HOKIE HEADLINES

- The Hokies finished off February with a 7-1 mark, which was their best record for the month since 1972 (6-1).
- Tech captured its first Quad 1 win of the season at

Miami, moving to 1-5.

- Per KenPom, the Hokies rank 26th in the country on offense in adjusted efficiency (points scored per 100 possessions).
 - Keve Aluma ranks fourth in the ACC in scoring at 17.3 points per game in conference-only action.
 - Aluma collected his sixth double-double of the season at Miami on Saturday night. It was his second consecutive doubledouble.
 - Tech is shooting 39.1 percent from three this season, but has only hit 31 of 120 (25.8%) in its last five games.

BY THE NUMBERS



The 2021-22 season is the **20th** of Mike Young's head coaching career. He has logged a 348-278 (.556) career record as the head whistle.



The Hokies have won **eight** of their last nine games, turning what was a 2-7 record in ACC play to 10-8. Tech has guaranteed itself a first-round bye in next week's ACC tournament. 81.5

Tech shot an impressive **81.5%** from 2-point field goals at Miami, connecting on 23 of 27 from inside the arc. The Hokies manufactured 36 points in the paint as a result.

NOTEWORTHY

HOT WHEN IT MATTERS

- Both halves finished with a team making a momentum-shifting run, as Miami closed the first segment on an 11-3 run. In fact, four of the Hurricanes' 3-pointers (six total) came in consecutive fashion during the final 4:02 of the first half.
- However, when Virginia Tech had its largest deficit (-8) of the game with 1:42 remaining, the Hokies shot 4-5 from the field, while only allowing Miami to get three shots (1-3) off.
- There were three separate occasions in Saturday's game when the Hokies made three or more consecutive shots.

GOOD TEAMS FIND A WAY

- Virginia Tech overcame a season-high 19 turnovers on Saturday, the most in a win by the Hokies since giving up 20 on opening night against Gardner-Webb in the 2018-19 season.
- Two Hokies had 5+ assists for the second time this season – Justyn Mutts (6) and Hunter Cattoor (6). Against Maine on opening night, Mutts had six, while Cattoor had five.
- Tech countered its turnover problem by moving the ball well in its offensive spurts. The Hokies had 21 assists, the most since they had 25 on Feb. 6, 2021 against...Miami.
- The Hokies made up ground on the boards, as well. Tech eclipsed 30 rebounds (31) for the third-consecutive game and outrebounded Miami by 10. Virginia Tech is now 14-0 this season when bagging more rebounds than its opponent.

ALUMA MOVES IN SILENCE

- Keve Aluma quietly recorded his sixth double-double (18 points and 10 rebounds) of the season, tying his tally from last season.
- After missing his first shot of the game, Aluma made his last eight – including 5-5 in the second half. One of those buckets was a dunk with 40 seconds remaining, joining Sean Pedulla and Darius Maddox in the late run.
- As Tech's offensive focus has shifted to inside the arc as of late, so has Aluma's. The big man has only attempted five 3-pointers in the last five games.
- Aluma's efficient shooting inside the arc was followed by the whole team, which shot 22-

27 from non-3s (81.5%) at Miami.

TRIPLE-DOUBLE MUTTY

- Justyn Mutts recorded the program's second-ever triple-double with 12 points, 14 rebounds and 11 assists vs. Syracuse.
- The only other triple-double in Tech history was by Chris Clarke vs. The Citadel on Dec. 17, 2016 (13 points, 12 rebounds, 10 assists).
- He's one of three ACC players to record a triple-double this season, joining Alondes Williams of Wake Forest and Wendell Moore, Jr. of Duke.

ALUMA, MUTTS MAKE HISTORY

• When Keve Aluma and Justyn Mutts both reached 1,000 career points in the same game (Feb. 2 vs. Georgia Tech), it marked the first time a pair of teammates accomplished that feat at the Division I level since Mississippi State's Aric Holman and Lamar Peters both hit 1,000 career points in the same game against Texas A&M on March 9, 2019.

PILLAR OF THE PROGRAM

• When asked about his assessment of Hunter Cattoor and the impact on the program, Coach Young responded, "Pretty damn good. Couldn't imagine life without him. He's a pillar of this program. He's one that we have built this program with. He may not pass the eye test at times, but you know what you're going to get. He's brilliant, just a smart basketball guy."

GET IT IN THE PAINT

- In Tech's two games against Notre Dame and NC State, the Hokies produced over 30 points in the paint, leading to two wins.
- When Tech scores 30 points in the paint, the team has a 9-3 record. The three losses were to Duke and North Carolina (twice).

ON A ROLL

- Not many in the country have played better than Keve Aluma this season.
- The redshirt senior had scored double figures in 15 straight games entering the Florida State game on Jan. 29. He scored a season-low four points against the Seminoles.
- It was the longest double-digit scoring streak by a Hokie since Zach LeDay put together 23 straight during the 2016-17

season.

MUTTS-SEE TV

- Justyn Mutts is one of the most dynamic players on the Tech roster. That was on full display vs. the Irish where Mutts dialed up a season-high 24 points. It tied for the most points he's scored in a Tech uniform (3/11/21 vs. North Carolina).
- However, rewind to Jan. 12 when he finished the UVA game with two points on 1-2 shooting, that didn't sit well with Coach Young.
- The two met prior to Thursday's (1/13) practice where Young asked Mutts what he needed of his head coach and what he could do to get Mutts going. "He's a terrific passer and he becomes so set in that and making the right pass instead of [having the mindset of] lay your ears back and go play," Young offered.
- In other words, when Mutts is the aggressor and more assertive, good things happen.

 Keve Aluma leads the Hokies with six double-doubles this season.

• Aluma has reached double-figure scoring in 25 of Tech's 29 games and double-figure rebounding in six games.

BENCH PRODUCTION

- Through 29 games, the Hokies' reserves are averaging 16.3 points per game.
- Tech has gone over the 30-point threshold five times, with a season-high 36 points coming against Maine and Cornell.
- The Hokies only managed 21 points in their five ACC games before going off for 17 at NC State.
- Tech had a season-high 32 bench points vs. an ACC foe (at Florida State, 1/29/22). Sean Pedulla led the way with a season-high 20 points.
- During Tech's six-game win streak, the Hokies averaged 18.7 points from the bench.

DEGREES ON DEGREES

- Storm Murphy and Justyn Mutts are both in grad school at Virginia Tech.
- Murphy graduated from Wofford with a finance degree in May 2021 and is currently pursuing a graduate degree in leadership studies within the Agricultural and Life Sciences program at Virginia Tech.
- Mutts graduated with a psychology degree from Delaware and completed his master's degree at Tech in agricultural and life sciences with a concentration in education in May 2021. He's currently pursuing his second master's degree in educational psychology.
- Keve Aluma earned his first undergraduate degree in human development from Virginia Tech in May 2021 and is currently working on his second undergraduate degree in sociology.

PUT THE CLAMPS ON 'EM

• Through the first five games of the season, the Hokies held each of their opponents below 60 points. Their 61.83 scoring defense average ranks second in the ACC and 19th nationally.

• In addition to their scoring defense, the Hokies rank fourth in the ACC in field-goal percentage defense (.426).

• Tech held its first six opponents of the season below 40 percent shooting before Xavier shot 47.8 percent against the Hokies on Nov. 26.

OWNING THE ARC

• The 3-point line has been under new management 29 games into the 2021-22 season. Tech has owned the offensive side of the arc, ranking first in 3FG% (.391) among ACC programs and second in 3-pointers made per game (8.8).

WINNING THE TURNOVER BATTLE

- Through 29 games this season, Tech has won the turnover battle 18 times, posting a 12-6 record.
- The Hokies rank seventh in the ACC and 45th nationally in turnovers per game (11.1).

TECH SIGNS NO. 26 CLASS IN THE COUNTRY

• Coach Young announced the signing of three standout recruits during the early signing period, which began on Nov. 10. The Hokies are set to welcome MJ Collins (Rock Hill, S.C.), Patrick Wessler (Matthews, N.C.) and Rodney Rice (Clinton, Md.) to Blacksburg next summer as part of Tech's 26th-ranked recruiting class according to 247Sports.

REUNITED IN BLACKSBURG

- Keve Aluma, Storm Murphy and Coach Young spent two seasons (2017-19) together at Wofford, highlighted by their 2018-19 season that included a first-round win (84-68) over Seton Hall in the 2019 NCAA Tournament.
- Upon Aluma's and Young's departure from Wofford, Murphy stuck around in Spartanburg, South Carolina, guiding the Terriers to a 34-25 record.
- While together at Wofford, the trio combined for a 51-18 (.739) mark.

WHO IS THIS GUY?

- Keve Aluma only attempted one 3-pointer in his two seasons at Wofford. In Coach Young's words, "it wasn't even close."
- Fast forward two seasons and Aluma has become a post player with range from beyond the arc. He attempted 57 threes in his Hokie debut in 2020-21, knocking down 20 of them for a 35.1 percent clip.
- After going 2-16 through Tech's first eight games this season, Aluma knocked down four of his seven attempts from long range vs. Wake Forest.

JUSTYN TIME

- Coach Young has gone on record saying, "Justyn Mutts was probably the key to our year last year."
- The Delaware transfer was the Hokies' fourth-leading scorer from last season (9.5) and second-leading rebounder (6.4).
- From Dec. 29, 2020 through the end of the season, Mutts scored at least nine points in 11 of Tech's 14 games. The Millville, New Jersey native twice broke the 20-point plateau at Miami (Fla.) (22) and vs. North Carolina (24) during that stretch.

LOGGING THE MINUTES

- Storm Murphy logged 3,723 minutes in his career entering this season, which is the 16th-most of anyone in the country returning for 2021-22.
- He ranked ninth in that category among point guards.

• Storm Murphy's first name comes from his Mom's maiden name - Storm, in addition to being born in January during a snowstorm in Wisconsin.

TRACKING THE TREY

- Coach Young's last four teams at Wofford all finished inside the top 10, nationally, in 3-point field-goal percentage.

ABOUT LOUISVILLE

- Louisville will conclude its three-game road swing in Blacksburg Tuesday night. The Cardinals have lost nine of their last 10 outings, including a 99-77 decision at Wake Forest on Saturday.
- At 12-16 overall and 6-12 in the ACC, Louisville is currently in a four-way tie for 10th in the league standings.
- The Cardinals have a 2-9 mark in road games this season. They last won on the road on Jan. 2 at Georgia Tech (67-64).
- Florida transfer Noah Locke leads the Cards in scoring at 9.9 points per game. The senior guard eclipsed 1,200 career points at Wake Forest on Saturday. He now has 1,209 points through three seasons with the Gators and this season with Louisville.
- Sydney Curry, a junior forward, came off the bench to score 28 points at Wake Forest on Saturday. He and Locke were the only two double-figure scorers for UofL in the loss.
- Louisville averages 68.4 points per game, which ranks 11th in the ACC, just behind the Hokies. On the defensive side, the Cards yield 70.4 points per game, which ranks 10th in the league.
- At 37.0 rebounds per game, Louisville ranks

third in the ACC. The Cards shoot a leagueworst 67.6% from the free-throw line.

- Mike Pegues is serving as interim head coach following the mutual parting of former Louisville head coach Chris Mack. Pegues is in his fourth year at UofL after working six seasons at Xavier (2012-18).
- The all-time leading scorer in Delaware men's basketball history with 2,030 points, Pegues led the Blue Hens to two NCAA Tournament appearances while playing under former UD head coach and current Notre Dame head coach Mike Brey from 1996-2000.





NOTEWORTHY

STORM WARNING

- Grad student Storm Murphy takes over the reins at point guard following the graduation of Wabissa Bede.
- The Wofford transfer averaged 17.8 points, 3.3 rebounds and 4.3 assists last season. He was one of only 11 players to average that stat line or better nationally.
- Murphy tallied double figures in 21 of 24 contests, including 10 20-point performances, and dished over five assists on eight occasions.
- He concluded his Wofford career with 1,315 points to finish 24th on the program's alltime scoring list.
- The First-Team All-SoCon selection will provide a scoring threat from outside, as he shot 40 percent from three last season.
- Murphy knocked down 70 3-pointers a year ago. In comparison, Bede connected on 12 with a 24.5 percent clip.

DANCIN' IN YEAR TWO

- In previous seasons in Virginia Tech history, the fastest head coach to make the NCAA Tournament was in Year Three. Those Hokies were Howie Shannon, Charlie Moir and Buzz Williams.
- Therefore, with Mike Young doing so in Year Two, he became the fastest Tech coach to make The Dance.

HOKIE CENSUS

- Tech has 13 players on the squad who represent eight states and two international countries (Netherlands, Nigeria).
- Florida leads the way with three players Hunter Cattoor, Lynn Kidd and Jalen Haynes
 – while Maryland has two players – Keve Aluma and Darius Maddox.

BOUNCEBACK MENTALITY

- Tech doesn't lose back-to-back games as it did against Memphis and Xavier, often.
- Young and the Hokies were 5-1 last season after a loss with their lone back-to-back losing skid coming at the end of the season to North Carolina in the ACC Tournament and Florida in the NCAA Tournament.
- In 2019-20, Young had five wins following a loss.

50 SPOT

- Tech shot over 50 percent in a game five times during the 2020-21 season going 5-0.
- Since Young got to Blacksburg, the Hokies are 21-2 in contests shooting 50 percent or greater only losses: vs. BYU (11/27/19) and vs. Miami (1/26/22).
- Since the 2010-11 season, Tech is 92-13 when shooting 50 percent or better.

LEADING AT THE BREAK

- Over the last two seasons, Tech is 26-5 when leading at halftime, with two of the losses coming against North Carolina and Florida to end the 2020-21 season.
- The Hokies are 39-9 in the Mike Young era when up at half.

GREEN-LIGHTED FROM THREE

- With the potential lineup of Storm Murphy, Hunter Cattoor, Nahiem Alleyne, Justyn Mutts and Keve Aluma, all five of those players have the green light from distance.
- The last team Coach Young had with this type of threat from deep was his 2018-19 Wofford squad, which ranked second nationally in 3-point accuracy (41.4). The Terriers finished 30-5 that season, including an unbeaten mark in SoCon action, and reached the second round of the 2019 NCAA

Tournament.

RANKED WINS BECOMIN' COMMON

• Tech had four ranked wins last season, tying the most-ever in school history (set 2017-18).

REACH OUR POTENTIAL

- When asked how he'd define success for this season, Coach Young expressed he wanted the Hokies to reach their potential.
- "That will be a real success for me," he said,
 "And I'll get back to the mountains of North Carolina this spring and fish with a big smile on my face."


ACC POY CONVERSATION

REACH FOR EXCELLENCE

- Virginia Tech announced on April 20, 2021 a \$400 million fundraising campaign to propel Hokie sports to the forefront of the Atlantic Coast Conference, prepare generations of student-athletes for success in life, and raise the university's profile nationwide.
- The campaign will leverage the momentum of recent successes on the field and in fundraising, such as adding about 10,000 more Hokie Club members in the past five years and opening the Student-Athlete Performance Center, thanks to a record gift. Still, leaders acknowledged that the athletics enterprise needs an infusion of revenue in order to compete at the top of the ACC.
- The budget increase will support athletics in three primary areas: facilities, coaching, and the student-athlete experience.



- The Reach for Excellence campaign has five main pillars, which are:
 - A football enhancement fund to build a program that consistently competes at the top of the ACC, by allotting \$30 million over time for recruiting, assistant coaches' salaries, quality-control coaches, player development, and capital needs.
 - Renovations to improve Cassell Coliseum, with at least \$50 million to be raised privately.
 - The Drive for 25 initiative to increase Hokie Club membership to 25,000 and raise \$20 million annually for student-

athlete scholarships.

- Striving for comprehensive excellence for all sports by providing operating expenses, facility improvements, nutritional and strength and conditioning programs, and more.
- Increasing the number of student-athlete scholarship endowments to expand capacity to support students and broaden reach in recruiting.
- When it's filled with nearly 10,000 fans cheering the Hokies to victory in the last seconds of a basketball game, Cassell Coliseum is an amazing sight. But when it's empty, the home of Virginia Tech basketball, volleyball, and wrestling shows its age. Built in the early 1960s, the Coliseum is due for an extensive renovation.
- Plans call for a completely redesigned experience, including:
 - A new glass entrance along Washington Street
 - Extended concourse areas along both sides to allow fans easier access to different sections of the coliseum
 - The addition of high-end premium seating areas, including club seating and luxury suites on both sides
- This much-needed \$75 million-plus project, helped by at least \$50 million in private support, would create one of the best home venues in the ACC.

WHAT'S A HOKIE?

The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute. With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body.

Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Hokie" yell which is still used today. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the word was solely the product of



his imagination and was used only as an attention-getter for his yell. It soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

The official university school colors -Chicago Maroon and Burnt Orange - also were introduced in 1896. The colors were chosen by a committee because they made a 'unique combination' not worn elsewhere at the time. The official definition of "Hokie" is "a loyal Virginia Tech Fan."




