KEY STORYLINES

TECH'S .400 CLUB

- Virginia Tech is one of seven NCAA Division I programs equipped with two or more qualifying hitters who are batting .400 or higher this season (Jack Hurley - .464, Cade Hunter - .409).
- Hurley pulls into Tech's series against NC State swinging one of the hottest bats in America.
- The Hokies' cleanup outfielder leads the nation in batting average while ranking second in slugging percentage (.928) and third in OPS (1.459).
- With 13 doubles, a triple and 10 home runs to his name, Hurley played his way onto the 2022 Golden Spikes Award midseason watch list, which gave a snapshot of the 45 high school or college athletes whose accolades best aligned with being named this year's top U.S. amateur baseball player.

- On Thursday, he was named to D1Baseball's Midseason All-America Team, of which seven of the 19 selections hailed from the ACC.
- Hurley and Hunter have safely reached base during each of their 24 respective appearances this season with Hurley turning in an active 24-game hitting streak that ties for Tech's ACC-era record with Steve Domecus (2009).
- Hunter has raised his batting average by 55 points across his last six games, during which he has hit 13-for-23 (.565), launched three home runs and totaled 10 RBIs.

HOKIE HURLERS

- Overshadowed by its red-hot offensive performance last week, Virginia Tech's starting pitching tandem of sophomore Griffin Green and rookie Drue Hackenberg was a key reason why the Hokies were able to secure their first-ever away

- series win at No. 18 North Carolina.
- Together, Green and Hackenberg combined to toss 11 innings against the ranked Tar Heels without conceding an earned run, picking up two winning decisions that delivered the Hokies their fourth and fifth consecutive ACC victories.
- Through his first six collegiate starts and seven appearances this season, Hackenberg has toed a 5-0 record and a 2.37 ERA, having struck out 33 batters and issued five walks.
- While not a dominate strikeout staff, Tech's hurlers have still been effective, moving into the conference's pack of seven teams with ERAs below 4.00.
- The Hokies have also allowed the league's second fewest walks (97) this season, as well as conceded its second fewest home runs (18).

SERIES PERSPECTIVE

- As it did against No. 18 North Carolina last weekend, Virginia Tech is looking to stage a historic weekend against No. 21 NC State on its home turf.

- The Hokies have yet to defeat the Wolfpack during a multi-game series, coming up winless during their 11 ACC regular season tries since joining the league in 2005.

- Tech has fared well against ranked teams this season, posting a 3-4 record against D1Baseball top 25 opponents, including two one-run defeats in March while beginning its ACC schedule at No. 13 Georgia Tech.

- Offensively, the Hokies trump the Wolfpack in nearly all offensive categories, maintaining a slight head-to-head lead in ERA and a healthy advantage in fielding percentage.

POLL VAULT

- Virginia Tech has been on a forward trajectory since exploding for 22 runs against Pitt on March 19, pulling into its series against NC State having won eight of its last nine games.

- After knocking off No. 12 Notre Dame in South Bend on March 25 – and picking up their fifth straight win at VMI (March 29) – the Hokies bullied No. 18 North Carolina, winning the opening two games of the weekend to clinch their first-ever road series against the Tar Heels.

- With three top-20 victories under its belt (per D1Baseball), each earned away from home, Tech cracked its first national poll of the season on

Monday, placing at No. 23 in Perfect Game's top 25 rankings.

- The Hokies held strong as the outlet's sixth best ACC team, leapfrogging UNC, who dropped from No. 22 out of Perfect Game's top 25 (dipping from No. 18 to No. 22 per D1Baseball).

GOING, GOING, GONE!

- Personifying its "Hammerin' Hokies" moniker, Virginia Tech totaled 12 home runs during its 3-1 week against VMI and No. 18 North Carolina – the most the Hokies have registered during a calendar week this season.

- Three Tech players registered multi-homer games last week, beginning with Cade Hunter during his 5-for-5 night at VMI (March 29) and ending in bizarre fashion on April 1 at UNC.

- During the first and fourth innings of the Hokies' 12-1 win against the Tar Heels, Gavin Cross and Tanner Schobel recorded two instances of hitting back-to-back home runs, achieving the rare feat together for the first time during Tech's ACC tenure.

- Cross went on to tack on a third home run against UNC during Sunday's series finale, bringing his season count to five that stands now behind Jack Hurley (10), Eduardo Malinowski (10), Carson DeMartini (eight) and Cade Hunter (eight).

- In total, the "Hammerin' Hokies" have drilled 58 home runs this season – more than they compiled across the entire 2021 season (52). Tech's 58 homers also rank as the fourth most among NCAA Division I programs this spring while the Hokies' 2.32 home runs per game average is second in the nation only to No. 1 Tennessee.

Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock announced the hiring of Tech's 25th head baseball coach on June 9, 2017 and formally introduced John Szeffc as the head coach of the baseball program at a press conference a few days later on June 15. The 2021 season will mark his fourth as the Hokies' head coach.

In his first three seasons, Szeffc (pronounced SHEFF) has coached the Hokies to a pair of seven-game winning streaks - one that opened the 2019 season and the second was in 2020, after the team started 1-3. Also in 2020, the team won 10 games in nonconference action, which included ending the shortened season on a nine-game winning streak, the longest since the team won 18 straight nonconference games in a row back in 2012.

The team also posted an 8-0 home record, the best start at the school since 2012, which helped the Hokies extend their home winning streak in the month of February to 15 straight victories. Added to the final win of 2019, Tech has won nine straight at home, the longest since an 11-game streak from April 28, 2015 through March 4, 2016, and will enter the 2021 season tied for the 12th longest home-win streak in the NCAA.

After the shortened 2020 season, three players earned All-America distinction from Collegiate Baseball Newspaper as it recognized both pitcher Ian Seymour and catcher Carson Taylor as Third Team selections, marking the first time Tech had multiple All-Americans since 2003. Outfielder Gavin Cross was later named to the All-American Freshman Team, just the seventh ever at the school. Also, despite just a five-round MLB Draft in 2020, the draft marked the first time in school history, two Tech players are chosen in the top four rounds as Seymour (2nd) and Taylor (4th) were selected.

Szeffc, who won his 400th career game on March 10, 2018 guiding the Hokies to a 3-1 victory over Pittsburgh, accepted the head coaching position at Tech after leading Maryland to three NCAA appearances and a 180-122 (.596) overall record as the Terrapins' head coach. Before arriving in Blacksburg, Szeffc owned a 392-259-3 (.602) career record in 12 seasons as an NCAA head coach, producing 10 campaigns with 30 or more wins.

In addition to ending a 43-year NCAA tournament drought and becoming the fastest coach to 100 career wins at Maryland, Szeffc spent seven seasons (1996-2002) at the helm of the Marist College baseball program, where he led the team to four conference championships, four NCAA Regional appearances and a 212-137-3 (.607) overall mark. Szeffc earned Northeastern Conference Coach of the Year honors in 1997 and was the American Baseball Coaches

Associate Northeast Region Coach of the Year in 2001.

The first coach in Maryland history to ever take the Terrapins to an NCAA Super Regional, Szeffc accomplished the feat twice in 2014 and 2015 as he guided the program to the first two 40-win seasons in school history and claimed Maryland's first two NCAA Regional crowns. Maryland achieved a final No. 14 ranking both seasons, the highest finishes in school history.

He guided the Terrapins to the ACC Tournament final for the first time in 38 years in 2014 and then took Maryland to the Big Ten tournament final in the school's initial season in that conference, winning a program-best 42 games in 2015.

Szeffc has coached 109 players that have been drafted or signed professional contracts since 1997, including four in 2018 and five in 2019. Over the last eight drafts, 36 of his players have been selected, including the 45th pick of the 2014 draft Jake Stinnett, the highest pick of a Maryland player in almost a decade. Almost a dozen have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, including most recently, Mike Shawaryn (Red Sox) and Lamonte Wade (Twins) in 2019. He has also helped develop 26 All-Americans, including 10 of the 20 players in Maryland history to earn that distinction.

The Middletown, N.Y. native arrived at Maryland after a two-year stint as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas State (2011-12) and a two-season stay as assistant head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas (2009-10). He also enjoyed a six-season tenure as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Louisiana-Lafayette (2003-08). Szeffc began his coaching career as an assistant at Sacred Heart (1995) and at Drexel (1990-93).

Szeffc managed the New York Generals in the Atlantic College Baseball League during the summers of 1995 and 1996. He led the club to a 47-28 record, earned two consecutive division titles and the ACBL title game in 1996.

Collegiately, he played two years at Connecticut before transferring in 1987 to Drexel. During his senior campaign for the Dragons, he was tabbed an All-East Coast Conference outfielder.

He graduated from Drexel University with a degree in corporate communications in 1989. He also holds a master's degree in sports administration from Temple University.

Szeffc and his wife, Barbara, have a daughter, Anna, and two sons, John Michael and Sam.
