KEY STORYLINES

HERE COME THE HOKIES

- In five short seasons under the direction of head coach John Szefc, Virginia Tech has emerged as a deserving ACC championship contender, having vaulted on Monday to No. 8 in *D1Baseball's* top 25 rankings.
- After their 0-4 start to league play, the Hokies have since won five consecutive ACC series with their 9-3 conference mark, chalking 15 victories during their last 18 games overall.
- Tech's No. 8 ranking marks the program's highest *D1Baseball* poll placement all-time, coming in three positions behind the current ACC leader, No. 5 Miami.
- Last week, the Hokies' lineup shelled the division-leading Hurricanes for 25 runs while taking the opening two games of the teams' three-game series in Blacksburg. Tech averaged 14.0

hits per nine innings against Miami, rallying for three-plus runs on five occasions.

- The Hokies' recent swell of ACC success can also be attributed to starting right-handers Griffin Green and Drue Hackenberg.

- Since March 18, Tech is 8-1 when playing behind Green and Hackenberg – Green has toed a 3-0 record with a 3.95 ERA, 23 strikeouts and nine walks during the stretch while Hackenberg has boasted a 4-0 record with a 2.40 ERA, 27 strikeouts and five walks.

SCHOBEL'S SLUGGING

- Sophomore shortstop Tanner Schobel is the latest member of the "Hammerin' Hokies" to go on a hot stretch.
- Coming off ACC Co-Player of the Week honors on Monday, Schobel batted 5-for-9 during Tech's two midweek victories

against VMI and Radford, scoring six runs while totaling six RBIs and swiping two bags.

- During his last eight games, Schobel has raised his batting average by 28 points to .382, having recorded four three-hit games and totaled 21 of his 49 RBIs.

- Camped in the third spot of the Hokies' batting order, he is one of five Tech players who rank among the top 100 NCAA Division I players in slugging percentage – a class that features Jack Hurley (.803), Cade Hunter (.787), Carson DeMartini (.690) and Gavin Cross (.679).

- With Schobel raking, Tech heads into this weekend's series at BC ranked second nationally in batting average (.328), second in slugging percentage (.612), tied for second in home runs (77) and sixth in scoring (9.5 runs per game).

• Three Virginia Tech hitters are ranked among the top 100 NCAA Division I players in batting average: Jack Hurley (.432, third), Cade Hunter (.385, 52nd) and Tanner Schobel (.382, t-65th).

HOME RUN STRETCHES

• **Eduardo Malinowski:** Seven home runs across first 10 games at Tech between Feb. 18 (Opening Day) and March 6.

• **Gavin Cross:** Six home runs across nine-game stretch between April 1 and April 12, featuring five home runs hit against No. 18 North Carolina and No. 21 NC State.

• **Tanner Schobel:** Seven home runs across eight-game stretch leading into Boston College series.

TAKEAWAYS AGAINST MIAMI

• Virginia Tech won its fifth consecutive ACC series.

• The Hokies scored their second straight top-10 series victory against Miami (won 2021 series against No. 6 Hurricanes in Coral Gables, Florida).

• Tech combined to outscore Miami, 30-15.

• The Hokies never trailed during their Friday and Saturday victories.

• Virginia Tech sent nine batters to the plate during the first inning against the Hurricanes' series-opening starting pitcher, Carson Palmquist - tying the most he had faced during the 2022 season.

• The Hokies knocked Miami starters Carson Palmquist (Thursday) and Karson Ligon (Friday) out of their games before finishing the fourth inning.

• Since losing 11 straight series meetings against the Hurricanes, Tech has now won four of the last six head-to-head matchups.

ON THE BUMP

• Virginia Tech starting pitchers Griffin Green and Drue Hackenberg are both coming off recent career best starts.

• On April 8 against No. 21 NC State, Green toed seven innings for the first time during his collegiate career, firing 107 pitches and striking out five while scattering five hits.

• Against No. 2 Miami on April 15, Hackenberg

shredded the Hurricanes through eight innings of work, improving to 7-0 on the season while recording seven strikeouts.

• With Green on the bump, Tech has won four straight ACC series-opening games.

• Virginia Tech is 8-1 when Hackenberg pitches, having won five consecutive games during which he has appeared.

• The first-year right-hander enters this week's series at Boston College ranked among the top 30 NCAA Division I pitchers in walks allowed per nine innings (1.36), among the top 50 in strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.00) - including the fifth best mark among freshmen - and is one of seven pitchers nationally to boast a 7-0 record or stronger this season through nine or fewer appearances.

POLL VAULT

• Virginia Tech deservingly benefitted from the shakeup that was Monday's reveal of the *D1Baseball* top 25 rankings.

• The Hokies soared to No. 8 in the outlet's presentation - a jump of 13 positions after winning their fifth consecutive ACC series by two games to one against then-No. 2 Miami.

• As it stands, Tech is the second highest ranked ACC squad in *D1Baseball*'s poll, trailing the now-No. 5 Hurricanes as well as two SEC sides and two Pac-12 programs.

• The Hokies' No. 8 ranking also marks their highest *D1Baseball* poll placement all-time.

• Elsewhere, Virginia Tech cracked the top 10 of Perfect Game's top 25, earning the No. 9 spot.

• The Hokies also came in at No. 11 in Baseball America's top 25, vaulted to No. 13 in the USA TODAY Sports baseball coaches poll and placed No. 16 in the NCBWA's top 30.

• After improving its quadrant one record to 10-7 following its two victories against Miami, Virginia Tech also leaped to No. 26 in the NCAA Division I Baseball RPI.

Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock announced the hiring of Tech's 25th head baseball coach on June 9, 2017 and formally introduced John Szeffc as the head coach of the baseball program at a press conference a few days later on June 15. The 2021 season will mark his fourth as the Hokies' head coach.

In his first three seasons, Szeffc (pronounced SHEFF) has coached the Hokies to a pair of seven-game winning streaks - one that opened the 2019 season and the second was in 2020, after the team started 1-3. Also in 2020, the team won 10 games in nonconference action, which included ending the shortened season on a nine-game winning streak, the longest since the team won 18 straight nonconference games in a row back in 2012.

The team also posted an 8-0 home record, the best start at the school since 2012, which helped the Hokies extend their home winning streak in the month of February to 15 straight victories. Added to the final win of 2019, Tech has won nine straight at home, the longest since an 11-game streak from April 28, 2015 through March 4, 2016, and will enter the 2021 season tied for the 12th longest home-win streak in the NCAA.

After the shortened 2020 season, three players earned All-America distinction from Collegiate Baseball Newspaper as it recognized both pitcher Ian Seymour and catcher Carson Taylor as Third Team selections, marking the first time Tech had multiple All-Americans since 2003. Outfielder Gavin Cross was later named to the All-American Freshman Team, just the seventh ever at the school. Also, despite just a five-round MLB Draft in 2020, the draft marked the first time in school history, two Tech players are chosen in the top four rounds as Seymour (2nd) and Taylor (4th) were selected.

Szeffc, who won his 400th career game on March 10, 2018 guiding the Hokies to a 3-1 victory over Pittsburgh, accepted the head coaching position at Tech after leading Maryland to three NCAA appearances and a 180-122 (.596) overall record as the Terrapins' head coach. Before arriving in Blacksburg, Szeffc owned a 392-259-3 (.602) career record in 12 seasons as an NCAA head coach, producing 10 campaigns with 30 or more wins.

In addition to ending a 43-year NCAA tournament drought and becoming the fastest coach to 100 career wins at Maryland, Szeffc spent seven seasons (1996-2002) at the helm of the Marist College baseball program, where he led the team to four conference championships, four NCAA Regional appearances and a 212-137-3 (.607) overall mark. Szeffc earned Northeastern Conference Coach of the Year honors in 1997 and was the American Baseball Coaches

Associate Northeast Region Coach of the Year in 2001.

The first coach in Maryland history to ever take the Terrapins to an NCAA Super Regional, Szeffc accomplished the feat twice in 2014 and 2015 as he guided the program to the first two 40-win seasons in school history and claimed Maryland's first two NCAA Regional crowns. Maryland achieved a final No. 14 ranking both seasons, the highest finishes in school history.

He guided the Terrapins to the ACC Tournament final for the first time in 38 years in 2014 and then took Maryland to the Big Ten tournament final in the school's initial season in that conference, winning a program-best 42 games in 2015.

Szeffc has coached 109 players that have been drafted or signed professional contracts since 1997, including four in 2018 and five in 2019. Over the last eight drafts, 36 of his players have been selected, including the 45th pick of the 2014 draft Jake Stinnett, the highest pick of a Maryland player in almost a decade. Almost a dozen have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, including most recently, Mike Shawaryn (Red Sox) and Lamonte Wade (Twins) in 2019. He has also helped develop 26 All-Americans, including 10 of the 20 players in Maryland history to earn that distinction.

The Middletown, N.Y. native arrived at Maryland after a two-year stint as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas State (2011-12) and a two-season stay as assistant head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas (2009-10). He also enjoyed a six-season tenure as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Louisiana-Lafayette (2003-08). Szeffc began his coaching career as an assistant at Sacred Heart (1995) and at Drexel (1990-93).

Szeffc managed the New York Generals in the Atlantic College Baseball League during the summers of 1995 and 1996. He led the club to a 47-28 record, earned two consecutive division titles and the ACBL title game in 1996.

Collegiately, he played two years at Connecticut before transferring in 1987 to Drexel. During his senior campaign for the Dragons, he was tabbed an All-East Coast Conference outfielder.

He graduated from Drexel University with a degree in corporate communications in 1989. He also holds a master's degree in sports administration from Temple University.

Szeffc and his wife, Barbara, have a daughter, Anna, and two sons, John Michael and Sam.
