### KEY STORYLINES

#### SCOUTING UNCW

- The Seahawks finished 4-23 a season ago with a 3-13 conference record in the CAA
- UNCW's wins came over North Alabama (3-1), Northeastern (3-1), James Madison (3-2) and William & Mary
- Katie Lanz and Brooke Hanshumaker return as the Seahawk's offensive leads. Lanz paced UNCW in kills with 261 and Hanshumaker led the team with a .213 hitting percentage
- UNCW also adds two transfers in Morgan Galligan and Caitlyn Callahan. Galligan began her career as a setter at Hartford while Callahan was a highly decorated middle at Millersville

#### SCOUTING COASTAL

- The Chanticleers posted a 19-9 overall mark last season with a 12-4 clip in conference play
- Coastal was picked to win the Sun Belt East Division, picking up seven first-place votes with 90 total points
- An All-Sun Belt setter, Brigitta Petrenko returns after tallying her 2,000th career assist a season ago, while also leading the conference with 48 service aces
- Lina Perugini led the team with 445 digs and a .953 service reception percentage, returning for her senior season
- Returning after a medical redshirt, Ella Saada saw action in 22 sets in 2021, finishing with 53 kills and 12 blocks

#### SCOUTING DAVIDSON

- The Wildcats went 14-13 in 2021 with a 10-6 mark in conference play. Head coach Chris Willis was named the A-10 Co-Coach of the Year following last season
- Davidson was picked to finish fifth in the preseason poll, the program's highest preseason nod since the 2014-15 season
- Defensive Player of the Year Bella Brady returns for the Wildcats, posting 542 digs a season ago with 5.37 digs per set
- Offensively, Isabel Decker was second on the team in kills with 227 and points with 259.5 points over 85 sets
- Xuan Nguyen was the assist leader with 530, posting 5.25 assists per set last season

## TECH 2021 RECAP

- Finished the season with a 12-18 overall record and 3-15 mark in conference play
- Defeated rival Virginia for the second straight season, taking down the Cavaliers 3-2 in Charlottesville
- Posted ACC wins over Boston College (3-1) and Wake Forest (3-1). Closed out the ACC schedule winning two of its last three matches
- Returns overall assists and digs leaders from a season ago in Brie Postema and Logan Mosley
- Postema finished 2021 with 538 total assists and 6.18 assists per set. She helped lead the Hokies in their victory over Virginia, recording a season-high 47 assists in the win
- Mosley tallied her 1,000th career dig a season ago and led the team with 409 total digs. She posted 3.62 digs per set and a .960 reception percentage

## TOUGH TRANSFERS

- The 2022 roster for the Hokies features six transfers: Cara Lewis, Maddie Slagle, Reagan Goeke, Sydney Petersen, Jenna Appel and Ava Francis
- Lewis, a transfer from Maryland, ranked first on the team, second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally with 1.54 blocks per set. Totaled 126 total blocks which also led the team
- Another Big Ten transfer, Slagle posted 760 digs in her career with Iowa, finishing with 1.959 digs per set, as well as 52 aces
- Goeke and Petersen will also join the Hokie block as transfers, with Goeke coming from Pepperdine and Petersen from Nevada. Francis comes to Blacksburg as an outside hitter, spending fall of 2021 at Arizona
- The Hokies add another setter in Jenna Appel from Loyola Chicago. As a sophomore, she finished with 605 assists and 26 aces. She also ranked 13th in the MVC with 5.00 assists per set

## FRESH FACES

- Along with the six transfers, the Hokies also add nine freshmen to the squad for this season
- Three of those freshmen were early enrollees and played the 2021 spring season for the Hokies; Sierra Cates, Hanna Borer and Lauren Fowler
- The other six joined the Hokies this summer and look to make an immediate impact on the young squad

## NEWCOMER FAST FACTS

- #0 Hanna Borer – Broke her high school record for assists in a single season with 798, also reached 1,000 career assists
- #1 Lauren Fowler – Helped her high school team to three State Championships and was named the 2020 Region Player of the Year, State Player of the Year and All-State honoree
- #6 Cara Lewis – Helped Maryland become Big Ten's best blocking team for the second

straight season, ranking first on the team, second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally with 1.54 blocks per set

- #8 Josie Bloom - Named to the AVCA Phenom List in 2020 and 2021. Also named the No. 1 ranked L/DS in the state of Michigan by PrepDig
- #9 Sierra Cates – Helped her high school team reach the second round of the State Championship Tournament and was named to the County All-Star Team
- #10 Maddie Slagle – Finished her career at Iowa with 760 digs and 1.96 digs per set. As a junior, ranked second on the team with 128 digs and tallied seven or more digs 10 times
- #11 Amaya Roberson – Named to the USA Volleyball Junior National Championships All-Tournament Team and helped her club team to a third-place finish at AAU Nationals
- #16 Sarah Malinowski – Posted an attack percentage of .370 or above in five different matches, with a high of .680 in high school. Also named to the JVA Watchlist (2019-2021)
- #17 Aerin Bowman – Made the All-Tournament Team at USAV Nationals and the 2021 AAU All-tournament Team in 2021
- #18 Lucky-Rose Williams – Earned First Team All-Conference and All-State honors, while helping her team to a Top-5 ranking in the state of Hawaii
- #19 Reagan Goeke – In a season at Pepperdine, finished the year with 19 kills, .54 kills per set and 31 points. Posted 20 blocks with only two errors
- #20 Sydney Petersen – As a junior at Nevada, placed first on the team in blocks (98), second in kills (223). As a freshman, set a new single season program record with 137 block assists
- #23 Jenna Appel – Played two seasons at Loyola Chicago and ranked 13th in the MVC as a sophomore with 5.00 assists per set. She also had eight double-doubles with 605 total assists
- #24 Ava Francis – Named to the PrepVolleyball Phenom List and ranked the No. 2 recruit in the state of Ohio. Also named an AVCA All-Region Team member, All-American Honorable Mention and an Under Armour All-American
- #26 Jordan Hallman – AVCA Second Team All-American and National All-Region Team in 2021. Ranked second in the state of Tennessee with a .428 hitting percentage and ranked 22nd nationally with 313 kills in high school

## TOURNAMENT SZN

- The Hokies went 9-3 in non-conference tournament play last season, going undefeated in the Virginia Tech Invitational to open the season
- Tech posted wins over Lehigh, Toledo and Elon to open the 2021 season 3-0. They followed that up with a win over Georgia State, before falling to North Florida in the UNF Invitational
- Other notable wins a season ago in non-conference include Chattanooga, Tennessee Tech, George Mason and Wofford

## HOKIE BLOCK PARTY

- A season ago, Virginia Tech ranked fifth nationally in total blocks midway through the season
- Tech ended the year with 259.5 blocks per season vs 205.5 posted by opponents throughout the season
- With 2.30 blocks per set, the Hokies also led opponents compared to 1.82 by opponents
- Cera Powell returns as a member of the Hokie block, posting 29 total a season ago. Cara Lewis, Sydney Petersen, Anabel Zier, Reagan Goeke and Jordan Hallman look to add some depth as well to the position group

## SEASON OPENERS

- The Hokies are 7-0 since 2014 in season openers, with their last season-opening loss coming at the hands of Butler on Aug. 29, 2014
- A season ago, Tech took down Lehigh 3-2 at the Virginia Tech Invitational. Elayna Duprey led the way with 11 kills and Cera Powell added 10
- Logan Mosley posted 23 digs and Mara Perry led the team with 21 assists

Marci Byers was named the sixth head coach of the Virginia Tech volleyball program in January, 2020. She enters her third season at the helm of the Hokies.

During her first season with Tech, the team tallied five conference wins including a sweep of Virginia and a win over then No. 14 Duke in five sets. The Hokies defeated Virginia in 2021 as well, taking down the Cavaliers in five sets. Tech also defeated Boston College and Wake Forest in ACC play during Byers' second season at the helm. Byers looks to build off the 2021 season with many key returners and 15 newcomers set to make an impact.

A four-time Big South Coach of the Year selection at Radford University, she is the winningest coach in Highlanders' history, leading the program to three Big South regular season titles, two Big South Tournament championships and two NCAA Tournament berths. She is one of only five head coaches in Big South history to register 200 or more career victories.

Throughout her tenure at Radford, the Chicago native consistently recruited top talent to the New River Valley from across the country, thanks to her strong relationships within the ACC footprint, as well as with elite club programs in the Midwest, Texas and California.

Byers' squads at Radford topped the 20-win mark five times over seven seasons and compiled an 81-34 (.708) overall record over four years. She led the Highlanders to a 22-7 record in 2018, including a 12-4 mark in Big South play. They reached the Big South Tournament title game for the second consecutive season and were selected to play in the National Invitational Volleyball Championship where they defeated App State in the first round. During her tenure at Radford, her student-athletes twice registered the top team GPA of any program at the school (2008 and 2013).

No stranger to defeating Power Five foes, under her direction in 2017 the Highlanders registered wins at Arizona, at South Carolina and at Virginia Tech en route to a Big South Tournament title and an NCAA Tournament berth. In 2016, Byers led Radford to a 24-6 record, including a perfect 11-0 mark at home and a Big South regular season championship. Her squads also registered wins against Wake Forest in 2016 and Washington State in 2015. Byers' 2014 squad finished with a 24-8

mark that included wins over California and Maryland as Radford claimed the Big South regular season title. The Highlanders earned their first NCAA Tournament appearance under Byers in 2013 after winning both the Big South regular season and tournament titles, finishing the season with a 25-10 record.

Prior to beginning her tenure at Radford in 2008, she spent two seasons at NCAA Division II Chowan University in Murfreesboro, N.C. After going 4-17 in her initial season in 2006, Byers guided the Hawks to a 26-11 record as the squad averaged the most aces per game of any Division II squad. Prior to joining the collegiate ranks, she posted a 121-49 record in 10 seasons coaching in the Richmond prep ranks, spending two seasons at Mills Godwin High School and eight years at Hermitage High School.

Byers has also been a successful coach at the club level. Her 2003-04 team qualified for the Junior Olympics in Houston, while her 2004-05 team reached the Junior Olympics in Salt Lake City. She was also invited to participate in the USA Volleyball Coaches Clinic at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs.

She is a 1995 graduate of Virginia Union University where she graduated with honors with a bachelor's degree in secondary education with a concentration in mathematics. A four-year starter on the volleyball team, she captained the team as both a junior and senior. Her husband, J.D., serves as an assistant men's basketball coach at VCU. The couple are parents of a daughter, Kamryn Grey.

NOTEWORTHY

ACC POWER

- Three Atlantic Coast Conference teams are ranked in the preseason American Volleyball Coaches Association Top 25 Poll and all three are in the top 10
- Reigning ACC Champion Louisville is No. 4 in the preseason poll, followed by No. 6 Pitt and No. 9 Georgia Tech. Both the Cardinals and Panthers advanced to last season's NCAA Championship semifinals and each finished with more than 30 wins.
- Georgia Tech's No. 9 ranking is the highest preseason ranking in program history. Miami, North Carolina and Florida State also received votes in the poll.

OPPONENT HISTORY

- The Hokies are a combined 11-1 against their opponents this weekend, with the one loss against Coastal Carolina in 2002
- Against UNCW, Tech is 3-0, with the last meeting a 3-0 win in 2014 in Blacksburg
- The Hokies battled Davidson a season ago at the North Florida Tournament, taking the win 3-2. Logan Mosley posted a season-high 34 digs in the victory and Brie Postema led the team with 29 assists.
- Tech is also 4-0 against Davidson in program history

TALKING DEFENSE

- Last season, Logan Mosley ranked seventh in the conference with 409 total digs and 10th in digs per set with 3.62
- In her 113 sets played, Mosley posted a reception percentage of .960 with only 17 errors in 425 attempts
- The Hokies also add graduate student Maddie Slagle to the libero position, a transfer from Iowa
- Slagle ended her career at Iowa with 760 digs and 1.959 digs per set. As a junior, she ranked second on the team with 128 digs and tallied seven or more digs 10 times.
- Slagle was also good from the service line, ending her career with 52 aces

1,000 ASSISTS

- Junior Brie Postema currently sits at 848 career assists after leading the team as a sophomore a season ago

- In 2021, she posted 538 assists, playing in 26 matches. As a rookie, Postema had 310 assists
- Her current career-high sits at 47 which she achieved in the five-set win against Virginia on Oct. 29, 2021
- Postema averaged 6.18 assists per set last year and also added 24 aces and 48.5 points for the Hokies

C. POWELL

- Cera Powell was one of the most consistent Hokies in the lineup a season ago, playing in 26 matches
- She totaled 223 total points, with 203 kills and 2.56 points per set. She also averaged 2.33 kills per set
- Powell also assists in the Hokie block, ranking fourth on the team with 29 total blocks and .33 blocks per set

PLEDGE PER SET

- The Hokie Club and Virginia Tech Volleyball are challenging Hokie Nation to make a Pledge Per Set Win during the 2022 season
- Donors will be charged their selected pledge amount times the number of sets won by the program at the conclusion of the season

ON THE ROAD

- The Hokies posted a 3-1 record at neutral sites a season ago with a 2-9 mark in road matches
- Notable wins at neutral sites include a win over Georgia State (3-2) and Davidson (3-2) at the North Florida Tournament, as well as Tennessee Tech (3-0) at the Chattanooga Classic
- In conference play, the Hokies defeated Virginia 3-2 in Charlottesville during the 2021 season
