KEY STORYLINES

HOKIES AT A GLANCE

- After sweeping its two non-conference games last week, Virginia Tech maintained its No. 5 national ranking courtesy of *D1Baseball*, as did each of the outlet's top six programs.
- On Monday, Tech remained the highest-ranked ACC squad in four of the six leading college baseball polls, shortening the range of its distribution between No. 3 and No. 7 after moving up a spot in *Collegiate Baseball Newspaper's* top 30.
- Through games completed on May 9, the Hokies come in at No. 8 in the NCAA Division I Baseball RPI - a testament to their 16-8 record against the RPI top 100, their 14 wins against the ACC (No. 2 conference RPI) and their eight consecutive weekend series victories (including a 1-0 record during their weather-shortened series at then-No. 12 Notre Dame).

- Statistically, Tech continues to boast one of the best power lineups in the nation.
- As of May 9, the Hokies house the second highest slugging percentage (.576) and the eighth best batting average (.315), leading the country in doubles per game (2.70) while ranking third in home runs per game (2.00).
- Additionally, Tech's 4.19 team ERA places among the top 35 programs nationally.

FROM THE ARM BARN

- Overshadowed by its red-hot offense and two talented starting pitchers, Virginia Tech's bullpen has been a reliable stake in the Hokies' recent stretch of success.
- Since March 19, Tech's relievers have sported a 4.02 team ERA, accounted for a 13-1 chunk of the Hokies' 23-4 record and closed (seven out of seven) save situations.

- During its 27-game run, Tech's pen has held opponents to a .244 opposing batting average while racking up 156 strikeouts across 130 relief innings.
- Within the Hokies' last five outings - including their Commonwealth Clash series victory at then-No. 11 Virginia - Tech's relief core has flexed a 0.81 ERA, allowing two earned runs across 22 and one-third innings pitched while scattering nine hits (.123 opposing batting average).

- Fourth-year junior Graham Firoved has emerged as the Hokies' best option out of the bullpen, controlling a 3.74 ERA across his 17 appearances this season, flaming 53 strikeouts across 33 and two-third innings of work.

BURN NOTICE

- Virginia Tech had to work for its April 12 midweek victory in Lynchburg, fighting fire with fire during its 10-6 win against Liberty at Worthington Field.

- Fifth-year left-hander Ryan Kennedy matched the Flames' starter, Trey Gibson, with three shutout innings before the Hokies broke the ice during the top of the fourth inning, rallying for four runs behind Cade Hunter's RBI double.

- However, Liberty clawed back during the bottom of the fifth inning, bringing nine batters to the plate to level the game at 4-4.

- Gavin Cross delivered Tech its final lead during the top of the seventh inning, connecting on the leadoff homer that sent the Hokies on their way to score six late-inning runs.

- Nick Holesa enjoyed his best game of the season, batting 3-for-5 with two doubles as Tech snapped its three-game series losing skid to the Flames.

- Virginia Tech enters Wednesday's contest in search of its first home victory against Liberty since 2013 (lost each of its last four opportunities).

- The Hokies' most recent calendar-year sweep of the Flames occurred during 2011.

FEATHERS IN CAPS

- After prevailing against No. 11 Virginia in Charlottesville – its first ACC series win at the site of its in-state rival – Virginia Tech leaped two spots in *D1Baseball's* top 25 rankings, cracking the top five for the first time during its program history.

- The Hokies were rewarded dearly for their series performance against the Cavaliers that was accented by Sunday's comeback victory from four runs down.

- Upon clinching its seventh straight ACC series, Tech climbed inside the top 10 of the NCAA Division I Baseball RPI, vaulting to No. 6 through games played as of May 5.

- Predicted to finish sixth in the ACC Coastal Division at the beginning of the season, the Hokies have far exceeded expectations, polishing a postseason resume that ranks among the elite in college baseball.

- The Hokies have won four of their five multi-game series against opponents ranked in *D1Baseball's* top 25 rankings and are 16-8 this season against the top 100 RPI programs.

- As it stands, Tech's postseason resume is most worthy of hosting during NCAA Regional weekend and also has the Hokies on the verge of earning a top-eight national seed.

INSIDE THE ACC RACE

- With two weeks remaining in the regular season, Virginia Tech (14-8 ACC) sits in sole possession of second place in the ACC Coastal Division.

- Upon topping Virginia two games to one in Charlottesville, the Hokies strengthened their control over the league's No. 3 seed, which would place Tech in Pool C at the 2022 ACC Baseball Championship in Charlotte (opposite seeds No. 6 and No. 10).

- Since joining the ACC, the Hokies' best Coastal Division finishes are third-place results in 2013 and 2015 while their best conference-wide regular season finishes are sixth-place results in 2010 and 2013.

Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock announced the hiring of Tech's 25th head baseball coach on June 9, 2017 and formally introduced John Szeffc as the head coach of the baseball program at a press conference a few days later on June 15. The 2021 season will mark his fourth as the Hokies' head coach.

In his first three seasons, Szeffc (pronounced SHEFF) has coached the Hokies to a pair of seven-game winning streaks - one that opened the 2019 season and the second was in 2020, after the team started 1-3. Also in 2020, the team won 10 games in nonconference action, which included ending the shortened season on a nine-game winning streak, the longest since the team won 18 straight nonconference games in a row back in 2012.

The team also posted an 8-0 home record, the best start at the school since 2012, which helped the Hokies extend their home winning streak in the month of February to 15 straight victories. Added to the final win of 2019, Tech has won nine straight at home, the longest since an 11-game streak from April 28, 2015 through March 4, 2016, and will enter the 2021 season tied for the 12th longest home-win streak in the NCAA.

After the shortened 2020 season, three players earned All-America distinction from Collegiate Baseball Newspaper as it recognized both pitcher Ian Seymour and catcher Carson Taylor as Third Team selections, marking the first time Tech had multiple All-Americans since 2003. Outfielder Gavin Cross was later named to the All-American Freshman Team, just the seventh ever at the school. Also, despite just a five-round MLB Draft in 2020, the draft marked the first time in school history, two Tech players are chosen in the top four rounds as Seymour (2nd) and Taylor (4th) were selected.

Szeffc, who won his 400th career game on March 10, 2018 guiding the Hokies to a 3-1 victory over Pittsburgh, accepted the head coaching position at Tech after leading Maryland to three NCAA appearances and a 180-122 (.596) overall record as the Terrapins' head coach. Before arriving in Blacksburg, Szeffc owned a 392-259-3 (.602) career record in 12 seasons as an NCAA head coach, producing 10 campaigns with 30 or more wins.

In addition to ending a 43-year NCAA tournament drought and becoming the fastest coach to 100 career wins at Maryland, Szeffc spent seven seasons (1996-2002) at the helm of the Marist College baseball program, where he led the team to four conference championships, four NCAA Regional appearances and a 212-137-3 (.607) overall mark. Szeffc earned Northeastern Conference Coach of the Year honors in 1997 and was the American Baseball Coaches

Associate Northeast Region Coach of the Year in 2001.

The first coach in Maryland history to ever take the Terrapins to an NCAA Super Regional, Szeffc accomplished the feat twice in 2014 and 2015 as he guided the program to the first two 40-win seasons in school history and claimed Maryland's first two NCAA Regional crowns. Maryland achieved a final No. 14 ranking both seasons, the highest finishes in school history.

He guided the Terrapins to the ACC Tournament final for the first time in 38 years in 2014 and then took Maryland to the Big Ten tournament final in the school's initial season in that conference, winning a program-best 42 games in 2015.

Szeffc has coached 109 players that have been drafted or signed professional contracts since 1997, including four in 2018 and five in 2019. Over the last eight drafts, 36 of his players have been selected, including the 45th pick of the 2014 draft Jake Stinnett, the highest pick of a Maryland player in almost a decade. Almost a dozen have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, including most recently, Mike Shawaryn (Red Sox) and Lamonte Wade (Twins) in 2019. He has also helped develop 26 All-Americans, including 10 of the 20 players in Maryland history to earn that distinction.

The Middletown, N.Y. native arrived at Maryland after a two-year stint as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas State (2011-12) and a two-season stay as assistant head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas (2009-10). He also enjoyed a six-season tenure as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Louisiana-Lafayette (2003-08). Szeffc began his coaching career as an assistant at Sacred Heart (1995) and at Drexel (1990-93).

Szeffc managed the New York Generals in the Atlantic College Baseball League during the summers of 1995 and 1996. He led the club to a 47-28 record, earned two consecutive division titles and the ACBL title game in 1996.

Collegiately, he played two years at Connecticut before transferring in 1987 to Drexel. During his senior campaign for the Dragons, he was tabbed an All-East Coast Conference outfielder.

He graduated from Drexel University with a degree in corporate communications in 1989. He also holds a master's degree in sports administration from Temple University.

Szeffc and his wife, Barbara, have a daughter, Anna, and two sons, John Michael and Sam.
