PACK TRACKS

- NC State dropped its fifth straight game with an 83-81 loss to Florida State on Saturday. The game featured 14 lead changes and five ties. The Pack led 75-74 with 1:51 to play, but the Seminoles rattled off the next five points and NC State was never able to get even again.
- Redshirt sophomore guard **Dereon Seabron** scored 32 points his best against an ACC opponent on 12of-14 shooting to lead NC State. Seabron added seven rebounds and a career-high seven assists against the
- Seabron is the first NC State player over the last 25 seasons to finish a conference game with 30+ points on 85% shooting. The only other Wolfpack player to shoot better than 80% in a 30-point conference game over that span was TJ Warren in 2013 when he played Florida State.
- Freshman guard Terguayion Smith added 23 points in the loss to Florida State. The Greenville, N.C. native made seven three-pointers, which are the most in a game by an ACC player this season. Smith's seven three-pointers tie for the second-most by a freshman in NC State history.
- Smith has now scored in double figures in seven consecutive games. In the last five games, he's averaging 20.3 points per game and has hit 17 three-pointers in that span. With 36 three-pointers this season, Smith has the second-most made three-pointers by an ACC player.

NOTING NC STATE

■ Between COVID pauses and injuries, Kevin Keatts was constantly juggling the lineup last season. In 25 games, eight players started at least eight games. Five of those eight players return this season.

- Kevin Keatts is entering his fifth season as head coach of NC State and for the fifth consecutive season he will have to replace the previous season's leading scorer. Devon Daniels led the team in scoring last season at 16.5 points per game. Jericole Hellems is the leading returning scorer at 12.9 points per game.
- North Carolina's team? Nine of NC State's 14 players are from the state of North Carolina. That's the most of the four ACC programs based in North Carolina. UNC has six of its 17 players from the state. Duke has five of its 14 players from the state and Wake Forest has four of its 19 players from the state.
- NC State only has two players (Thomas Allen and Jericole Hellems) who will complete their eligibility this season. Allen is a redshirt senior, who played his first two seasons at Nebraska before transfering home to NC State. Hellems is the only four-year senior on the team. He and redshirt junior Manny Bates have each been in the program four years. Nine of NC State's 14 players are either in their first or second seasons with the program.
- After not adding any transfers last season for the first time since he became head coach, Kevin Keatts added two transfers this offseason in Providence transfer Greg Gantt and Virginia transfer Casey Morsell. Keatts has now added 13 transfers to the program in his five seasons as head coach.

TUESDAY STORYLINES

- For the second consecutive game, NC State will play a team coming off of a COVID-layoff. On Saturday, Florida State was playing its first game since Dec. 15. On Tuesday, NC State will face a Virginia Tech that hasn't played since Dec. 22.
- Virginia Tech is one of just two ACC teams that the Pack has not beaten since Kevin Keatts became head coach of the program for the 2017-18 season (Georgia Tech is the other). Keatts' teams are 0-3 against Virginia Tech since he became head coach of NC State. The two programs did not play each other last season.
- NC State is currently on its longest losing streak of the Kevin Keatts era at five games. Prior to the 2021 calendar year, NC State had never lost more than three games in a row under Keatts. At 0-3 in ACC play, the Pack is off to its worst start in ACC play since the 2015-16 team lost its first five games of conference play.
- Have to finish games. NC State is 7-7 on the season, but has led in the second half in 12 of the 14 games. In the only two losses that NC State never led in the second half (Oklahoma State and Richmond) the Pack was within one possession of the lead with under three minutes to play in both games. In the Pack's 0-3 start to conference play, NC State has led deep into the second half of all three games. NC State led Louisville 68-64 with 3:00 to go before the Cardinals ended the game on a 9-0 run to win, 73-68. Against Miami, the Pack led at halftime and Miami did not take its first lead of the second half until a three-pointer with 4:39 to play broke a 73-73 tie as the Canes went on to win, 91-83. On Saturday against Florida State, NC State led for 25:00 of game time and had a 75-74 lead with 1:51 to play, but FSU ended the game on a 9-6 run to win, 83-81.
- Trending up: Terquavion Smith since moving into the starting lineup. Smith made his first start of the season in the Pack's game against Louisville on Dec. 4 and has stayed in the lineup since. In seven games starting, Smith is averaging 19.1 points per game and has hit 23 three-pointers (3.3 per game). Smith was named ACC Freshman of the Week in back-to-back weeks in December and has scored at least 20 points in three of seven games, including 23 in Saturday's game against Florida State. The only freshman in the ACC to average more points per game than Smith (14.4) is Duke's Paolo Banchero (17.1). Smith and Banchero both lead all freshman with four 20-point plus performances. Smith leads all freshmen in the ACC and ranks second in the ACC with 36 three-pointers made.
- Thomas Allen Stepping up: Senior guard Thomas Allen missed the final eight games of last season because of an ankle injury and his senior season got off to a slow start as well. Through the first 10 games he played in this season, Allen had made only six field goals and scored 18 points total. On Wednesday at Miami, Allen was 6-of-10 shooting and scored 13 points off the bench for NC State. On Saturday, Allen got his first start of the season and hit three three-pointers in the first half on his way to nine points for the game.
- NC State shot a season-best 51.9 percent on Saturday against Florida State and hit a season-high 12 three-pointers against the Seminoles. Virginia Tech ranks fourth in the ACC in opponent field goal percentage, holding its opposition to just 40.7 percent shooting and leads the conference in three-point field goal percentage defense, holding opponents to just 25.9 percent shooting.
- Through the first nine games of the season, NC State was holding its opponents to 41.2 percent shooting and only one team had shot over 50 percent against the Pack. During NC State's current five game losing streak, all five opponents have shot 50 percent or better. Top-ranked Purdue shot 50 percent in its comeback overtime win. Richmond shot a then-season high for an opponent by shooting 52.5 percent in its win in Charlotte. Wright State matched the Spiders' shooting percentage of 52.5 percent in its win. Miami shot 55.4 percent from the field in its win on Wednesday night. Florida State shot 50.9 percent in its win on Saturday. Overall, during the current five-game skid, NC State's opponents are shooting 51.8 percent from the field against the Pack.

NC STATE - VIRGINIA TECH SERIES

- Tuesday is the 59th meeting between the two programs. NC State leads the all-time series, 40-18, but the Hokies have won the last three meetings and four of the last five.
- Virginia Tech won the last meeting between the programs, 72-58, on January 11, 2020. The Pack jumped out to a 10-0 start, but Virginia Tech responded with 13 consecutive points to take the lead. NC State trailed 55-52 with 7:41 to play, but the Hokies used an 11-0 run to gain separation and win going away. D.J. Funderburk led the Pack with 18 points and nine rebounds. NC State shot a season-low 31.9 percent in the loss to the Hokies.

DEREON SEABRON BREAKING OUT

- Redshirt sophomore guard Dereon Seabron has broken out as one of the ACC's best players this season.
- Seabron is tied for the lead in the ACC with eight double-doubles this season and is currently atop of the ACC individual rankings in rebounding (10.1) and offensive rebounding (3.5). He ranks third in the league in scoring (19.6), sixth in field goal percentage (54.2%), eighth in assists (3.6) and ninth in steals (1.7).
- He leads NC State in scoring, rebounding, assists and steals and his 54.2 percent field goal shooting is also the best on the team. Seabron is the only player in the ACC to lead his team in scoring, rebounding, assists and steals.
- The ACC doesn't give out player of the month honors, but if it did it would be hard to find a better candidate than Seabron for the month of November. The Norfolk, Va., ended the month, leading the ACC in steals (2.67), tied for first in rebounding (9.83), second in offensive rebounding (3.0), third in field goal percentage (60.3%) and fourth in scoring (18.8). Seabron also had four double-doubles in November, the most of any player in the ACC.
- Seabron averaged 5.2 points and 3.9 rebounds per game last season as a redshirt freshman. He saw limited time in the first two months of the season as minutes were hard to find with Devon Daniels playing ahead of him. Daniels was injured in the Pack's win over Wake Forest on Jan. 27. At that point in the season Seabron was averaging 3.8 points and 2.4 rebounds per game and had only played more than 15 minutes in a game two times. After Daniels went down, Seabron's minutes went up and he started to show flashes of what was to come this season. He averaging 8.4 points per game over last eight outings of the season and had all three double-digit scoring games of the season during that stretch. He ended the regular season by being named ACC Freshman of the Week on March 8 after posting then career-highs in points (17), rebounds (13) and blocks (3) in a win at Notre Dame

HELLEMS HAS SHOWN SUSTAINED IMPROVEMENT

- NC State senior forward Jericole Hellems has improved his numbers every season of his collegiate career. After making a jump in every statistical category as a sophomore, Hellems made another jump as a junior as he has increased his output in every category.
- The Saint Louis, Mo., native was the only NC State player last season to lead the team in at least one game in points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks.

WHAT THE PACK IS MISSING IN MANNY BATES

- Redshirt junior forward Manny Bates suffered a right shoulder dislocation just 57 seconds into the Pack's season-opener and will miss the rest of the regular season.
- The Fayetteville, N.C. native had led the ACC in blocked shots in his freshman and sophomore seasons and was aiming to be the first ACC player since Duke's Shelden Williams (2004-06) to lead the conference in blocked shots in three consecutive seasons.
- Bates registered his 100th career block in just his 34th career game. He is the fastest player in program history to 100 blocks and is the fastest ACC player to 100 career blocks in over 20 seasons. Since 1985-86, Wake Forest's Tim Duncan and Georgia's Tech Alvin Jones are the only ACC players to get to 100 blocks in less games than Bates.
- Bates ranks third (83 freshman season) and sixth (64 sophomore season) on NC State's single-season blocked shot chart and is fourth on the program's career blocked shot list.
- Bates has also been an efficient scorer for the Pack. Last season, Bates set the program's single-season field goal percentage record by shooting 64.1 percent (100-of-156) from the field. He also shot 68.6 percent from the free throw line, improving over 20 percentage points from his freshman campaign at the stripe.
- For his career, Bates is shooting 64.7 percent (165-of-255) from the field. He needs 200 made field goals to qualify for the career field goals chart. His current shooting pace would shatter the current leader in career field goal percentage (Kevin Thompson, 1990-93 58.8%).

EXPERIENCE LACKING BEHIND MANNY BATES

- The Pack does not have very much experience in the frontcourt with Bates out for the season. Bates injury means the Pack only has three players on its team that are 6'9" or taller available. Prior to this season, that trio (Ebenezer Dowuona, Jaylon Gibson and Ernest Ross) had played a combined 128 minutes of college basketball with zero starts.
- Ebenezer Dowuona has stepped into the starting lineup to replace Bates. As a freshman last season, Dowuona appeared in 9 of NC State's 25 games and played a total of 48 minutes. The Ghana native played 25 minutes in each of the Pack's first two games this season to surpass last season's total minutes played. For the season, Dowuona is averaging 3.9 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.5 blocks per game. He ranks fourth in the ACC in blocked shots per game.
- Jaylon Gibson appeared in 17 games last season as a freshman and averaged 0.8 points and 0.9 rebounds in 4.7 minutes of action a game. He is averaging 11.7 minutes per game this season and has shown a knack for offensive rebounding, 18 of his 30 rebounds this season are offensive.

IMPORTANCE OF A DEEP BENCH

- Since Kevin Keatts arrival at NC State, the Pack has had one of the best benches in the country.
- In 140 games with Keatts as head coach, NC State's bench has averaged 22.4 points per game and has outscored the opponent's bench by 701 points (3,137 bench points for NC State and 2,417 for its opponents).
- Kevin Keatts teams have accounted for 11 of top-21 NC State bench scoring performances since 1999-2000 season, including the top-3. (see chart to left for best bench performances under Keatts).

PACK HAS BEEN ONE OF ACC'S BEST UNDER KEATTS IN TURNOVER MARGIN

■ In four seasons with Kevin Keatts, NC State has finished second twice, third place once and fourth place once in the ACC in turnover margin. The Pack had a +2.64 turnover margin in 2017-18 and a +3.08 turnover margin in 2018-19. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 71-30 (70.3%) when it has the same or fewer turnovers than its opponent and just 15-24 when it has more turnovers than its opponent.

DEFENSIVE PRESSURE UNDER KEATTS

■ In the first two seasons under Kevin Keatts, the Pack led the ACC in forcing opponent turnovers. After ranking fifth in the ACC in his third season, the Pack was back towards the top, finishing in second place. In his first season with NC State in 2017-18, the Pack forced 487 opponent turnovers, an average of 14.8 per game. In 2018-19, NC State forced 560 turnovers, an average of 15.6 per game. The 560 opponent turnovers are the third-most forced turnovers in program history. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 49-16 (75.4%) when it forces an opponent into 15 or more turnovers.

DEREON SEABRON NAMED ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK (TWO TIMES)

- Redshirt sophomore guard Dereon Seabron has been named ACC Player of the Week on Monday, Nov. 15 and Monday, Dec. 6 to start this season.
- Seabron posted double-doubles in NC State's two opening week wins. He had a then-career-high 18 points and 12 rebounds in the win over Bucknell. He followed up by resetting his career-high with 21 points and 10 rebounds against Colgate. Seabron hit the game-winning free throws, breaking a 74-74 tie, with two seconds remaining against Colgate.
- In the first games of December, Seabron had career-highs in points (39) and rebounds (19) to lead the Pack to a 4 OT win over Nebraska on Dec. 1. He followed up with 11 points and nine rebounds in the Pack's ACC-opener against Louisville.

ROAD WIN STREAK

■ NC State ended the 2021-22 regular season winning its last five conference road games. It's the first time since the 1973-74 season that NC State has won five consecutive ACC road games in the same season.

NC STATE ADDS THREE TALENTED SIGNEES IN 2021 CLASS TO THIS YEAR'S ROSTER

- NC State has added three four-star freshmen to this year's roster in Breon Pass (Reidsville, N.C.), Ernest Ross (Alachua, Fla.) and Terquavion Smith (Greenville, N.C.)
- Smith won three consecutive North Carolina Class 2A State Titles and was named North Carolina Mr. Basketball and North Carolina Gatorade Player of the Year. Ross was named Player of the Year in Florida by the coaches association and led his high school to the state championship game, while Pass is one of the more decorated dual-sport signees in NC State history. Pass had power five offers to play both college basketball and college football. Pass averaged 32.6 points and 12.3 rebounds per game on the basketball court and caught 35 passes for 758 yards and 11 touchdowns on the football field as a senior.

NC STATE ADDS TWO SIGNEES IN FALL CLASS

- NC State signed two playes on the first day of the fall signing period on Nov. 10. The Pack added Shawn Phillips (Dayton, Ohio) and LJ Thomas (Stone Mountain, Ga.) to the program. Both players will join the team for the 2022-23 season
- Phillips is a four-star prospect according to ESPN and Rivals. He's ranked as the No. 98 overall prospect in the country according to Rivals and is playing his senior season at Dream City Christian School in Glendale, Ariz.
- Thomas is a four-star prospect by ESPN and the No. 138 overall recruit in the country according to 247Sports. He averaged 18.5 points, 4.2 assists and 3.5 rebounds per game while shooting 44 percent from the




