### **KEY STORYLINES**

#### **SCOUTING LOUISVILLE**

• The Cardinals are ranked No. 2 in this week's AVCA poll, after sweeping Syracuse and Boston College on the road last weekend

• Louisville has battled seven ranked teams so far this season, with its only loss coming at the hands of then-No. 8 Ohio State (3-1) earlier this season

• Notable wins for the Cards include then-No. 9 Purdue (3-0), No. 13 Kentucky (3-2) and No. 11 Georgia Tech (3-1) • With 3.04 blocks per set, Louisville ranks first in the ACC and second nationally in blocks per set with 3.04. The Cardinals also lead the ACC in hitting percentage with .316 (second nationally)

Amaya Tillman leads the

conference with 1.42 blocks per set and is also fifth in hitting percentage with .345 • With 10.02 assists per set, Raquel Lazaro is third in the ACC and leads the Cardinals as the setter

• Claire Chaussee also helps out offensively with 201 kills and 3.72 kills per set

#### **SCOUTING NOTRE DAME**

• The Fighting Irish are 7-9 overall and 2-3 in ACC play. Most recently, the Irish took on Syracuse and Boston College, sweeping the Orange and defeating Boston College 3-1

• Three Notre Dame attackers have over 100 kills as Avery Ross (166), Lucy Trump (132) and Kaylyn Winkler (122) lead the Irish. Trump leads the team with 2.64 kills per set and Ross is hitting at a .218 this season, with a team-high 175.5 total points on the year • Phyona Schrader is the primary setter for Notre Dame, leading the team with 499 and 7.92 assists per set

• Defensively, Winkler and Lauren Tarnoff lead the charge at the net, with Winkler recording 55 blocks and Tarnoff adding 54. Charity McDowell also adds 41 and leads the team with 1.08 blocks per set

• Hattie Monson is the digs leader for the Irish, scooping up 275 digs so far. She has 4.37 digs per set and also leads the team with 21 service aces

• Schrader also adds 181 digs, with 2.87 digs per set

#### LAST TIME OUT

• The Hokies finished out their homestand 0-2 last weekend, falling to NC State 3-1 and North Carolina 3-1

• Against the Wolfpack, Cera Powell finished with 11 kills on the day to lead the Hokies' offense

• Defensively, Tech had two players reach double figures in digs as Maddie Slagle had 15 and Hanna Borer had 10.

• From the front row, Cara Lewis contributed six blocks and Anabel Zier added six rejections.

• Against the Tar Heels, Lewis finished with a .389 hitting percentage to lead the Hokies and Slagle added 17 digs.

• Hanna Borer recorded a double-double with 14 assists and 13 digs

### **OFFENSIVE SUCCESS**

• The Hokies had one of their best offensive performances against the Tigers to open ACC play, hitting .249, including a .387 clip in the first set with 14 kills.

• Sydney Petersen led the team to with 21 kills on 39 attempts, averaging 2.63 per set and an impressive .462 kill percentage in the two games.

• The Hokies followed that up with their best hitting percentage of the season against Boston College, hitting .353 over three sets, as Petersen recorded a .526 hitting percentage

### **ACC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK**

• Freshman setter Hanna Borer was named the ACC Freshman of the Week for the first time in her career following the Hokies win over Clemson

• This was Virginia Tech's first Freshman of the Week honor since Kaity Smith earned the award in 2017.

• The freshman recorded her fifth doubledouble of the season in the win over Clemson with 34 assists and 14 digs. She helped the Hokie attack hit at a .249 clip with 68 kills.

• Tech hit over .200 in every set except for one against the Tigers, with a match-high .387 in the first set. Borer also recorded an ace in the win.

• Against No. 13 Georgia Tech, Borer added 18 assists for the Hokies as well as six digs

• On the weekend, Borer totaled 52 assists, averaging 6.50 assists per set and helping the Hokies hit .210 over the weekend. She added 20 digs defensively, with 2.50 per set, as well as adding an ace to her weekend point total.

#### **TOUGH TRANSFERS**

• The 2022 roster for the Hokies features six transfers: Cara Lewis, Maddie Slagle, Reagan Goeke, Sydney Petersen, Jenna Appel and Ava

#### Francis

• Lewis, a transfer from Maryland, ranked first on the team, second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally with 1.54 blocks per set. Totaled 126 total blocks which also led the team

• Another Big Ten transfer, Slagle posted 760 digs in her career with Iowa, finishing with 1.959 digs per set, as well as 52 aces

• Goeke and Petersen will also join the Hokie block as transfers, with Goeke coming from Pepperdine and Petersen from Nevada. Francis comes to Blacksburg as an outside hitter, spending fall of 2021 at Arizona

• The Hokies add another setter in Jenna Appel from Loyola Chicago. As a sophomore, she finished with 605 assists and 26 aces. She also ranked 13th in the MVC with 5.00 assists per set

#### FRESH FACES

Along with the six transfers, the Hokies also add nine freshmen to the squad for this season
Three of those freshmen were early enrollees and played the 2021 spring season for the Hokies; Sierra Cates, Hanna Borer and Lauren Fowler

• The other six joined the Hokies this summer and look to make an immediate impact on the young squad

Marci Byers was named the sixth head coach of the Virginia Tech volleyball program in January, 2020. She enters her third season at the helm of the Hokies.

During her first season with Tech, the team tallied five conference wins including a sweep of Virginia and a win over then No. 14 Duke in five sets. The Hokies defeated Virginia in 2021 as well, taking down the Cavaliers in five sets. Tech also defeated Boston College and Wake Forest in ACC play during Byers' second season at the helm. Byers looks to build off the 2021 season with many key returners and 15 newcomers set to make an impact.

A four-time Big South Coach of the Year selection at Radford University, she is the winningest coach in Highlanders' history, leading the program to three Big South regular season titles, two Big South Tournament championships and two NCAA Tournament berths. She is one of only five head coaches in Big South history to register 200 or more career victories.

Throughout her tenure at Radford, the Chicago native consistently recruited top talent to the New River Valley from across the country, thanks to her strong relationships within the ACC footprint, as well as with elite club programs in the Midwest, Texas and California.

Byers' squads at Radford topped the 20-win mark five times over seven seasons and compiled an 81-34 (.708) overall record over four years. She led the Highlanders to a 22-7 record in 2018, including a 12-4 mark in Big South play. They reached the Big South Tournament title game for the second consecutive season and were selected to play in the National Invitational Volleyball Championship where they defeated App State in the first round. During her tenure at Radford, her student-athletes twice registered the top team GPA of any program at the school (2008 and 2013).

No stranger to defeating Power Five foes, under her direction in 2017 the Highlanders registered wins at Arizona, at South Carolina and at Virginia Tech en route to a Big South Tournament title and an NCAA Tournament berth. In 2016, Byers led Radford to a 24-6 record, including a perfect 11-0 mark at home and a Big South regular season championship. Her squads also registered wins against Wake Forest in 2016 and Washington State in 2015. Byers' 2014 squad finished with a 24-8 mark that included wins over California and Maryland as Radford claimed the Big South regular season title. The Highlanders earned their first NCAA Tournament appearance under Byers in 2013 after winning both the Big South regular season and tournament titles, finishing the season with a 25-10 record.

Prior to beginning her tenure at Radford in 2008, she spent two seasons at NCAA Division II Chowan University in Murfreesboro, N.C. After going 4-17 in her initial season in 2006, Byers guided the Hawks to a 26-11 record as the squad averaged the most aces per game of any Division II squad. Prior to joining the collegiate ranks, she posted a 121-49 record in 10 seasons coaching in the Richmond prep ranks, spending two seasons at Mills Godwin High School and eight years at Hermitage High School.

Byers has also been a successful coach at the club level. Her 2003-04 team qualified for the Junior Olympics in Houston, while her 2004-05 team reached the Junior Olympics in Salt Lake City. She was also invited to participate in the USA Volleyball Coaches Clinic at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs.

She is a 1995 graduate of Virginia Union University where she graduated with honors with a bachelor's degree in secondary education with a concentration in mathematics. A four-year starter on the volleyball team, she captained the team as both a junior and senior. Her husband, J.D., serves as an assistant men's basketball coach at VCU. The couple are parents of a daughter, Kamryn Grey.

### NOTEWORTHY

#### **ACC POWER**

• Three Atlantic Coast Conference teams were ranked in the preseason American Volleyball Coaches Association Top 25 Poll and all three were in the top 10 to enter the season

• Reigning ACC Champion Louisville is No. 2 in this week's poll, followed by No. 8 Pittsburgh and No. 11 Georgia Tech. Both the Cardinals and Panthers advanced to last season's NCAA Championship semifinals and each finished with more than 30 wins.

• Georgia Tech's No. 5 ranking in week 2 was the highest preseason ranking in program history. Miami, North Carolina and Florida State also received votes in the preseason poll.

### **MILESTONE WATCH**

• Junior Brie Postema recorded six assists against NC State to reach 1,000 career assists as a junior

• In 2021, she posted 538 assists, playing in 26 matches. As a rookie, Postema had 310 assists. Her current career-high sits at 47 which she achieved in the five-set win against Virginia on Oct. 29, 2021.

• Maddie Slagle is also closing in on 1,000 digs, sitting at 993 over her five-year career. After spending four years at Iowa, Slagle leads the team with 233 digs as a Hokie

• Logan Mosley reached her 1,000th career dig a season ago and is now poised to move up on the all-time career digs leaderboard

• Mosley has 1,218 career digs, which is 16 away from tying for 10th all-time in school history with Justine Record (2008-11)

#### **MIDWAY POINT**

• The Hokies are halfway through the season and are currently 9-8 overall and 2-4 in ACC play.

• The current kills leader is Cera Powell with a total of 161 and an average of 2.73 per set. Maddie Slagle leads the Hokies with a total of 233 and an average of 3.76 per set.

• Hanna Borer leads the Hokies in assists with a total of 369 and leads in service aces with a total of 17.

#### **DEFENSE WINS MATCHES**

Anabel Zier has been solid on defense this season, ranking 8th in the ACC with 1.12 blocks/ set and a total of 67 on the season.
She is tied with Chiamaka Nwokolo of Pitt and is only .01 from the 6th place spot

• Zier has had help as Cara Lewis trails Zier by only 8 blocks with a .97 blocks per set.

Maddie Slagle has also helped out the

defense, ranking 6th in the ACC with 233 digs with 3.76/set.

• She has led the team in digs this season, producing about 28% of the team's total.

### **ON THE ROAD**

• The Hokies opened the ACC schedule on the road but have been at home since opening weekend

• Tech split the weekend on the road, defeating Clemson 3-2 and falling to #13 Georgia Tech 3-0

• The win over Clemson was the first in the Marci Byers' era and the first over the Tigers since 2019

### **C. POWELL**

• Cera Powell was one of the most consistent Hokies in the lineup a season ago, playing in 26 matches

• She totaled 223 total points, with 203 kills and 2.56 points per set. She also averaged 2.33 kills per set

• She currently leads the team with 161 kills and 2.73 kills per set

• Powell is averaging 3.06 points per set, which is more than a half point than the next highest player on the team
