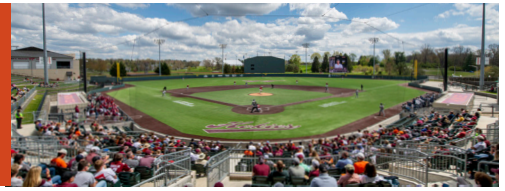

KEY STORYLINES

HAMMERIN' HOKIES

- Coming out of Tuesday's midweek victory, Virginia Tech is the only NCAA Division I program with two hitters who are ranked among the top 15 nationally in both batting average and slugging percentage (Cade Hunter, Jack Hurley).
- Sophomore outfielder Jack Hurley and third-year catcher Cade Hunter enter this week's series against Miami batting .429 and .422, respectively - Hunter having elevated his clip by .068 since March 22 courtesy of his 20-for-37 (.541) run at the plate.
- As a team, Virginia Tech holds strong with the nation's second highest slugging percentage (.618).
- The Hokies recently took over the national lead in home runs per game (2.45), hammering eight fewer home runs (71) than

No. 1 Tennessee has (79) across four fewer games played.

- Among Tech's latest uptick in home runs, third-year outfielder Gavin Cross has pelted six during his last eight games, swinging three against then-No. 18 North Carolina and two against then-No. 21 NC State.
- As he did last year, Cross is again pacing the ACC in triples, locked in a three-way tie at four - one more than teammate Eduardo Malinowski (three).
- Cross is also ranked among the country's top 10 players in runs scored per game (1.33).

HURRICANE WATCH

- Virginia Tech is seeking its second top-10 series victory during as many seasons as the Hokies vie to emulate their success against No. 6 Miami at the beginning of the 2021 campaign.

- During its February 2021 stay in Coral Gables, Tech took two out of three games against the ranked Hurricanes, setting its early course for a 14-7 start within the ACC.
- The Hokies relied on big bats Cade Hunter and TJ Rumfield to steady their 5-3, series-opening victory, though struggled to decipher game two starter Alejandro Rosario, who kept Tech to three hits across seven innings while striking out seven.
- On Sunday, the Hokies matched Miami with 11 hits, rallying for seven runs across the final four innings to clinch the series in 9-6 fashion.
- Since the beginning of the 2021 season, Tech is 12-11 against opponents ranked in *D1Baseball's* top 25, having won six of its last eight regular season series.
- The Hokies' 2021 series victory at Miami also snapped their

11-game, head-to-head losing skid against the Hurricanes while marking the program's first series win since 2012 in Blacksburg.

ON THE BUMP

• Virginia Tech starting pitchers Griffin Green and Drue Hackenberg are both coming off their best career starts last weekend against then-No. 21 NC State.

• On April 8, Green toed seven innings for the first time during his collegiate career, firing 107 pitches and striking out five while scattering five hits.

• With Green on the bump, Tech has won three straight ACC series-opening games with its leading right-hander sporting a 3.24 ERA across those appearances.

• In the wake of Green's NC State start, Hackenberg shoved against the Wolfpack as well, setting rookie season highs in innings pitched (seven) and strikeouts (eight).

• Virginia Tech is 7-1 when Hackenberg pitches, having won four consecutive games during which he has appeared.

• The first-year right-hander enters this week's series against Miami ranked among the top 20 NCAA Division I pitchers in strikeout-to-walk ratio (8.20) – including the third best mark among freshmen – and is one of 13 pitchers nationally to boast a 6-0 record or stronger this season through eight or fewer appearances.

• Pitching is most certainly a forte for the Hurricanes, who enter Thursday's series opener with the third best ERA in the ACC (3.78).

• At the beginning of the week, Miami's staff had held opposing lineups to a .214 batting average and the third fewest hits within the league – numbers that may be in jeopardy against the Hokies' elite, high-powered offense.

POLL VAULT

• Virginia Tech cracked three national polls on Monday after notching its fourth consecutive ACC series victory and becoming the program's fastest team to eclipse 20 victories during its current conference tenure (since 2005).

• Recognized most prominently by the NCAA and the ACC, *D1Baseball* slotted the Hokies at No. 21 this week – a direct replacement of the No. 21 NC State team Tech took two out of three games from over the weekend at English Field.

• Elsewhere, the Hokies jumped from No. 23 to No. 17 inside *Perfect Game*'s top 25 while earning the No. 28 spot in the NCBWA's top 30.

• Virginia Tech also began the week ranked No. 40 in the NCAA Division I Baseball RPI – the ninth highest mark among ACC programs. The Hokies scored a big midweek victory against Liberty (RPI No. 36) as Tech continues to pad its postseason resume.

TECH'S .400 CLUB

• Virginia Tech is one of seven NCAA Division I programs equipped with two or more qualifying hitters who are batting .400 or higher this season (Jack Hurley – .464, Cade Hunter – .409).

• Hurley pulls into Tech's series against NC State swinging one of the hottest bats in America.

• The Hokies' cleanup outfielder leads the nation in batting average while ranking second in slugging percentage (.928) and third in OPS (1.459).

• With 13 doubles, a triple and 10 home runs to his name, Hurley played his way onto the 2022 Golden Spikes Award midseason watch list, which gave a snapshot of the 45 high school or college athletes whose accolades best aligned with being named this year's top U.S. amateur baseball player.

• On Thursday, he was named to *D1Baseball*'s Midseason All-America Team, of which seven of the 19 selections hailed from the ACC.

• Hurley and Hunter have safely reached base during each of their 24 respective appearances this season with Hurley turning in an active 24-game hitting streak that ties for Tech's ACC-era record with Steve Domecus (2009).

• Hunter has raised his batting average by 55 points across his last six games, during which he has hit 13-for-23 (.565), launched three home runs and totaled 10 RBIs.

Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock announced the hiring of Tech's 25th head baseball coach on June 9, 2017 and formally introduced John Szeffc as the head coach of the baseball program at a press conference a few days later on June 15. The 2021 season will mark his fourth as the Hokies' head coach.

In his first three seasons, Szeffc (pronounced SHEFF) has coached the Hokies to a pair of seven-game winning streaks - one that opened the 2019 season and the second was in 2020, after the team started 1-3. Also in 2020, the team won 10 games in nonconference action, which included ending the shortened season on a nine-game winning streak, the longest since the team won 18 straight nonconference games in a row back in 2012.

The team also posted an 8-0 home record, the best start at the school since 2012, which helped the Hokies extend their home winning streak in the month of February to 15 straight victories. Added to the final win of 2019, Tech has won nine straight at home, the longest since an 11-game streak from April 28, 2015 through March 4, 2016, and will enter the 2021 season tied for the 12th longest home-win streak in the NCAA.

After the shortened 2020 season, three players earned All-America distinction from Collegiate Baseball Newspaper as it recognized both pitcher Ian Seymour and catcher Carson Taylor as Third Team selections, marking the first time Tech had multiple All-Americans since 2003. Outfielder Gavin Cross was later named to the All-American Freshman Team, just the seventh ever at the school. Also, despite just a five-round MLB Draft in 2020, the draft marked the first time in school history, two Tech players are chosen in the top four rounds as Seymour (2nd) and Taylor (4th) were selected.

Szeffc, who won his 400th career game on March 10, 2018 guiding the Hokies to a 3-1 victory over Pittsburgh, accepted the head coaching position at Tech after leading Maryland to three NCAA appearances and a 180-122 (.596) overall record as the Terrapins' head coach. Before arriving in Blacksburg, Szeffc owned a 392-259-3 (.602) career record in 12 seasons as an NCAA head coach, producing 10 campaigns with 30 or more wins.

In addition to ending a 43-year NCAA tournament drought and becoming the fastest coach to 100 career wins at Maryland, Szeffc spent seven seasons (1996-2002) at the helm of the Marist College baseball program, where he led the team to four conference championships, four NCAA Regional appearances and a 212-137-3 (.607) overall mark. Szeffc earned Northeastern Conference Coach of the Year honors in 1997 and was the American Baseball Coaches

Associate Northeast Region Coach of the Year in 2001.

The first coach in Maryland history to ever take the Terrapins to an NCAA Super Regional, Szeffc accomplished the feat twice in 2014 and 2015 as he guided the program to the first two 40-win seasons in school history and claimed Maryland's first two NCAA Regional crowns. Maryland achieved a final No. 14 ranking both seasons, the highest finishes in school history.

He guided the Terrapins to the ACC Tournament final for the first time in 38 years in 2014 and then took Maryland to the Big Ten tournament final in the school's initial season in that conference, winning a program-best 42 games in 2015.

Szeffc has coached 109 players that have been drafted or signed professional contracts since 1997, including four in 2018 and five in 2019. Over the last eight drafts, 36 of his players have been selected, including the 45th pick of the 2014 draft Jake Stinnett, the highest pick of a Maryland player in almost a decade. Almost a dozen have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, including most recently, Mike Shawaryn (Red Sox) and Lamonte Wade (Twins) in 2019. He has also helped develop 26 All-Americans, including 10 of the 20 players in Maryland history to earn that distinction.

The Middletown, N.Y. native arrived at Maryland after a two-year stint as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas State (2011-12) and a two-season stay as assistant head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas (2009-10). He also enjoyed a six-season tenure as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Louisiana-Lafayette (2003-08). Szeffc began his coaching career as an assistant at Sacred Heart (1995) and at Drexel (1990-93).

Szeffc managed the New York Generals in the Atlantic College Baseball League during the summers of 1995 and 1996. He led the club to a 47-28 record, earned two consecutive division titles and the ACBL title game in 1996.

Collegiately, he played two years at Connecticut before transferring in 1987 to Drexel. During his senior campaign for the Dragons, he was tabbed an All-East Coast Conference outfielder.

He graduated from Drexel University with a degree in corporate communications in 1989. He also holds a master's degree in sports administration from Temple University.

Szeffc and his wife, Barbara, have a daughter, Anna, and two sons, John Michael and Sam.
