MOUNTAIN HAWKS TRAVEL TO BLACKSBURG TO TAKE ON VIRGINIA TECH

The Lehigh men's basketball squad faces off with another ACC opponent on Thursday, as the Mountain Hawks take on Virginia Tech at Cassell Coliseum. Lehigh dropped its season opener to Syracuse, 90-72, inside the JMA Wireless Dome Monday night.

There were 10 different Mountain Hawks to make a basket in the JMA Wireless Dome, and they were paced by the offensive efforts of Evan Taylor, who ended the night playing 33 minutes and scoring 20 points to go with his four 3-pointers, three rebounds, two steals and two blocked shots. This is the eighth time in Taylor's career that he has scored 20 or more points in a game.

Keith Higgins Jr. registered nine points with a team-leading three assists, two rebounds and a steal while Jakob Alamudun tallied eight points on three made baskets and a clean 2-for-2 from the free-throw line. He also contributed two rebounds and an asist. Dominic Parolin finished the night with seven points, going 3-for-4 from the charity stripe and 2-for-4 from the floor. The leading rebounder for the Brown and White was J.T. Tan, who grabbed eight boards and was a co-leader in assists with three to go with his six points.

The Mountain Hawks concluded the night shooting 42.9 percent, with a clip of 51.6 percent in the second half while the Orange shot 54.5 percent from the field. Syracuse shot 50 percent (6-12) from beyond the three-point line and 77.4 percent (24-31) at the foul line while Lehigh was 38.1 (8-21) from long distance and 76.9 percent from the free-throw line.

Thursday night's game will mark just the second meeting between Lehigh and Virginia Tech. The Hokies claimed the first meeting in November 2019. Last year, Virginia Tech won the ACC Tournament title and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.



ALL-TIME VS. VIRGINIA TECH

The Hokies won the lone previous meeting with Lehigh, 79-53 in Blacksburg on Nov. 16, 2019.

SCOUTING THE HOKIES

Virginia Tech opened its season with a 95-57 home win over Delaware State Monday night. Grant Basile notched an impressive double-double for the Hokies with 30 points and 10 rebounds. Sean Pedulla, Darius Maddox and Lynn Kidd made their first career starts. The Hokies' 95 points were the most by Tech in a season opener since 2017 (111). Virginia Tech had a plus-18 rebounding margin, which is the largest margin since Dec. 3, 2020 against VMI (18). The Hokies reached 50% from deep – a threshold that Tech met five times last season.

Basile hit six threes and Pedulla knocked down five more. The last time the Hokies had two players make more than five 3-point attempts in one game was on Jan. 29 at Florida State. Basile and Lynn Kidd led Virginia Tech with a gamehigh 10 rebounds apiece. The Hokies finished with 11 offensive rebounds on the night, converting those into 16 second-chance points.

HOKIES LAST TIME OUT ...

BLACKSBURG - An impressive offensive performance - highlighted by 30 points from Grant Basile - powered Virginia Tech to a 95-57 win over Delaware State on Monday night inside Cassell Coliseum.

The Hokies had three players score in double figures, including Basile, who put together a double-double with 30 points and 10 rebounds. Sean Pedulla added 18 points and eight assists and Darius Maddox chipped in as well with 14 points. Basile's 30 points were the most in a Tech debut since Landers Nolley II dialed up 30 at Clemson in Mike Young's first game at the helm of the Hokies.

The Virginia Tech offense was impressive from downtown, pouring in 14 threes on 28 attempts. Basile hit six treys for the Hokies in the contest.

Virginia Tech's defense held Delaware State to only 38.7% shooting from the field, including 25% from beyond the arc. The Hornets didn't have much luck cleaning up their misses on the offensive glass either, as they finished with seven offensive rebounds and managed 15 second-chance points while Virginia Tech cleared 31 defensive rebounds.

IF LEHIGH BEATS VIRGINIA TECH...

 \cdot Lehigh would win its first game over the Hokies in program history in just the second meeting between the two programs

• Lehigh would beat a power-conference opponent for the first time since winning at Mississippi State on Nov. 25, 2016 - an 87-73 Mountain Hawks' victory.

• Head coach Brett Reed would pick up his second-career victory over the ACC, his first since downing Duke in the 2012 NCAA Tournament. He owns wins over DePaul and Rutgers of the Big East (the Scarlet Knights were in the Big East in 2008), Duke of the ACC, Arizona State of the Pac-12 and Mississippi State of the SEC.

TAYLOR AND FENTON NAMED CO-CAPTAINS

Prior to the season-opener head coach Brett Reed announced that seniors Reed Fenton (Latrobe, Pa.) and Evan Taylor (Glen Ellyn, Ill.) will serve as captains for the 2022-23 season.

"I am pleased to announce that Reed and Evan have established themselves as captains for the upcoming season," commented Reed. "Both of them exemplify what it takes to be leaders for our team and have been effective mentors and uphold the standards of our program. I have a great deal of confidence that they will fill this important roll effectively."

Taylor was recognized as a Preseason All-Patriot League Team, coming off a season where he earned third team all-league honors. The Mountain Hawks' leading returning scorer averaged 13.0 points per contest last season and tied for 13th in the Patriot League. He also averaged team-highs of 5.8 rebounds per game and 1.0 block per contest. Taylor shot 47.2 percent from the field and averaged 1.3

LAST MEETING NOTABLES

- Senior Jordan Cohen and sophomore Jeameril Wilson both scored 11 points to lead the offense. Among Wilson's scoring was a thunderous, highlight-reel dunk less than two minutes into the second half.

- Freshman Reed Fenton and junior Marques Wilson both scored six points, combining to hit 3-of-7 3-pointers.

 Léhigh got off to a fast start taking several early leads, due in large part to early 3-pointers from freshmen Evan Taylor and Fenton. Trailing 9-8, the Mountain Hawks staged a 7-0 run, capped off by an Ed Porter basket, to take a 15-9 lead with 12:58 on the first-half clock.

- With Lehigh leading 18-13, the Hokies scored 10 straight points to go up 23-18, but the Mountain Hawks fought back and pulled even at 23 and later 25. Virginia Tech answered with a 7-0 surge, but two Cohen free throws with 1:39 on the clock rounded out the first-half scoring and helped keep the Mountain Hawks within striking distance (37-32) at the half.

 Wilson's highlight dunk helped spark the Mountain Hawks early in the second half, but Virginia Tech came out of the locker room strong, eventually opening a double-digit lead. Lehigh was still within 12 with 12:15 remaining, but the Hokies used a 10-0 run to open a 22-point advantage. The Mountain Hawks could never get back in it, falling by the 79-53 final.

 For the game, the Mountain Hawks shot 39.6 percent from the field (21-of-53) and 31.8 percent from 3-point range (7-of-22). The Hokies finished at 47.7 percent (31-of-65) and 37.8 percent from long range (14-of-37). Virginia Tech held a 36-28 edge in rebounds. Lehigh turned the ball over 19 times compared to just 10 for the Hokies.

- Landers Nolley II scored 27 points and connected on seven 3-pointers to pace Virginia Tech.

LAST MEETING

BLACKSBURG, Va. (11/16/19) - The Lehigh men's basketball team led by as much as six in the first half Saturday and trailed by just five after 20 minutes of play, but Virginia Tech outscored the Mountain Hawks 42-21 in the second half for the 79-53 victory at Cassell Coliseum. Lehigh shot 48.0 percent from the field in the first half (and 41.7 percent from 3-point range), but tides turned in the second as Lehigh couldn't pull off the upset against a Hokies' program coming off a Sweet 16 appearance. In the end, 19 Mountain Hawk turnovers also proved costly.

LEHIGH LAST TIME OUT

SYRACUSE, N.Y. (11/7/22) - After possessing a five-point advantage early in the first half, the Lehigh men's basketball team suffered a 90-72 loss to Syracuse in the season opener for both teams inside the JMA Wireless Dome on Monday evening. Senior Evan Taylorled the way for Lehigh with 20 points, including four 3-pointers. Taylor added three rebounds, two steals and two blocked shots. This is the eighth time in Taylor's career that he has scored 20 or more points in a game. Lehigh played Syracuse evenly early, but an Orange run late in the first half put them up 44-26 at the break. assists per contest. Taylor was also named to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court and Academic All-Patriot League Team.

Fenton, a former Patriot League All-Rookie Team honoree, played in 29 of 32 contests and made seven starts a season ago. He contributed 4.0 points per game and shot 36 percent from the floor. Fentor contributed 35 assists, 17 steals, knocked down 17 three-pointers and shot 75 percent from the free throw line.

COACH REED PUTTING UP THE W'S

Head coach Brett Reed reached 100-career Patriot League (regular season) wins three seasons ago, becoming just the fourth coach in league history to reach that plateau. Below is the list. Reed tied Jeff Jones of American coach for fastest to reach 100 PL wins in terms of number of seasons (11th season for both Reed and Jones). However, for both Flannery and Jones, it took fewer games to reach 100.

Here is where Reed stands among Patriot League laurels for total wins and Patriot League victories. Reed's 200th win came during a 78-72 home-opening win over Marist on Nov. 13, 2018. He tied Jones for third place with a home win over Saint Francis (Pa.) (Dec. 22) and overtook Jones with an 86-83 victory over Lafayette (Jan. 2) in Stabler Arena. With the thrilling overtime win at Lafayette on Jan. 30, 2019, Reed moved past Jones all alone into third place for Patriot League victories. *Most Patriot League Games Won (Regular Season)*

TURNER PRESEASON ALL-LEAGUE

Following a season which saw him earn third team All-Patriot League honors, Taylor was one of five players from around the league recognized. The Mountain Hawks' leading returning scorer averaged 13.0 points per contest last season - good for tops on the Mountain Hawks and tied for13th in the Patriot League. On top of Taylor's third team All-League honors, he was also named to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court and Academic All-Patriot League Team.

JENNINGS NAMED DIRECTOR OF OPS

Lehigh head men's basketball coach Brett Reed announced the addition of Zay Jennings to staff as Director of Basketball Operations. A native of Allentown and graduate of Allentown Central Catholic, Jennings was a four-year starter at Le Moyne where he was a regular in the lineup as a junior and senior.

REMEMBERING LEHIGH'S WIN OVER DUKE A DECADE LATER

- The 75-70 win on March 16, 2012 will always be a historic moment for not only the program and Lehigh Athletics department, but also the university. It brought together people, past and present, near and far, and was a display of the power of sports.

- A competitive regular season saw the Mountain Hawks earn the No. 2 seed in the Patriot League Tournament and win at top-seeded Bucknell in the championship game – Lehigh's second victory at Bucknell in less than a month. It came against a very strong Bison team that, like Lehigh, featured a future NBA player in Mike Muscala.

- On Selection Sunday, there was not only excitement, but also genuine confidence amongst the players when they heard that Duke was the opponent. There was a ton of respect for the Duke program and that year's team, which was 27-6 and 13-3 in the ACC. But the strength of the Blue Devils was their guards, which was also Lehigh's greatest strength. The Mountain Hawks' backcourt featured future NBA standout CJ Mc-Collum, along with Mackey McKnight - who finished his Lehigh career with 1,327 points and 574 assists, and went on to play several years professionally overseas.

- Everyone will talk about McCollum's 30 points, rightfully so. It was arguably the day that turned him from a great player with a future playing professionally somewhere, into an NBA lottery pick. Not to be forgotten, though, was his supporting cast, who without, Lehigh would not have won.

MCCOLLUM IN NEW ORLEANS

- Former Lehigh standout C.J. McCollum is starring in his tenth NBA season, but first full season with the New Orleans Pelicans. He was traded from the Portland Trail Blazers, where he spent the first nine seasons, to the Pelicans on Tuesday, Feb. 8.

- McCollum averaged 20+ points per game each of the previous six years (2015-21) as one of the NBA's most elite scorers.

- On June 27, 2013, McCollum became the first player in school history to be selected in the NBA Draft. He declared for the 2012 draft, but officially withdrew from the NBA Draft on Monday, Apr. 9, 2012 to return to Lehigh for his senior season. McCollum went on to write a piece published on Sporting News' website titled "Why I'm returning to Lehigh for my senior year," citing earning his degree as one of the primary reasons.

STRONG IN THE CLASSROOM

- The Mountain Hawks take a lot of pride in their academic performance. In the fall, 2020 semester, the team put forth an impressive 3.57 GPA and followed that with a 3.14 GPA in the spring of 2021.

- Last spring, the Mountain Hawks placed five student-athletes onto the Patriot League Academic Honor Roll (for a semester GPA of 3.2+) - Dominic Parolin (3.75, Mathematics), Reed Fenton (3.65, Chemical Engineering), Burke Cheburhar (3.38, Finance), Jalin Sinclair (3.28, Sociology) and graduated senior Jeameril Wilson (3.20, Finance)

- In July, the Mountain Hawks received the NABC Team Academic Excellence Award by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC). Teams with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher during the 2021-22 academic year were recognized.

- In addition, rising seniors Reed Fenton and Evan Taylor were both named to the NABC Honors Court.

- Fenton and Taylor received individual honors as juniors or seniors with a cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher at the conclusion of the 2021-22 academic year.

- Taylor was named to the Academic All-Patriot League team in March while Fenton and rising junior Dominic Parolin earned a spot on the Dean's List this spring semester.

- Parolin was also named the Mountain Hawks' Scholar-Athlete of the Year at the end-of-season banquet.

Head Coach - 16th Season

The 2022-23 season is Dr. Brett Reed's 16th as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In 16 years on the sideline,

Reed has become the winningest coach in Lehigh history and has won nearly 70 percent of his games at Stabler Arena. During the 2012-13 season, Reed won his 100th career game and became the fastest coach to 100 wins in the history of the Patriot League. The same sea-son, he also became the all-time winningest coach in school history. Early in the 2018-19 season, he reached 200 career victories. Reed is the Patriot League's second longest-tenured coach.

Reed owns a 55.3 career winning percentage, among the best in Patriot League history and second among active coaches. Reed's 233 overall wins, and 125 Patriot League victories, are both third in league history.

Reed has consistently won at Lehigh, eclipsing 20 wins three times in a four-year span from 2009-13, which also included three national postseason ap-pearances. The Mountain Hawks twice won the Patriot League and advanced to the NCAA Tournament while advancing to the College Basketball Invitational in 2013. Lehigh reached back-to-back Patriot League Championship Games in 2016 and 2017, marking the third and fourth times in eight seasons the Mountain Havks played in the title game. In 2018-19, Reed led Lehigh to 20 victories for the fifth time in 10 years, finishing in the top four of the league standings in nine of the last 10 seasons. Reed's teams have played their best basketball when it matters, posting a 22-2 record in February between 2016 and 2018 (9-0 in 2016, 6-2 in 2017 and 7-0 in 2018). The Mountain Hawks are 27-5 in February from 2016-19, 32-9 from 2016-20 and 65-40 in the month during Reed's head coaching career. Lehigh has developed plenty of impressive talent in Reed's tenure, led by two-time All-American and Patriot League Player of the Year C.J. McCollum '13 who was selected 10th overall by the Portland Trail Blazers in the 2013 NBA Draft and has developed into an NBA star. McCollum has finished at or near the top 20 in the NBA in scoring each of the last three seasons (23.0 points per game in 2016-17, 21.4 in 2017-18, 21.0 in 2018-19 and 22.2 in 2019-20). Tim Kempton '17 was

20 in the NBA in scoring each of the last three seasons (23.0 points per game in 2016-17, 21.4 in 2017-18, 21.0 in 2018-19 and 22.2 in 2019-20). Tim Kempton '17 was a two-time Patriot League Player of the Year, who was invited to play for the Milwaukee Bucks in the NBA Summer League following graduation, leading to a professional contract overseas. Reed has recruited at an extremely effective rate, as 19 alumni have signed pro contracts over his first 13 years as head coach. Reed will be most remembered for the 2011-12 season, when the Mountain Hawks posted a school-record 27 wins, along with the program's third Patriot League Championship (and second in the three years). The highlight was a historic 75-70 NCAA Tournament win over Duke, becoming only the sixth No. 15 seed to ever beat a No. 2 seed and second in the same day (Norfolk State defeated Missouri just hours earlier). McCollum led the way with 30 points as Lehigh never trailed by more than five and was leading for much of the game. Mountain Hawks' largest lead came in the final minute (eight) as the squad always had an answer for the Blue Devils' runs.

That game helped put the Lehigh men's basketball program squarely on the map as over the ensuing days, the Mountain Hawks were featured in an end-less number of national media outlets including SportsCenter, ESPN Radio, Fox Sports Radio, Sports Illustrated, USA Today and much more. The Mountain Hawks entered the following season ranked among the mid-major's best teams by numerous outlets. The 2011-12 season also featured a school record for nonleague wins (12), the Mountain Hawks shattered the program's previous wins record of 22 (also set by a Reed-led team). Along the way, Lehigh played tough against power conference foes, including NCAA Tournament No. 1 seed Michigan State when the Mountain Hawks held a 38-35 lead at the half.

The Mountain Hawks earned two more wins against power conference foes during the 2014-15 season as Lehigh took a big step forward in its quest to return to championship contention. The Mountain Hawks' season was highlighted by two wins over power conference opponents DePaul and Arizona State, and a tight loss to eventual No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament Villanova. The Mountain Hawks rebounded by winning seven-of-eight games midway through the Patriot League schedule. Late in the season, Lehigh dominated eventual regular season champion Bucknell to clinch a home game in the Patriot League Quarterfinals.

Several individuals took their play to new levels in 2014-15, highlighted by Kempton who was named the league's Player of the Year as just a sophomore. Along with Kempton, freshman Kahron Ross became the Mountain Hawks' fifth Patriot League Rookie of the Year in the previous nine seasons, along with Mar-quis Hall (2007), Rob Keefer (2008), McCollum (2010) and Kempton (2014). Ross set a single-game record with 14 assists in Lehigh's thrilling win at Arizona State. Lehigh rebounded from a slow start in 2015-16 winning 11 straight games beginning in early February, tying the program's 90-year school record. The Moun-

tain Hawks surged to the No. 2 seed in the league tournament and went on to host the quarterfinals, semifinals and championship game. It marked the sixth time in seven seasons that Lehigh has played at least one Patriot League Tournament game at home. The Mountain Hawks wrapped up an undefeated February, their first undefeated month since November of 1993. When all was said and done, Lehigh finished the season with a school-record 13 Patriot League victories. Kempton and Ross were each named first team All-Patriot League, marking the first time in school history Lehigh has featured multiple first team honor-team back the state of the size of the size of the season with a school-record the season of the season back the season of the season back the season

Kempton was also named Patriot League Player of the Year for the second straight season, becoming just the third player in league history to earn the honor twice before his senior season. The others were McCollum

and Colgate's Adonal Foyle. As a team, Lehigh finished the season 15th nationally in three-point percentage (39.2). The Mountain Hawks finished the 2016-17 season with a 20-12 record, tied for second in the league standings before defeating Colgate and Boston University in the Patriot League Tournament to reach their second straight title game. Among Lehigh's wins was an 87-73 win at Mississippi State, the program's Versity in the factor factor for the factor for the factor of the second straight factor and the grant for the factor for the factor of the factor for th

Bucknell in early February, handing the eventual Patriot League Champion its last defeat until the NCAA Tournament. Lehigh finished the season 4-1 in overtime. Ross finished his career as the Lehigh and Patriot League all-time career leader for assists. He was named second team All-Patriot League, becoming the program's first-ever four-time All-League honoree. Ross also became the first student-athlete in program history to finish his career 4-0 at archrival Lafayette. In

one stretch, Lehigh exceeded 50 percent from three-point range in six straight games. The Mountain Hawks had double-digit makes in eight straight and 10of-11, finishing the year 40.6 percent as a team, good for ninth nationally

The hot shooting continued in 2018-19 as Lehigh knocked down 42.3 percent of its three-pointers, leading the nation and almost a full percent more than any other team in the country. It also marked a Patriot League record. The Mountain Hawks finished the year 20-11 and 12-6 in league play, their fifth straight season with 10+ Patriot League victories. Lehigh's 7-4 nonleague record was its best since 2011-12. Lance Tejada received All-League recognition for a second straight season, garnering first-team laurels for the first time. The Mountain Hawks did not lose two straight games all season, showing strong resiliency and an ability to bounce back. In the Patriot League Quarterfinals vs. Army, Lehigh came back from a double-figure second-half deficit to advance, marking the Mountain Hawks' third double-figure second-half comeback against the Black Knights of the season. In the Patriot League opener at Holy Cross, Lehigh erased an 18-point deficit to beat the Crusaders in overtime, the largest comeback in Reed's head coaching tenure. Tejada tied the program record for three-pointers with 10 in the victory, tying the mark set by Joe Knight and teammate Pat Andree. Less than a month later, Lehigh went on to erase a 19-point deficit at Army West Point.

The 2019-20 season saw the Mountain Hawks fight through some early struggles, but never quit and finished the season 6-3 over their final nine games. It included wins over three of the four eventual Patriot League semifinal teams, and a home Patriot League Tournament victory over Loyola. It was the 10th time in 11 seasons Lehigh hosted at least one PLT contest.

Another impressive season under Reed came in 2012-13 when the Mountain Hawks finished 21-10 and played in a national postseason tournament for a second straight season and third time in four years. Lehigh began the sea-son 9-2, including an eight-game winning streak capped off by a 90-75 win at North Texas. McCollum went down with a season-ending injury at VCU on Jan. 5, but the Mountain Hawks wouldn't go away guietly. Lehigh posted a 10-4 record in league play to tie for second in the league standings. Reed picked up his 100th career win in style as the Mountain Hawks defeated Fairleigh Dickinson, 102-62. He went on to post his school record-breaking victory in a 72-43 win at Navy. Following the season, McCollum, the Patriot League's all-time leading scorer, became the first player in school history and second in league history selected in the NBA Draft.

Reed's first Patriot League Title as head coach came in 2009-10 when he led the Mountain Hawks to their second Patriot League Tournament Championship, first outright regular season league title, the most wins in school history (at the time) and the most-ever wins at Stabler Arena. The Mountain Hawks also led the Patriot League in scoring offense, scoring margin, threepoint percentage, assist-to-turnover ratio and defensive rebounds. Their 220 made three-pointers established a new school record, later broken just four seasons later when Lehigh knocked down 235 in 2013-14. The 2009-10 team also set a mark for the most dominant run in the Patriot League Tournament's history, winning every game by 15 points or more. They also excelled in the classroom. Lehigh's starting five of Dave Buchberger, Zahir Carrington, Hall, McCollum and Gabe Knutson achieved an average grade point average of 3.2. During Reed's second season at the helm in 2008-09 season, the Moun-

tain Hawks continued to build upon the solid foundation established at the beginning of his Lehigh career. The accomplishments included the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a Big East foe. Hall went onto became Lehigh's first-ever Patriot League Men's Basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year, while Carrington was the school's first All-District selection since 1988.

In his first season as a collegiate head coach, Reed led the Mountain Hawks to the third most wins for a first-year headman in the 108-season history of Lehigh Basketball. Reed mentored the Mountain Hawks' second consecutive Patriot League Rookie of the Year in Keefer as Lehigh became the first school in the league to accomplish that feat. In addition, Reed oversaw a defensive unit that held league foe Bucknell to just 39 points on February 27, 2008 - the second fewest points ever allowed by the Brown and White since the inception of Patriot League play in 1990. Reed has recruited and developed some excellent basketball talent over

the course of his career at Lehigh. In addition to McCollum and several Rookie of the Year performers, there have been a host of others who have enjoyed individual accomplishments and recognition. Lehigh has also featured high-level performers in the classroom and community as well. Hall was named the Patriot League Scholar-Athlete of the Year in consecutive seasons while Knut-son was a three-time Academic All-Patriot League performer. Andree and Jordan Cohen were named Academic All-League in 2017-18. Hall, McCollum and Kempton have been named finalists for the Senior CLASS Award while Knutson, Corey Schaefer, Austin Price and Tejada have been named candidates for the prestigious award.

Reed was named Lehigh's head coach on August 10, 2007. He had been an assistant at Lehigh for the previous five years, serving as associate head coach for the 2006-07 campaign.

Prior to his time at Lehigh, Reed served as the top assistant coach at High


