GAME NOTES

- Virginia Tech won the coin toss and deferred its option to the second half.
- The weather at kickoff was 62°F with rain falling on and off during the game.
- Tech led, 3-0, scoring first at the 9:19 mark of the first quarter (William Ross 34-yard field goal).
- The Hokies are now 25-14-6 against North Carolina on the gridiron and 8-5-2 during series meetings in Chapel Hill.

HEAD COACH BRENT PRY

- Record moves to 2-3 as the head coach at Virginia Tech (0-2 during away games).
- Record moves to 0-1 in games played within the state of North Carolina.

VIRGINIA TECH TEAM NOTES

- Virginia Tech's record during its first ACC road game of a season moves to 15-4.
- Tech's 10 points scored against UNC mark the 350th consecutive game during which Virginia Tech has scored, the third-longest active streak in the nation among FBS schools. It is also the fifth longest streak through FBS history.
- The Hokies' special teams unit extended its nation-leading streak to 248 consecutive made extra points (kicking), dating back to Oct. 20, 2016, against Miami.
- Tech conceded a first guarter scoring play for the first time this season (UNC 3-yard touchdown, 4:37 1st).

NOTES ON THE DATE

• Virginia Tech football is now 8-8-1 all-time on Oct. 1.

PLAYER NOTES **QB GRANT WELLS**

- Career record moves to 16-12 as a starting quarterback.
- Ran for a 2-yard touchdown during the second guarter, marking his 11th career rushing touchdown (second of 2022).

Made three solo tackles.

 Set a season high with six tackles (four solo) and was credited with a guarterback hurry.

• Broke up a pass.

 Recorded two solo tackles and forced a fumble.

DB NASIR PEOPLES

 Broke up a pass and registered two solo tackles.

 Forced his first career fumble during the first guarter (retained by UNC out of bounds).
