KEY STORYLINES

SCOUTING BOSTON COLLEGE

- The Eagles are 13-3 on the season, most recently defeating Bryant 3-2 in Chestnut Hill on Wednesday
- Junior outside hitter Alayna Crabtree and sophomore middle blocker Jenna Pollock paced the BC offense against Bryant with 11 kills each. Pollock also added four blocks and two digs
- BC opened up conference play with a 1-1 record, falling to Syracuse 3-2 but defeating Duke 3-2
- Crabtree leads the Eagles offense with 197.5 points, including 161 kills and 25 service aces. She is averaging .46 service aces per set
- Defensively, BC has 151 blocks, almost 30 more than opponents. Julia Haggerty

leads the charge at the net with 72 total, which is first in the ACC

- Anna Murphy has 220 digs on the season, with a .970 reception percentage and 3.67 digs per set

SCOUTING SYRACUSE

- The Orange are 6-6 on the season and opened ACC play 2-0 last weekend, notching wins against Boston College (3-2) and Duke (3-1)
- Other notable wins for Syracuse include North Florida (3-0), Campbell (3-1) and Wofford (3-2)
- Polina Shemanova is the points and kills leader for the Orange, recording 201.5 (5th in the ACC) points so far this season (4.29 per set) and 178

kills, which ranks her 4th in the ACC (3.79 per set). She also has 14 blocks on the year

- Lauren Woodford plays a role in Syracuse's offensive success, leading the team in assists with 254. She is averaging 5.40 per set and adds 77 digs
- At the net, Syracuse has 104 total blocks, compared 91.5 from opponents. Raina Hughes has 45 on the year, averaging .96 per set
- In the most recent win over Duke, Polina Shemanova recorded a double-double, registering 14 kills and 20 digs. The setting duo of Riley Hoffman and Lauren Woodford combined for a total of 33 assists, just two less than Duke's total.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Hokies went 1-1 to open ACC play, defeating Clemson 3-2 but falling to Georgia Tech 3-0
- Tech's win at Clemson was its first win over the Tigers since 2019, opening up ACC play 1-0
- The Hokies offense was paced by Ava Francis, who finished with 17 kills on the day (a season-high) while posting a hitting percentage of .452. Cera Powell added 15 kills and Sydney Petersen chipped in with 12 as part of a balanced Virginia Tech attack.
- Defensively, Tech had two players reach double figures in digs as Maddie Slagle had 26 and Hanna Borer had 14. Borer finished the match with a double-double, adding 34 assists in the win.

OFFENSIVE SUCCESS

- The Hokies had one of their best offensive performances against the Tigers last week, hitting .249, including a .387 clip in the first set with 14 kills.
- Sydney Petersen led the team last weekend with 21 kills on 39 attempts, averaging 2.63 per set and an impressive .462 kill percentage in her last two games.
- Right behind her was Cera Powell with 19 kills. Powell leads the team with 129 kills and a 2.93/set average
- The two of them combine for almost 39% of the teams' total kills, currently sitting at 222 out of the 573.

ACC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

- Freshman setter Hanna Borer was named the ACC Freshman of the Week for the first time in her career, the conference announced on Monday
- This is Virginia Tech's first Freshman of the Week honor since Kaitly Smith earned the award in 2017.
- The freshman recorded her fifth double-double of the season in the win over Clemson with 34 assists and 14 digs. She helped the Hokie attack hit at a .249 clip with 68 kills.
- Tech hit over .200 in every set except for one against the Tigers, with a match-high .387 in the first set. Borer also recorded an ace in the win.
- Against No. 13 Georgia Tech, Borer added 18 assists for the Hokies as well as six digs
- On the weekend, Borer totaled 52 assists, averaging 6.50 assists per set and helping the Hokies hit .210 over the weekend. She added 20 digs defensively, with 2.50 per set, as well as adding an ace to her weekend point total.

TOUGH TRANSFERS

- The 2022 roster for the Hokies features six transfers: Cara Lewis, Maddie Slagle, Reagan Goeke, Sydney Petersen, Jenna Appel and Ava

Francis

- Lewis, a transfer from Maryland, ranked first on the team, second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally with 1.54 blocks per set. Totaled 126 total blocks which also led the team
- Another Big Ten transfer, Slagle posted 760 digs in her career with Iowa, finishing with 1.959 digs per set, as well as 52 aces
- Goeke and Petersen will also join the Hokie block as transfers, with Goeke coming from Pepperdine and Petersen from Nevada. Francis comes to Blacksburg as an outside hitter, spending fall of 2021 at Arizona
- The Hokies add another setter in Jenna Appel from Loyola Chicago. As a sophomore, she finished with 605 assists and 26 aces. She also ranked 13th in the MVC with 5.00 assists per set

FRESH FACES

- Along with the six transfers, the Hokies also add nine freshmen to the squad for this season
- Three of those freshmen were early enrollees and played the 2021 spring season for the Hokies; Sierra Cates, Hanna Borer and Lauren Fowler
- The other six joined the Hokies this summer and look to make an immediate impact on the young squad

NEWCOMER FAST FACTS

- #0 Hanna Borer – Broke her high school record for assists in a single season with 798, also reached 1,000 career assists
- #1 Lauren Fowler – Helped her high school team to three State Championships and was named the 2020 Region Player of the Year, State Player of the Year and All-State honoree
- #6 Cara Lewis – Helped Maryland become Big Ten's best blocking team for the second straight season, ranking first on the team, second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally with 1.54 blocks per set
- #8 Josie Bloom - Named to the AVCA Phenom List in 2020 and 2021. Also named the No. 1 ranked L/DS in the state of Michigan by PrepDig
- #9 Sierra Cates – Helped her high school team reach the second round of the State Championship Tournament and was named to the County All-Star Team
- #10 Maddie Slagle – Finished her career at Iowa with 760 digs and 1.96 digs per set. As a junior, ranked second on the team with 128 digs and tallied seven or more digs 10 times
- #11 Amaya Roberson – Named to the USA Volleyball Junior National Championships All-Tournament Team and helped her club team to a third-place finish at AAU Nationals
- #16 Sarah Malinowski – Posted an attack percentage of .370 or above in five different matches, with a high of .680 in high school. Also named to the JVA Watchlist (2019-2021)
- #17 Aerin Bowman – Made the All-Tournament Team at USAV Nationals and the 2021 AAU All-tournament Team in 2021
- #18 Lucky-Rose Williams – Earned First Team

All-Conference and All-State honors, while helping her team to a Top-5 ranking in the state of Hawaii

- #19 Reagan Goeke – In a season at Pepperdine, finished the year with 19 kills, .54 kills per set and 31 points. Posted 20 blocks with only two errors
- #20 Sydney Petersen – As a junior at Nevada, placed first on the team in blocks (98), second in kills (223). As a freshman, set a new single season program record with 137 block assists
- #23 Jenna Appel – Played two seasons at Loyola Chicago and ranked 13th in the MVC as a sophomore with 5.00 assists per set. She also had eight double-doubles with 605 total assists
- #24 Ava Francis – Named to the PrepVolleyball Phenom List and ranked the No. 2 recruit in the state of Ohio. Also named an AVCA All-Region Team member, All-American Honorable Mention and an Under Armour All-American
- #26 Jordan Hallman – AVCA Second Team All-American and National All-Region Team in 2021. Ranked second in the state of Tennessee with a .428 hitting percentage and ranked 22nd nationally with 313 kills in high school

Marci Byers was named the sixth head coach of the Virginia Tech volleyball program in January, 2020. She enters her third season at the helm of the Hokies.

During her first season with Tech, the team tallied five conference wins including a sweep of Virginia and a win over then No. 14 Duke in five sets. The Hokies defeated Virginia in 2021 as well, taking down the Cavaliers in five sets. Tech also defeated Boston College and Wake Forest in ACC play during Byers' second season at the helm. Byers looks to build off the 2021 season with many key returners and 15 newcomers set to make an impact.

A four-time Big South Coach of the Year selection at Radford University, she is the winningest coach in Highlanders' history, leading the program to three Big South regular season titles, two Big South Tournament championships and two NCAA Tournament berths. She is one of only five head coaches in Big South history to register 200 or more career victories.

Throughout her tenure at Radford, the Chicago native consistently recruited top talent to the New River Valley from across the country, thanks to her strong relationships within the ACC footprint, as well as with elite club programs in the Midwest, Texas and California.

Byers' squads at Radford topped the 20-win mark five times over seven seasons and compiled an 81-34 (.708) overall record over four years. She led the Highlanders to a 22-7 record in 2018, including a 12-4 mark in Big South play. They reached the Big South Tournament title game for the second consecutive season and were selected to play in the National Invitational Volleyball Championship where they defeated App State in the first round. During her tenure at Radford, her student-athletes twice registered the top team GPA of any program at the school (2008 and 2013).

No stranger to defeating Power Five foes, under her direction in 2017 the Highlanders registered wins at Arizona, at South Carolina and at Virginia Tech en route to a Big South Tournament title and an NCAA Tournament berth. In 2016, Byers led Radford to a 24-6 record, including a perfect 11-0 mark at home and a Big South regular season championship. Her squads also registered wins against Wake Forest in 2016 and Washington State in 2015. Byers' 2014 squad finished with a 24-8

mark that included wins over California and Maryland as Radford claimed the Big South regular season title. The Highlanders earned their first NCAA Tournament appearance under Byers in 2013 after winning both the Big South regular season and tournament titles, finishing the season with a 25-10 record.

Prior to beginning her tenure at Radford in 2008, she spent two seasons at NCAA Division II Chowan University in Murfreesboro, N.C. After going 4-17 in her initial season in 2006, Byers guided the Hawks to a 26-11 record as the squad averaged the most aces per game of any Division II squad. Prior to joining the collegiate ranks, she posted a 121-49 record in 10 seasons coaching in the Richmond prep ranks, spending two seasons at Mills Godwin High School and eight years at Hermitage High School.

Byers has also been a successful coach at the club level. Her 2003-04 team qualified for the Junior Olympics in Houston, while her 2004-05 team reached the Junior Olympics in Salt Lake City. She was also invited to participate in the USA Volleyball Coaches Clinic at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs.

She is a 1995 graduate of Virginia Union University where she graduated with honors with a bachelor's degree in secondary education with a concentration in mathematics. A four-year starter on the volleyball team, she captained the team as both a junior and senior. Her husband, J.D., serves as an assistant men's basketball coach at VCU. The couple are parents of a daughter, Kamryn Grey.

NOTEWORTHY

ACC POWER

- Three Atlantic Coast Conference teams were ranked in the preseason American Volleyball Coaches Association Top 25 Poll and all three were in the top 10 to enter the season
- Reigning ACC Champion Louisville is No. 2 in this week's poll, followed by No. 10 Pittsburgh and No. 11 Georgia Tech. Both the Cardinals and Panthers advanced to last season's NCAA Championship semifinals and each finished with more than 30 wins.
- Georgia Tech's No. 5 ranking in week 2 was the highest preseason ranking in program history. Miami, North Carolina and Florida State also received votes in the preseason poll.

BLOCKING THE EAGLES

- The Hokies split last year's matches against the Eagles, falling 3-2 at Boston College but defeating BC 3-1 in Blacksburg
- The first match in Boston saw the Hokies set a new season-high in blocks, recording 19 total in the five sets
- Tech followed that up with 18 blocks in the win over BC in Cassell Coliseum, one block short from the season-high they set in the previous match against the Eagles

HOME SWEET CASSELL

- The Hokies are 5-0 so far at Cassell Coliseum this season
- Tech has not dropped a set so far in Cassell, recording all five sweeps this season
- The Hokies are 388-181 in Blacksburg in program history

DEFENSE WINS MATCHES

- Anabel Zier has been solid on defense this season, ranking 6th in the ACC with 1.20 blocks/set and a total of 54 on the season.
- She sits only 0.26/set behind Riley Shaak of N.C. State.
- Zier has had help as Cara Lewis trails Zier by only 12 blocks with a .91 blocks per set.
- Maddie Slagle has also helped out the defense ranking 6th in the ACC with 179 digs with 3.81/set.
- She has led the team in digs this season, producing about 28% of the team's total.

1,000 ASSISTS

- Junior Brie Postema currently sits at 975 career assists after leading the team as a sophomore a season ago
- In 2021, she posted 538 assists, playing in 26 matches. As a rookie, Postema had 310 assists
- Her current career-high sits at 47 which she achieved in the five-set win against Virginia on Oct. 29, 2021
- Postema averaged 6.18 assists per set last year and also added 24 aces and 48.5 points for the Hokies

C. POWELL

- Cera Powell was one of the most consistent Hokies in the lineup a season ago, playing in 26 matches
- She totaled 223 total points, with 203 kills and 2.56 points per set. She also averaged 2.33 kills per set
- She currently leads the team with 129 kills and 2.93 kills per set
- Powell is averaging 3.28 points per set, which is almost more than a point more than the next highest player on the team
- The senior has also made an impact defensively and on the service line, adding 87 digs and 11 service aces

HOKIE BLOCK PARTY

- A season ago, Virginia Tech ranked fifth nationally in total blocks midway through the season
- Tech ended the year with 259.5 blocks per season vs 205.5 posted by opponents throughout the season
- With 2.30 blocks per set, the Hokies also led opponents compared to 1.82 by opponents
