### KEY STORYLINES

#### SCOUTING BOSTON COLLEGE

- Boston College is 18-12 on the season with a 6-10 mark in conference play. Most recently, the Eagles swept Syracuse in Chestnut Hill
- BC also has wins over Virginia (3-2), Florida State (3-1) and Miami (3-1)
- Against Syracuse, Silvia Ianselli had 12 kills with a .409 hitting percentage, adding seven digs and four service aces
- Julia Haggerty had seven kills and added three blocks to her point total
- On the season, Izzy Clavenna leads Boston College with 244 kills, averaging 2.28 per set. Alayna Crabtree adds 232 kills with 2.73 per set. She is the points leader with 280
- Anna Murphy has 434 digs this year with 3.81 per set. Four

- other Eagles have over 100 digs with Grace Penn (182), Bridget Green (168), Alayna Crabtree (141) and Sophia Lambros (114)
- Julia Haggerty and Kate Brennan lead the block for Boston College, as Haggerty has 128 and Brennan adds 114
- Grace Penn leads the setters with 674 assists and 5.91 assists per set

#### LAST TIME VS THE EAGLES

- The Hokies swept Boston College in the first meeting this season between the two teams on September 30
- Sydney Petersen continued to impress for the Hokies, finishing with 11 kills on the day to lead the Hokies offense, while posting a hitting

- percentage of .526
- The Hokies recorded seven blocks in the match, as five different players had at least two blocks. Cara Lewis led the way with four total
- Tech got nine digs from Maddie Slagle to lead them defensively.
- The Hokies hit .353 over three sets, the highest hitting percentage so far at that point in the season
- Throughout the match, the Hokies recorded just eight attack errors, compared to 26 from the Eagles who hit just .085, a credit to the Hokie defense.
- Seven different Hokies had a kill in the win, while Brie Postema added nine assists to go along with Borer's 21

## LAST TIME OUT

- Hokies went 0-2 last week, falling in rematches against Virginia (3-0) and Wake Forest (3-1)
- Against UVA, Cera Powell finished with 10 kills on the day to lead the Hokies attack, while finishing with a hitting percentage of .250. Ava Francis also chipped in, recording nine kills and a .238 hitting percentage.
- Sydney Petersen led the Hokies, hitting .538 with eight kills. Tech also got seven digs from Maddie Slagle to lead them defensively.
- Powell finished with 14 kills on the day to lead the Hokies attack again vs Wake Forest.
- Tech had two players reach double figures in digs as Hanna Borer had 16 and Slagle had 11

## OFFENSIVE SUCCESS

- The Hokies matched their season-high in hitting percentage against Wake Forest on November 2, hitting .353 on the night with 49 kills
- Tech last hit .353 against Boston College on September 30
- Sarah Malinowski hit .615 on the night and Cera Powell added a .375 hitting percentage. Cara Lewis also had a solid night with seven kills and a .556 percentage
- Tech made only 13 errors on the night on 102 attempts, compared to Wake Forest who hit .222 on the night with only 29 kills

## ACC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

- Freshman setter Hanna Borer was named the ACC Freshman of the Week for the second time this season after leading the Hokies against Virginia and Wake Forest
- Her first honor (9/26) was Virginia Tech's first Freshman of the Week honor since Kaity Smith earned the award in 2017.
- Playing in seven sets, Borer averaged 10 assists per set on 188 total attempts. She also recorded four kills for the Hokies and assisted in three blocks over the weekend. Defensively, Borer's 20 digs led the team.
- Borer had solid match against Wake Forest, recording 40 assists for the Hokies and 16 digs. Her 16 digs were two away from her career-high.
- The match against Wake Forest also marked her 12th double-double of the season, which is tied for third in the ACC.
- Borer currently leads the Hokies with 616 assists and 6.77 per set. She also ranks ninth in the ACC over her 91 sets played. She also ranks second on the team with 214 digs and 2.18 digs per set.

## TOUGH TRANSFERS

- The 2022 roster for the Hokies features six transfers: Cara Lewis, Maddie Slagle, Reagan Goeke, Sydney Petersen, Jenna Appel and Ava Francis
- Lewis, a transfer from Maryland, ranked first

on the team, second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally with 1.54 blocks per set. Totaled 126 total blocks which also led the team

- Another Big Ten transfer, Slagle posted 760 digs in her career with Iowa, finishing with 1.959 digs per set, as well as 52 aces
- Goeke and Petersen will also join the Hokie block as transfers, with Goeke coming from Pepperdine and Petersen from Nevada. Francis comes to Blacksburg as an outside hitter, spending fall of 2021 at Arizona
- The Hokies add another setter in Jenna Appel from Loyola Chicago. As a sophomore, she finished with 605 assists and 26 aces. She also ranked 13th in the MVC with 5.00 assists per set

## FRESH FACES

- Along with the six transfers, the Hokies also add nine freshmen to the squad for this season
- Three of those freshmen were early enrollees and played the 2021 spring season for the Hokies; Sierra Cates, Hanna Borer and Lauren Fowler
- The other six joined the Hokies this summer and look to make an immediate impact on the young squad

## NEWCOMER FAST FACTS

- #0 Hanna Borer – Broke her high school record for assists in a single season with 798, also reached 1,000 career assists
- #1 Lauren Fowler – Helped her high school team to three State Championships and was named the 2020 Region Player of the Year, State Player of the Year and All-State honoree
- #6 Cara Lewis – Helped Maryland become Big Ten's best blocking team for the second straight season, ranking first on the team, second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally with 1.54 blocks per set
- #8 Josie Bloom - Named to the AVCA Phenom List in 2020 and 2021. Also named the No. 1 ranked L/DS in the state of Michigan by PrepDig
- #9 Sierra Cates – Helped her high school team reach the second round of the State Championship Tournament and was named to the County All-Star Team
- #10 Maddie Slagle – Finished her career at Iowa with 760 digs and 1.96 digs per set. As a junior, ranked second on the team with 128 digs and tallied seven or more digs 10 times
- #11 Amaya Roberson – Named to the USA Volleyball Junior National Championships All-Tournament Team and helped her club team to a third-place finish at AAU Nationals
- #16 Sarah Malinowski – Posted an attack percentage of .370 or above in five different matches, with a high of .680 in high school. Also named to the JVA Watchlist (2019-2021)
- #17 Aerin Bowman – Made the All-Tournament Team at USAV Nationals and the 2021 AAU All-tournament Team in 2021
- #18 Lucky-Rose Williams – Earned First Team All-Conference and All-State honors, while

helping her team to a Top-5 ranking in the state of Hawaii

- #19 Reagan Goeke – In a season at Pepperdine, finished the year with 19 kills, .54 kills per set and 31 points. Posted 20 blocks with only two errors
- #20 Sydney Petersen – As a junior at Nevada, placed first on the team in blocks (98), second in kills (223). As a freshman, set a new single season program record with 137 block assists
- #23 Jenna Appel – Played two seasons at Loyola Chicago and ranked 13th in the MVC as a sophomore with 5.00 assists per set. She also had eight double-doubles with 605 total assists
- #24 Ava Francis – Named to the PrepVolleyball Phenom List and ranked the No. 2 recruit in the state of Ohio. Also named an AVCA All-Region Team member, All-American Honorable Mention and an Under Armour All-American
- #26 Jordan Hallman – AVCA Second Team All-American and National All-Region Team in 2021. Ranked second in the state of Tennessee with a .428 hitting percentage and ranked 22nd nationally with 313 kills in high school

Marci Byers was named the sixth head coach of the Virginia Tech volleyball program in January, 2020. She enters her third season at the helm of the Hokies.

During her first season with Tech, the team tallied five conference wins including a sweep of Virginia and a win over then No. 14 Duke in five sets. The Hokies defeated Virginia in 2021 as well, taking down the Cavaliers in five sets. Tech also defeated Boston College and Wake Forest in ACC play during Byers' second season at the helm. Byers looks to build off the 2021 season with many key returners and 15 newcomers set to make an impact.

A four-time Big South Coach of the Year selection at Radford University, she is the winningest coach in Highlanders' history, leading the program to three Big South regular season titles, two Big South Tournament championships and two NCAA Tournament berths. She is one of only five head coaches in Big South history to register 200 or more career victories.

Throughout her tenure at Radford, the Chicago native consistently recruited top talent to the New River Valley from across the country, thanks to her strong relationships within the ACC footprint, as well as with elite club programs in the Midwest, Texas and California.

Byers' squads at Radford topped the 20-win mark five times over seven seasons and compiled an 81-34 (.708) overall record over four years. She led the Highlanders to a 22-7 record in 2018, including a 12-4 mark in Big South play. They reached the Big South Tournament title game for the second consecutive season and were selected to play in the National Invitational Volleyball Championship where they defeated App State in the first round. During her tenure at Radford, her student-athletes twice registered the top team GPA of any program at the school (2008 and 2013).

No stranger to defeating Power Five foes, under her direction in 2017 the Highlanders registered wins at Arizona, at South Carolina and at Virginia Tech en route to a Big South Tournament title and an NCAA Tournament berth. In 2016, Byers led Radford to a 24-6 record, including a perfect 11-0 mark at home and a Big South regular season championship. Her squads also registered wins against Wake Forest in 2016 and Washington State in 2015. Byers' 2014 squad finished with a 24-8

mark that included wins over California and Maryland as Radford claimed the Big South regular season title. The Highlanders earned their first NCAA Tournament appearance under Byers in 2013 after winning both the Big South regular season and tournament titles, finishing the season with a 25-10 record.

Prior to beginning her tenure at Radford in 2008, she spent two seasons at NCAA Division II Chowan University in Murfreesboro, N.C. After going 4-17 in her initial season in 2006, Byers guided the Hawks to a 26-11 record as the squad averaged the most aces per game of any Division II squad. Prior to joining the collegiate ranks, she posted a 121-49 record in 10 seasons coaching in the Richmond prep ranks, spending two seasons at Mills Godwin High School and eight years at Hermitage High School.

Byers has also been a successful coach at the club level. Her 2003-04 team qualified for the Junior Olympics in Houston, while her 2004-05 team reached the Junior Olympics in Salt Lake City. She was also invited to participate in the USA Volleyball Coaches Clinic at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs.

She is a 1995 graduate of Virginia Union University where she graduated with honors with a bachelor's degree in secondary education with a concentration in mathematics. A four-year starter on the volleyball team, she captained the team as both a junior and senior. Her husband, J.D., serves as an assistant men's basketball coach at VCU. The couple are parents of a daughter, Kamryn Grey.

NOTEWORTHY

ACC POWER

- Three Atlantic Coast Conference teams were ranked in the preseason American Volleyball Coaches Association Top 25 Poll and all three were in the top 10 to enter the season
- Reigning ACC Champion Louisville is No. 4 in this week's poll, followed by No. 7 Pittsburgh and No. 13 Georgia Tech. Both the Cardinals and Panthers advanced to last season's NCAA Championship semifinals and each finished with more than 30 wins.
- Georgia Tech's No. 5 ranking in week 2 was the highest preseason ranking in program history. Miami, North Carolina and Florida State also received votes in the preseason poll.

MILESTONES ACHIEVED

- Junior Brie Postema recorded six assists against NC State to reach 1,000 career assists as a junior
- In 2021, she posted 538 assists, playing in 26 matches. As a rookie, Postema had 310 assists. Her current career-high sits at 47 which she achieved in the five-set win against Virginia on Oct. 29, 2021.
- Maddie Slagle recorded her 1,000th career dig against Louisville on Friday, registering 12 total to lead the Hokies. She has a team-high 259 digs as a grad student, after spending four years at Iowa
- Over the weekend, Logan Mosley moved into the top-10 in school history in career digs.
- She now sits 8th in school history with 1,246. Mosley is chasing down 7th place in school history, as Lindsey Owens (2013-16) holds the 7th spot with 1,309

SENIOR SALUTE

- The Hokies have four graduating athletes this season, who all have been making an impact
- As the libero, grad student Maddie Slagle leads the team in digs with 345, averaging 3.52 per set. She adds 20 aces
- Senior Anabel Zier is first on the team in aces with 21 and is also second on the team lead in blocks with 94. She is averaging 1.04 per set
- Senior Logan Mosley also helps out on the defensive end, recording 183 digs so far this season to rank third on the team. She has 1.87 digs per set
- Leading the offense is senior Cera Powell with 256 kills and 2.81 kills per set. She is averaging 3.13 points per set and adds 162 digs as a six

rotation player

HALLMAN ACC DEBUT

- Freshman Jordan Hallman made her first start of the season against Louisville. She had played in just one set prior to that match
- Against the Cardinals, Hallman posted 9.5 points, which ranked third on the team. She also had three aces which led the Hokies.
- Along with the service aces, the freshman had four kills with a .429 hitting percentage and four block assists
- She followed that up with another start against Notre Dame, adding a kill and a block assist in the match

ACC RANKINGS

- Anabel Zier ranks 9th in hitting percentage with a .329 in the ACC. She ranks 11th in blocks per set with 1.04, leading the Hokies in that category as well
- Cara Lewis also ranks in the top 20 for total blocks, ranking 12th with 97 total. She is averaging 1.00 per set which ranks her 16th in the conference
- Maddie Slagle is averaging 3.52 digs per set to rank ninth in the ACC. Her 345 digs rank her eighth overall in the conference as well

SARAH ON THE SCENE

- Sarah Malinowski had a great two matches for the Hokies against Wake and Duke (Nov. 2 and 4), finishing with 20 kills and 2.86 kills per set. She had a .457 hitting percentage over her seven sets played and also added three blocks
- In the sweep over Wake Forest, Malinowski recorded 10 kills, leading the team with a .615 hitting percentage
- She followed that up with a career-high match against Duke, recording 10 kills for the second straight match, adding 11.5 points, another career-high. She had a .364 hitting percentage and two digs
