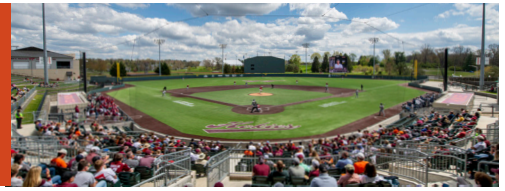

KEY STORYLINES

THE COMMONWEALTH CLASH

- Winner of six consecutive ACC series, Virginia Tech pulls into Charlottesville for the first time since 2018 eager to make a statement against its most loathsome rival.
- The Hokies are seeking their first series victory against the Cavaliers since 2015 – the year Virginia went on to win the national championship.
- For the first time during its ACC tenure, Tech will square off against Virginia as the higher-ranked program.
- The Hokies are ranked as a top-10 club inside five of the six major college baseball polls, highlighted by their *D1Baseball*-record No. 7 ranking that trumps the Cavaliers by four spots.
- As they are in the polls, Tech and Virginia are also neck and

neck in the ACC Coastal Division standings.

- Entering Friday, the second-place Hokies are percentage points ahead of the third-place Cavaliers in both the divisional and league races.
- This weekend's series winner between Tech and Virginia will most certainly boast the strongest postseason resume among the two sides with aspirations of hosting during NCAA Regional weekend.
- For the Hokies, a series win at Virginia would only strengthen their No. 19 RPI ranking while chalking their fifth series victory against *D1Baseball*'s top 25 poll.
- Not to mention, Tech would also clinch the Commonwealth Clash trophy for the athletic department should it champion its weekend on the diamond against the Cavaliers.

SPOTLIGHT SLUGGERS

- Two of the nation's top sluggers will collide at Davenport Field this weekend when Virginia Tech's Jack Hurley crosses bats with Virginia's Jake Gelof.
- While Hurley leads the ACC with the country's fourth best batting average (.430), Gelof ranks sixth nationally in slugging percentage (.822) – three positions ahead of his Blacksburg counterpart.
- With a pair of two-baggers hit during Wednesday's 11-8 victory against James Madison, Hurley became the first Tech player since 2017 to eclipse 20 doubles (Tom Stoffel), putting him in a tie for second nationally this season behind UNLV's Joey Walls (22).
- Where Hurley has edged Gelof in doubles, Gelof has outperformed him in home runs, rounding the bases 16 times to Hurley's 11 trips. Behind Hurley

and Gelof are two equally dominant lineups in the Hokies and the Cavaliers.

- Virginia Tech's .320 team batting average ranks as the fourth highest in the country – one position behind third-ranked Virginia (.323).

ALL WE DO IS WIN

- Virginia Tech is chasing its first 30-win season since 2013 when the Hokies posted a 40-22 record on their way to hosting the NCAA Blacksburg Regional.

- Tech's 29 victories this season are the most the program has achieved under fifth-year head coach John Szefc, who has eclipsed 30 wins on 10 occasions.

- Since March 19, the Hokies have won 19 of their last 22 games, including a 12-3 mark against the ACC and a 7-3 record against opponents ranked in *D1Baseball's* top 25.

- During the stretch, weekend starters Griffin Green and Drue Hackenberg have combined to lead Tech to a 10-0 record during their appearances.

- Heading into the Virginia series, Hackenberg is one of six NCAA Division I pitchers with a record of 8-0 or better and has thrown the most innings (60) among freshmen with eight or more winning decisions this season.

RIDING THE WAVES

- Virginia Tech doubled down on its No. 8 ranking last week, turning in a 5-0 record against VMI, Radford and Boston College (three-game sweep) to eclipse 28 victories for the first time since the 2013 campaign.

- Tech's five-game winning streak was paired with slight adversity as the Hokies came from behind to win three contests, erasing a five-run deficit against the Keydets at English Field.

- Despite sweeping the Eagles during ACC play, Tech witnessed one of its quieter offensive performances, yielding three-game series lows in runs scored (14), hits (22) and home runs (three).

- Although scoring dipped, the Hokies emerged as a team capable of winning close ballgames.

- Prior to its series at BC, Tech had been 1-8 this season when scoring six runs or fewer – a trend the Hokies overcame during each of their victories against the Eagles.

- Shortstop Tanner Schobel and catcher Cade Hunter co-lead Tech with 13 home runs apiece while pacing the squad with 54 and 52 RBIs, respectively.

- On Tuesday, Hunter and Schobel were both named to *D1Baseball's* list of the top six Draft Risers for the 2022 MLB Draft.

Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock announced the hiring of Tech's 25th head baseball coach on June 9, 2017 and formally introduced John Szeffc as the head coach of the baseball program at a press conference a few days later on June 15. The 2021 season will mark his fourth as the Hokies' head coach.

In his first three seasons, Szeffc (pronounced SHEFF) has coached the Hokies to a pair of seven-game winning streaks - one that opened the 2019 season and the second was in 2020, after the team started 1-3. Also in 2020, the team won 10 games in nonconference action, which included ending the shortened season on a nine-game winning streak, the longest since the team won 18 straight nonconference games in a row back in 2012.

The team also posted an 8-0 home record, the best start at the school since 2012, which helped the Hokies extend their home winning streak in the month of February to 15 straight victories. Added to the final win of 2019, Tech has won nine straight at home, the longest since an 11-game streak from April 28, 2015 through March 4, 2016, and will enter the 2021 season tied for the 12th longest home-win streak in the NCAA.

After the shortened 2020 season, three players earned All-America distinction from Collegiate Baseball Newspaper as it recognized both pitcher Ian Seymour and catcher Carson Taylor as Third Team selections, marking the first time Tech had multiple All-Americans since 2003. Outfielder Gavin Cross was later named to the All-American Freshman Team, just the seventh ever at the school. Also, despite just a five-round MLB Draft in 2020, the draft marked the first time in school history, two Tech players are chosen in the top four rounds as Seymour (2nd) and Taylor (4th) were selected.

Szeffc, who won his 400th career game on March 10, 2018 guiding the Hokies to a 3-1 victory over Pittsburgh, accepted the head coaching position at Tech after leading Maryland to three NCAA appearances and a 180-122 (.596) overall record as the Terrapins' head coach. Before arriving in Blacksburg, Szeffc owned a 392-259-3 (.602) career record in 12 seasons as an NCAA head coach, producing 10 campaigns with 30 or more wins.

In addition to ending a 43-year NCAA tournament drought and becoming the fastest coach to 100 career wins at Maryland, Szeffc spent seven seasons (1996-2002) at the helm of the Marist College baseball program, where he led the team to four conference championships, four NCAA Regional appearances and a 212-137-3 (.607) overall mark. Szeffc earned Northeastern Conference Coach of the Year honors in 1997 and was the American Baseball Coaches

Associate Northeast Region Coach of the Year in 2001.

The first coach in Maryland history to ever take the Terrapins to an NCAA Super Regional, Szeffc accomplished the feat twice in 2014 and 2015 as he guided the program to the first two 40-win seasons in school history and claimed Maryland's first two NCAA Regional crowns. Maryland achieved a final No. 14 ranking both seasons, the highest finishes in school history.

He guided the Terrapins to the ACC Tournament final for the first time in 38 years in 2014 and then took Maryland to the Big Ten tournament final in the school's initial season in that conference, winning a program-best 42 games in 2015.

Szeffc has coached 109 players that have been drafted or signed professional contracts since 1997, including four in 2018 and five in 2019. Over the last eight drafts, 36 of his players have been selected, including the 45th pick of the 2014 draft Jake Stinnett, the highest pick of a Maryland player in almost a decade. Almost a dozen have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, including most recently, Mike Shawaryn (Red Sox) and Lamonte Wade (Twins) in 2019. He has also helped develop 26 All-Americans, including 10 of the 20 players in Maryland history to earn that distinction.

The Middletown, N.Y. native arrived at Maryland after a two-year stint as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas State (2011-12) and a two-season stay as assistant head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas (2009-10). He also enjoyed a six-season tenure as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Louisiana-Lafayette (2003-08). Szeffc began his coaching career as an assistant at Sacred Heart (1995) and at Drexel (1990-93).

Szeffc managed the New York Generals in the Atlantic College Baseball League during the summers of 1995 and 1996. He led the club to a 47-28 record, earned two consecutive division titles and the ACBL title game in 1996.

Collegiately, he played two years at Connecticut before transferring in 1987 to Drexel. During his senior campaign for the Dragons, he was tabbed an All-East Coast Conference outfielder.

He graduated from Drexel University with a degree in corporate communications in 1989. He also holds a master's degree in sports administration from Temple University.

Szeffc and his wife, Barbara, have a daughter, Anna, and two sons, John Michael and Sam.
