# NEED TO KNOW

- Duke is back on the road for ESPN's Big Monday to battle Virginia Tech at Cassell Coliseum. >> The Blue Devils, playing their first of three Saturday-Monday sets in ACC play, are coming off
- a 68-66 win over No. 17 Miami Saturday at Cameron Indoor, where Duke is 10-0 this season. The game vs. the Hurricanes was Duke's third straight against a team that entered in first
- or second place in the ACC -- the Blue Devils went 2-1 in that stretch. Freshman Kyle Filipowski, who last week was named ACC Rookie of the Week for a league-
- leading fifth time, has scored 63 points and grabbed 43 rebounds in posting three straight double-doubles, including a monster 28-15 effort vs. Pitt to become just the third Duke freshman all-time with at least 28-15 in a game.
- Filipowski is fifth in the ACC, 29th nationally and leads all power conference freshmen in rebounds (9.5). His nine double-doubles are tied for third in the ACC and lead all D-I freshmen.
- Filipowski is averaging 15.0 points and 10.0 rebounds in ACC play -- one of just four players averaging 15-10 in conference play.
- Junior guard Jeremy Roach (right) returned Saturday from a three-game absence (toe injury) and scored 14 points with four assists and two late steals to seal the Miami win.
- Filling in for Roach, freshman guard Tyrese Proctor has scored double digits in three straight games, including a career-high 17 points at Clemson and 14 in the Pitt win.
- Duke has out-rebounded 15 of its first 19 opponents and is 13-2 this season when holding an advantage on the glass. Duke is 11-2 when leading in offensive rebounding.
- The ACC's best rebounding team, Duke ranks fourth nationally in rebound margin (+8.8), ninth in offensive rebounds (13.7) and 10th in rebounds per game (40.0) -- leading the conference in each category. Duke has not finished as the ACC's team leader in rebounds since 1998-99.
- Duke is the nation's only team ranked inside the NCAA's top 10 for each rebound margin, offensive rebounds and total rebounds.
- Duke has held 17 of 19 teams below their season scoring average, ranking second in the ACC and 35th nationally in scoring defense (63.5) and 27th nationally in three-point defense (.295).

- VT has lost seven straight, including one in overtime, by a combined 35 points entering Monday's game.
- Sean Pedulla's 15.9 points leads the Hokies in scoring, while Grant Basile (13.8) and Justyn Mutts (13.1) are the others averaging in double figures.
- Hunter Cattoor, who scored 31 points in last year's ACC Championship game win over Duke on his way to Tournament MVP honors, returned Wednesday after a four-game injury absence.
- As a freshman, Jeremy Roach poured in a career-high 22 points in Blacksburg on Jan. 12, 2021, shooting 6-of-14 from the field and 8-of-8 at the free throw line -- 74-67 Hokie win.

# Scheyer In First Season as Head Coach

- » Former Duke All-American and two-time team captain **Jon Scheyer** is the 20th head coach in Duke's storied basketball history. He was named to the position on June 4, 2021, succeeding Hall of Famer **Mike Krzyzewski**, who announced in June 2021 his plan to retire from coaching following the 2021-22 season.
- » The 35-year-old Scheyer is among the youngest head coaches in Division-I men's basketball, and the youngest at a power conference institution. He was named to *The Athletic*'s 40 Under 40 in college sports in 2022, and was previously touted as one of the best assistant coaches in college basketball.
- » He has vast experience on the Duke bench, having served on Krzyzewski's staff since the 2013-14 season. His previous roles with the Blue Devils include special assistant, assistant coach and the previous three years as associate head coach.
- » As a player, Scheyer sparked the Blue Devils to two ACC championships and the 2010 NCAA title as a player from 2007-10. Over his previous nine years on the coaching staff, he helped Duke compile a 245-71 (.775) record, a national championship (2015), two Final Fours (2015, 2022) and two ACC Tournament crowns (2017, 2019).
- » The Northbrook, III., native has been integral in the recruiting and development of several young Duke stars since joining the staff, and landed the nation's No. 1-ranked recruiting class for the 2022-23 campaign. Duke announced its five-man 2023-24 class this week, which includes five top-50 players and is currently ranked as the No. 2 class by ESPN and 247Sports.
- » Duke has signed a top-three recruiting class per ESPN in every season since Scheyer joined the staff, including the No. 1 class five times in 10 seasons (2014, 2015, 2017, 2018, 2022).
- » Among Scheyer's personnel moves in June were the hiring of Jai Lucas as an assistant coach and the promotion of Amile Jefferson to assistant coach. Scheyer also added Mike Schrage as special assistant to the head coach and Rachel Baker as general manager.

# Roach Returns; Duke Beats No. 17 Miami at Cameron

- » Junior Jeremy Roach returned from a three-game absence (toe injury) and scored 14 points with four assists and two crucial steals in the game's final 2:30 to seal the 68-66 victory over No. 17 Miami on Saturday.
- » The game marked the 500th consecutive sellout at Cameron Indoor Stadium -- the all-time NCAA record per Yahoo.
- » Freshman Kyle Filipowski recored his third straight double-double with 17 points and 14 rebounds and was 4-of-4 at the free throw line in the closing 2:05.
- » Duke tallied a season-high eight blocked shots, including a career-high-tying five from freshman **Dereck Lively II**, who also recorded his first career double-digit rebound game with 10, including a career-high six offensive boards.
- » The Blue Devils held the high scoring Hurricanes to 12 points below their season average, matching Miami's season-low for points with 66.
- » Miami became the 17th opponent this season held below its season scoring average by Duke

# Blue Devils Allowing 63.5 Points -- Second in ACC and 36th Nationally in Scoring Defense; 27th Nationally in Three-Point Defense

- » Duke is second in the ACC and 36th nationally in scoring defense, yielding just 63.5 points per game. Fourteen of the first 19 opponents have been held to less than 70 points, while seven have failed to score more than 60.
- » Duke has held 17 of the 19 opponents to below their season scoring average -- Duke is 14-3 in those games. Seven scored their then-season low for points, including holding lowa to a then-season-low 62, Xavier to 64 (20 points below its average) and Miami to a season-low tying 66 (12 off its scoring average).
- » Duke's strong defensive numbers come against a schedule rated 24th-toughest versus opponent offenses (per KenPom).
- » Ten opponents this season have failed to top 30 percent from behind the arc, as Duke is second in the ACC and 27th nationally in three-point defense (.295).
- » Four of the ACC's most explosive scorers -- Miami's Isaiah Wong, Clemson's Hunter Tyson and Chase Hunter and Pitt's Blake Hinson -- have been bottled up by the Blue Devils over the last three games to the tune of 29 combined points (7.3 per player) on 8-of-32 (.250) combined shooting from the field and 4-of-14 (.286) from three-point range.

# Duke: Only Team Ranked in NCAA's Top 10 for Rebounds, Offensive Rebounds and Rebound Margin,

- » Duke has been among the nation's best rebounding teams this season, ranking third nationally in offensive rebounding percentage (38.8), fourth nationally in rebound margin (+8.8), ninth in offensive rebounds per game (13.8) and 10th in total rebounds per game (40.0) -- leads the ACC in each category.
- » Duke is the only team ranked inside the top 10 for each rebound margin, offensive rebounds and total rebounds.
- » Leading the ACC in rebounding, Duke is looking to finish as the conference's leader in total rebounds per game for the first time since 1998-99.
- » The Blue Devils have out-rebounded 15 of their first 19 opponents, including nine by double-digit margins. Duke opened the season with a double-digit rebound margin in each of the first six games -- the program record for longest such streak (at any point in a season). Duke had five-game streaks in 2017-18, 1998-98, 1962-63 and 1960-61.
- » Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Duke is 45-6 when out-rebounding its opponent (13-2 this season).
- » Offensive rebounding has been a significant strength, with Duke totaling 20+ on the offensive glass four times already -- the Blue Devils hadn't had more than 19 offensive boards in any game over each of the last two seasons.
- » Duke is +103 (251-148) in second-chance scoring this season and Duke is 10-3 in games this season when leading in second-chance scoring.
- » Individually, freshman Kyle Filipowski is 29th nationally and fifth in the ACC in rebounds (9.5) and leads all power conference freshmen. Graduate Ryan Young is 59th nationally (fourth in the ACC) in offensive rebounds (2.9) and is ranked No. 21 nationally in KenPom in offensive rebound percentage (15.3).

# **Bounce-Back Ability**

» Duke is 27-3 following a loss since the 2016-17 season, not dropping consecutive games since 2019-20 -- not including the 2020-21 COVID season.

» Over the last 25 seasons, Duke has lost by 20+ points in the regular season just six times, and is undefeated in the game to follow -- including the Jan. 7th win at Boston College.

# Filipowski's Big Week Leads to Fifth ACC Weekly Honor

- » Kyle Filipowski was named the ACC Rookie of the Week in men's basketball on Jan. 16 for the fifth time this season.
- » Filipowski had a monster outing in Duke's comeback win over Pitt on Jan. 11, scoring a career-high 28 points on 8-of-14 shooting and 11-of-13 from the free throw line, while matching his career-high with 15 rebounds.
- » He is now just the third Duke freshmen all-time to have at least 28-15 in a game, joining Marvin Bagley III who did it four times in 2017-18 and Jabari Parker, who did it once in 2013-14.
   » Flip is just the 13th player in Division-I to have at least 28-15 in a game this season (seventh power conference player) and the only freshman nationally to do so.
- » Fights just the istic player in Division to have at least 2010 in a game tins season (seventin power concernice player) and the only resin
   » Last Saturday at Clemson, Filipowski scored 18 points and grabbed 14 rebounds, both team-highs, for his eighth double-double.

   » The freshman is averaging 15.0 points and 10.0 rebounds in ACC play, joining three other players -- North Carolina's Armando Bacot, Florida State's Matthew Cleveland and Clemson's
- Hunter Tyson -- averaging at least 15-10 in conference play this season.
- » Filipowski is the first Blue Devil since Marvin Bagley III in 2017-18 record at least three consecutive games with at least 17 points and 14 rebounds.

# **Duke's Three-Point Streak**

- » Duke has connected on at least one three-pointer in 1,172 straight games, the second-longest streak nationally.
- » It has been more than 30 years since Duke was held without a three-point field goal -- Dec. 30, 1989, versus Hawai'i.

# Blue Devils Out-Dunking Teams 59-24

- » Duke has opened the season out-dunking the opposition 59-24, led by Dereck Lively II's 24 and Mark Mitchell's 17 slams.
- $\, \times \,$  Lively is 30-of-54 from the field with 24 of his first 30 career field goals being dunks.
- » The freshman Lively has been emerging as a rim protetor as well, blocking five shots Saturday vs. Miami to match a career high to go with a career-high 10 rebounds and six points in 18 minutes. Lively has blocked at least one shot in each of the 17 games played this season.

# A Season for Charity

- » Duke is 15th nationally and second in the ACC in free throw percentage, hitting .775 from the charity stripe. The Blue Devils have 10 games this season shooting .800+ at the free throw line -- each of the 10 have come over the last 17.
- » Individually, eight different Blue Devils are converting .700+ at the line.
- » Graduate Jacob Grandison has made each of his nine attempts this season, while freshman Darig Whitehead has converted 14-of-15 (.933) and freshman Tyrese Proctor has made 37-of-43 (.860).
- » Graduate Ryan Young had a streak of 19 consecutive free throws snapped at NC State -- the team's longest streak this season (Proctor hit 17 straight earlier). Young is 35-of-42 (.833).
- » In the last five minutes of games, Duke is 55-of-67 (.821) -- including going 5-of-6 in the final five minutes at BC -- a game Duke won, 65-64.
- » Grandison is 8-of-8 at the line in the final five minutes of game this season, with Proctor going 12-of-15 and **Kyle Filipowski** 13-of-15 -- including 4-of-4 in the final 2:05 to close out the 68-66 win over No. 17 Miami on Jan. 21.

# Duke's Depth is the Difference Maker

- » Seven different players have led the team in scoring over the last 13 games -- after Kyle Filipowski was the leading scorer in five of the first six.
- » Graduate **Ryan Young**'s 20-point, 12-rebound effort off the bench led Duke vs. Florida State on Dec. 31, while sophomore **Jaylen Blakes**' career-high 17 points off the bench at Wake Forest on Dec. 20 marked the first time in his career he led Duke in scoring. Freshman **Dariq Whitehead**'s thencareer-high 15 points came in his first career start on Dec. 10 vs. Maryland Eastern Shore -- a game in which Duke started five freshmen for the first time in program history.
- » Thanks to Young (20 points) and Whitehead (career-high 16), Duke racked up 46 bench points in the FSU win, the team's most bench points in an ACC game since 2005. It also marked the third-highest percentage of bench points in an ACC game in school history (53.5 percent).
- » The game at BC marked the Blue Devils' fifth different starting lineup this season. Blakes made his first career start against FSU and posted his second straight career-high 17-point effort, while Whitehead made his second career at BC and scored a career-high 18 points.
- Young pulled down 10 rebounds in the Pitt win on Jan. 11, including seven on the offensive glass, while Dereck Lively II played 12 minutes vs. Pitt and finished with a plus-minus of 17, including +15 in the second half in six minutes of game time -- two points, two rebounds, one assist, one steal, one block.
   Head coach Jon Scheyer has utilized five different starting lineups this season as Duke has navigated injury issues, including playing four games
- (three straight) without starting point guard Jeremy Roach with a toe injury. Roach returned Jan. 21 vs. Miami and scored 14 points with four assists and two steals.
- » Stepping up to handle point guard duties in place of Roach, freshman Tyrese Proctor scored a career-high 17 points at Clemson on the heels of 14 points, five assists and no turnovers vs. Pitt. Proctor added 11 points vs. Miami to post three straight double-digit scoring games for the first time this season.

# Cameron Indoor Stadium's 500th Consecutive Sellout

- » Duke has sold out 500 consecutive games at Cameron Indoor Stadium -- the all-time NCAA record per Yahoo.
- » The last time Duke played before a non-sold out crowd at Cameron was Nov. 16, 1990 against Boston College -- 11,754 days (as of Jan. 21, 2023).
- » The sellout figure is the longest current streak (by time) in either men's college basketball or the NBA.
- » Duke's record at Cameron during the sellout streak is 454-46.

# The Blue Devils Have Won Nearly 85% of Games at Cameron Indoor Stadium

- » Duke has posted an all-time record of 940-171 (.846) at Cameron Indoor, that included a 572-76 (.883) record under Coach K.
- » Duke has won more games at its current home venue than any team in college basketball.
- » Cameron celebrated its 83rd birthday on January 6 as the home of the Blue Devils.
- » Duke has averaged 11.1 wins since the venue opened January 6, 1940 -- a 36-27 win over Princeton.
- » The Blue Devils have 18 undefeated home seasons.
- » This season, Duke is 10-0 at home.

# Five on Preseason Positional Awards: Duke Lone Program with Player on Each

» The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame has announced its preseason watch lists for national positional awards, with five Blue Devils earning recognition:

- » Duke was the only team nationally to have at least one player on each of the five positional lists.
- » Filipowski remains on the midseason watch lists for the Wooden Award and Oscar Robertson Award, both presented to the player of the year in college basketball.
- » Last season, Wendell Moore Jr., was named the winner of the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year award.

# Current Freshman Class Ranked No. 1 Nationally; Next Year's Class Ranked No. 2 -- Duke's Ninth and 10th Consecutive Top-3 Class

- » In the first class recruited and signed by Scheyer, Duke's freshman class was ranked No. 1 in ESPN's 2022-23 class rankings.
- » Duke announced the signing of Scheyer's second class this week, which is on pace to finish No. 2 in ESPN's 2023-24 class rankings.
  - The current class is led by ESPN's overall top two players -- Dereck Lively II and Dariq Whitehead and was boosted even more when five-star guard Tyrese Proctor reclassified.
- » The class includes three McDonald's All-Americans (Lively, Mitcheal), three named the Gatorade Player of the Year in their state (Lively, Schutt, Whitehead) and three that participated in the Jordan Brand All-Star Game (Filipowski, Lively, Whitehead).
- » Next season's five-man class has each of the five ranked in 247Sports' top 25, with four in the top 20, led by the No. 5 overall player in forward Mackenzie Mgbako (pronounced "em-BAH-ko"). Three of the signees are ranked as the overall No. 1 player in their respective state - forward Sean Stewart (Florida), Caleb Foster (California) and TJ Power (Massachusetts). The class also includes the No. 18 overall player in guard Jared McCain.
- Including the 2023-24 class, Scheyer has helped Duke sign a top-three class in each of his 10 seasons on the staff, including the No. 1 class five times (2014, 2015, 2017, 2018, 2022).

- » Duke generated 613 million total impressions across all DukeMBB platforms, generating over \$4 million in brand value for Duke.
- » The program boasted 46.3 million social engagements across all platforms in 2022 -- a 51% increase from 2021 and tops in college sports.
- » It gained 390,644 followers (a 1003% increase in follower gain from 2021) and generated 148 million video views across all platforms (138% increase from 2021).

As a player, Scheyer sparked the Blue Devils to two ACC championships and the 2010 NCAA title as a player from 2007-10. In his previous time on the coaching staff, he helped Duke compile a 245-71 (.775) record, a national championship (2015), two Final Fours (2015, 2022) and two ACC Tournament crowns (2017, 2019).

The Northbrook, III., native has been integral in the recruiting and development of several young Duke stars since joining the staff, and landed the nation's No. 1-ranked recruiting class for the 2022-23 campaign.

Duke has signed a top-three recruiting class per ESPN in every season since Scheyer joined the staff, including the No. 1 class five times in nine seasons (2014, 2015, 2017, 2018, 2022).
