SCOUTING WAKE FOREST

• So far this season, the Demon Deacons are 13-10 overall and 5-7 in ACC play. Wake Forest is coming off a weekend with a 3-0 loss to Pitt and a 3-0 sweep over Virginia Against Virginia, the Demon Deacons hit .358, the secondbest hitting percentage this season. Ashley Slater led the way with 10 kills

 Wake Forest also had 11 service aces, as Andrea Fuentes had a career-high five aces. She also added 15 assists • Paige Crawford leads the team with 230 kills, averaging 3.24 kills per set. She also leads the team with 3.73 points per set

• Defensively, Emmy Ogogor has 80 blocks on the year with .98 blocks per set. Olivia Franke isn't far behind with 78 blocks and .95 blocks per set • Emma Farrell has played in every set for Wake, recording 373 digs and 4.49 digs per set. She also has a reception percentage of .946. Farrell leads the ACC with 373 digs and 4.49 digs per set • As the setter, Rian Baker has 467 assists and 6.67 per set. Fuentes also adds 391 assists and 5.84 per set

SCOUTING DUKE

• Duke also has an overall record of 13-10 and an ACC record of 4-8. The Blue Devils split the most recent weekend, falling to Louisville 3-0 and defeating Notre Dame 3-2

• The Blue Devils recorded a reverse sweep against the Irish, falling in the first two sets but rallying to come from behind and take the final three sets

 Gracie Johnson recorded her 1,000th career kill in the win and also led Duke with 20 kills and 15 digs. She also added three aces and two blocks. Rachel Richardson tallied her fifth straight double-double with 15 kills and two digs. Rylie Kadel led the team with eight blocks

 Johnson leads the team with 397 points and 5.03 points per set. She adds 329 kills and 4.16 kills per set. She also leads the team with 50 aces on the year • Devon Chang ranks fourth in the ACC with 10.08 assists per set and 867 total. Defensively, Rylie Kadel is averaging 1.18 blocks per set with 103 total to rank 6th in the conference

LAST TIME OUT

• The Hokies battled at home last Friday, falling to Virginia 3-2. The Hokies offense was paced by Cera Powell, who finished with 16 kills on the day.

Zier added 14 and Cara Lewis chipped in with 10 as part of balanced Virginia Tech attack.
Defensively, Tech had three players reach double figures in digs, including Logan Mosley's 14, 12 from Hanna Borer, and 10 more from Maddie Slagle.

• The Hokies fell to #7 Pitt on Sunday, 3-0. Ava Francis finished with six kills on the day to lead the Hokies offense. Defensively, Maddie Slagle and Sierra Cates finished in double figures in digs, as Slagle added 11 and Cates added 10.

OFFENSIVE SUCCESS

• The Hokies had one of their best offensive performances against the Tigers to open ACC play, hitting .249, including a .387 clip in the first set with 14 kills.

• Sydney Petersen led the team to with 21 kills on 39 attempts, averaging 2.63 per set and an impressive .462 kill percentage in the two games.

• The Hokies followed that up with their best hitting percentage of the season against Boston College, hitting .353 over three sets, as Petersen recorded a .526 hitting percentage

ACC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

• Freshman setter Hanna Borer was named the ACC Freshman of the Week for the first time in her career following the Hokies win over Clemson

• This was Virginia Tech's first Freshman of the Week honor since Kaity Smith earned the award in 2017.

• The freshman recorded her fifth doubledouble of the season in the win over Clemson with 34 assists and 14 digs. She helped the Hokie attack hit at a .249 clip with 68 kills.

• Tech hit over .200 in every set except for one against the Tigers, with a match-high .387 in the first set. Borer also recorded an ace in the win.

Against No. 13 Georgia Tech, Borer added 18 assists for the Hokies as well as six digs
On the weekend, Borer totaled 52 assists, averaging 6.50 assists per set and helping the Hokies hit .210 over the weekend. She added 20 digs defensively, with 2.50 per set, as well as adding an ace to her weekend point total.

• The 2022 roster for the Hokies features six transfers: Cara Lewis, Maddie Slagle, Reagan Goeke, Sydney Petersen, Jenna Appel and Ava Francis

· Lewis, a transfer from Maryland, ranked first

on the team, second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally with 1.54 blocks per set. Totaled 126 total blocks which also led the team • Another Big Ten transfer, Slagle posted 760 digs in her career with lowa, finishing with 1.959 digs per set, as well as 52 aces • Goeke and Petersen will also join the Hokie block as transfers, with Goeke coming from Pepperdine and Petersen from Nevada. Francis comes to Blacksburg as an outside hitter, spending fall of 2021 at Arizona • The Hokies add another setter in Jenna

Appel from Loyola Chicago. As a sophomore, she finished with 605 assists and 26 aces. She also ranked 13th in the MVC with 5.00 assists per set

FRESH FACES

Along with the six transfers, the Hokies also add nine freshmen to the squad for this season
Three of those freshmen were early enrollees and played the 2021 spring season for the Hokies; Sierra Cates, Hanna Borer and Lauren Fowler

• The other six joined the Hokies this summer and look to make an immediate impact on the young squad

Marci Byers was named the sixth head coach of the Virginia Tech volleyball program in January, 2020. She enters her third season at the helm of the Hokies.

During her first season with Tech, the team tallied five conference wins including a sweep of Virginia and a win over then No. 14 Duke in five sets. The Hokies defeated Virginia in 2021 as well, taking down the Cavaliers in five sets. Tech also defeated Boston College and Wake Forest in ACC play during Byers' second season at the helm. Byers looks to build off the 2021 season with many key returners and 15 newcomers set to make an impact.

A four-time Big South Coach of the Year selection at Radford University, she is the winningest coach in Highlanders' history, leading the program to three Big South regular season titles, two Big South Tournament championships and two NCAA Tournament berths. She is one of only five head coaches in Big South history to register 200 or more career victories.

Throughout her tenure at Radford, the Chicago native consistently recruited top talent to the New River Valley from across the country, thanks to her strong relationships within the ACC footprint, as well as with elite club programs in the Midwest, Texas and California.

Byers' squads at Radford topped the 20-win mark five times over seven seasons and compiled an 81-34 (.708) overall record over four years. She led the Highlanders to a 22-7 record in 2018, including a 12-4 mark in Big South play. They reached the Big South Tournament title game for the second consecutive season and were selected to play in the National Invitational Volleyball Championship where they defeated App State in the first round. During her tenure at Radford, her student-athletes twice registered the top team GPA of any program at the school (2008 and 2013).

No stranger to defeating Power Five foes, under her direction in 2017 the Highlanders registered wins at Arizona, at South Carolina and at Virginia Tech en route to a Big South Tournament title and an NCAA Tournament berth. In 2016, Byers led Radford to a 24-6 record, including a perfect 11-0 mark at home and a Big South regular season championship. Her squads also registered wins against Wake Forest in 2016 and Washington State in 2015. Byers' 2014 squad finished with a 24-8 mark that included wins over California and Maryland as Radford claimed the Big South regular season title. The Highlanders earned their first NCAA Tournament appearance under Byers in 2013 after winning both the Big South regular season and tournament titles, finishing the season with a 25-10 record.

Prior to beginning her tenure at Radford in 2008, she spent two seasons at NCAA Division II Chowan University in Murfreesboro, N.C. After going 4-17 in her initial season in 2006, Byers guided the Hawks to a 26-11 record as the squad averaged the most aces per game of any Division II squad. Prior to joining the collegiate ranks, she posted a 121-49 record in 10 seasons coaching in the Richmond prep ranks, spending two seasons at Mills Godwin High School and eight years at Hermitage High School.

Byers has also been a successful coach at the club level. Her 2003-04 team qualified for the Junior Olympics in Houston, while her 2004-05 team reached the Junior Olympics in Salt Lake City. She was also invited to participate in the USA Volleyball Coaches Clinic at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs.

She is a 1995 graduate of Virginia Union University where she graduated with honors with a bachelor's degree in secondary education with a concentration in mathematics. A four-year starter on the volleyball team, she captained the team as both a junior and senior. Her husband, J.D., serves as an assistant men's basketball coach at VCU. The couple are parents of a daughter, Kamryn Grey.

ACC POWER

• Three Atlantic Coast Conference teams were ranked in the preseason American Volleyball Coaches Association Top 25 Poll and all three were in the top 10 to enter the season • Reigning ACC Champion Louisville is No. 5 in this week's poll, followed by No. 7 Pittsburgh and No. 10 Georgia Tech. Both the Cardinals and Panthers advanced to last season's NCAA Championship semifinals and each finished with more than 30 wins.

• Georgia Tech's No. 5 ranking in week 2 was the highest preseason ranking in program history. Miami, North Carolina and Florida State also received votes in the preseason poll.

MILESTONES ACHIEVED

• Junior Brie Postema recorded six assists against NC State to reach 1,000 career assists as a junior

• In 2021, she posted 538 assists, playing in 26 matches. As a rookie, Postema had 310 assists. Her current career-high sits at 47 which she achieved in the five-set win against Virginia on Oct. 29, 2021.

• Maddie Slagle recorded her 1,000th career dig against Louisville on Friday, registering 12 total to lead the Hokies. She has a team-high 259 digs as a grad student, after spending four years at lowa

• Logan Mosley moved into the top-10 in school history in career digs.

• She now sits 8th in school history with 1,263. Mosley is chasing down 7th place in school history, as Lindsey Owens (2013-16) holds the 7th spot with 1,309

The Hokies have four graduating athletes this season, who all have been making an impact
As the libero, grad student Maddie Slagle leads the team in digs with 299, averaging 3.56 per set. She adds 17 aces

• Senior Anabel Zier is tsecond on the team in aces with 16 and is also second on the team in blocks with 77. She is averaging 1.01 per set which is a team-high

• Senior Logan Mosley also helps out on the defensive end, recording 155 digs so far this season to rank third on the team. She has 1.85 digs per set

• Leading the offense is senior Cera Powell with 202 kills and 2.62 kills per set. She is averaging

2.93 points per set and adds 141 digs as a six rotation player

HALLMAN ACC DEBUT
