of the season at home (9-0).
- Snap the Hokies' two-game losing streak in the series. Improve Tech to 4-4 on the
- road this season.

HOKIE HEADLINES

- Keve Aluma crossed the 20-point plateau for the fifth time of the season on Saturday at Boston College.
- The Berlin, Maryland native hit 7 of 14 shots and pulled down a team-high eight rebounds in the 68-63 setback.
- Aluma (943) and Justyn Mutts (959) are both on track to reach 1,000 career points this season.
- Tech is slated to play three games in five days, which began with the Boston College contest on Saturday. ACC leader Miami visits Blacksburg following Tech's trip to Chapel Hill on Monday.

BY THE NUMBERS



The 2021-22 season is the **20th** of Mike Young's head coaching career. He has logged a 340-275 (.553) career record as the head whistle.



Keve Aluma has scored 20 or more points **five** times this season. Four of those games have been against ACC competition.



Virginia Tech caps a **three**-game road swing in six days Monday night in Chapel Hill. The Hokies opened at NC State, then visited Boston College on Jan. 22.

NOTEWORTHY

ON A ROLL

- Not many in the country have played better than Keve Aluma as of late.
- The redshirt senior has scored double figures in 13 straight games for the first time in his career.
- It's the longest double-digit scoring streak by a Hokie since Nickeil Alexander Walker put together 13 straight games to open the 2018-19 season.
- The next longest streak is 23 set by Zach LeDay during the 2016-17 season.

MAKE OR BREAK WEEK

- Tech braces for a pivotal stretch in its season this week. The Hokies are set to face three of the ACC's top six teams beginning Monday night at North Carolina.
- Following the UNC game, Tech welcomes Miami to Cassell on Wednesday night before traveling to Tallahassee for Saturday's showdown with league leader Florida State.

GET IT IN THE PAINT

- In Tech's two games against Notre Dame and NC State, the Hokies produced over 30 points in the paint, leading to two wins.
- When Tech scores 30 points in the paint, the team has a 6-1 record. The lone loss was at Duke.
- "Every chance you can get to touch it down [to the bigs, Mutts and Aluma], the coaches make a good point: You have to touch them," Sean Pedulla said of the inside-out approach by the Hokies. "It's not like a black hole where some big guys, you throw it in and never see it again. They're looking to pass it back out to you, so whenever you throw it back, it's just get to the open spot. Thought process is just get it down to them, and we're at our best when we're playing inside-out."

INCONSISTENCY ON THE GLASS

- The Hokies put together a clinic on the boards against the Wolfpack, who are third in the league in rebounds. Tech held a 37-26 advantage on the glass.
- Justyn Mutts and Keve Aluma accounted for 20 of Tech's 37 rebounds, which were a season-high in ACC contests for the Hokies.
- NC State's 26 rebounds were the fewest it's had all season and the league's secondleading rebounder, Dereon Seabron, tied a season-low in rebounds with five.
- Fast forward to Saturday's game at Boston College and the Hokies were out-rebounded by 15, its worst rebounding margin of the season. Tech had not lost the rebounding battle by 15 or more since March 10, 2020 vs. North Carolina in the ACC Tournament (-15).
- This is concerning considering UNC pulled down a season-high 23 offensive rebounds in its loss at Wake Forest. The Tar Heels haven't loss the rebounding battle since Dec. 18, 2021 vs. Kentucky (-18).

KEEP BELIEVING

- The Hokies were 0-5 when trailing at the half before the Notre Dame game, in which they trailed 40-32 at halftime. Shooting 70 percent from the field and 63 percent from three in the second half spurred on Tech's rally.
- Virginia Tech trailed by 10 with 14:53 remaining in the second half. The last time the Hokies erased a 10-point deficit and won the game was against Virginia on Jan. 30, 2021.
- "First of all, what a great atmosphere," Notre Dame head coach Mike Brey said after the game. "I thought the Virginia Tech crowd kept their team believing the whole time."

MUTTS-SEE TV

- Justyn Mutts is one of the most dynamic players on the Tech roster. That was on full display vs. the Irish where Mutts dialed up a season-high 24 points. It tied for the most points he's scored in a Tech uniform (3/11/21 vs. North Carolina).
- However, rewind to Wednesday when he finished the UVA game with two points on 1-2 shooting, that didn't sit well with Coach Young.
- The two met prior to Thursday's (1/13) practice where Young asked Mutts what he needed of his head coach and what he

could do to get Mutts going. "He's a terrific passer and he becomes so set in that and making the right pass instead of [having the mindset of] lay your ears back and go play," Young offered.

• In other words, when Mutts is the aggressor and more assertive, good things happen.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE KEVE

Keve Aluma leads the Hokies with four double-doubles this season.

• Aluma has reached double-figure scoring in 16 of Tech's 18 games and double-figure rebounding in four games.

MOMENTUM ON OUR SIDE

- With its third-place finish in the regularseason standings in 2020-21, Tech has finished in the top five of the ACC two of the last three seasons.
- Placing third tied for the highest ACC finish in school history as the Hokies tied for third in 2006-07 and 2009-10.
- If Tech can post a top-five ACC finish this season, it would mark the third time in four years accomplishing that feat.

• The Hokies charted five top-five ACC finishes in seven years from 2004-05 to 2011-12.

BENCH PRODUCTION

- Through 18 games, the Hokies' reserves are averaging 14.6 points per game.
- Tech has gone over the 30-point threshold three times, with a season-high 36 points coming against Maine and Cornell.
- However, the Virginia game was the second time in three outings where Tech only managed two points from the bench.
- The Hokies only managed 21 points in their five ACC games before going off for 17 at NC State.

DEGREES ON DEGREES

- Storm Murphy and Justyn Mutts are both in grad school at Virginia Tech.
- Murphy graduated from Wofford with a finance degree in May 2021 and is currently pursuing a graduate degree in leadership studies within the Agricultural and Life Sciences program at Virginia Tech.
- Mutts graduated with a psychology degree from Delaware and completed his master's degree at Tech in agricultural and life sciences with a concentration in education in May 2021. He's currently pursuing his second master's degree in educational psychology.
- Keve Aluma earned his first undergraduate degree in human development from Virginia Tech in May 2021 and is currently working on his second undergraduate degree in sociology.

PUT THE CLAMPS ON 'EM

• Through the first five games of the season, the Hokies held each of their opponents below 60 points. Their 59.78 scoring defense average ranks second in the ACC and 14th nationally.

- The last time Tech opened the season holding its first five opponents below 60 points was the 1946-47 season. That season, the Hokies held their first 18 opponents below the 60-point threshold.
- In addition to their scoring defense, the Hokies rank fifth in the ACC in field-goal percentage defense (.416).
- Tech held its first six opponents of the season below 40 percent shooting before Xavier shot 47.8 percent against the Hokies on Nov. 26.

OWNING THE ARC

• The 3-point line has been under new management 18 games into the 2021-22 season. Tech has owned both sides of the arc, ranking first in 3FG% defense (.280) and first in 3FG% (.387) among ACC programs. The Hokies are also third in 3-pointers made per game (8.4).

WINNING THE TURNOVER BATTLE

- Through 18 games this season, Tech has won the turnover battle 13 times, posting an 8-5 record.
- The Hokies rank sixth in the ACC and 30th nationally in turnovers per game (11.0).

TECH SIGNS NO. 26 CLASS IN THE COUNTRY

• Coach Young announced the signing of three standout recruits during the early signing period, which began on Nov. 10. The Hokies are set to welcome MJ Collins (Rock Hill, S.C.), Patrick Wessler (Matthews, N.C.) and Rodney Rice (Clinton, Md.) to Blacksburg next summer as part of Tech's 26th-ranked recruiting class according to 247Sports.

REUNITED IN BLACKSBURG

- Keve Aluma, Storm Murphy and Coach Young spent two seasons (2017-19) together at Wofford, highlighted by their 2018-19 season that included a first-round win (84-68) over Seton Hall in the 2019 NCAA Tournament.
- Upon Aluma's and Young's departure from Wofford, Murphy stuck around in Spartanburg, South Carolina, guiding the Terriers to a 34-25 record.
- While together at Wofford, the trio combined for a 51-18 (.739) mark.

WHO IS THIS GUY?

- Keve Aluma only attempted one 3-pointer in his two seasons at Wofford. In Coach Young's words, "it wasn't even close."
- Fast forward two seasons and Aluma has become a post player with range from beyond the arc. He attempted 57 threes in his Hokie debut in 2020-21, knocking down 20 of them for a 35.1 percent clip.
- After going 2-16 through Tech's first eight games this season, Aluma knocked down four of his seven attempts from long range vs. Wake Forest.

JUSTYN TIME

- Coach Young has gone on record saying, "Justyn Mutts was probably the key to our year last year."
- The Delaware transfer was the Hokies' fourth-leading scorer from last season (9.5) and second-leading rebounder (6.4).
- From Dec. 29, 2020 through the end of the season, Mutts scored at least nine points in 11 of Tech's 14 games. The Millville, New Jersey native twice broke the 20-point plateau at Miami (Fla.) (22) and vs. North Carolina (24) during that stretch.

LOGGING THE MINUTES

- Storm Murphy logged 3,723 minutes in his career entering this season, which is the 16th-most of anyone in the country returning for 2021-22.
- He ranked ninth in that category among point guards.

• They have combined for 9,616 minutes played, 353 games played and 3,371 points scored.

ALUMA-NATING

- After sitting out the 2019-20 season due to NCAA transfer policy, Keve Aluma bursted onto the scene in Blacksburg.
- He has steadily expanded his game to the point where he led the Hokies in multiple categories last season.

IT'S IN THE NAME

• Storm Murphy's first name comes from his Mom's maiden name - Storm, in addition to being born in January during a snowstorm in Wisconsin.

TRACKING THE TREY

- Coach Young's last four teams at Wofford all finished inside the top 10, nationally, in 3-point field-goal percentage.



ABOUT NORTH CAROLINA

- North Carolina (12-6, 4-3 ACC) has dropped its last two outings, both by 20-plus points, most recently to Wake Forest on Saturday night, 98-76. It was the most points scored by Wake Forest against North Carolina since 1965 (107-85).
- Armando Bacot is one of the country's most well-rounded athletes as he's the only ACC player averaging a double-double (16.9 points and 11.3 rebounds). Bacot's 62.2-percent field-goal percentage leads the conference, as well.
- The Tar Heels dominate the boards with a league-leading 9.1 rebounding margin, something the Hokies will need to improve upon coming off Saturday's performance at Boston College.
- Of its seven ACC games, six of North Carolina's contests have been decided by 15 or more points (4-2). The team is also 9-0 inside the Smith Center.
- The Tar Heels are led by first-year head coach Hubert Davis. An understudy of legendary coach Roy Williams from 2012-21, Davis played for North Carolina between 1988 and 1992.



LAST TIME VS. NORTH CAROLINA

- Virginia Tech and North Carolina last met on March 11, 2021, in the ACC Tournament, where the Tar Heels downed the Hokies, 81-73. The result marked the second year in a row that North Carolina eliminated Tech from the ACC Tournament.
- Armando Bacot's double-double was the standout performance of the contest, as he put up 17 points and reeled in 13 rebounds in 25 minutes of action. R.J. Davis also had an impressive showing, adding a team-high 19 points off the bench. The Tar Heels' bench outscored Tech's, 36-8.
- Rebounds were also a deciding factor in the matchup. North Carolina's 43 rebounds were the most that Tech gave up all season.
- The Hokies took a 35-32 advantage into the break as Justyn Mutts and Tyrece Radford had 14 points apiece in the first half.
- A 10-2 run by North Carolina erased Virginia Tech's advantage and the Hokies put together another run to surpass the Tar Heels, despite drawing it within five points with two minutes remaining.
- Mutts finished the game with a season-high 24 points, which ties his highest tally with the Hokies.

CHALLENGING NONCON

- Coach Young's nonconference scheduling philosophy is quite different from his predecessor - one in which should provide plenty of Quadrant 1 and Quadrant 2 opportunities for the NCAA Tournament resume.
- The Hokies have the potential to play up to six Quadrant 1 or 2 games in their nonconference slate, highlighted by games vs. Memphis, vs. Xavier, at Maryland and vs. St. Bonaventure.
- It's important to note, Tech secured two Quadrant 1 wins all of last season (vs. Villanova and vs. Virginia).
- Six of the Hokies' 11 nonconference games will be played either on the road or at neutral sites.
- Three of Tech's nonconference opponents appeared in the AP preseason poll: No. 12 Memphis, No. 21 Maryland and No. 23 St. Bonaventure.

HOKIES IN PRIMETIME

- If you're a night owl, then the Hokies' 2021-22 schedule will be right up your ally.
- Tech is set to appear in at least 11 games this season with an official start time of 8 p.m. or later. Seven of those games will tip at 9 p.m. or later.

PROGRAM WIN NO. 1,500

- Virginia Tech earned its 1,500th program win Nov. 21 vs. Merrimack, becoming the 90th men's basketball program in Division I history to achieve the mark.
- Tech joined ACC counterparts North Carolina, Duke, Syracuse, Notre Dame, NC State, Louisville, Virginia, Pitt and Wake Forest as the 10 conference programs that have reached the milestone.

NOTEWORTHY

STORM WARNING

- Grad student Storm Murphy takes over the reins at point guard following the graduation of Wabissa Bede.
- The Wofford transfer averaged 17.8 points, 3.3 rebounds and 4.3 assists last season. He was one of only 11 players to average that stat line or better nationally.
- Murphy tallied double figures in 21 of 24 contests, including 10 20-point performances, and dished over five assists on eight occasions.
- He concluded his Wofford career with 1,315 points to finish 24th on the program's alltime scoring list.
- The First-Team All-SoCon selection will provide a scoring threat from outside, as he shot 40 percent from three last season.
- Murphy knocked down 70 3-pointers a year ago. In comparison, Bede connected on 12 with a 24.5 percent clip.

DANCIN' IN YEAR TWO

- In previous seasons in Virginia Tech history, the fastest head coach to make the NCAA Tournament was in Year Three. Those Hokies were Howie Shannon, Charlie Moir and Buzz Williams.
- Therefore, with Mike Young doing so in Year Two, he became the fastest Tech coach to make The Dance.

HOKIE CENSUS

- Tech has 13 players on the squad who represent eight states and two international countries (Netherlands, Nigeria).
- Florida leads the way with three players Hunter Cattoor, Lynn Kidd and Jalen Haynes
 while Maryland has two players – Keve Aluma and Darius Maddox.

BOUNCEBACK MENTALITY

- Tech doesn't lose back-to-back games as it did against Memphis and Xavier, often.
- Young and the Hokies were 5-1 last season after a loss with their lone back-to-back losing skid coming at the end of the season to North Carolina in the ACC Tournament and Florida in the NCAA Tournament.
- In 2019-20, Young had five wins following a loss.

50 SPOT

- Tech shot over 50 percent in a game five times during the 2020-21 season going 5-0.
- Since Young got to Blacksburg, the Hokies are 16-1 in contests shooting 50 percent or greater, with the lone loss coming to BYU on Nov. 27, 2019 in the fifth-place game of the Maui Jim Maui Invitational.
- Over the last decade (2010-11 season to present), Tech is 87-12 when shooting 50 percent or better.

LEADING AT THE BREAK

- Over the last two seasons, Tech is 21-5 when leading at halftime, with two of the losses coming against North Carolina and Florida to end the 2020-21 season.
- The Hokies are 34-9 in the Mike Young era when up at half.

GREEN-LIGHTED FROM THREE

- With the potential lineup of Storm Murphy, Hunter Cattoor, Nahiem Alleyne, Justyn Mutts and Keve Aluma, all five of those players have the green light from distance.
- The last team Coach Young had with this type of threat from deep was his 2018-19 Wofford squad, which ranked second nationally in 3-point accuracy (41.4). The Terriers finished 30-5 that season, including

an unbeaten mark in SoCon action, and reached the second round of the 2019 NCAA Tournament.

RANKED WINS BECOMIN' COMMON

• Tech had four ranked wins last season, tying the most-ever in school history (set 2017-18).

REACH OUR POTENTIAL

- When asked how he'd define success for this season, Coach Young expressed he wanted the Hokies to reach their potential.
- "That will be a real success for me," he said, "And I'll get back to the mountains of North Carolina this spring and fish with a big smile on my face."


ACC POY CONVERSATION

- Keve Aluma is undoubtedly in the conversation for ACC Player of the Year heading into the 2021-22 season.
- The 6-foot-9 forward was a Second-Team All-ACC pick last season, four points behind Virginia's Sam Hauser for the final spot on the first team.
- With the entire All-ACC first team gone, Aluma is the leading returning point getter from the all-conference voting a year ago.

CASSELL COLISEUM - RENDERING OF PROPOSED \$75 MILLION-PLUS RENOVATION OF VIRGINIA TECH'S HOME VENUE

REACH FOR EXCELLENCE

- Virginia Tech announced on April 20, 2021 a \$400 million fundraising campaign to propel Hokie sports to the forefront of the Atlantic Coast Conference, prepare generations of student-athletes for success in life, and raise the university's profile nationwide.
- The campaign will leverage the momentum of recent successes on the field and in fundraising, such as adding about 10,000 more Hokie Club members in the past five years and opening the Student-Athlete Performance Center, thanks to a record gift. Still, leaders acknowledged that the athletics enterprise needs an infusion of revenue in order to compete at the top of the ACC.
- The budget increase will support athletics in three primary areas: facilities, coaching, and the student-athlete experience.



- The Reach for Excellence campaign has five main pillars, which are:
 - A football enhancement fund to build a program that consistently competes at the top of the ACC, by allotting \$30 million over time for recruiting, assistant coaches' salaries, quality-control coaches, player development, and capital needs.
 - Renovations to improve Cassell Coliseum, with at least \$50 million to be raised privately.
 - The Drive for 25 initiative to increase Hokie Club membership to 25,000 and raise \$20 million annually for student-

athlete scholarships.

- Striving for comprehensive excellence for all sports by providing operating expenses, facility improvements, nutritional and strength and conditioning programs, and more.
- Increasing the number of student-athlete scholarship endowments to expand capacity to support students and broaden reach in recruiting.
- When it's filled with nearly 10,000 fans cheering the Hokies to victory in the last seconds of a basketball game, Cassell Coliseum is an amazing sight. But when it's empty, the home of Virginia Tech basketball, volleyball, and wrestling shows its age. Built in the early 1960s, the Coliseum is due for an extensive renovation.
- Plans call for a completely redesigned experience, including:
 - A new glass entrance along Washington Street
 - Extended concourse areas along both sides to allow fans easier access to different sections of the coliseum
 - The addition of high-end premium seating areas, including club seating and luxury suites on both sides
- This much-needed \$75 million-plus project, helped by at least \$50 million in private support, would create one of the best home venues in the ACC.



WHAT'S A HOKIE?

The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute. With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body.

Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Hokie" yell which is still used today. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the word was solely the product of



his imagination and was used only as an attention-getter for his yell. It soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

The official university school colors -Chicago Maroon and Burnt Orange - also were introduced in 1896. The colors were chosen by a committee because they made a 'unique combination' not worn elsewhere at the time. The official definition of "Hokie" is "a loyal Virginia Tech Fan."


NAW IN YEAR 3




