KEY STORYLINES

SCOUTING FLORIDA STATE

- Sitting at 12-7 so far this year, the Seminoles are 4-4 in ACC play after falling to No. 8 Pitt and Virginia on the road this past weekend
- FSU lost to Virginia 3-2 in a tight match on Friday and was swept by Pitt on Sunday
- Audrey Koenig and Emma Clothier led the Noles with eight kills apiece against Pitt, while Alejandra Perez led the way defensively with nine digs
- The Noles rank third in the ACC with a .258 hitting percentage and 890 kills. They also rank third in opponent hitting percentage, holding opposing teams to just a .172 hitting percentage
- Koenig ranks 10th in the conference with .33 service aces per set and setter

Andjelija Draskovic is averaging 6.42 assist per set to rank 10th in the ACC

• The Noles have three players with over 100 digs on the season with Emery Dupes (176), Koenig (145) and Draskovic (141) leading the way. FSU is also out-digging opponents 943 to 909

SCOUTING MIAMI

- The Hurricanes are 11-8 on the season and 4-4 in ACC play, coming off a 1-1 weekend on the road
- Miami fell to No. 8 Pitt on Friday 3-0 but followed up with a 3-1 win over Virginia to close out the weekend
- Against the Cavaliers, the Hurricanes recorded 13 team blocks and 13 aces, good for seventh-most in program

history

- Angela Grieve finished with a match-high 20 kills and hit .381. Peyman Yardimci had a career-high five aces and setter Savannah Vach had a match-high 47 assists
- On the attacking end, Miami is leading opponents with 939 kills, compared to 890 put up by opponents. The Canes are also hitting .243 vs .211 from opposing teams
- Miami also excels from the service line, recording 105 aces so far this season and allowing only 74 from opponents
- Vach leads the ACC in assists per set and total assists, recording 753 total assists with 10.32 per set
- Grieve is also ranked in the ACC with the sixth-most kills per set (3.75). She has 255 total kills

LAST TIME OUT

- The Hokies fell on the road last weekend to No. 2 Louisville and Notre Dame by a score of
- Cera Powell finished with 12 kills on the day to lead the Hokies offense against the Cardinals. Maddie Slagle had a team-high 12 digs and Hanna Borer added 27 assists
- Jordan Hallman made her first career start and recorded a team-high four aces for the Hokies
- Against the Irish, Ava Francis led the way offensively with 10 kills. Cara Lewis contributed nine blocks and Sydney Petersen added six to help the Hokies record a season-high 14 blocks
- Hanna Borer had a double-double with 30 assists and 10 digs

OFFENSIVE SUCCESS

- The Hokies had one of their best offensive performances against the Tigers to open ACC play, hitting .249, including a .387 clip in the first set with 14 kills.
- Sydney Petersen led the team to with 21 kills on 39 attempts, averaging 2.63 per set and an impressive .462 kill percentage in the two
- The Hokies followed that up with their best hitting percentage of the season against Boston College, hitting .353 over three sets, as Petersen recorded a .526 hitting percentage

ACC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

- Freshman setter Hanna Borer was named the ACC Freshman of the Week for the first time in her career following the Hokies win over Clemson
- This was Virginia Tech's first Freshman of the Week honor since Kaity Smith earned the award in 2017.
- The freshman recorded her fifth double-double of the season in the win over Clemson with 34 assists and 14 digs. She helped the Hokie attack hit at a .249 clip with 68 kills.
- Tech hit over .200 in every set except for one against the Tigers, with a match-high .387 in the first set. Borer also recorded an ace in the win
- Against No. 13 Georgia Tech, Borer added 18 assists for the Hokies as well as six digs
- On the weekend, Borer totaled 52 assists, averaging 6.50 assists per set and helping the Hokies hit .210 over the weekend. She added 20 digs defensively, with 2.50 per set, as well as adding an ace to her weekend point total.

TOUGH TRANSFERS

 The 2022 roster for the Hokies features six transfers: Cara Lewis, Maddie Slagle, Reagan Goeke, Sydney Petersen, Jenna Appel and Ava Francis

- Lewis, a transfer from Maryland, ranked first on the team, second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally with 1.54 blocks per set. Totaled 126 total blocks which also led the team
- Another Big Ten transfer, Slagle posted 760 digs in her career with lowa, finishing with 1.959 digs per set, as well as 52 aces
- Goeke and Petersen will also join the Hokie block as transfers, with Goeke coming from Pepperdine and Petersen from Nevada. Francis comes to Blacksburg as an outside hitter, spending fall of 2021 at Arizona
- The Hokies add another setter in Jenna Appel from Loyola Chicago. As a sophomore, she finished with 605 assists and 26 aces. She also ranked 13th in the MVC with 5.00 assists per set

FRESH FACES

- Along with the six transfers, the Hokies also add nine freshmen to the squad for this season
- Three of those freshmen were early enrollees and played the 2021 spring season for the Hokies; Sierra Cates, Hanna Borer and Lauren Fowler
- The other six joined the Hokies this summer and look to make an immediate impact on the young squad

NEWCOMER FAST FACTS

- #0 Hanna Borer Broke her high school record for assists in a single season with 798, also reached 1,000 career assists
- #1 Lauren Fowler Helped her high school team to three State Championships and was named the 2020 Region Player of the Year, State Player of the Year and All-State honoree
- #6 Cara Lewis Helped Maryland become Big Ten's best blocking team for the second straight season, ranking first on the team, second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally with 1.54 blocks per set
- #8 Josie Bloom Named to the AVCA Phenom List in 2020 and 2021. Also named the No. 1 ranked L/DS in the state of Michigan by PrepDig
- #9 Sierra Cates Helped her high school team reach the second round of the State Championship Tournament and was named to the County All-Star Team
- #10 Maddie Slagle Finished her career at lowa with 760 digs and 1.96 digs per set. As a junior, ranked second on the team with 128 digs and tallied seven or more digs 10 times
- #11 Amaya Roberson Named to the USA Volleyball Junior National Championships All-Tournament Team and helped her club team to a third-place finish at AAU Nationals
- #16 Sarah Malinowski Posted an attack percentage of .370 or above in five different matches, with a high of .680 in high school. Also named to the JVA Watchlist (2019-2021)
- #17 Aerin Bowman Made the All-Tournament Team at USAV Nationals and the 2021 AAU All-tournament Team in 2021
- #18 Lucky-Rose Williams Earned First Team All-Conference and All-State honors, while helping her team to a Top-5 ranking in the

state of Hawaii

- #19 Reagan Goeke In a season at Pepperdine, finished the year with 19 kills, .54 kills per set and 31 points. Posted 20 blocks with only two errors
- #20 Sydney Petersen As a junior at Nevada, placed first on the team in blocks (98), second in kills (223). As a freshman, set a new single season program record with 137 block assists
- #23 Jenna Appel Played two seasons at Loyola Chicago and ranked 13th in the MVC as a sophomore with 5.00 assists per set. She also had eight double-doubles with 605 total assists
- #24 Ava Francis Named to the PrepVolleyball Phenom List and ranked the No. 2 recruit in the state of Ohio. Also named an AVCA All-Region Team member, All-American Honorable Mention and an Under Armour All-American
- #26 Jordan Hallman AVCA Second Team All-American and National All-Region Team in 2021. Ranked second in the state of Tennessee with a .428 hitting percentage and ranked 22nd nationally with 313 kills in high school

Marci Byers was named the sixth head coach of the Virginia Tech volleyball program in January, 2020. She enters her third season at the helm of the Hokies.

During her first season with Tech, the team tallied five conference wins including a sweep of Virginia and a win over then No. 14 Duke in five sets. The Hokies defeated Virginia in 2021 as well, taking down the Cavaliers in five sets. Tech also defeated Boston College and Wake Forest in ACC play during Byers' second season at the helm. Byers looks to build off the 2021 season with many key returners and 15 newcomers set to make an impact.

A four-time Big South Coach of the Year selection at Radford University, she is the winningest coach in Highlanders' history, leading the program to three Big South regular season titles, two Big South Tournament championships and two NCAA Tournament berths. She is one of only five head coaches in Big South history to register 200 or more career victories.

Throughout her tenure at Radford, the Chicago native consistently recruited top talent to the New River Valley from across the country, thanks to her strong relationships within the ACC footprint, as well as with elite club programs in the Midwest, Texas and California.

Byers' squads at Radford topped the 20-win mark five times over seven seasons and compiled an 81-34 (.708) overall record over four years. She led the Highlanders to a 22-7 record in 2018, including a 12-4 mark in Big South play. They reached the Big South Tournament title game for the second consecutive season and were selected to play in the National Invitational Volleyball Championship where they defeated App State in the first round. During her tenure at Radford, her student-athletes twice registered the top team GPA of any program at the school (2008 and 2013).

No stranger to defeating Power Five foes, under her direction in 2017 the Highlanders registered wins at Arizona, at South Carolina and at Virginia Tech en route to a Big South Tournament title and an NCAA Tournament berth. In 2016, Byers led Radford to a 24-6 record, including a perfect 11-0 mark at home and a Big South regular season championship. Her squads also registered wins against Wake Forest in 2016 and Washington State in 2015. Byers' 2014 squad finished with a 24-8

mark that included wins over California and Maryland as Radford claimed the Big South regular season title. The Highlanders earned their first NCAA Tournament appearance under Byers in 2013 after winning both the Big South regular season and tournament titles, finishing the season with a 25-10 record.

Prior to beginning her tenure at Radford in 2008, she spent two seasons at NCAA Division II Chowan University in Murfreesboro, N.C. After going 4-17 in her initial season in 2006, Byers guided the Hawks to a 26-11 record as the squad averaged the most aces per game of any Division II squad. Prior to joining the collegiate ranks, she posted a 121-49 record in 10 seasons coaching in the Richmond prep ranks, spending two seasons at Mills Godwin High School and eight years at Hermitage High School.

Byers has also been a successful coach at the club level. Her 2003-04 team qualified for the Junior Olympics in Houston, while her 2004-05 team reached the Junior Olympics in Salt Lake City. She was also invited to participate in the USA Volleyball Coaches Clinic at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs.

She is a 1995 graduate of Virginia Union University where she graduated with honors with a bachelor's degree in secondary education with a concentration in mathematics. A four-year starter on the volleyball team, she captained the team as both a junior and senior. Her husband, J.D., serves as an assistant men's basketball coach at VCU. The couple are parents of a daughter, Kamryn Grey.

NOTEWORTHY

ACC POWER

- Three Atlantic Coast Conference teams were ranked in the preseason American Volleyball Coaches Association Top 25 Poll and all three were in the top 10 to enter the season
- Reigning ACC Champion Louisville is No. 2 in this week's poll, followed by No. 8 Pittsburgh and No. 10 Georgia Tech. Both the Cardinals and Panthers advanced to last season's NCAA Championship semifinals and each finished with more than 30 wins.
- Georgia Tech's No. 5 ranking in week 2 was the highest preseason ranking in program history. Miami, North Carolina and Florida State also received votes in the preseason poll.

MILESTONE WATCH

- Junior Brie Postema recorded six assists against NC State to reach 1,000 career assists as a junior
- In 2021, she posted 538 assists, playing in 26 matches. As a rookie, Postema had 310 assists. Her current career-high sits at 47 which she achieved in the five-set win against Virginia on Oct. 29, 2021.
- Maddie Slagle recorded her 1,000th career dig against Louisville on Friday, registering 12 total to lead the Hokies. She has a team-high 259 digs as a grad student, after spending four years at Iowa
- Logan Mosley reached her 1,000th career dig a season ago and is now poised to move up on the all-time career digs leaderboard
- Mosley has 1,234 career digs, which is 2 away from tying for 10th all-time in school history with Justine Record (2008-11)

SENIOR SALUTE

- The Hokies have four graduating athletes this season, who all have been making an impact
- As the libero, grad student Maddie Slagle leads the team in digs with 259, averaging 3.70 per set. She adds 15 aces
- Senior Anabel Zier is tied for second on the team in aces with Slagle and is also tied for the team lead in blocks with 71. She is averaging 1.13 per set
- Senior Logan Mosley also helps out on the defensive end, recording 128 digs so far this season to rank third on the team. She has 1.83 digs per set
- Leading the offense is senior Cera Powell with 176 kills and 2.67 kills per set. She is averaging 2.99 points per set and adds 127

digs as a six rotation player

HALLMAN ACC DEBUT

- Freshman Jordan Hallman made her first start of the season on Friday against Louisville. She had played in just one set prior to Friday's match
- Against the Cardinals, Hallman posted 9.5 points, which ranked third on the team. She also had three aces which led the Hokies.
- Along with the service aces, the freshman had four kills with a .429 hitting percentage and four block assists
- She followed that up with another start against Notre Dame on Sunday, adding a kill and a block assist in the match

ACC RANKINGS

- Anabel Zier ranks in the top 10 in two categories in the ACC. She is fifth in hitting percentage with a .365 and 10th in blocks per set with a 1.13. She leads the Hokies in both of those categories as well
- Cara Lewis also ranks in the top 20 for blocks per set, ranking 12th in the conference with 1.03 per set
- Maddie Slagle is averaging 3.70 digs per set to rank seventh in the ACC. Her 259 digs rank her sixth overall in the conference

HOKIE BLOCK PARTY

- A season ago, Virginia Tech ranked fifth nationally in total blocks midway through the season
- Tech ended the year with 259.5 blocks per season vs 205.5 posted by opponents throughout the season
- With 2.30 blocks per set, the Hokies also led opponents compared to 1.82 by opponents
