KEY STORYLINES

THE SERIES

- Despite NC State leading the all-time series 40-18, the Hokies have prevailed in four of the previous five head-tohead matchups.
- The two sides did not meet last season. They were scheduled to clash in Raleigh, North Carolina for the regular-season finale, but was canceled due to COVID protocols.
- Tech won the last meeting with the Wolfpack, 72-58, in Blacksburg.
- The Hokies are 10-12 at home against NC State.
- NC State's Kevin Keatts is 0-3 against the Hokies as the head coach of the Wolfpack.

A WIN WOULD...

- Give the Hokies their fourth straight win over NC State, tying for the longest winning streak by Tech in the series since 2009-2011 (also four games).
- Improve Coach Young's record to 2-0 against the Wolfpack as Tech's head coach.
- Prevent Tech from dropping to 0-3 in ACC play for the first time since the 2014-15 season when the Hokies lost their first six league games.
- Improve Tech to 6-1 at home this season.
- Be Mike Young's 40th win as head coach of the Hokies.

HOKIE HEADLINES

- Keve Aluma has reached double-figure scoring in eight straight games. He's at least tied for leading scorer honors in five of the last six games.
- The redshirt-senior dropped in a season-high 25 points on 11-of-20 shooting at No.
 2 Duke on Dec. 22. It was Aluma's second straight ACC outing this season where he dialed up 20-plus points. Aluma leads the ACC in scoring for conferenceonly games at 24.0 ppg.
- Hunter Cattoor has scored double figures in six of the last seven games, including a career-high 21 points vs.
 St. Bonaventure on Dec. 17.

The 2021-22 season is the **20th** of Mike Young's head coaching career. He has logged a 338-272 (.554) career record as the head whistle.

It has been 27 days since the Hokies last played in Cassell Coliseum - a 93-60 win over Cornell on Dec. 8.



Virginia Tech ranks **No. 10** in the country in scoring defense, holding opponents to 58.0 points per game.

NOTEWORTHY

20-20 VISION FOR ALUMA, MUTTS AT DUKE

- Keve Aluma (25) and Justyn Mutts (20) combined for 45 points against the secondranked Blue Devils.
- It was the first time since Nov. 28, 2020 vs. No. 3/3 Villanova two Tech players scored 20 or more points in the same game. Aluma (23) and Nahiem Alleyne (20) combined for the feat that night.

ALUMA VS. BANCHERO

- One can only hope the Dec. 22 matchup between Keve Aluma and Paolo Banchero will not be the only time we get to see the two elite players clash head-to-head in college.
- Two of the front runners for ACC Player of the Year, Aluma and Banchero put on a show for fans across the country. Aluma dialed up a season-high 25 points, while Banchero chipped in 23 points.
- Aluma held his own against the future NBA
 Draft lottery pick and drew praise from Duke
 head coach Mike Krzyzewski. "[Keve] Aluma,
 he's one of the better players in the country
 and a huge matchup problem," Coach K
 noted.

DOWN. BUT NOT OUT

- Is the 0-2 start to ACC play less than ideal? Sure. Is there ground to be made up? You bet. Can this veteran Tech group rally as we begin the new year? We certainly believe so, and so does Coach K.
- Following the Duke game, Krzyzewski had this to say about the Hokies: "They are really good. They're old, they play outstanding defense and they are very difficult to defend. [...] Mike [Young] does such a good job with his team. [...] They are going to be as good as anyone in our conference."

STAY SAFE EVERYONE

- Tech had its UNC and Pitt games postponed due to COVID protocols. Those were the first two games the Hokies had to postpone/ cancel since early March of last season.
- Over the last two seasons, Tech has had 10 games postponed/canceled due to COVID protocols.

M-V-THREE

 Hunter Cattoor tied his career high in 3-point field goals made with five, although the St. Bonaventure contest was the first

- time he shot 100 percent (5-5) from three while doing so. His performance earned him MVP honors for the game.
- Keve Aluma, Cattoor and Murphy combined for 51 points, which surpassed St. Bonaventure's team tally of 49. The three of them together shot 64 percent from both the field and beyond the arc.

DIALED IN THE QUEEN CITY

- Tech made 13 3-pointers for the first time this season, marking the second time in three games it set a new season high in threes (12 vs. Cornell). Dec. 17 was the ninth time the Hokies have made at least 13 threes since 2019-20 and the first time since Feb. 27, 2021 against Wake Forest (13).
- The Hokies set a new high in free throws made – 17 on 23 attempts. Shooting 74 percent from the line was the secondhighest number of the season with a minimum of 20 attempts (80 percent vs. Saint Francis).

WHAT CAN YA DO?

- On Dec. 4, Wake Forest shot 63.5 percent (33-52) from the field, the highest mark by any Virginia Tech opponent since Dayton (63.6) on Nov. 26, 2019 in the Maui Invitational.
- It was the highest field-goal percentage by an ACC team in any game this season, and Tech became the first high-major program to allow an opponent to shoot 63.5 or higher (as of Dec. 4).

DOUBLE-DOUBLE KEVE

- Keve Aluma recorded his first double-double of the season vs. Memphis - 14 points and 11 rebounds.
- The Berlin, Maryland native recorded the second double-double of the season in his homecoming game against the Terrapins on Dec. 1 - 17 points and 12 rebounds.
- Aluma manufactured his third doubledouble of the season at No. 2 Duke - 25 points and 10 rebounds.
- He led all Hokies with six double-doubles during the 2020-21 campaign.
- Aluma has reached double-figure scoring in 11 of Tech's 13 games and double-figure rebounding in three games.

WHAT A START

Tech won each of its first five games by an

- average of 28 points per game.
- Each game was decided by at least 20 points. The smallest margin of victory was at Navy (77-57). The largest margin of victory was vs. Maine in the season opener (82-47).
- The last time the Hokies won five games in a row, all by 20-or-more points, was in 1943-44. Between Jan. 26 and Feb. 12, 1944, Tech rattled off six-consecutive wins by 20-plus points against VMI (twice), Blackstone Army Airfield, Woodrow Wilson Hospital, William & Mary and Emory & Henry.

MOMENTUM ON OUR SIDE

- With its third-place finish in the regularseason standings in 2020-21, Tech has finished in the top five of the ACC two of the last three seasons.
- Placing third tied for the highest ACC finish in school history as the Hokies tied for third in 2006-07 and 2009-10.
- If Tech can post a top-five ACC finish this season, it would mark the third time in four years accomplishing that feat.

YOU GET A BUCKET, YOU GET A BUCKET, EVERYBODY GETS A BUCKET

- Eight players scored a 3-point field goal vs.
 Merrimack. The last time that occurred was against Coppin State on Dec. 19, 2020.
- With late threes from walk-ons Camden
 Johnson and Ben Varga, each member of
 the Hokies' squad has scored a point this
 season. Keve Aluma leads the way for Tech
 with 158 points.

BENCH PRODUCTION

- A big question mark entering the 2021-22 season was the impact Tech's bench would have.
- Through 13 games, the Hokies' reserves are averaging 17.3 points per game.
- Tech has gone over the 30-point threshold three times, with a season-high 36 points coming against Maine and Cornell.

DEGREES ON DEGREES

- Storm Murphy and Justyn Mutts are both in grad school at Virginia Tech.
- Murphy graduated from Wofford with a finance degree in May 2021 and is currently pursuing
 a graduate degree in leadership studies within the Agricultural and Life Sciences program at
 Virginia Tech.
- Mutts graduated with a psychology degree from Delaware and completed his master's degree
 at Tech in agricultural and life sciences with a concentration in education in May 2021. He's
 currently pursuing his second master's degree in educational psychology.
- Keve Aluma earned his first undergraduate degree in human development from Virginia Tech in May 2021 and is currently working on his second undergraduate degree in sociology.

PUT THE CLAMPS ON 'EM

• Through the first five games of the season, the Hokies held each of their opponents below 60 points. Their 58.0 scoring defense average ranks second in the ACC and 10th nationally.

- The last time Tech opened the season holding its first five opponents below 60 points was the 1946-47 season. That season, the Hokies held their first 18 opponents below the 60-point threshold.
- In addition to their scoring defense, the Hokies rank fourth in the ACC in field-goal percentage defense (.407).
- Tech held its first six opponents of the season below 40 percent shooting before Xavier shot 47.8 percent against the Hokies on Nov. 26.

OWNING THE ARC

• The 3-point line has been under new management 13 games into the 2021-22 season. Tech has owned both sides of the arc, ranking first in 3FG% defense (.259) and third in 3FG% (.391) among ACC programs. The Hokies are also third in 3-pointers made per game (8.7).

WINNING THE TURNOVER BATTLE

- Through 13 games this season, Tech has won the turnover battle 12 times.
- The lone game where the Hokies failed to win the turnover battle was against Wake Forest on Dec. 4.
- The Hokies rank fifth in the ACC and 35th nationally in turnovers per game (10.9).

TECH SIGNS NO. 26 CLASS IN THE COUNTRY

 Coach Young announced the signing of three standout recruits during the early signing period, which began on Nov. 10. The Hokies are set to welcome MJ Collins (Rock Hill, S.C.), Patrick Wessler (Matthews, N.C.) and Rodney Rice (Clinton, Md.) to Blacksburg next summer as part of Tech's 26th-ranked recruiting class according to 247Sports.

REUNITED IN BLACKSBURG

- Keve Aluma, Storm Murphy and Coach Young spent two seasons (2017-19) together at Wofford, highlighted by their 2018-19 season that included a first-round win (84-68) over Seton Hall in the 2019 NCAA Tournament.
- Upon Aluma's and Young's departure from Wofford, Murphy stuck around in Spartanburg, South Carolina, guiding the Terriers to a 34-25 record.
- While together at Wofford, the trio combined for a 51-18 (.739) mark.

WHO IS THIS GUY?

- Keve Aluma only attempted one 3-pointer in his two seasons at Wofford. In Coach Young's words, "it wasn't even close."
- Fast forward two seasons and Aluma has become a post player with range from beyond the arc. He attempted 57 threes in his Hokie debut in 2020-21, knocking down 20 of them for a 35.1 percent clip.
- After going 2-16 through Tech's first eight games this season, Aluma knocked down four of his seven attempts from long range vs. Wake Forest.

JUSTYN TIME

- Coach Young has gone on record saying, "Justyn Mutts was probably the key to our year last year."
- The Delaware transfer was the Hokies' fourth-leading scorer from last season (9.5) and second-leading rebounder (6.4).
- From Dec. 29, 2020 through the end of the season, Mutts scored at least nine points in 11 of Tech's 14 games. The Millville, New Jersey native twice broke the 20-point plateau - at Miami (Fla.) (22) and vs. North Carolina (24) - during that stretch.

LOGGING THE MINUTES

- Storm Murphy logged 3,723 minutes in his career entering this season, which is the 16th-most of anyone in the country returning for 2021-22.
- He ranked ninth in that category among point guards.

GOOD THINGS COME IN THREES

 Tech has three fifth-year seniors on its roster in Keve Aluma, Storm Murphy and Justyn Mutts. They have combined for 9,134 minutes played, 338 games played and 3,187 points scored.



ABOUT NC STATE

- The Wolfpack (7-7, 0-3 ACC) are currently stuck in a five-game losing streak that was triggered on Sunday, Dec. 12 in an overtime loss to then-No. 1 Purdue. Since then, NC State has dropped two ACC contests and sits 0-3 in league play. Of note, six of the Wolfpack's seven losses have come by single digits, including their most recent defeat – an 83-81 loss to Florida State.
- Despite struggling to get results, NC State has one of the league's most versatile players in Dereon Seabron. The Norfolk, Virginia native averages 19.6 points per game (third in the ACC) and 10.1 boards (first in the ACC). The 6-foot-7 guard has recorded eight double-doubles this season and has popped off for two 30-plus point games (Florida State and Nebraska).
- Senior forward Jericho Hellems and freshman guard Terquavion Smith are also having noteworthy seasons to complement Seabron's numbers. Hellems is second on the team in points per game, with 14.6, while Smith is right behind him with 14.4 points per game. Smith is a two-time ACC Freshman of the Week this season.
- NC State is led by fifth-year head coach

Kevin Keatts. In his first four seasons, Keatts carried the Wolfpack to an NCAA Tournament appearance in 2018 and two NIT berths (2019 and 2021).



LAST TIME VS. NC STATE

- Virginia Tech and NC State will meet for the first time in nearly two years after the 2020-21 contest was canceled due to COVID-19. Their last tilt, a game in Cassell Coliseum on Jan. 11, 2020, saw the Hokies come away with a 72-58 victory.
- Tech was led by Landers Nolley II, who had 29 points, and Tyrece Radford, who added 18 points.
- Despite falling into an early 10-0 hole, the Hokies went on a 13-0 run to claw back into the game. After taking a 21-19 lead with 10:39 remaining in the first half, Tech did not look back and held the lead for the rest of the contest. The Wolfpack got into striking distance late, but an 11-0 run from the Hokies going into the final media timeout sealed the result.
- Tech shot 19-21 (91.0 percent) from the free-throw line, the third-best number in the Mike Young era and the highest single-game percentage with a minimum 15 attempts.

CHALLENGING NONCON

- Coach Young's nonconference scheduling philosophy is quite different from his predecessor - one in which should provide plenty of Quadrant 1 and Quadrant 2 opportunities for the NCAA Tournament resume.
- The Hokies have the potential to play up to six Quadrant 1 or 2 games in their nonconference slate, highlighted by games vs. Memphis, vs. Xavier, at Maryland and vs. St. Bonaventure.
- It's important to note, Tech secured two Quadrant 1 wins all of last season (vs. Villanova and vs. Virginia).
- Six of the Hokies' 11 nonconference games will be played either on the road or at neutral sites.
- Three of Tech's nonconference opponents appeared in the AP preseason poll: No. 12 Memphis, No. 21 Maryland and No. 23 St. Bonaventure.

HOKIES IN PRIMETIME

- If you're a night owl, then the Hokies' 2021-22 schedule will be right up your ally.
- Tech is set to appear in at least 10 games this season with an official start time of 8 p.m. or later. Seven of those games will tip at 9 p.m. or later.

PROGRAM WIN NO. 1,500

- Virginia Tech earned its 1,500th program win Nov. 21 vs. Merrimack, becoming the 90th men's basketball program in Division I history to achieve the mark.
- Tech joined ACC counterparts North Carolina, Duke, Syracuse, Notre Dame, NC State, Louisville, Virginia, Pitt and Wake Forest as the 10 conference programs that have reached the milestone.

NOTEWORTHY

STORM WARNING

- Grad student Storm Murphy takes over the reins at point guard following the graduation of Wabissa Bede.
- The Wofford transfer averaged 17.8 points, 3.3 rebounds and 4.3 assists last season. He was one of only 11 players to average that stat line or better nationally.
- Murphy tallied double figures in 21 of 24 contests, including 10 20-point performances, and dished over five assists on eight occasions.
- He concluded his Wofford career with 1,315 points to finish 24th on the program's alltime scoring list.
- The First-Team All-SoCon selection will provide a scoring threat from outside, as he shot 40 percent from three last season.
- Murphy knocked down 70 3-pointers a year ago. In comparison, Bede connected on 12 with a 24.5 percent clip.

DANCIN' IN YEAR TWO

- In previous seasons in Virginia Tech history, the fastest head coach to make the NCAA Tournament was in Year Three. Those Hokies were Howie Shannon, Charlie Moir and Buzz Williams.
- Therefore, with Mike Young doing so in Year Two, he became the fastest Tech coach to make The Dance.

HOKIE CENSUS

- Tech has 13 players on the squad who represent eight states and two international countries (Netherlands, Nigeria).
- Florida leads the way with three players Hunter Cattoor, Lynn Kidd and Jalen Haynes – while Maryland has two players – Keve Aluma and Darius Maddox.

BOUNCEBACK MENTALITY

- Tech doesn't lose back-to-back games as it did against Memphis and Xavier, often.
- Young and the Hokies were 5-1 last season after a loss with their lone back-to-back losing skid coming at the end of the season to North Carolina in the ACC Tournament and Florida in the NCAA Tournament.
- In 2019-20, Young had five wins following a loss.

50 SPOT

- Tech shot over 50 percent in a game five times during the 2020-21 season - going 5-0.
- Since Young got to Blacksburg, the Hokies are 15-1 in contests shooting 50 percent or greater, with the lone loss coming to BYU on Nov. 27, 2019 in the fifth-place game of the Maui Jim Maui Invitational.
- Over the last decade (2010-11 season to present), Tech is 86-12 when shooting 50 percent or better.

LEADING AT THE BREAK

- Over the last two seasons, Tech is 20-3 when leading at halftime, with two of the losses coming against North Carolina and Florida to end the 2020-21 season.
- The Hokies are 33-7 in the Mike Young era when up at half.

GREEN-LIGHTED FROM THREE

- With the potential lineup of Storm Murphy, Hunter Cattoor, Nahiem Alleyne, Justyn Mutts and Keve Aluma, all five of those players have the green light from distance.
- The last team Coach Young had with this type of threat from deep was his 2018-19 Wofford squad, which ranked second nationally in 3-point accuracy (41.4). The Terriers finished 30-5 that season, including

an unbeaten mark in SoCon action, and reached the second round of the 2019 NCAA Tournament.

RANKED WINS BECOMIN' COMMON

• Tech had four ranked wins last season, tying the most-ever in school history (set 2017-18).

REACH OUR POTENTIAL

- When asked how he'd define success for this season, Coach Young expressed he wanted the Hokies to reach their potential.
- "That will be a real success for me," he said,
 "And I'll get back to the mountains of North Carolina this spring and fish with a big smile on my face."


ACC POY CONVERSATION

CASSELL COLISEUM - RENDERING OF PROPOSED \$75 MILLION-PLUS RENOVATION OF VIRGINIA TECH'S HOME VENUE

REACH FOR EXCELLENCE

- Virginia Tech announced on April 20, 2021 a \$400 million fundraising campaign to propel Hokie sports to the forefront of the Atlantic Coast Conference, prepare generations of student-athletes for success in life, and raise the university's profile nationwide.
- The campaign will leverage the momentum of recent successes on the field and in fundraising, such as adding about 10,000 more Hokie Club members in the past five years and opening the Student-Athlete Performance Center, thanks to a record gift. Still, leaders acknowledged that the athletics enterprise needs an infusion of revenue in order to compete at the top of the ACC.
- The budget increase will support athletics in three primary areas: facilities, coaching, and the student-athlete experience.



- The Reach for Excellence campaign has five main pillars, which are:
 - A football enhancement fund to build a program that consistently competes at the top of the ACC, by allotting \$30 million over time for recruiting, assistant coaches' salaries, quality-control coaches, player development, and capital needs.
 - Renovations to improve Cassell Coliseum, with at least \$50 million to be raised privately.
 - The Drive for 25 initiative to increase Hokie Club membership to 25,000 and raise \$20 million annually for student-

- athlete scholarships.
- Striving for comprehensive excellence for all sports by providing operating expenses, facility improvements, nutritional and strength and conditioning programs, and more.
- Increasing the number of student-athlete scholarship endowments to expand capacity to support students and broaden reach in recruiting.
- When it's filled with nearly 10,000 fans cheering the Hokies to victory in the last seconds of a basketball game, Cassell Coliseum is an amazing sight. But when it's empty, the home of Virginia Tech basketball, volleyball, and wrestling shows its age. Built in the early 1960s, the Coliseum is due for an extensive renovation.
- Plans call for a completely redesigned experience, including:
 - A new glass entrance along Washington Street
 - Extended concourse areas along both sides to allow fans easier access to different sections of the coliseum
 - The addition of high-end premium seating areas, including club seating and luxury suites on both sides
- This much-needed \$75 million-plus project, helped by at least \$50 million in private support, would create one of the best home venues in the ACC.



WHAT'S A HOKIE?

The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute. With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body.

Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Hokie" yell which is still used today. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the word was solely the product of

his imagination and was used only as an attention-getter for his yell. It soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

The official university school colors - Chicago Maroon and Burnt Orange - also were introduced in 1896. The colors were chosen by a committee because they made a 'unique combination' not worn elsewhere at the time. The official definition of "Hokie" is "a loyal Virginia Tech Fan."
